DESCRIPTION

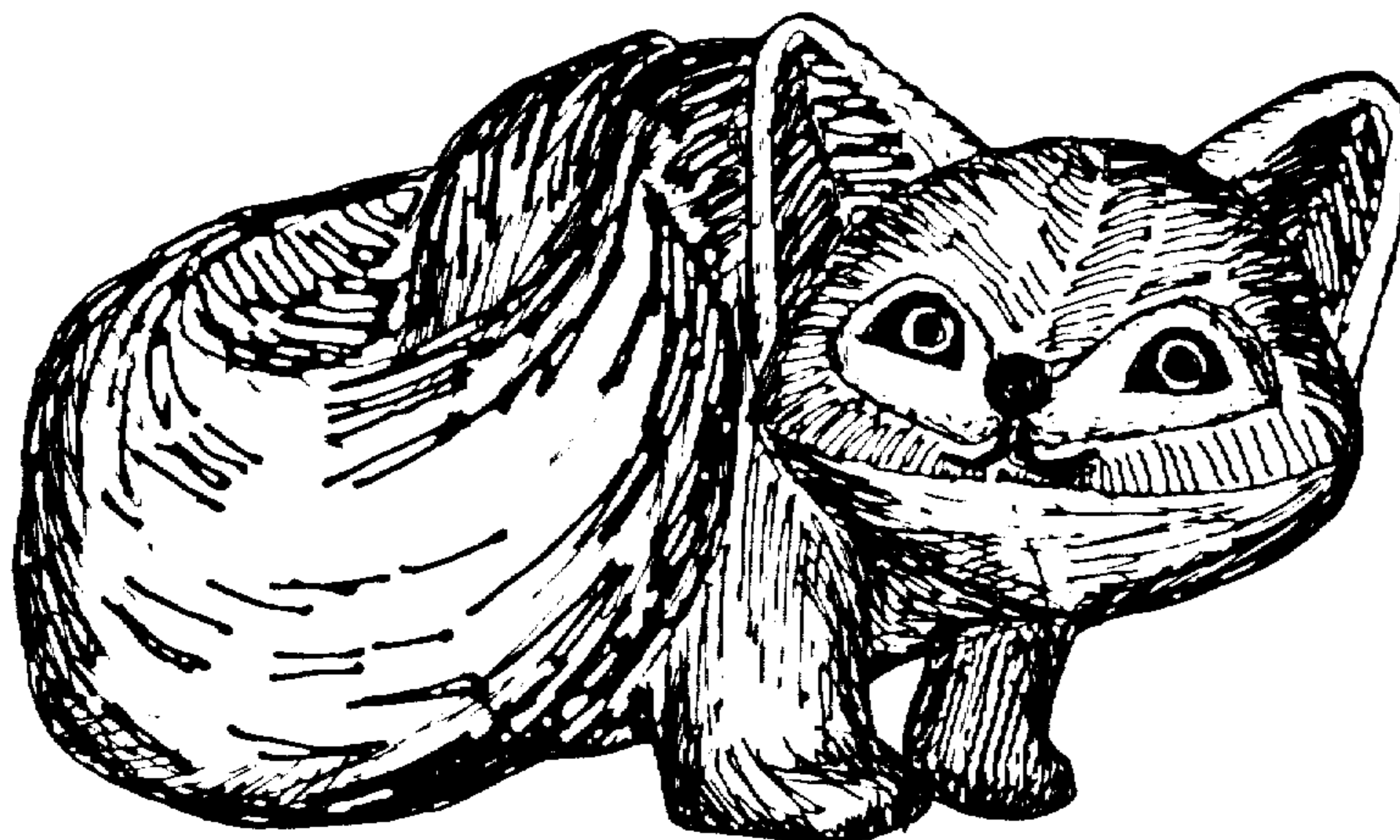
FIG. 1 is a side perspective view of a figurine showing our new design;

FIG. 5 is a top plan view of FIG. 1.



