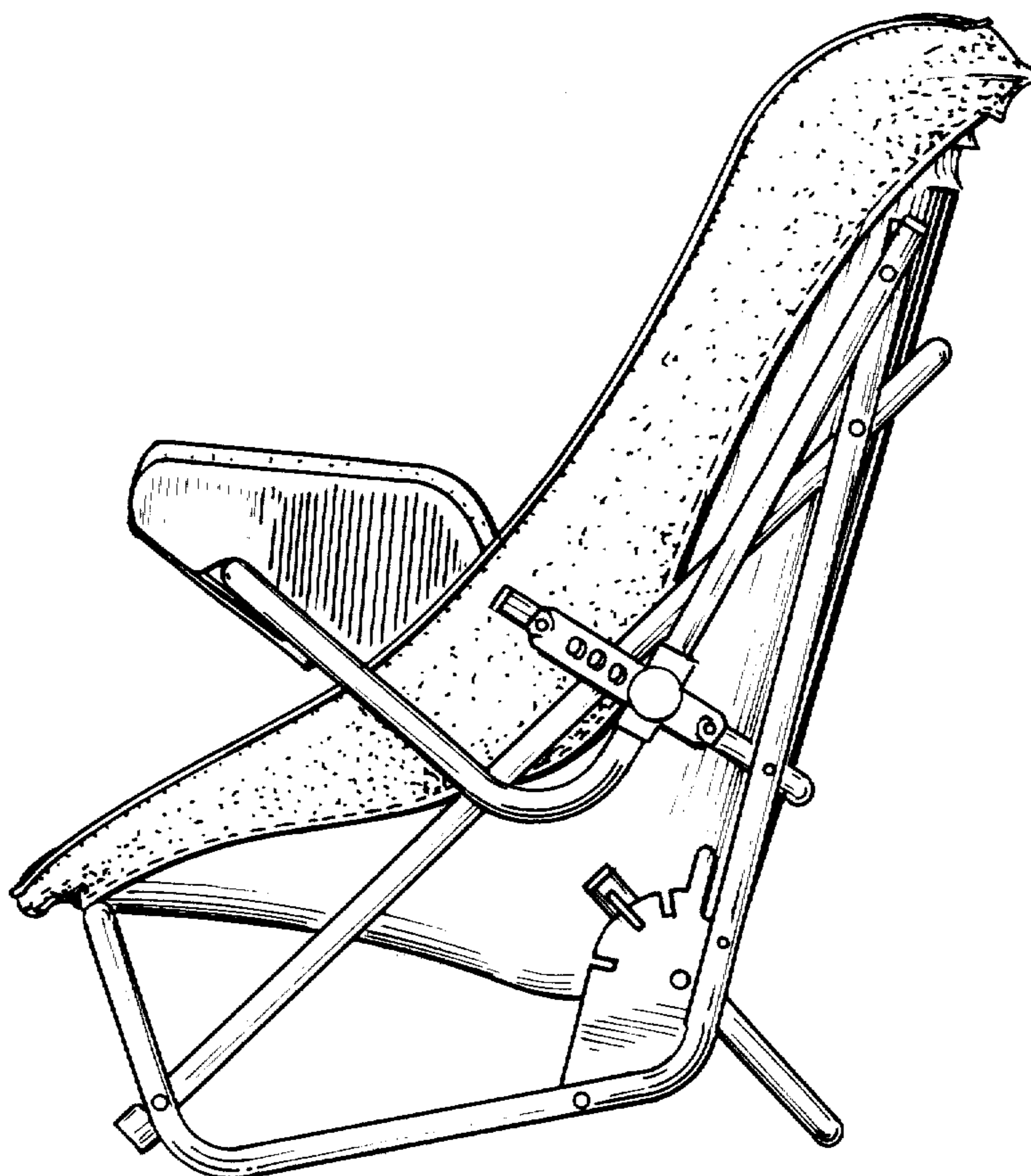

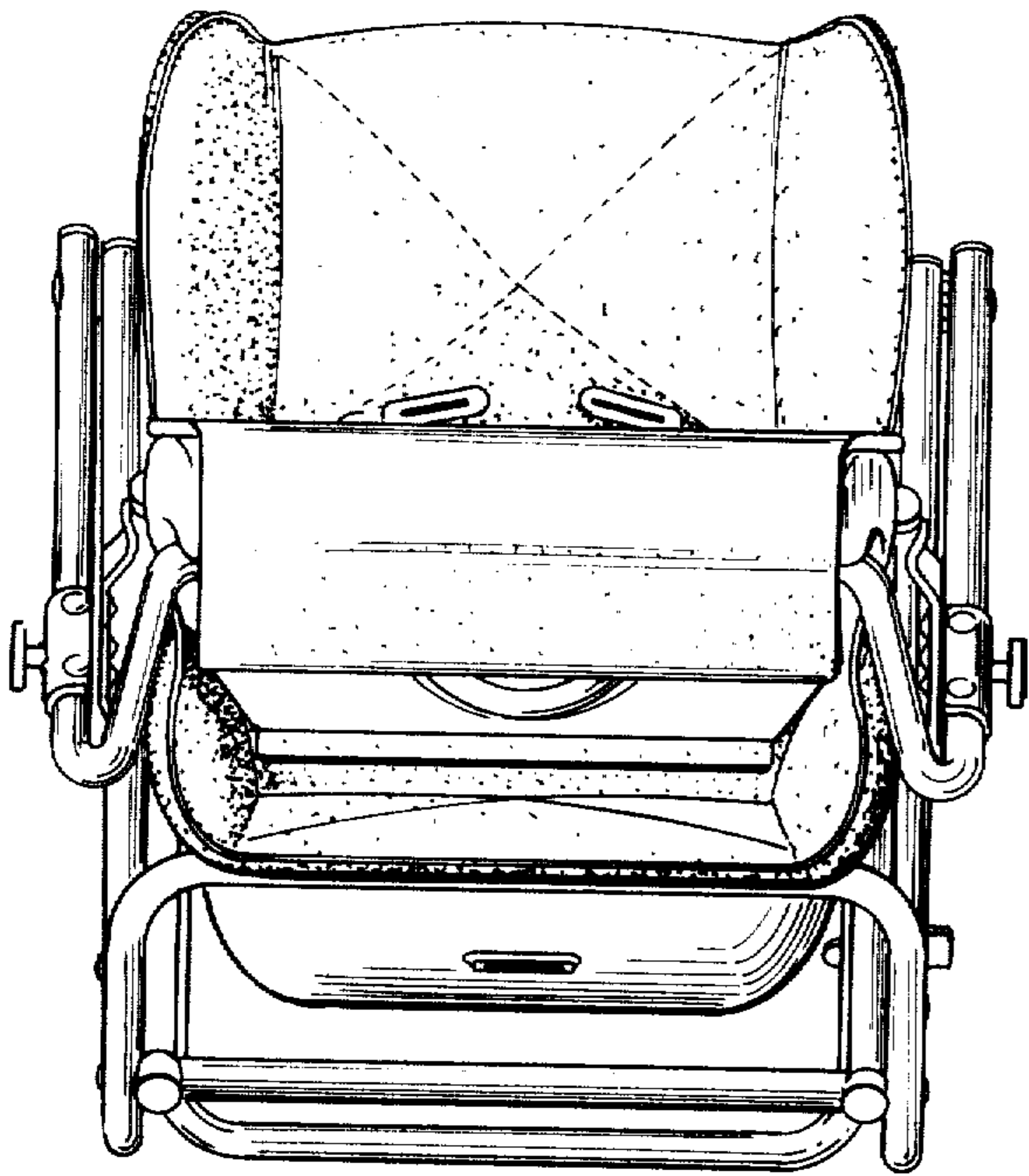

The ornamental design for a juvenile seat, as shown.

