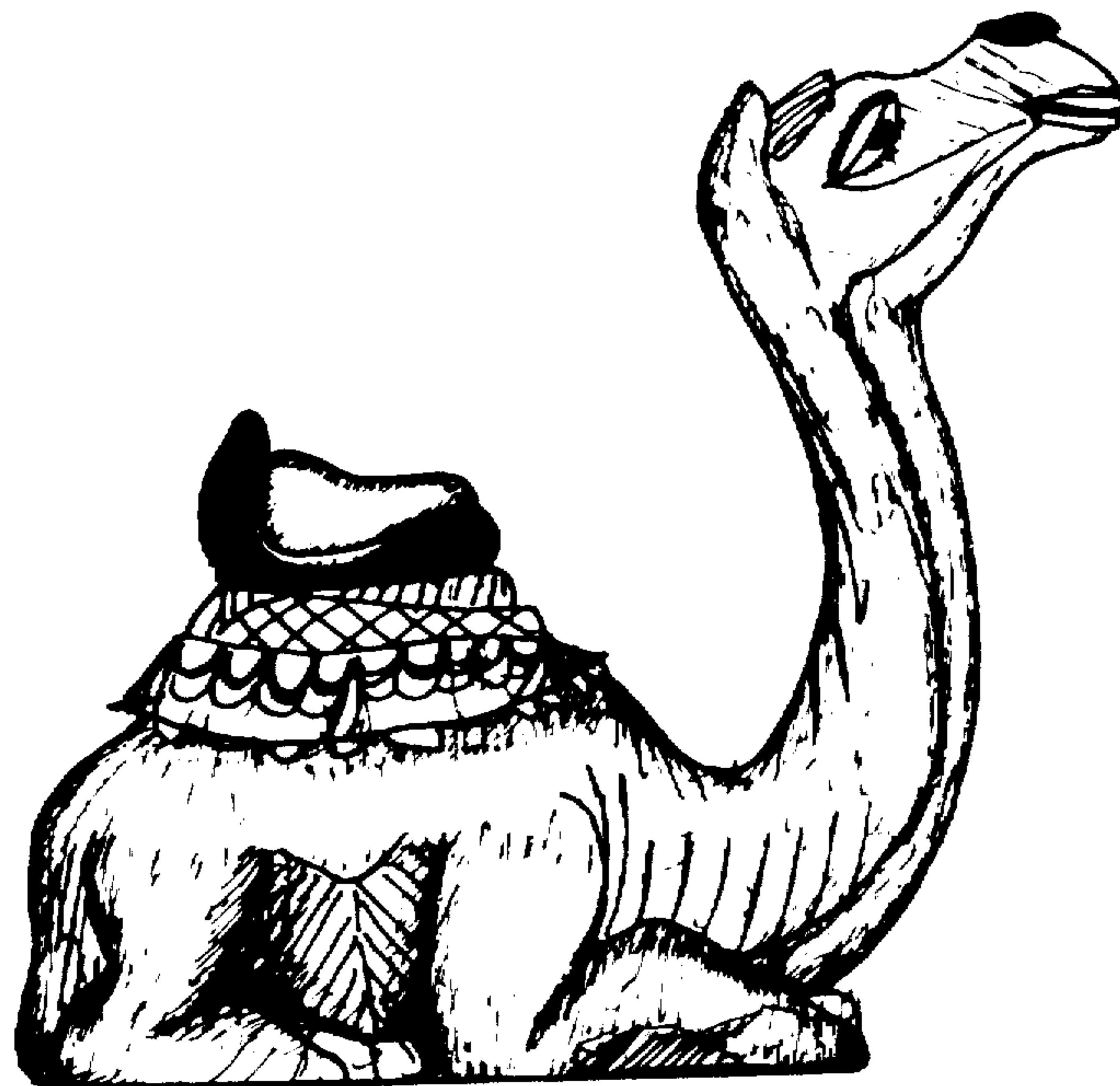

**CLAIM**

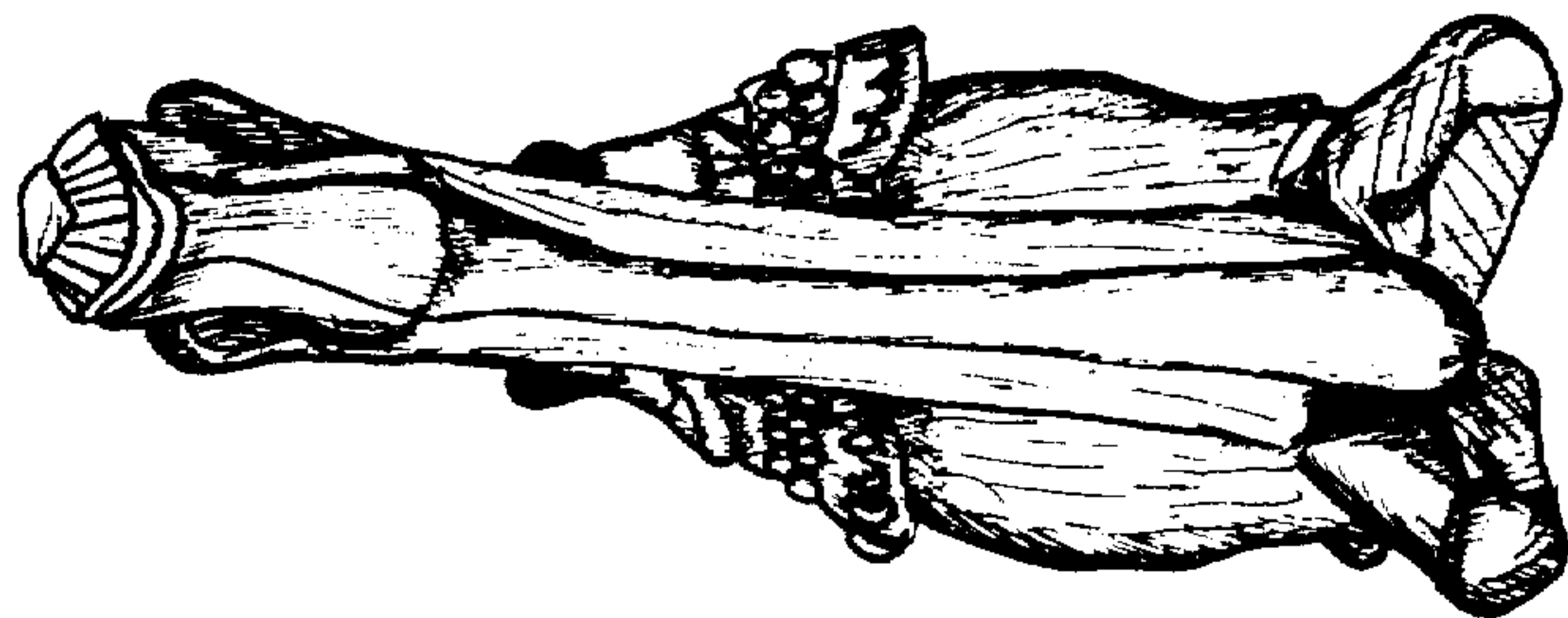
The ornamental design for a figurine of a camel, sub-

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front