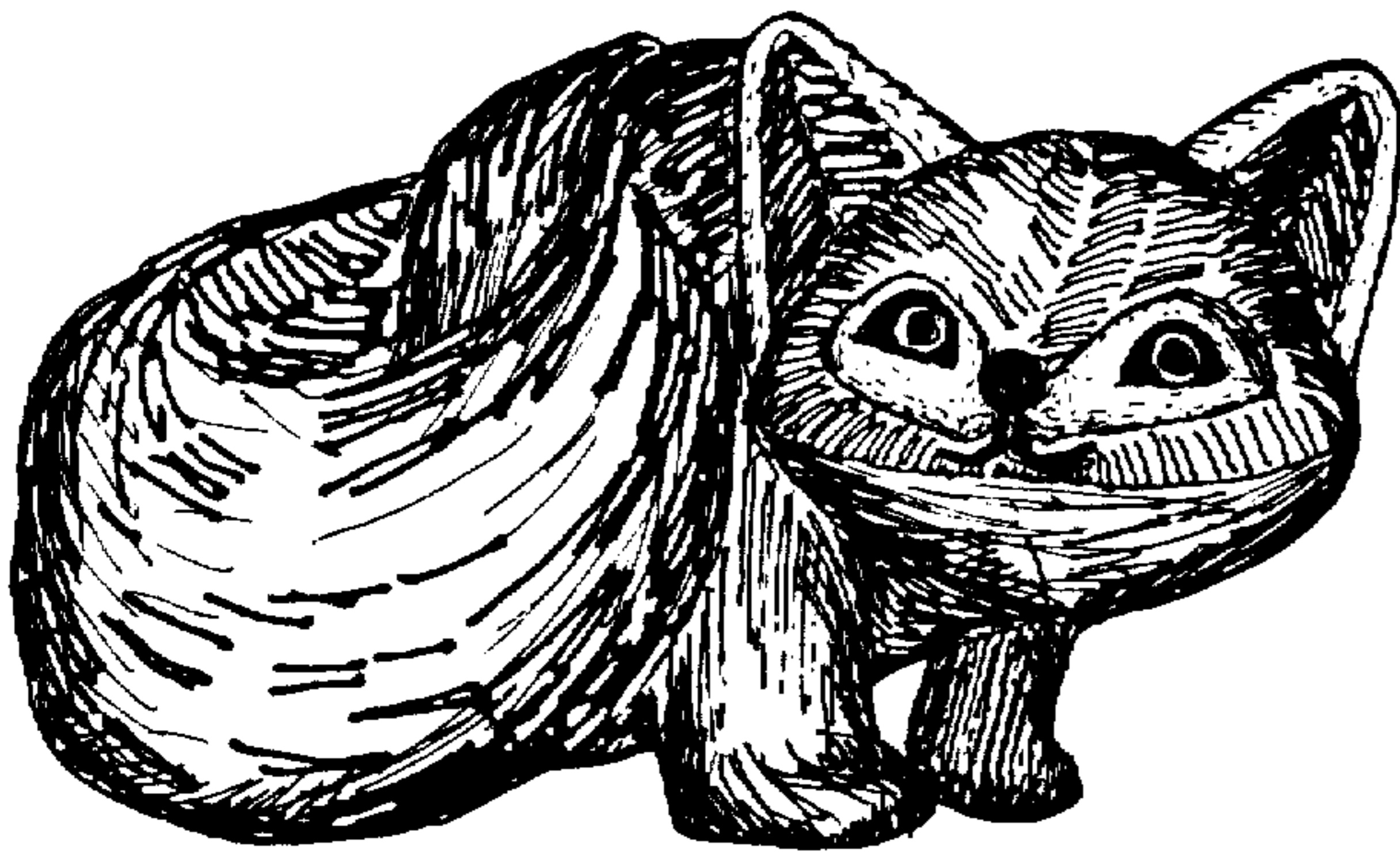

