[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a figurine of a condor, sub-
stantially as shown.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front end view of a figurine showing our
new design;

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a side perspective view of FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is an opposite side perspective view showing the
side opposite that shown in FIG. 3; and

FIG. 5 is a rear end perspective view of FIG. 1.

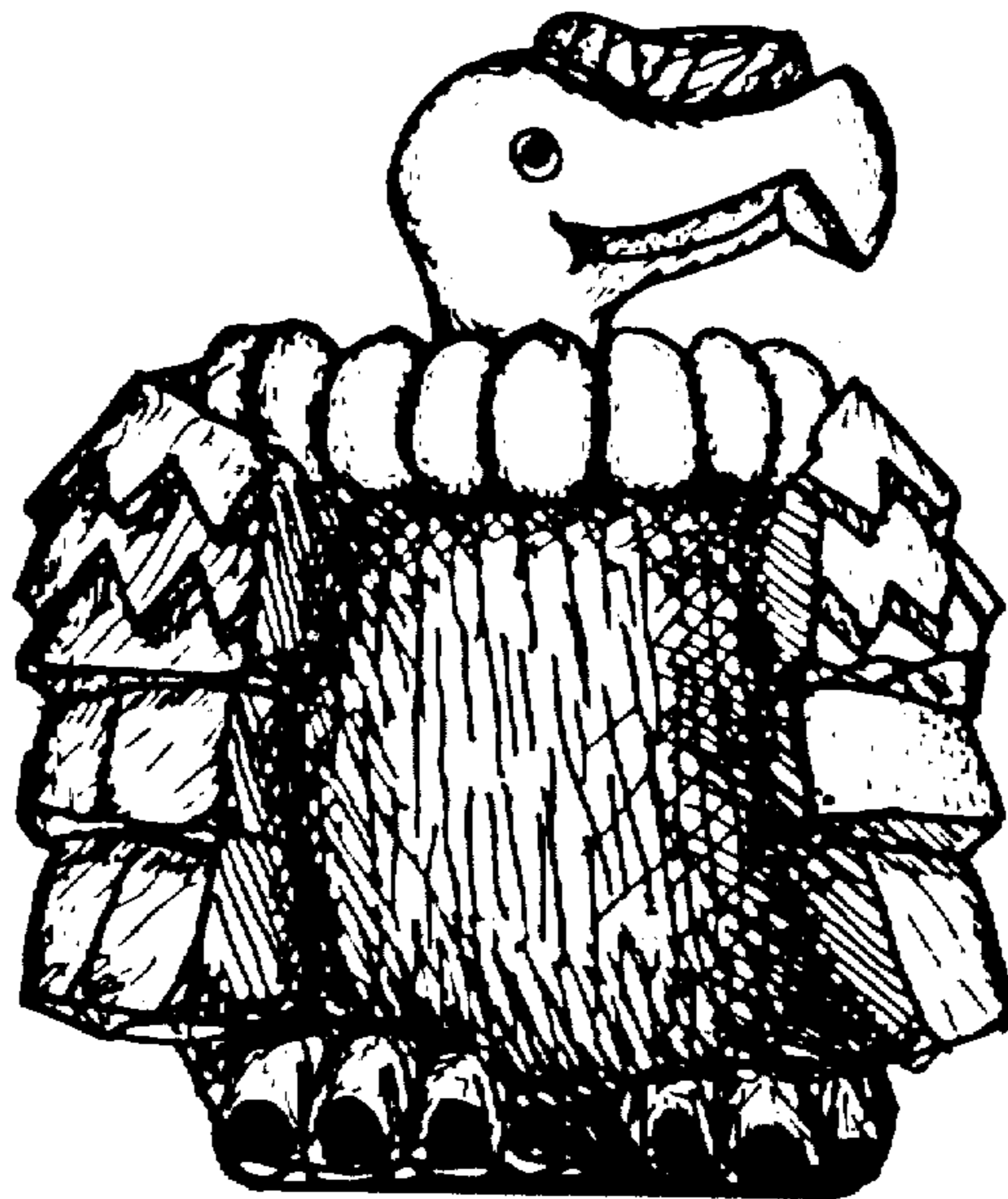

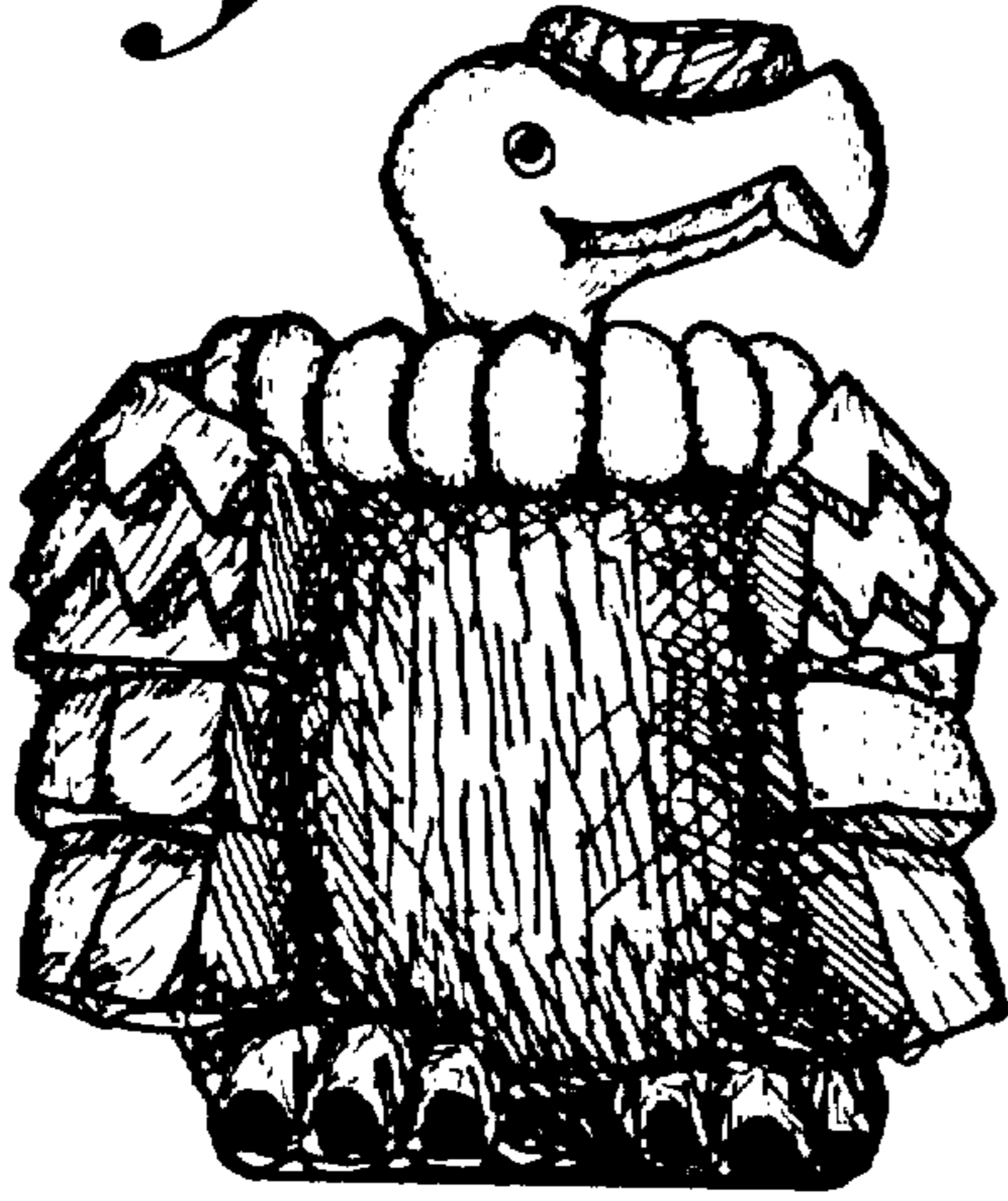

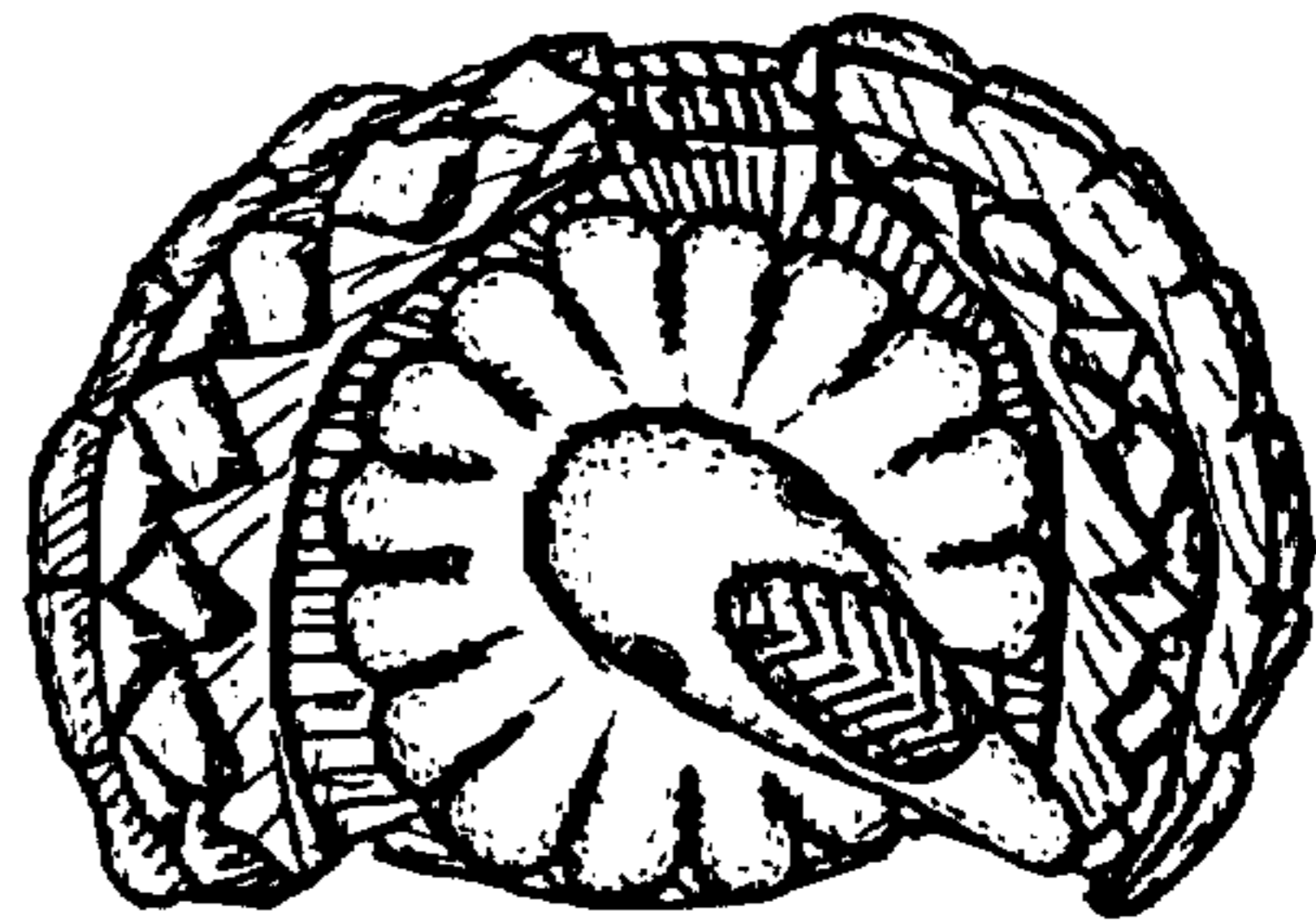

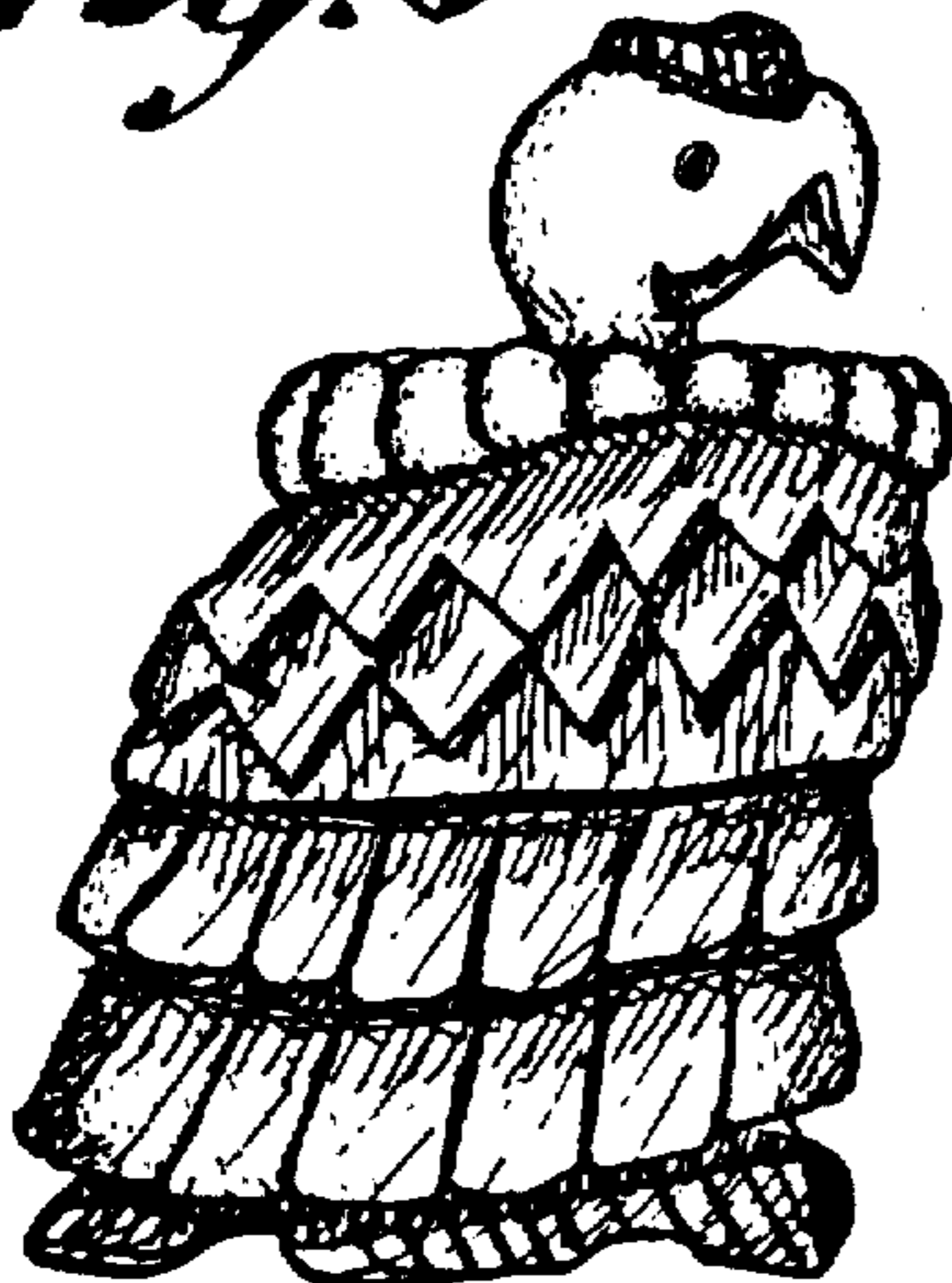