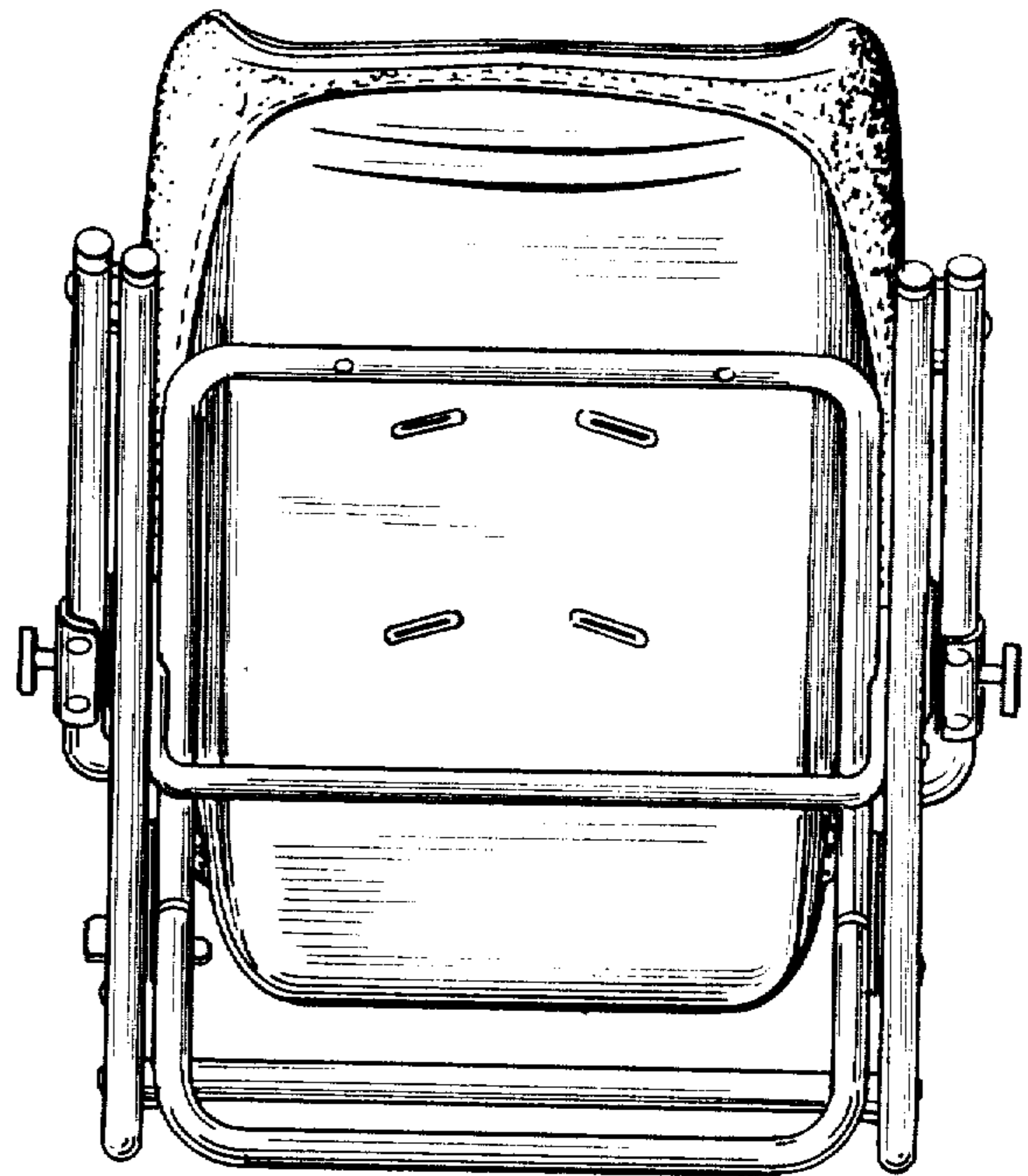
DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the juvenile seat showing one embodiment of our new design;

 FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view showing a storage position of the juvenile seat shown in FIG. 1.

