The ornamental design for a projection television receiver, substantially as shown and described.

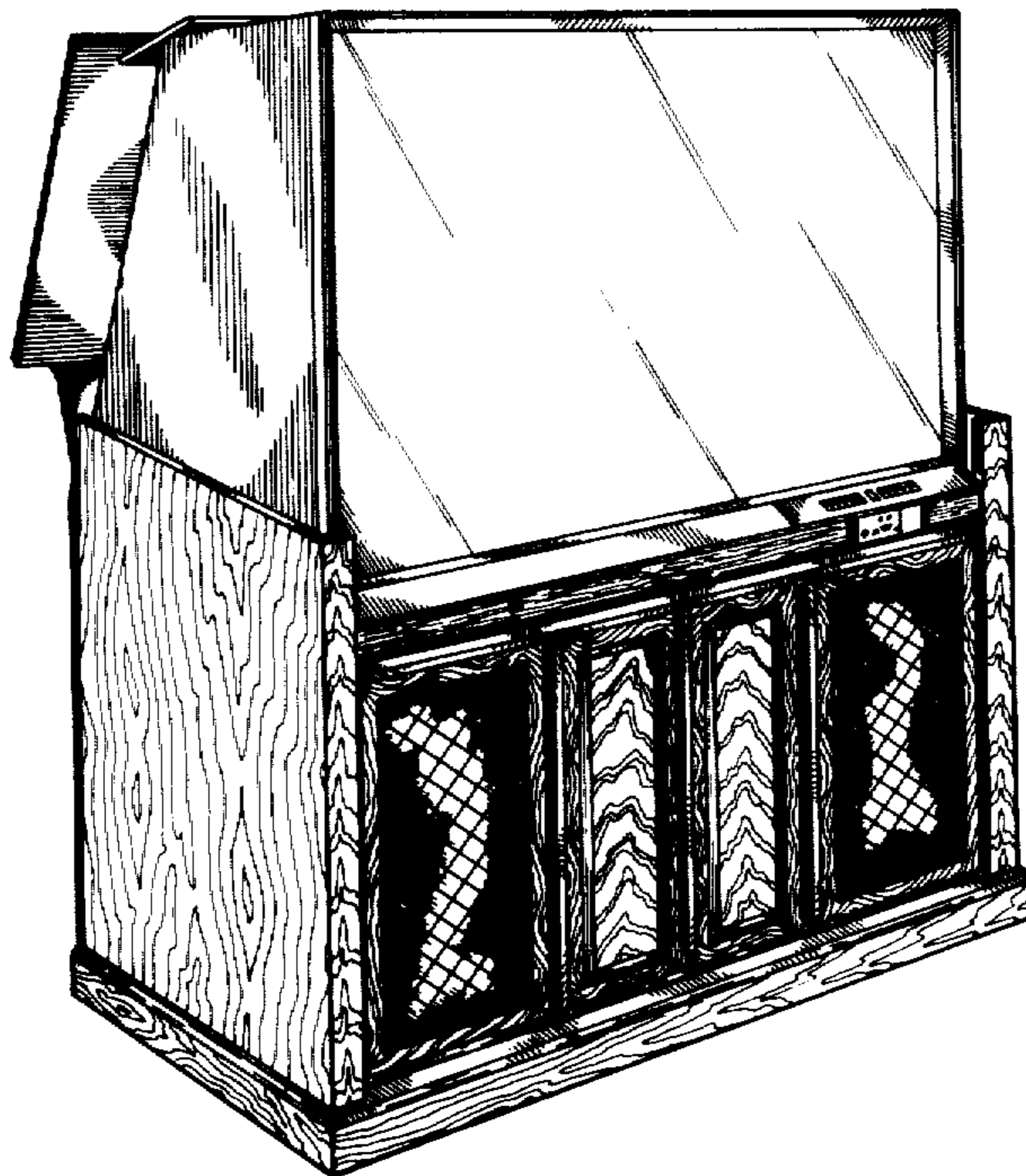
DESCRIPTION

