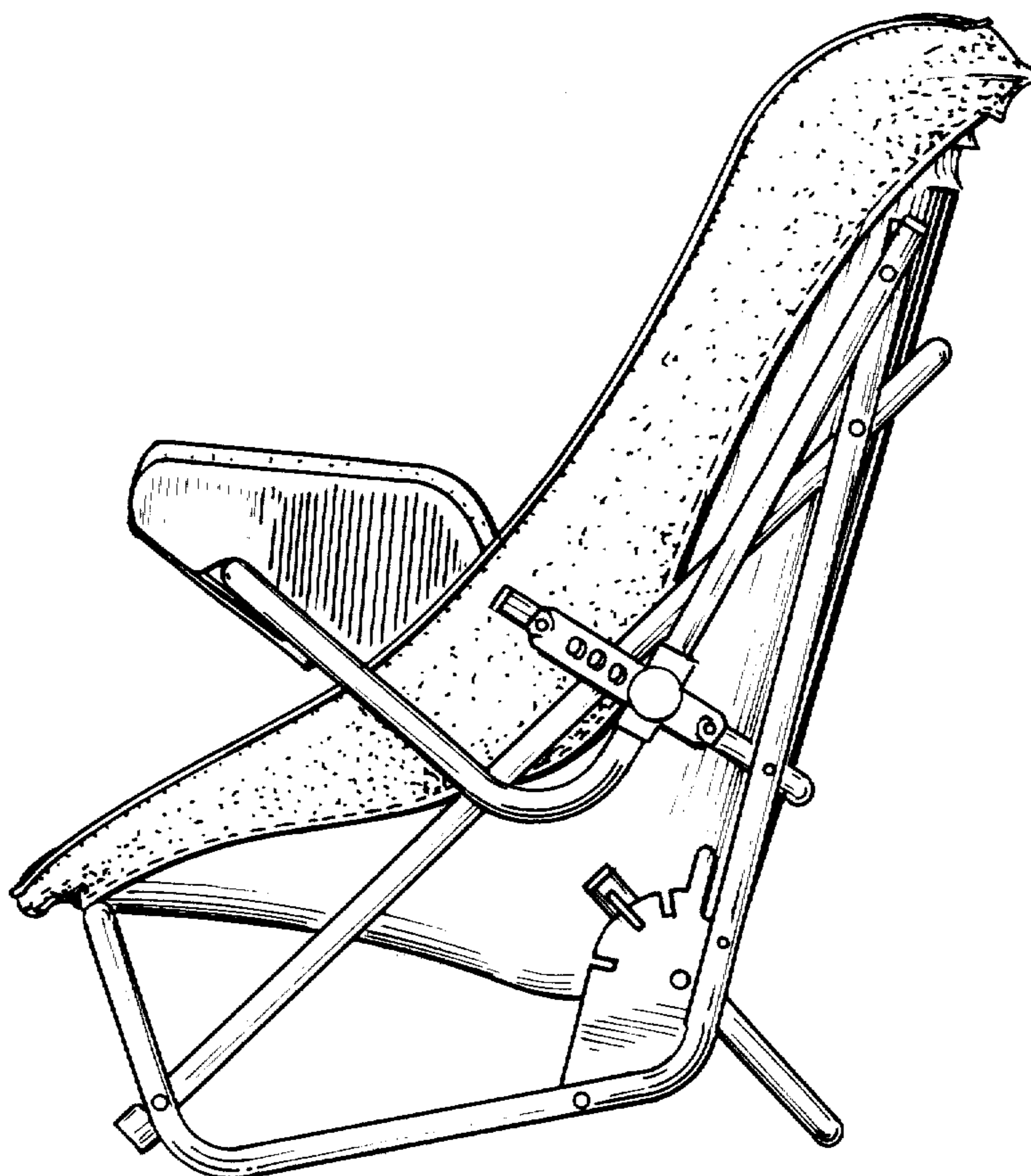

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of the juvenile seat showing one embodiment of our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a rear elevational view of the juvenile seat shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a left side elevational view of the juvenile seat shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a right side elevational view of the juvenile seat shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view of the juvenile seat shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view of the juvenile seat shown in FIG. 1; and
 FIG. 7 is a left side elevational view showing a storage position of the juvenile seat shown in FIG. 1.



