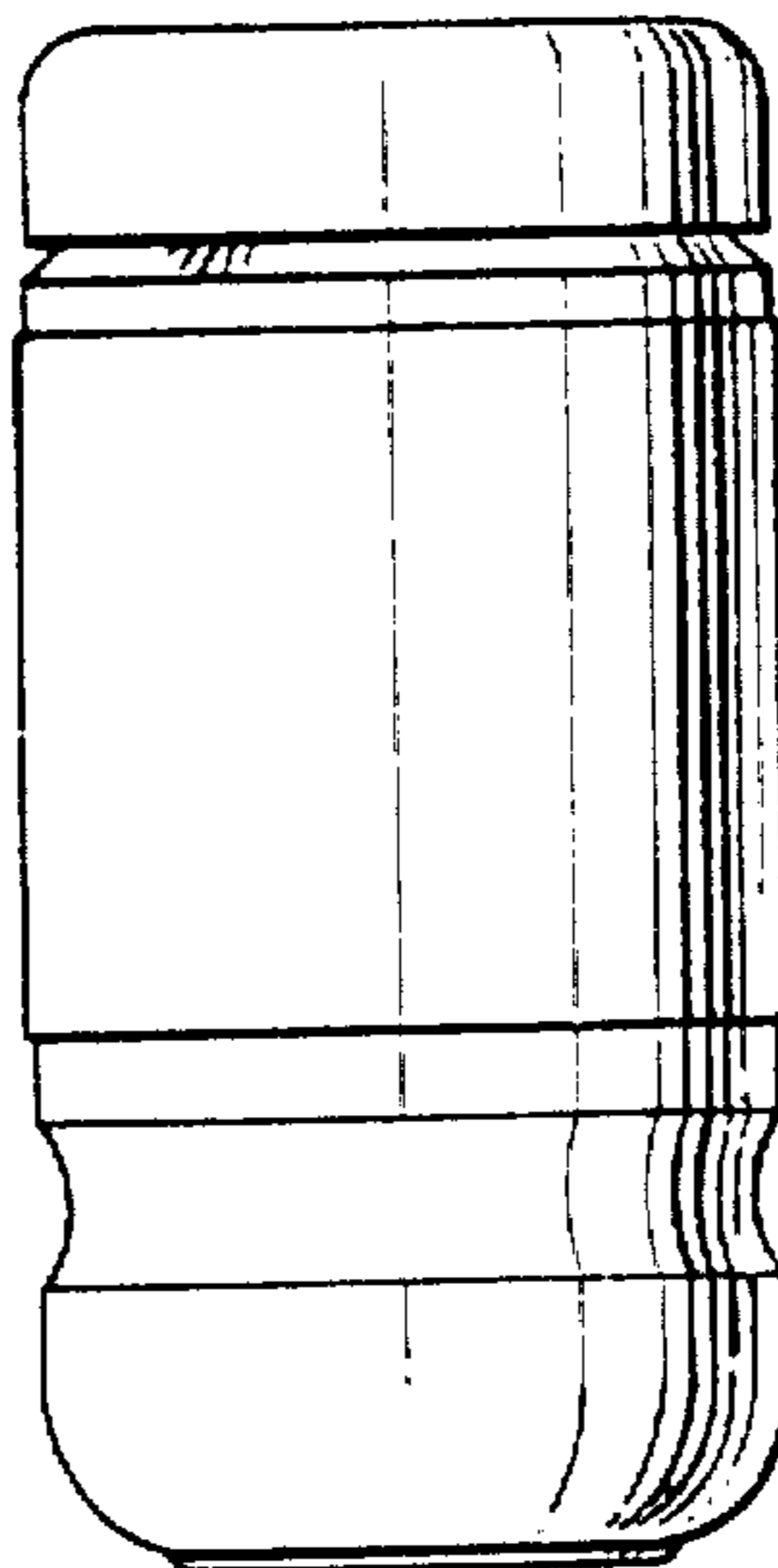

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined jar and lid, as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined jar and lid showing our new design;
FIG. 2 is a side elevational view, the opposite side being substantially the same in appearance;
FIG. 3 is a top plan view; and
FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.
Stippling is used in FIG. 1 for configuration clarity only.