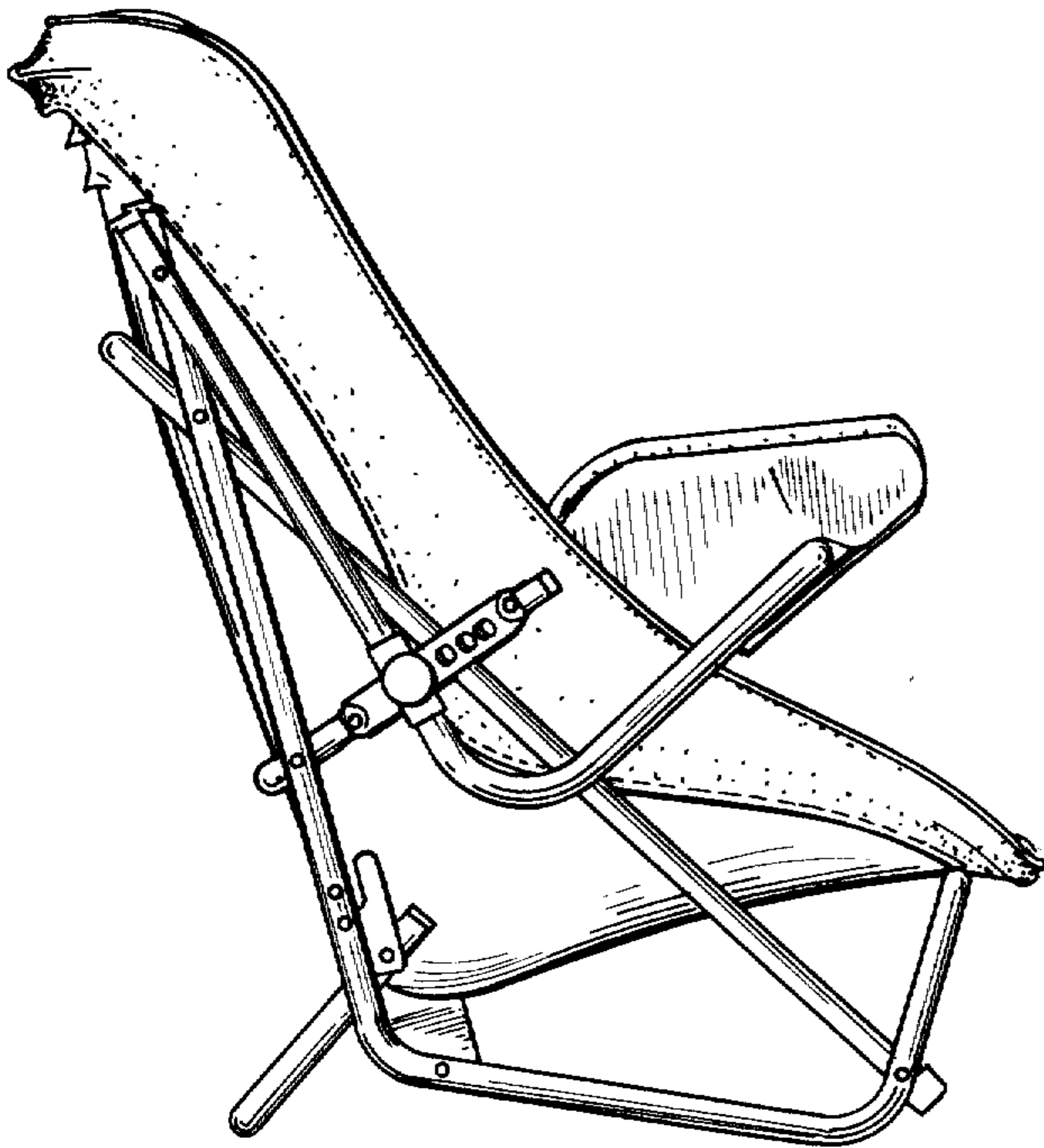