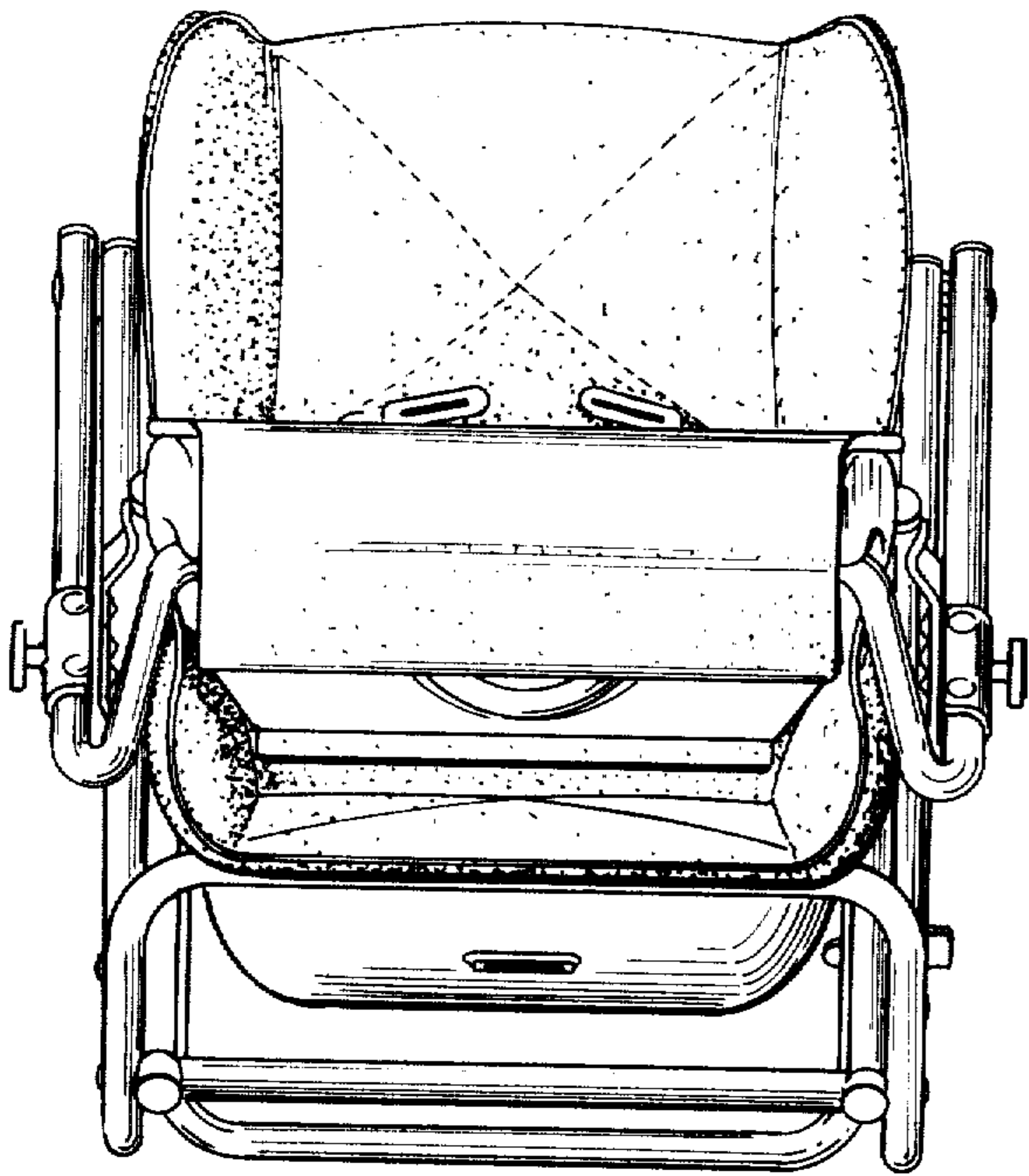