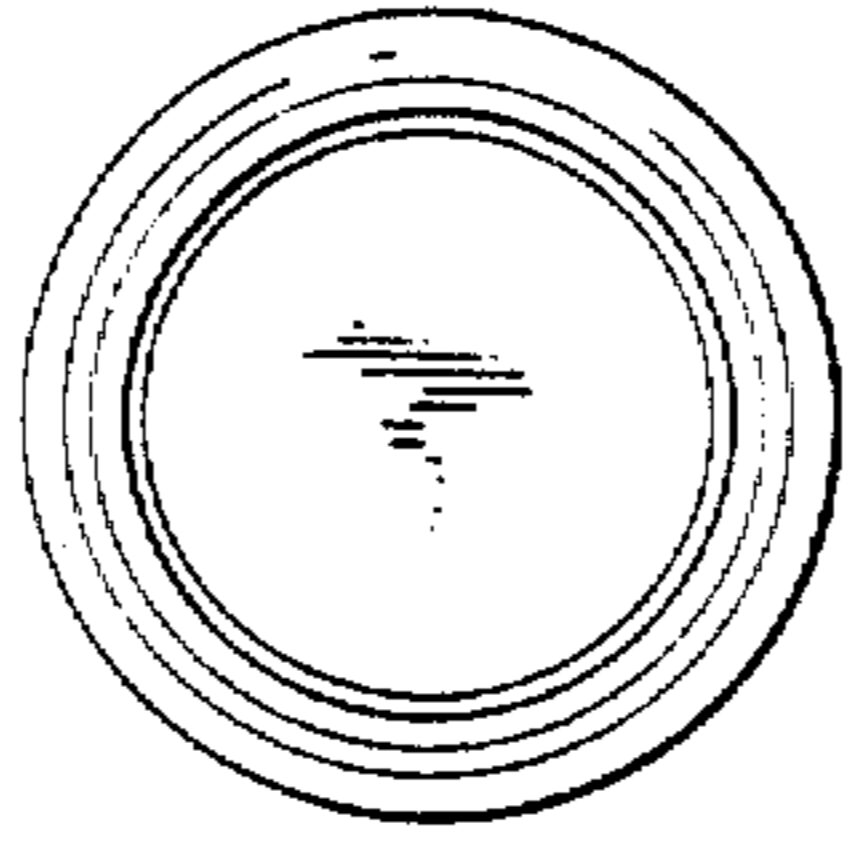