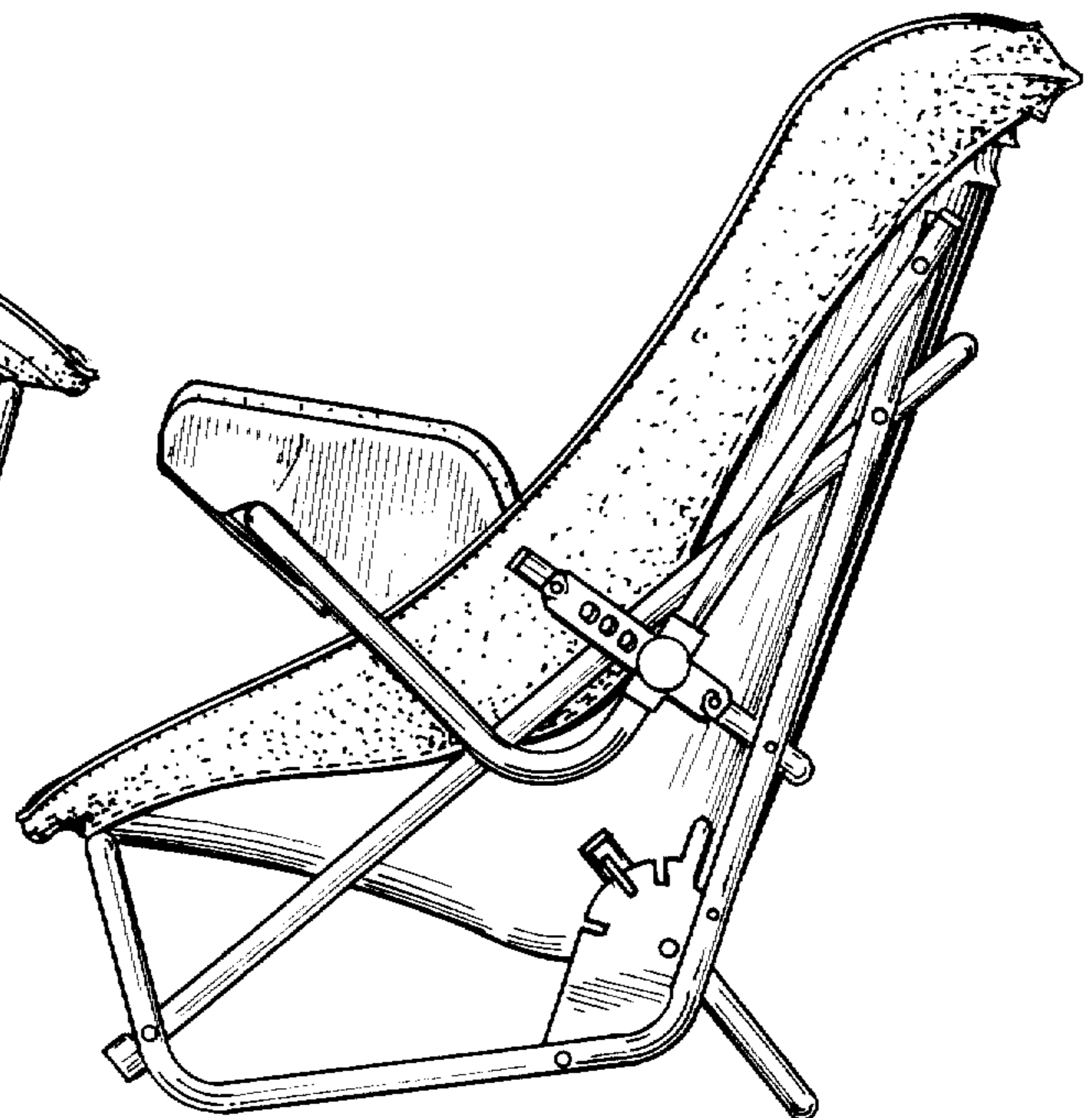