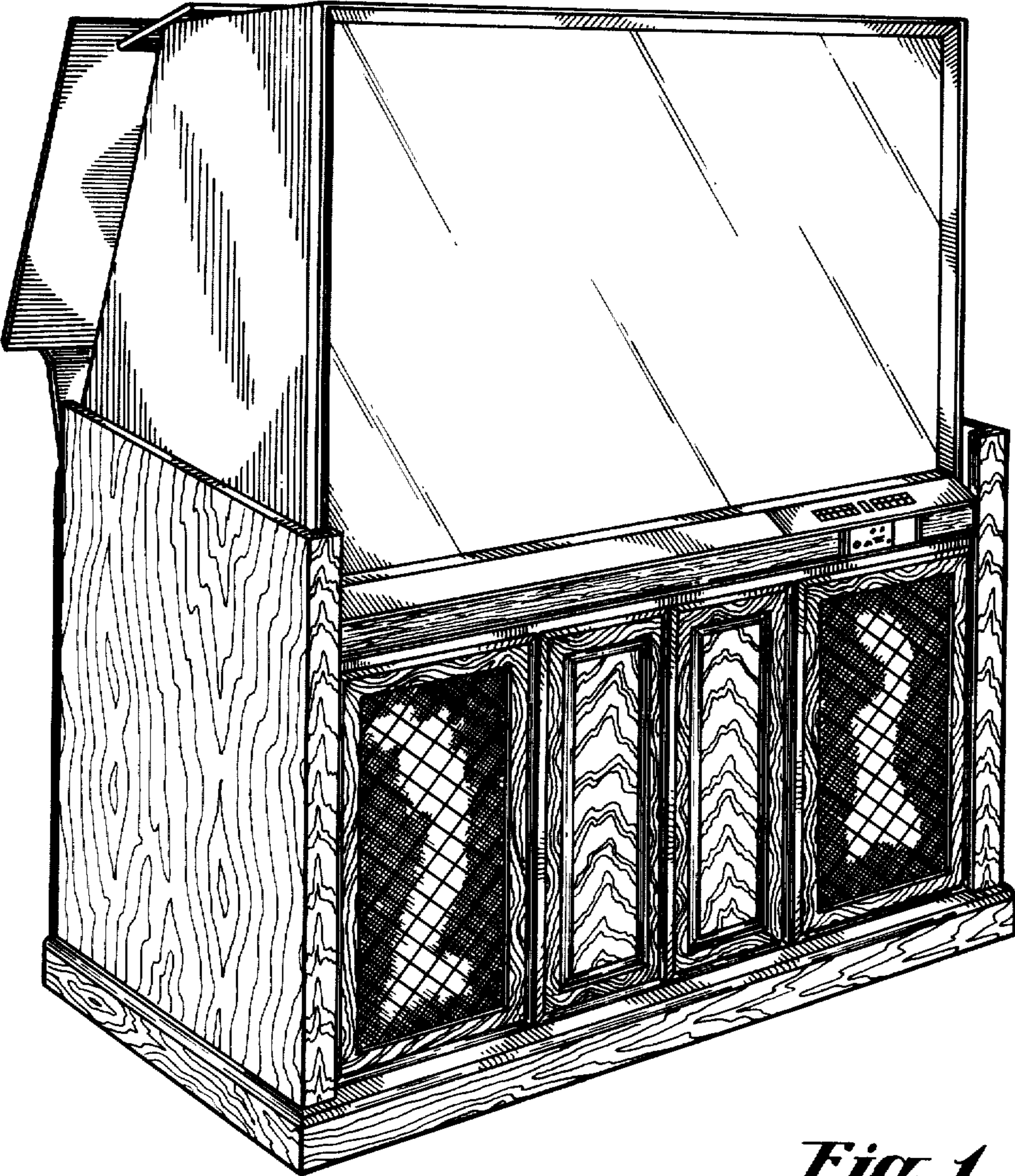
FIG. 1 is a front, top and partial left side perspective view of a projection television receiver showing our new design;

FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view; and,

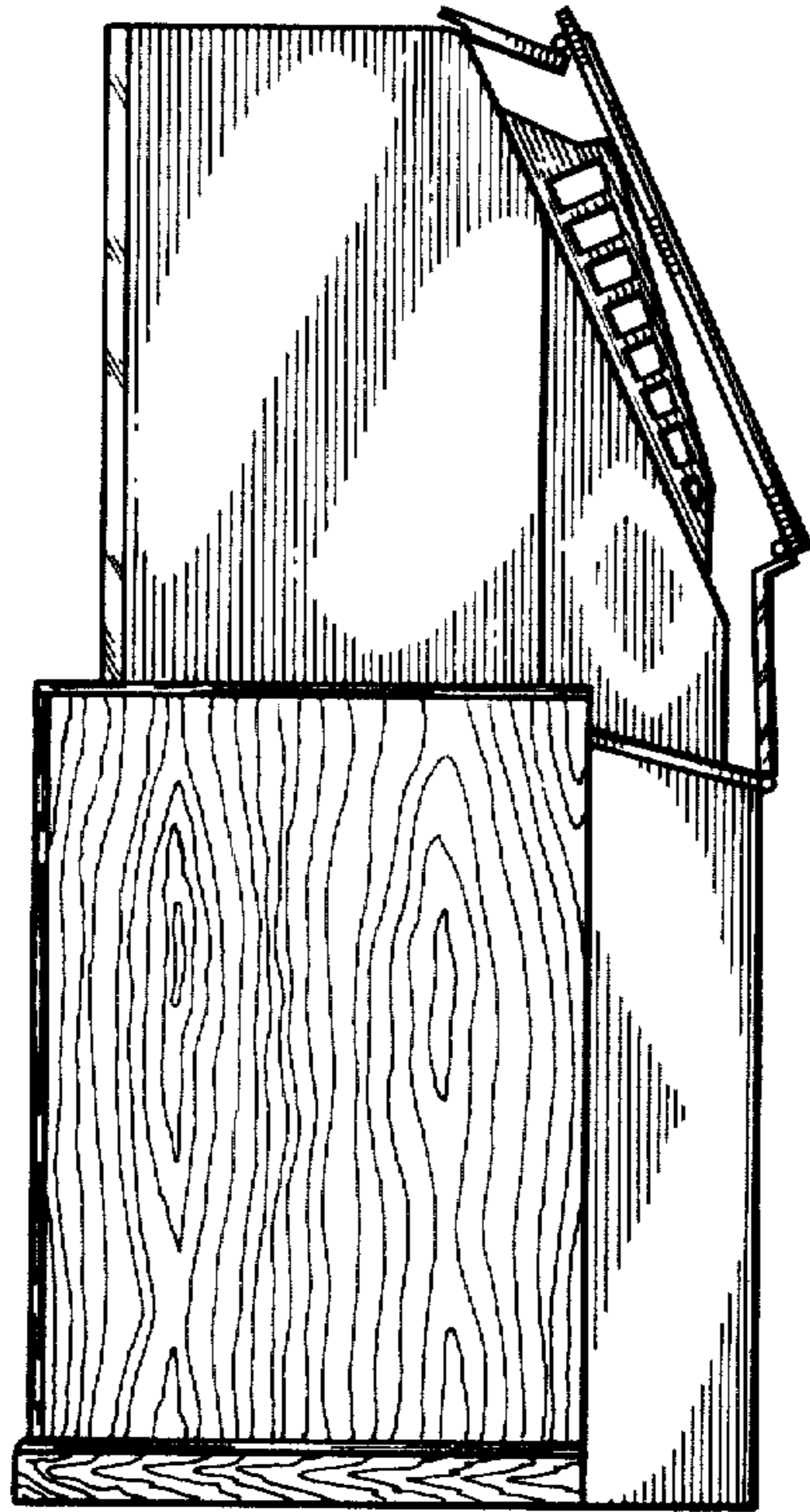
FIG. 4 is a top plan view.