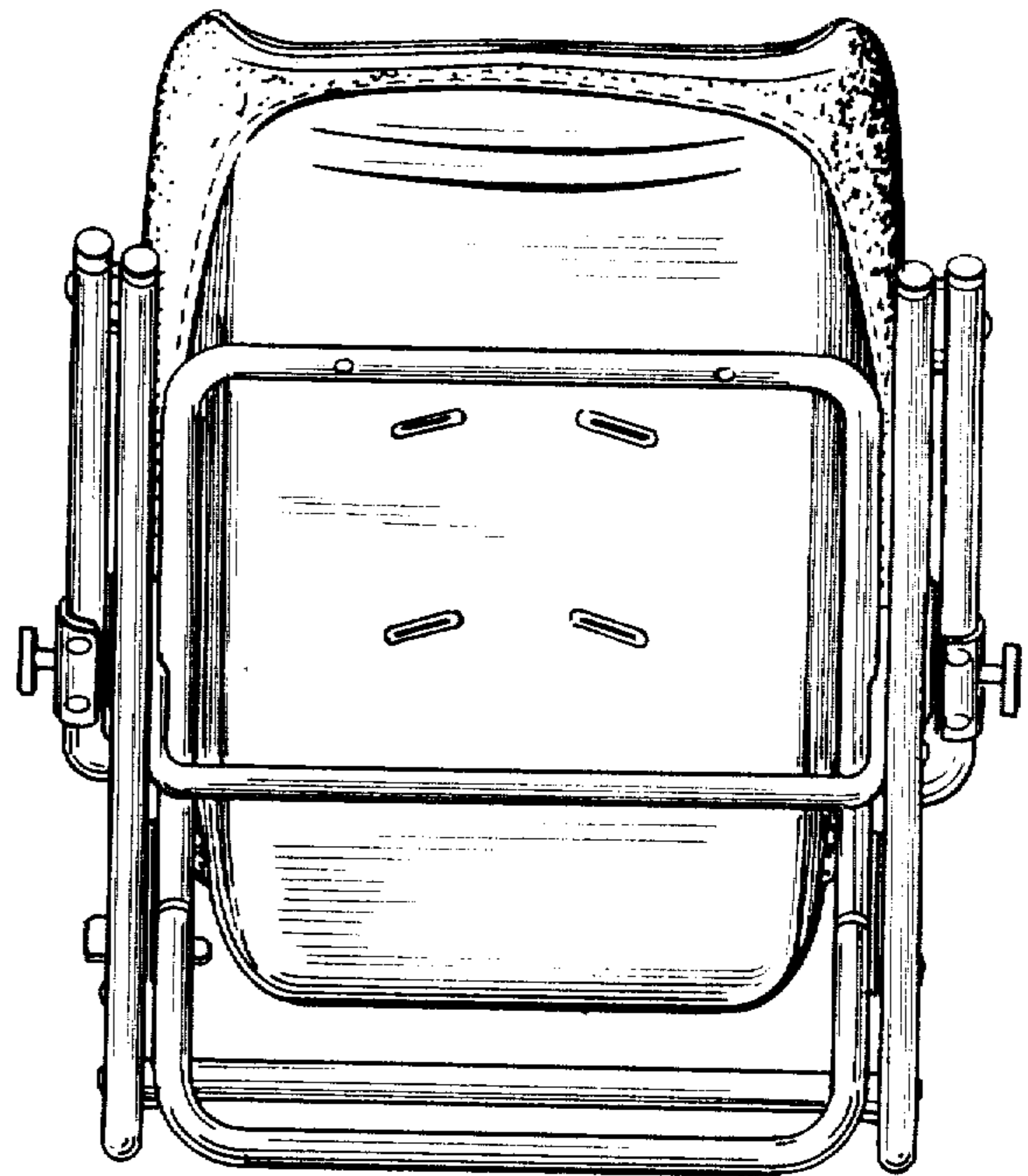