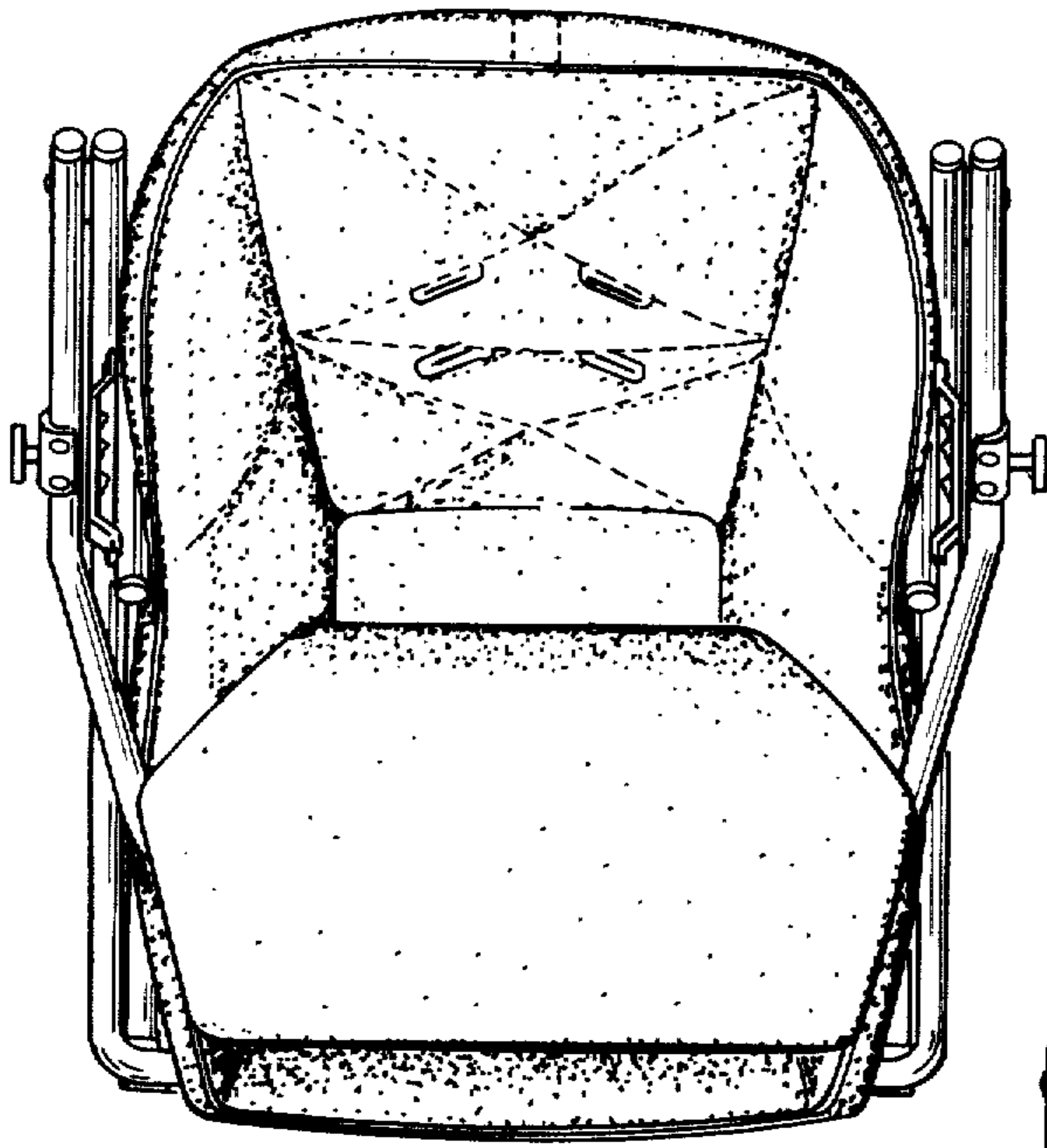