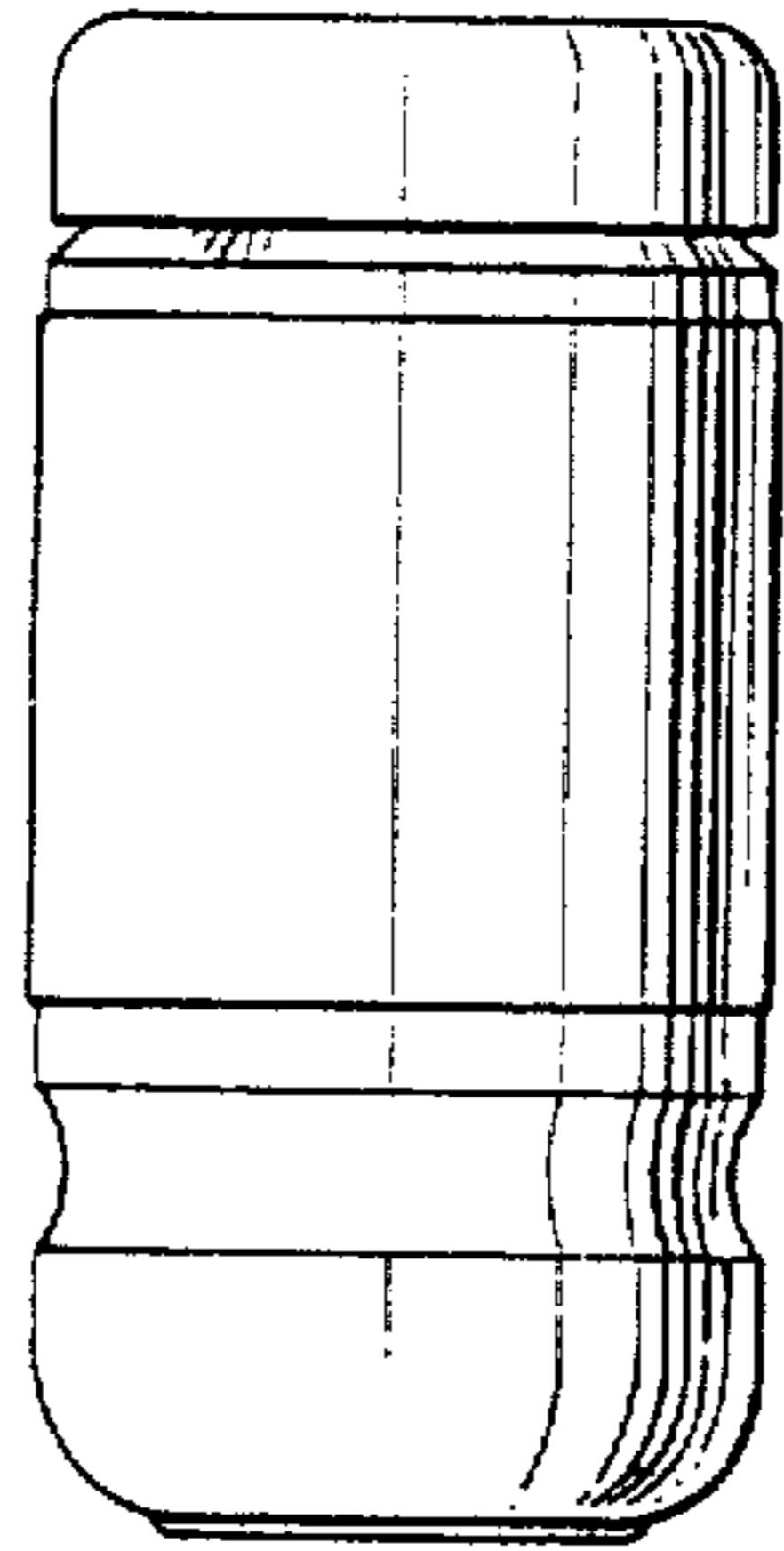

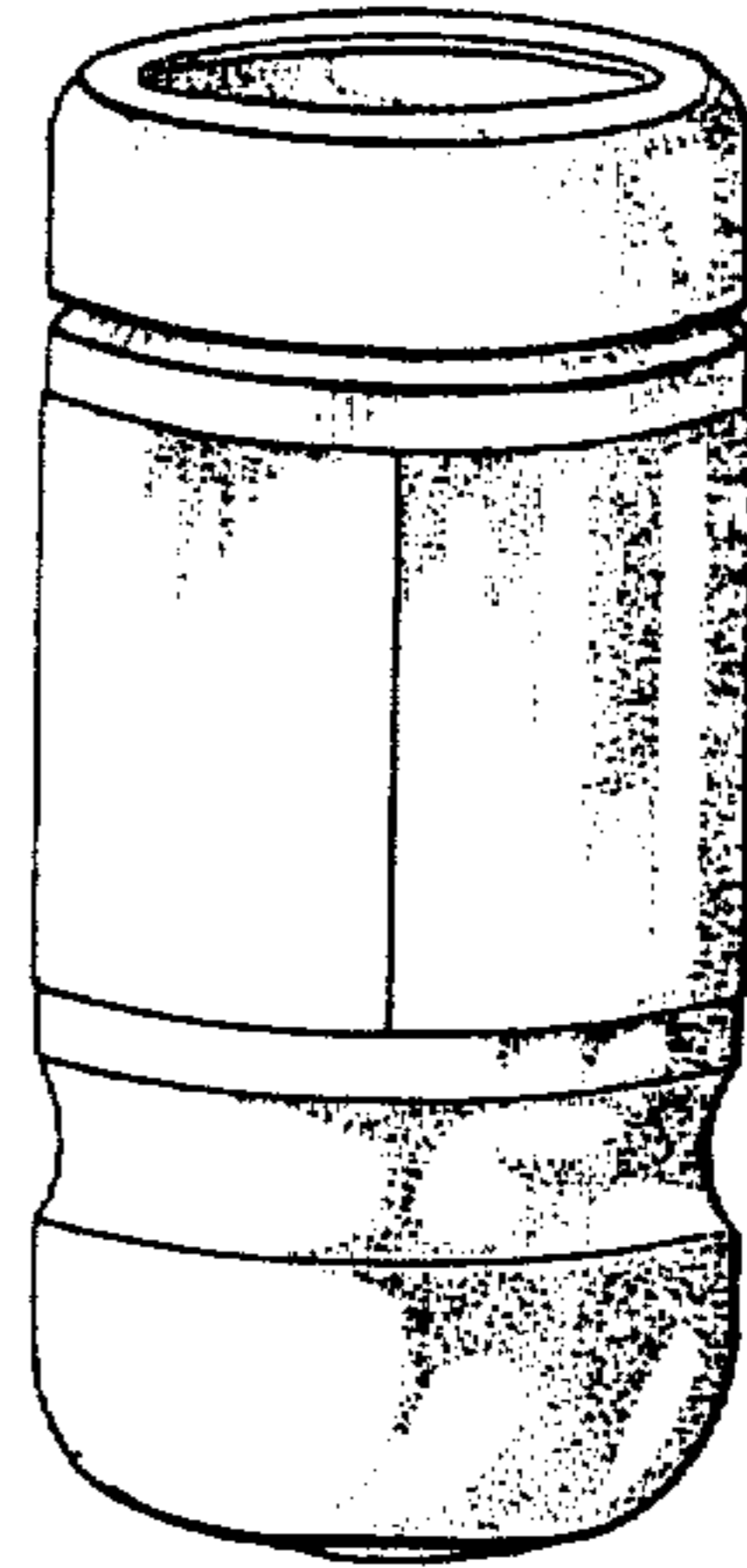