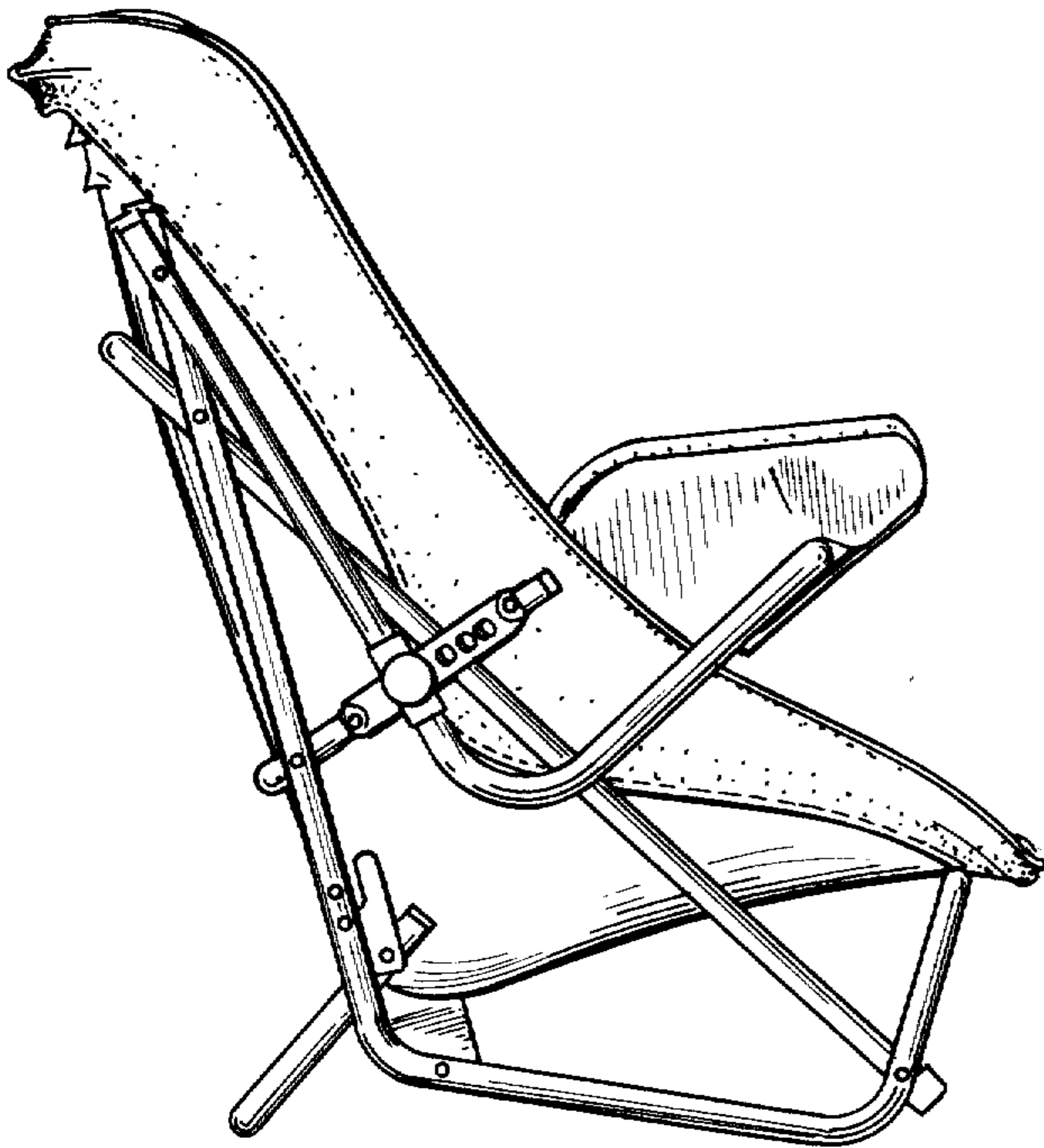