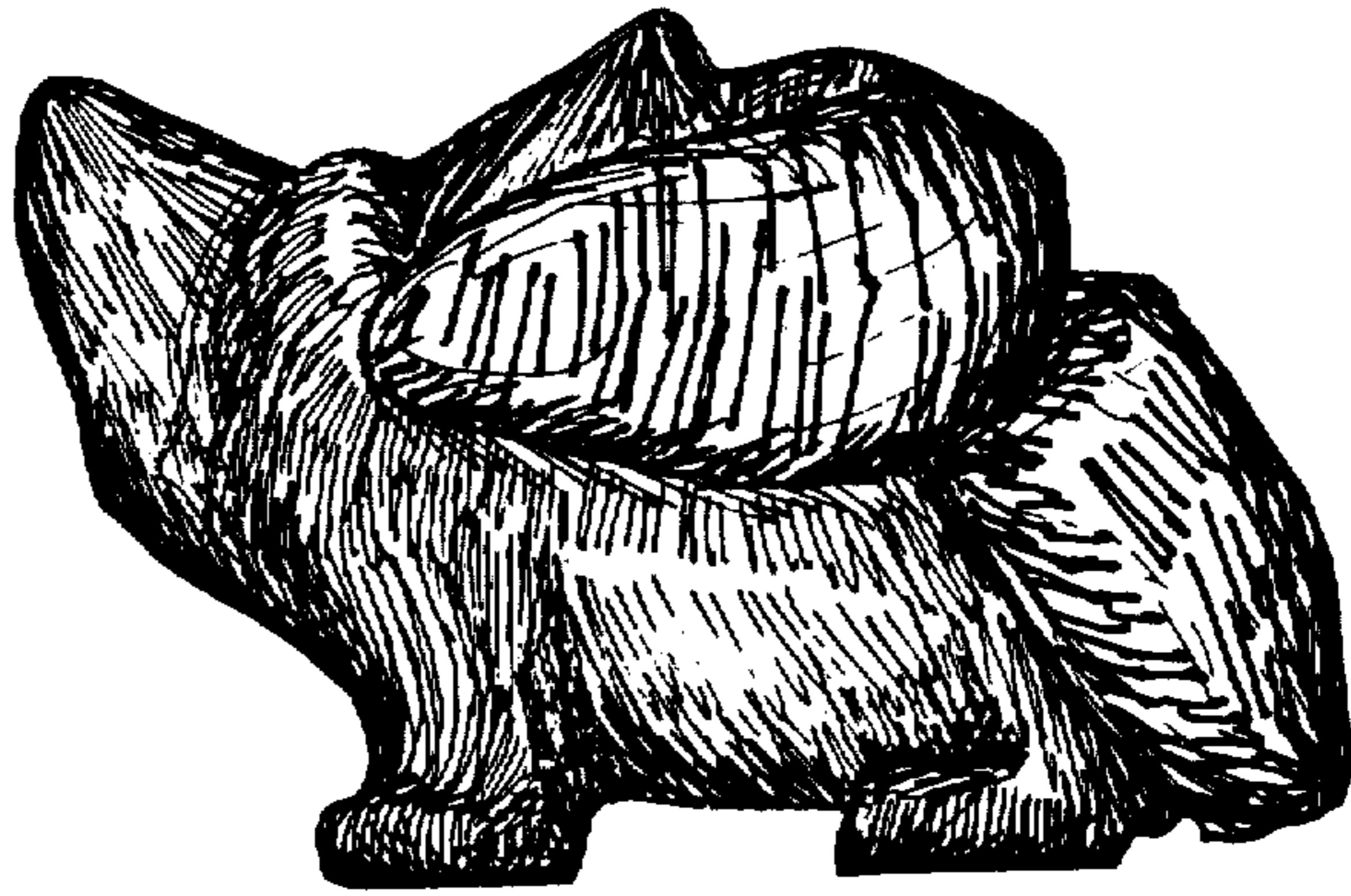