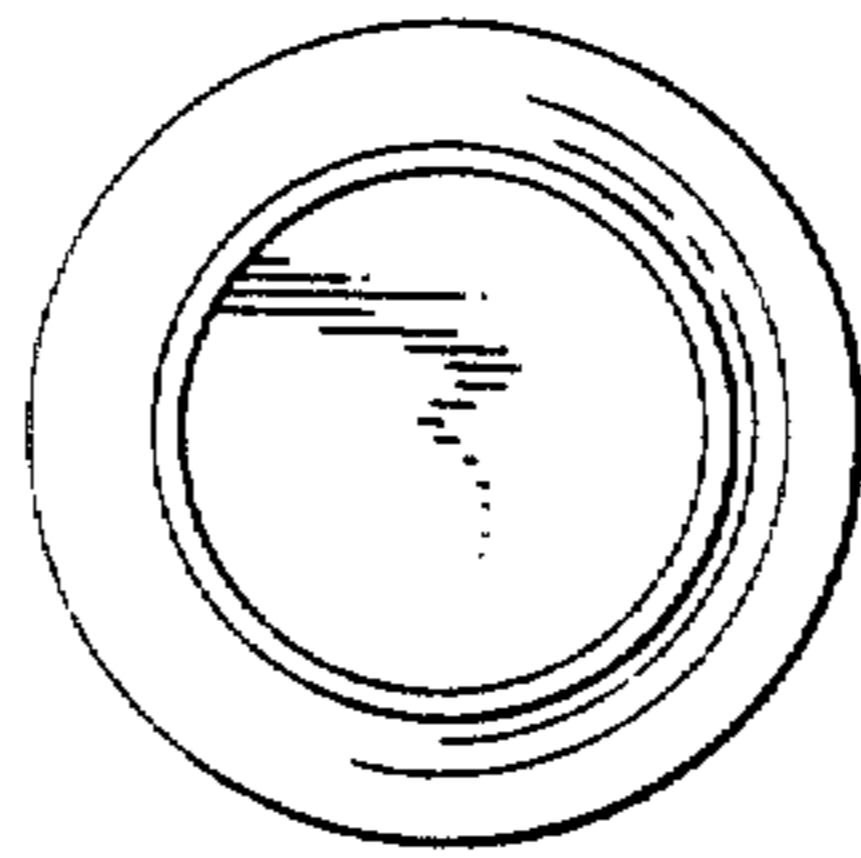