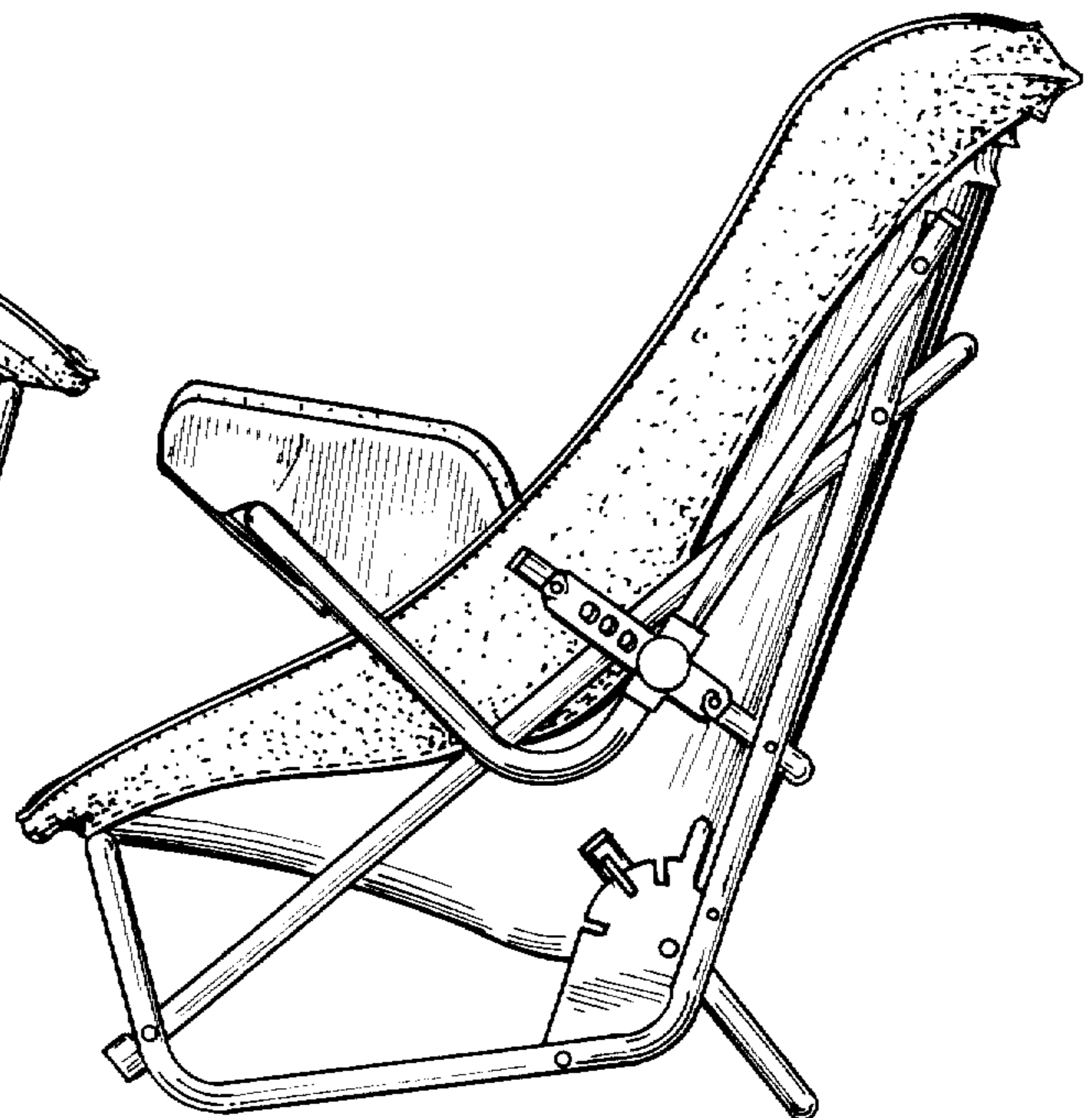

