FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof.

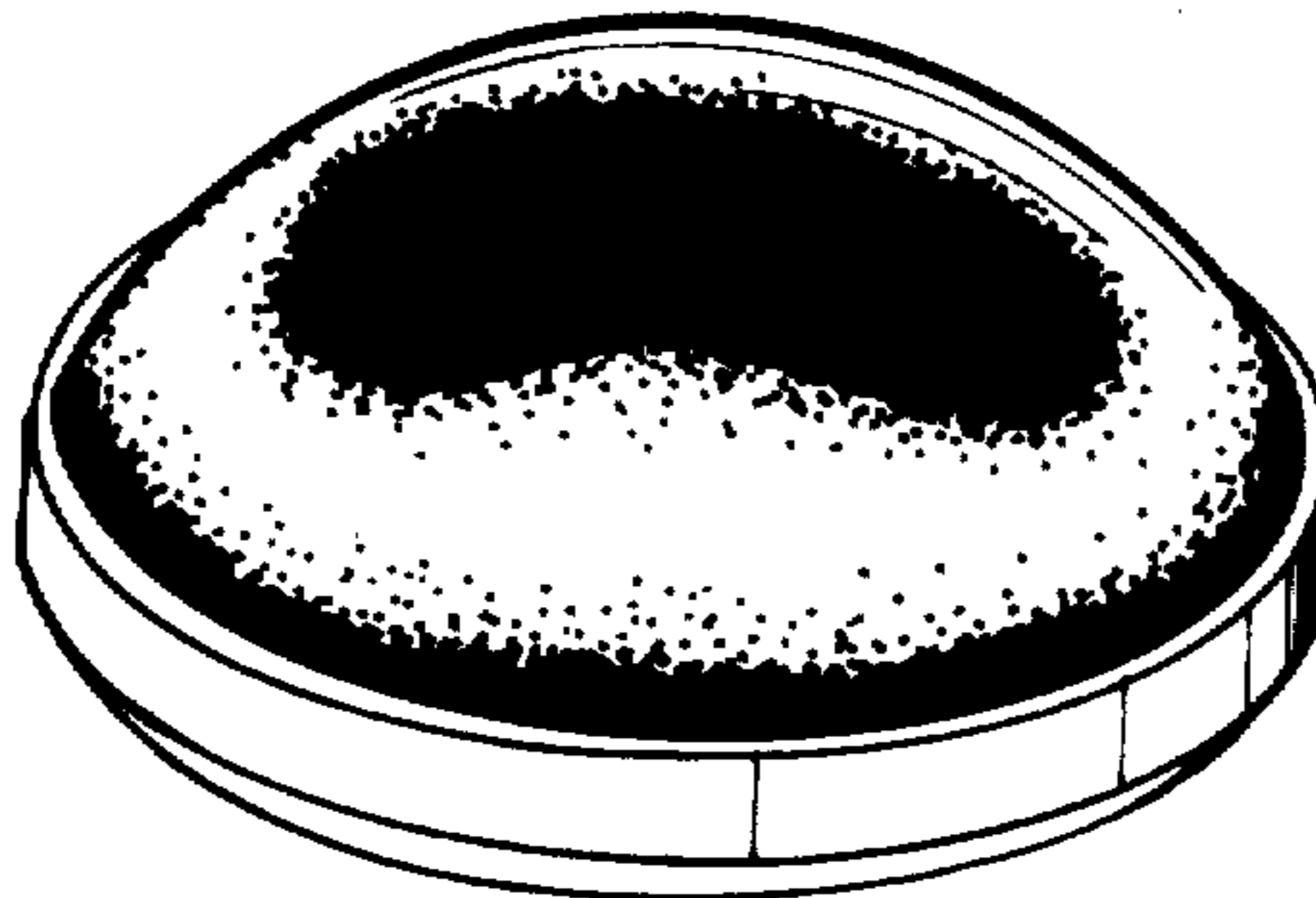

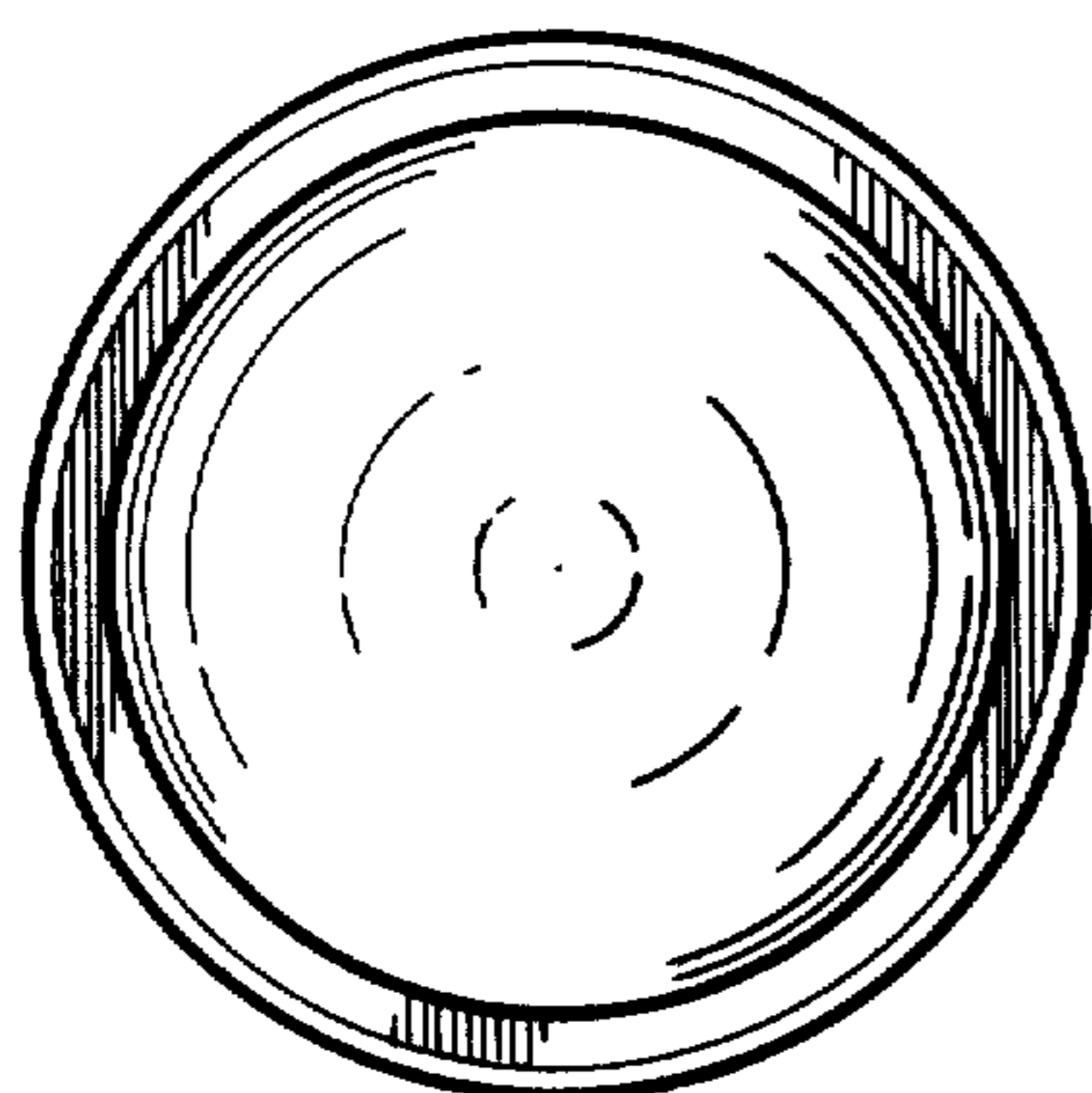