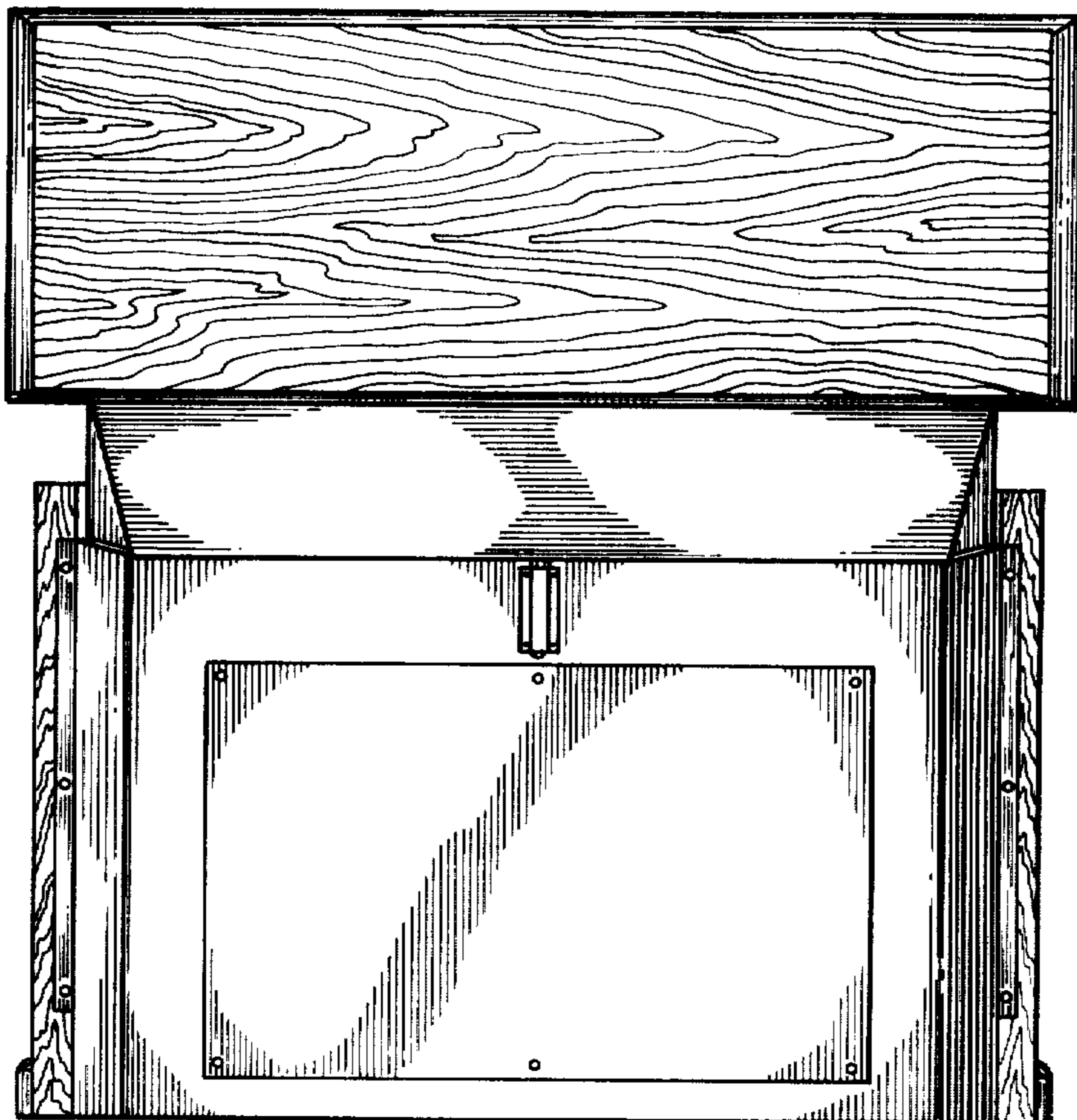