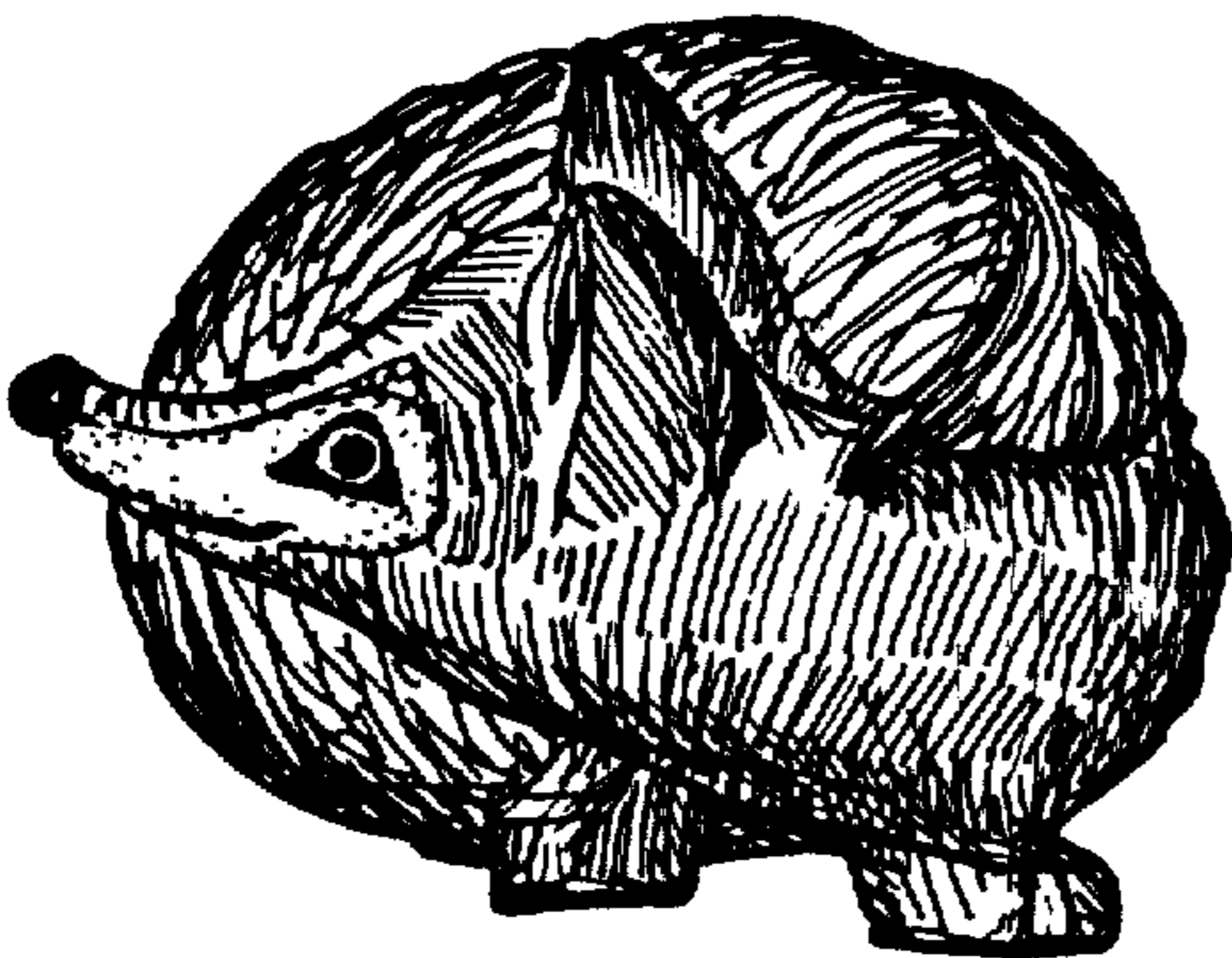

