DESCRIPTION

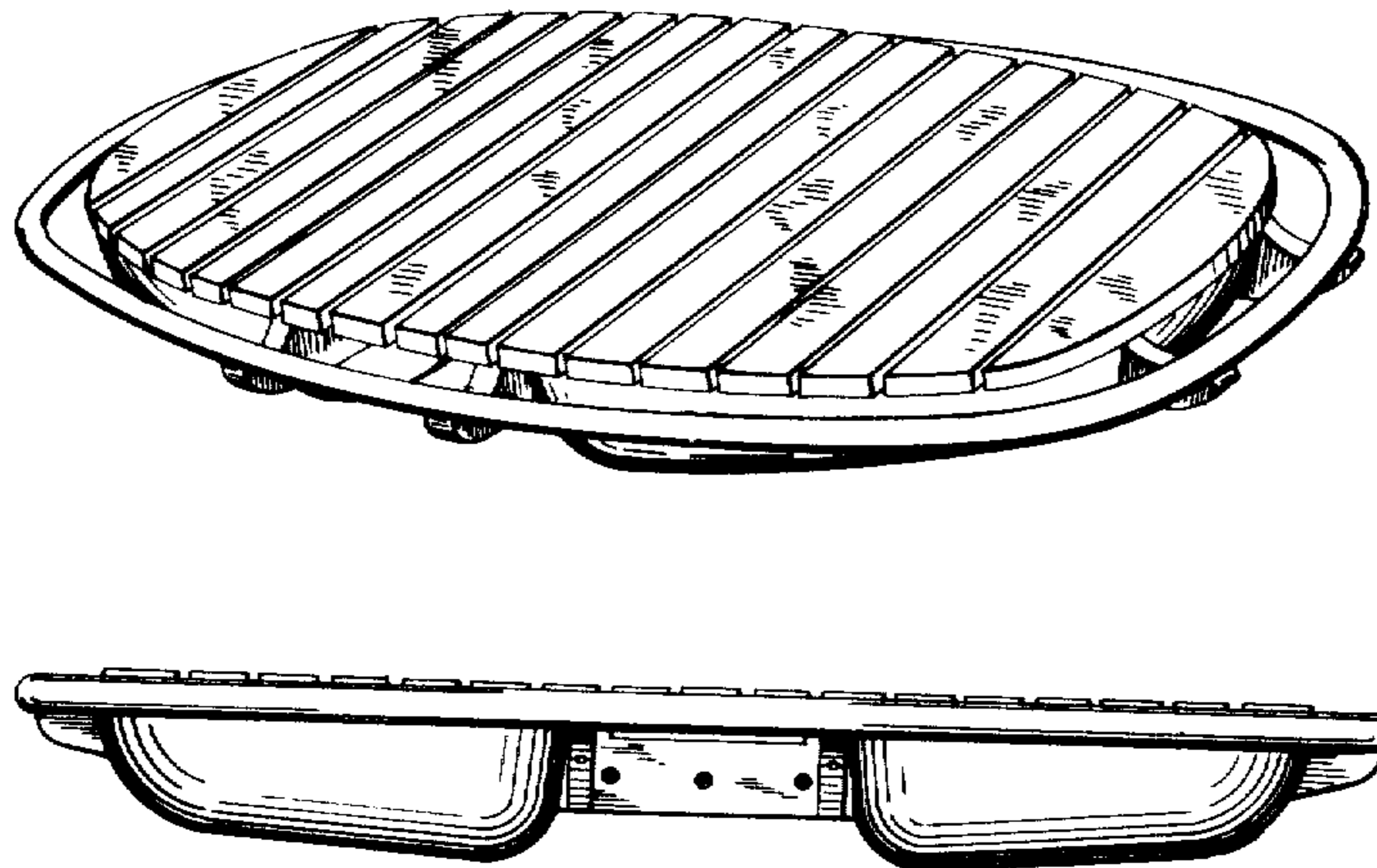
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a