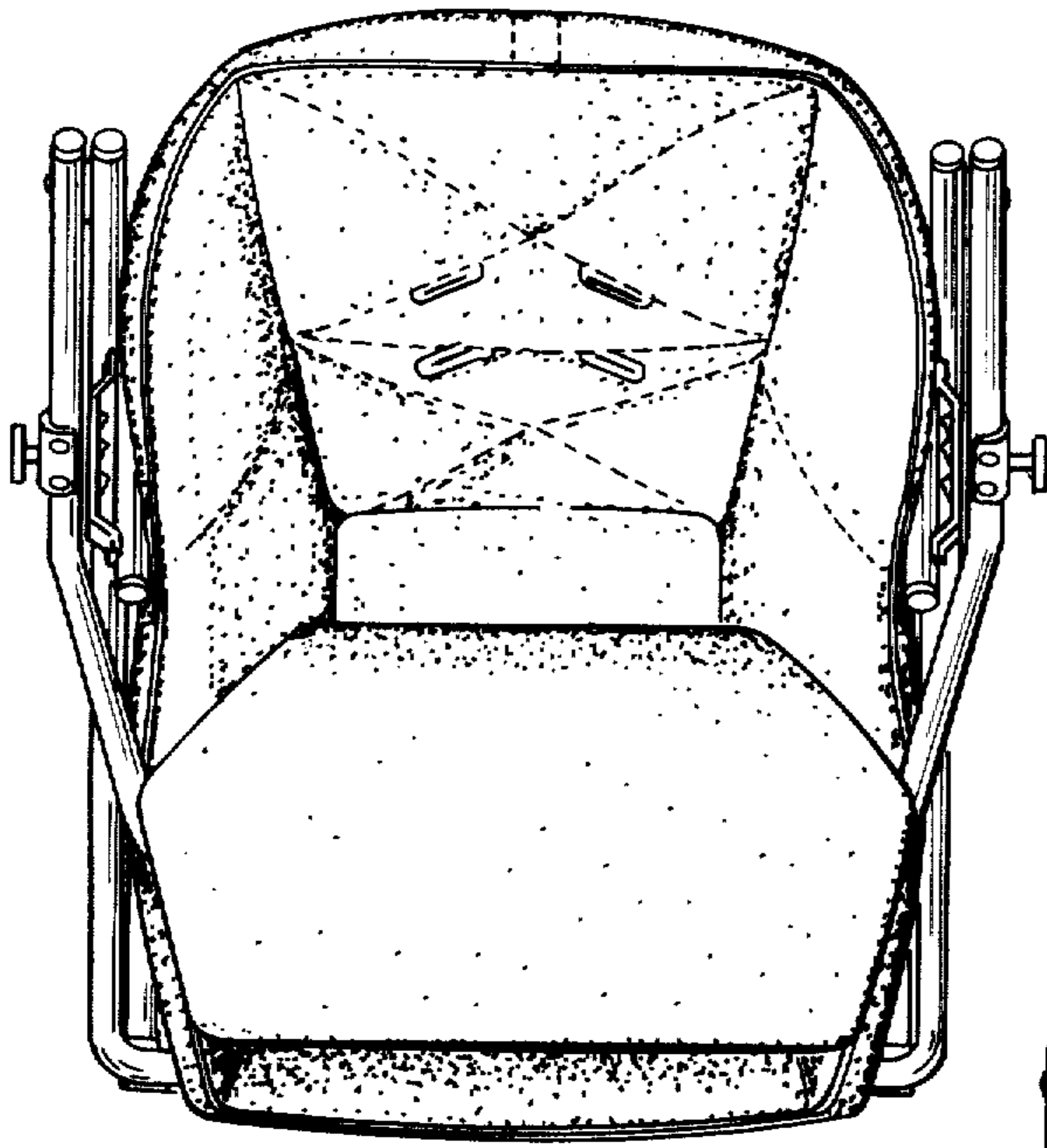