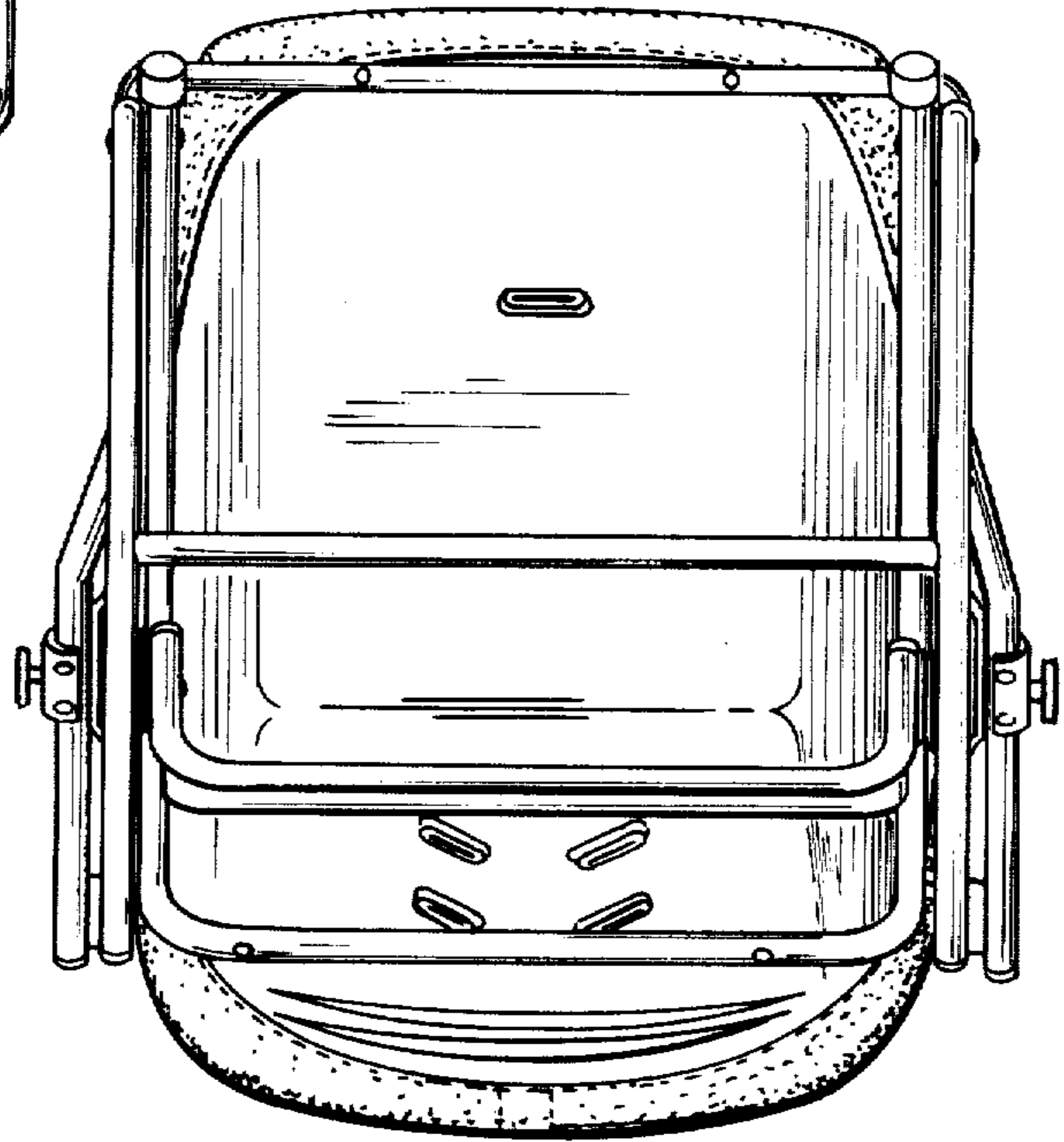