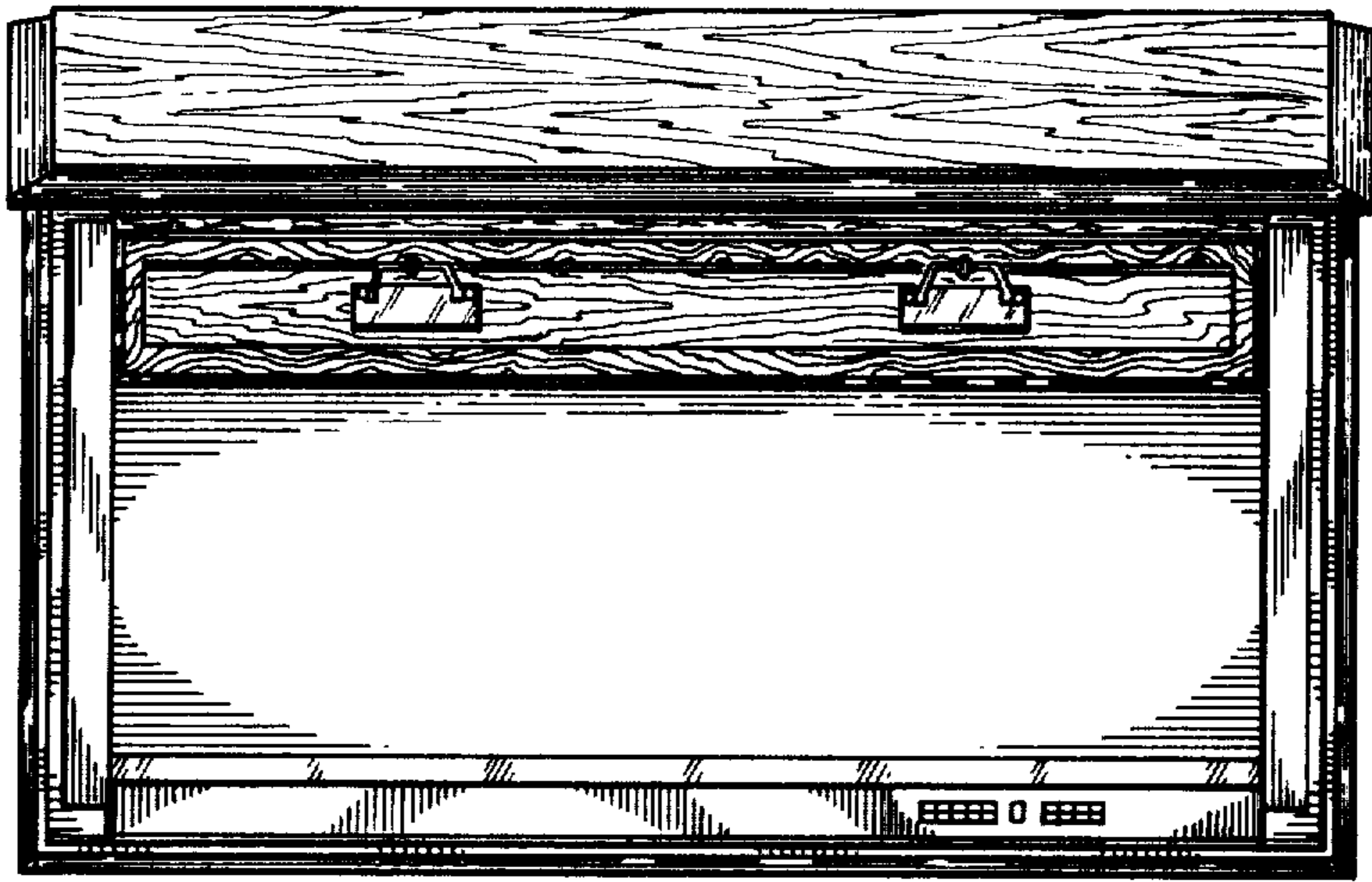