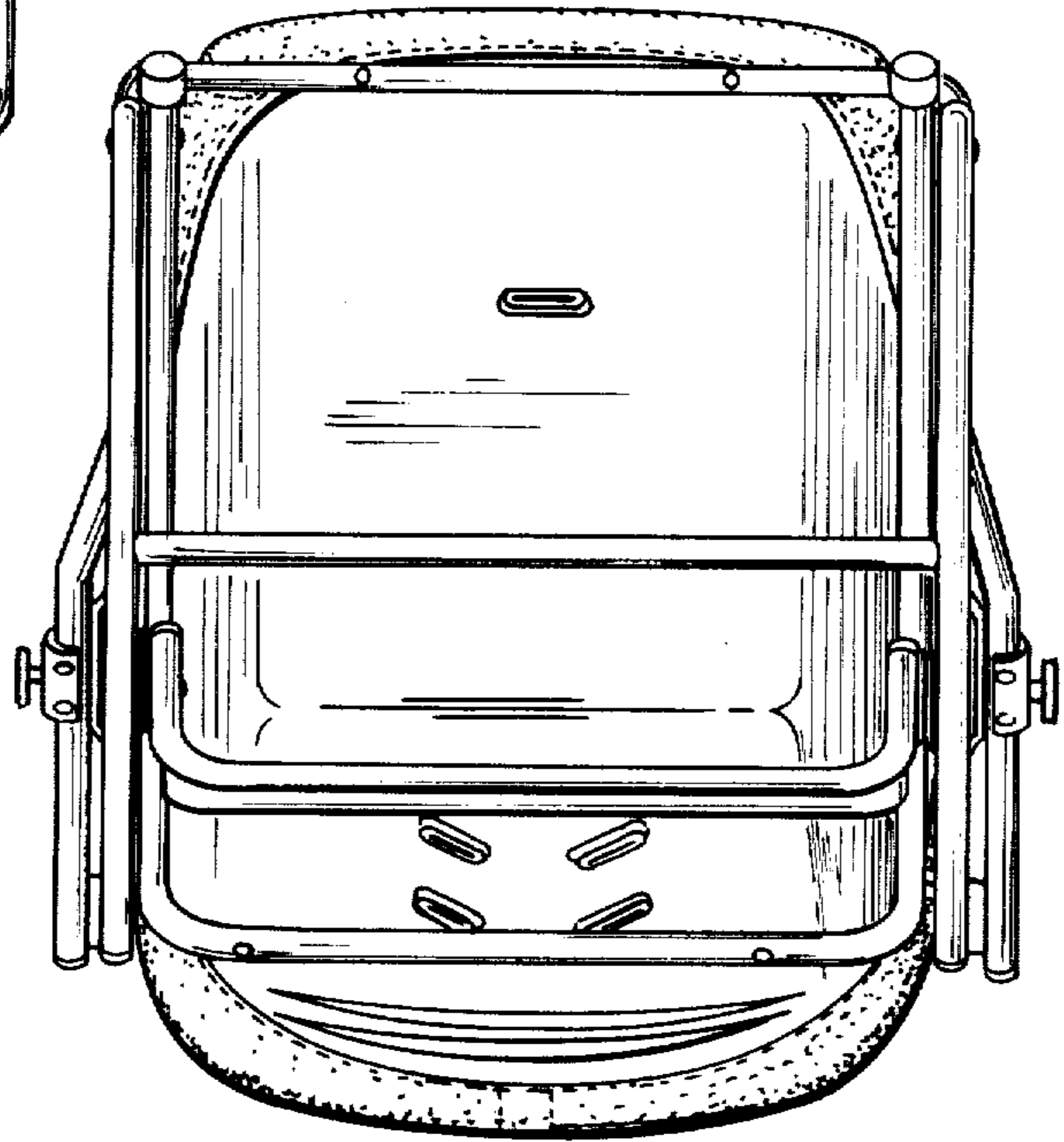