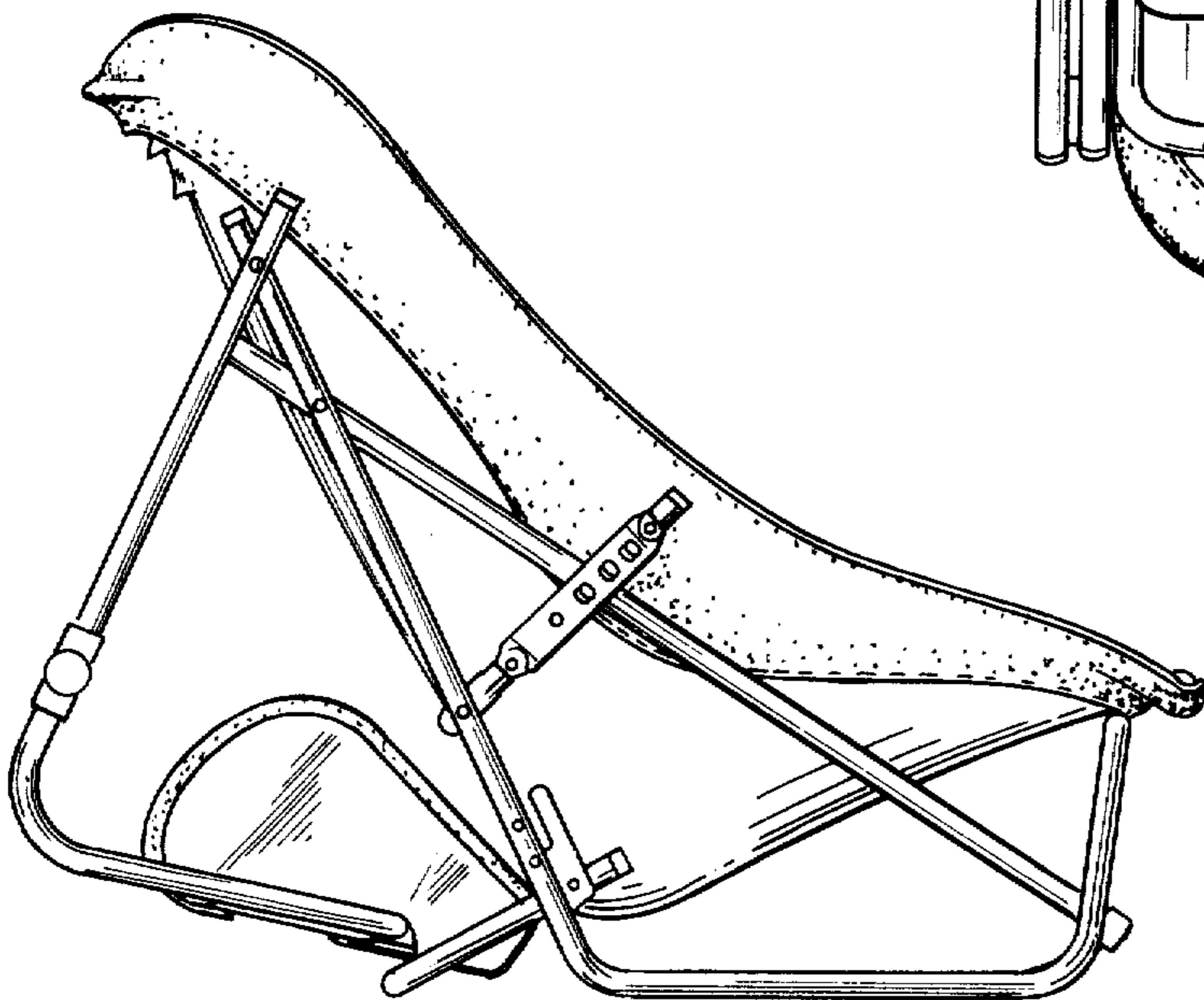