spa table showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



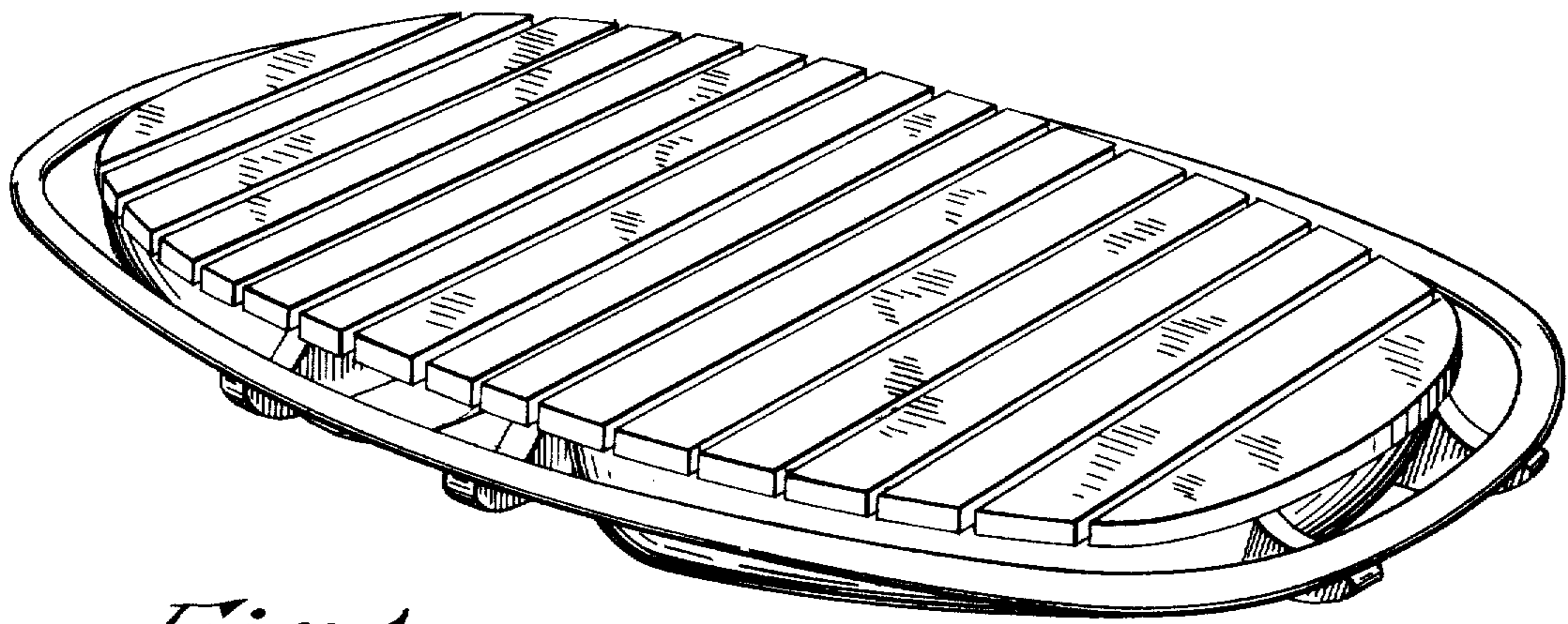

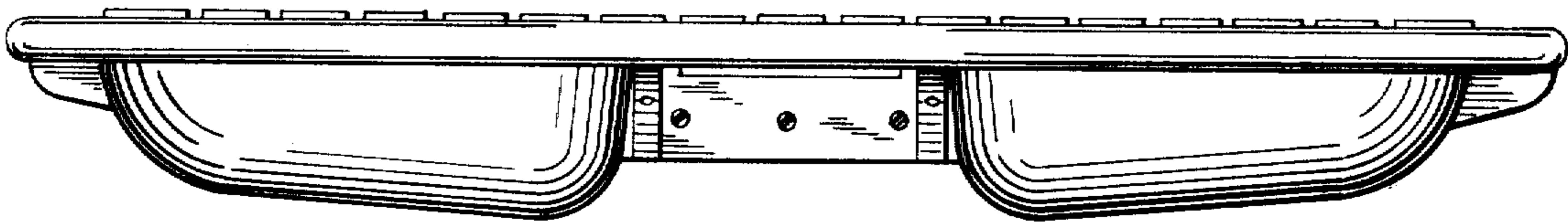
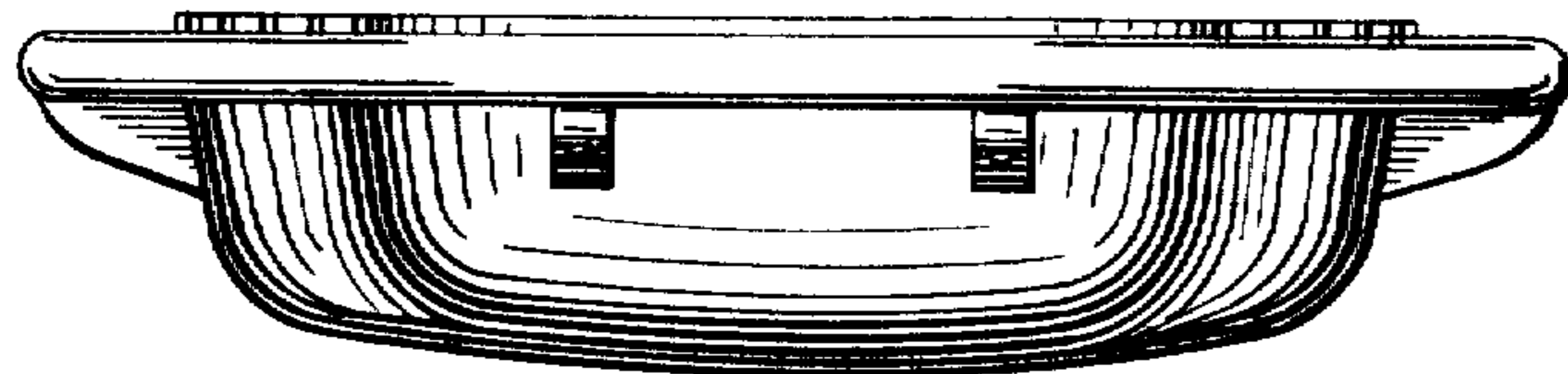