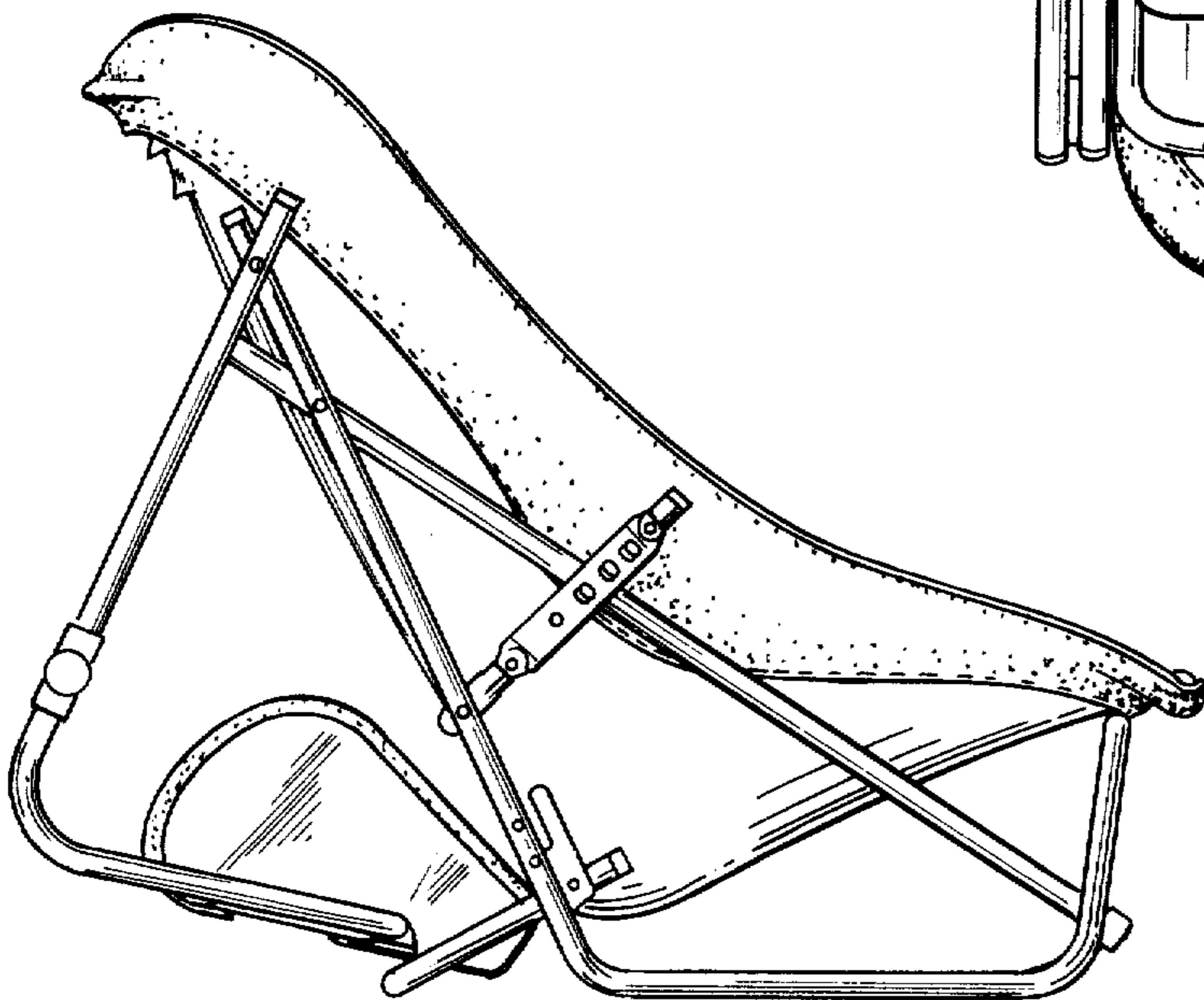