end perspective view of a figurine  
showing our new design;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.



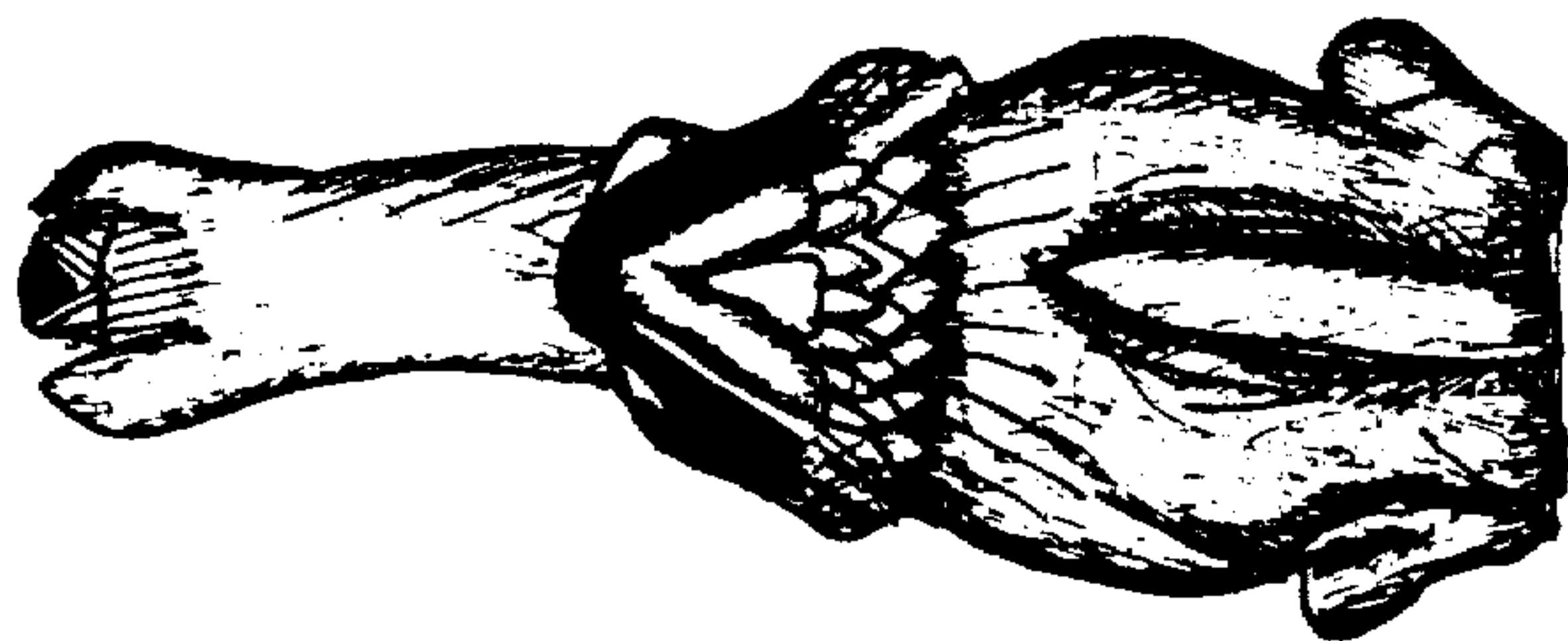