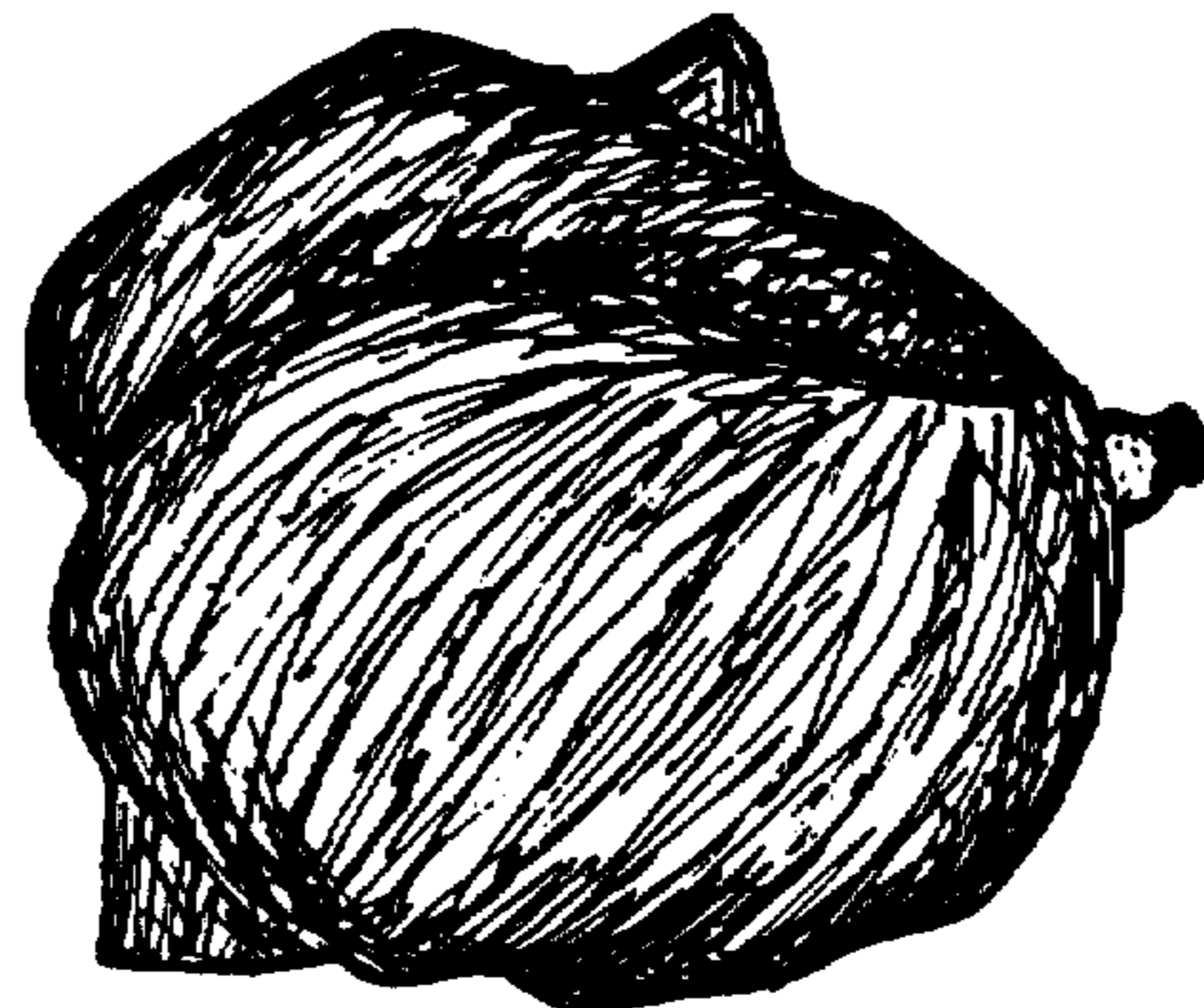