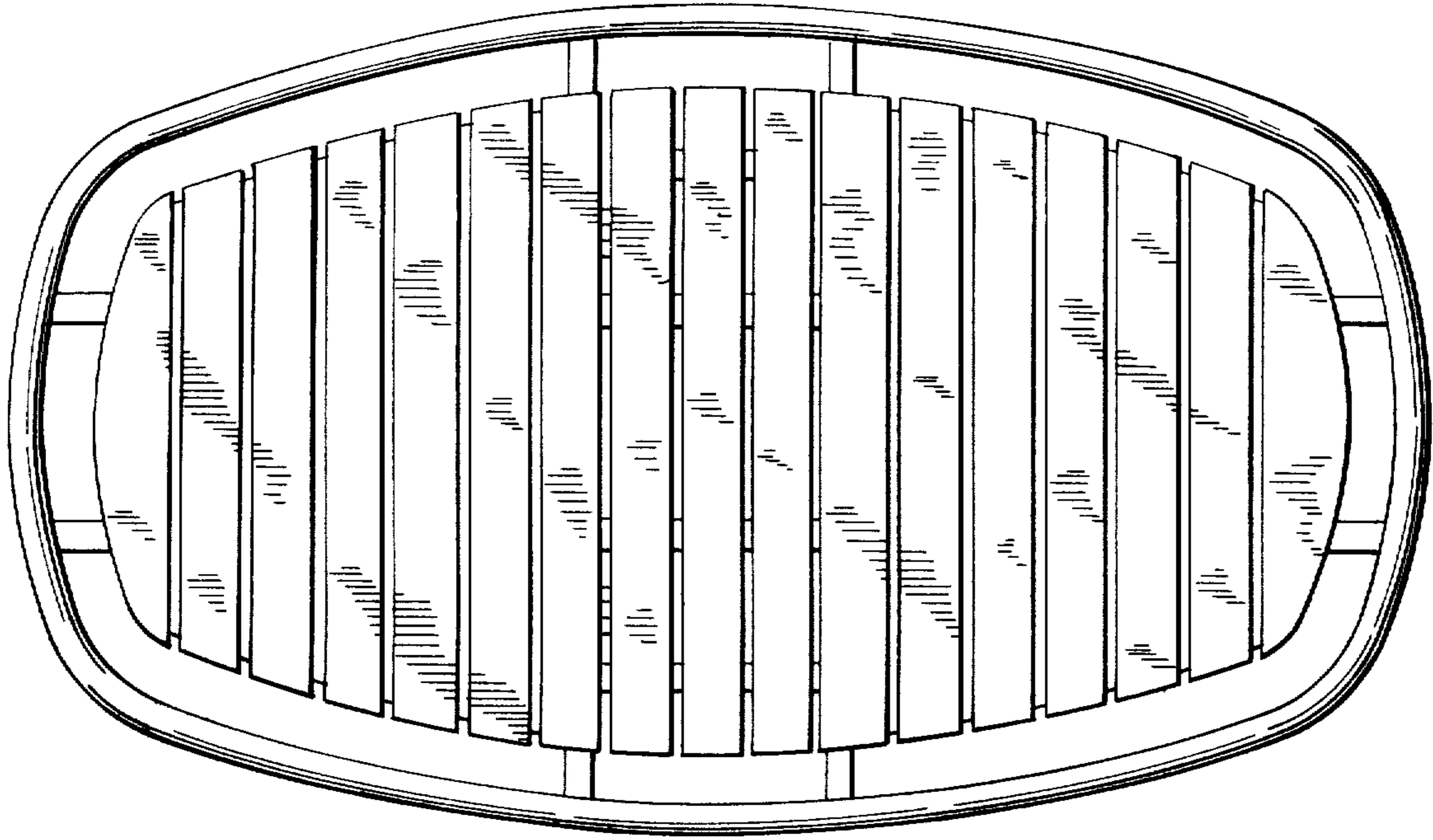

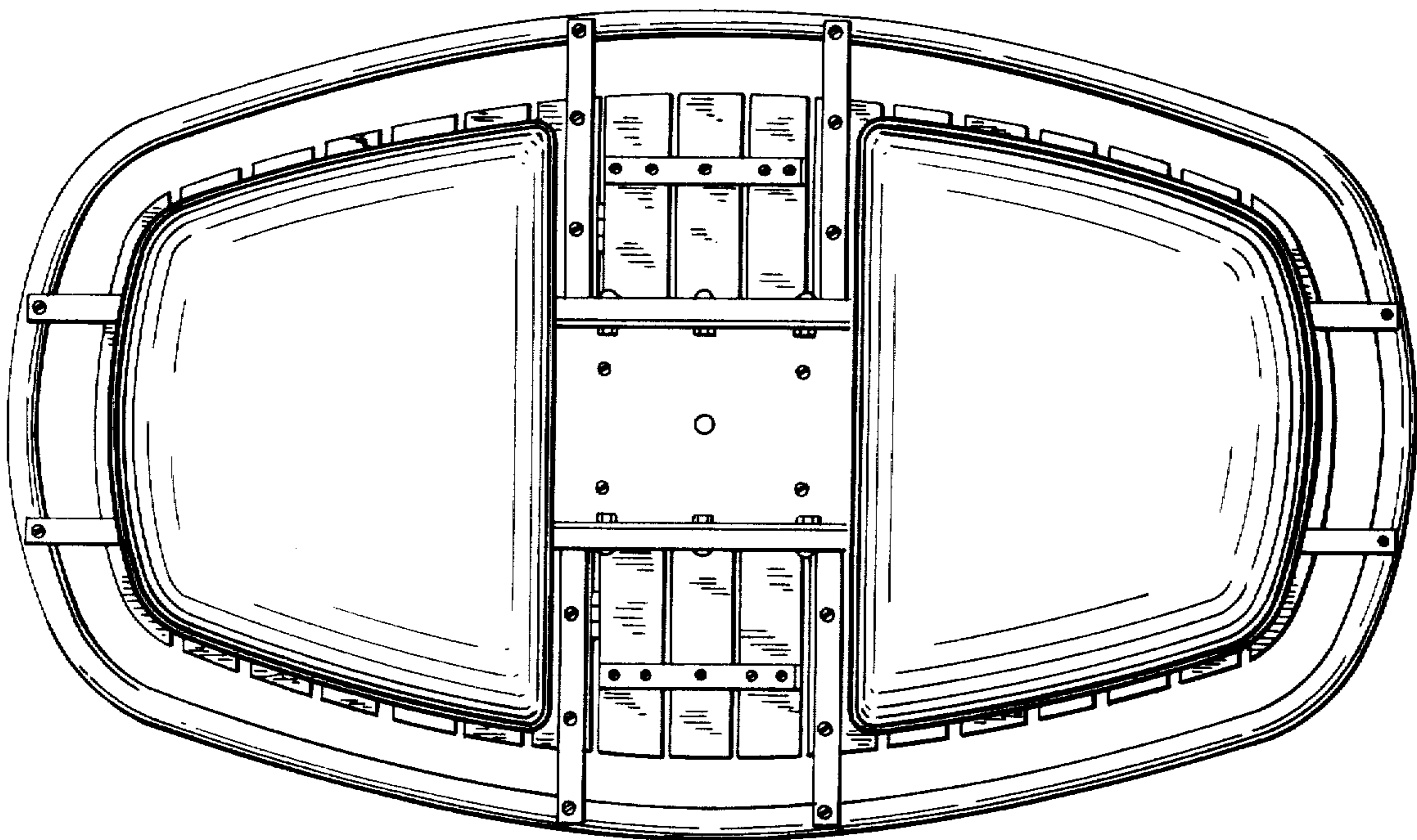