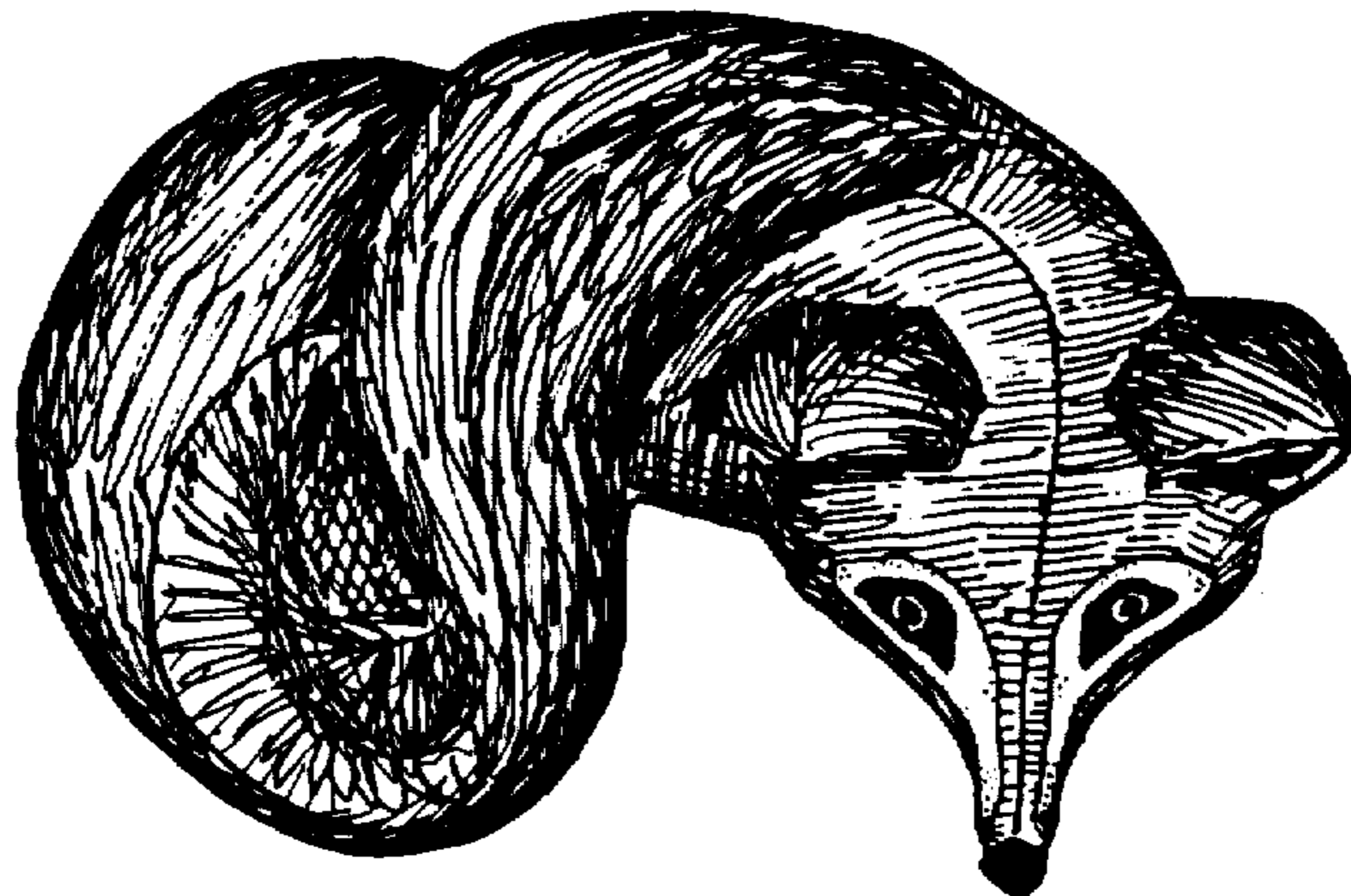