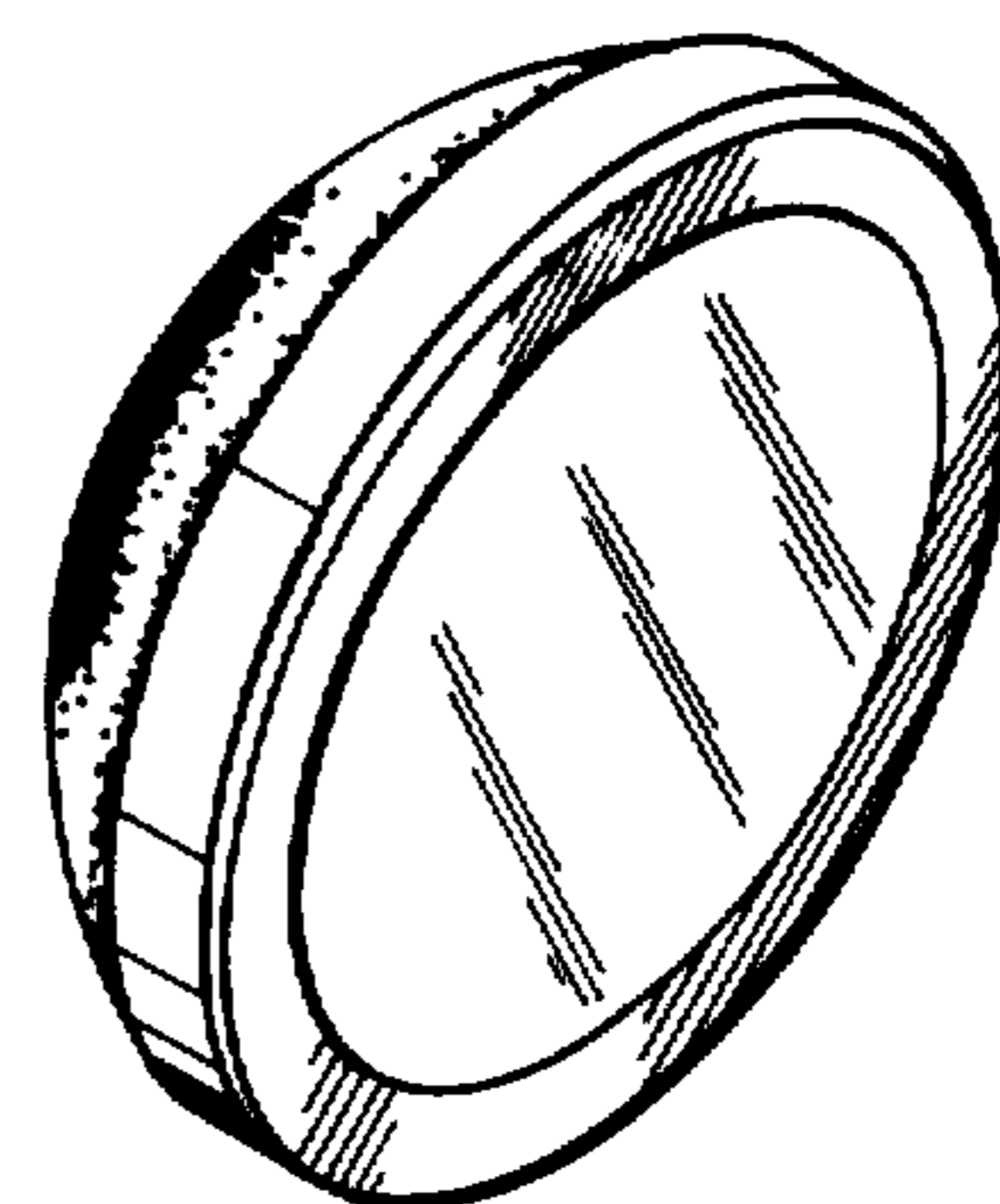

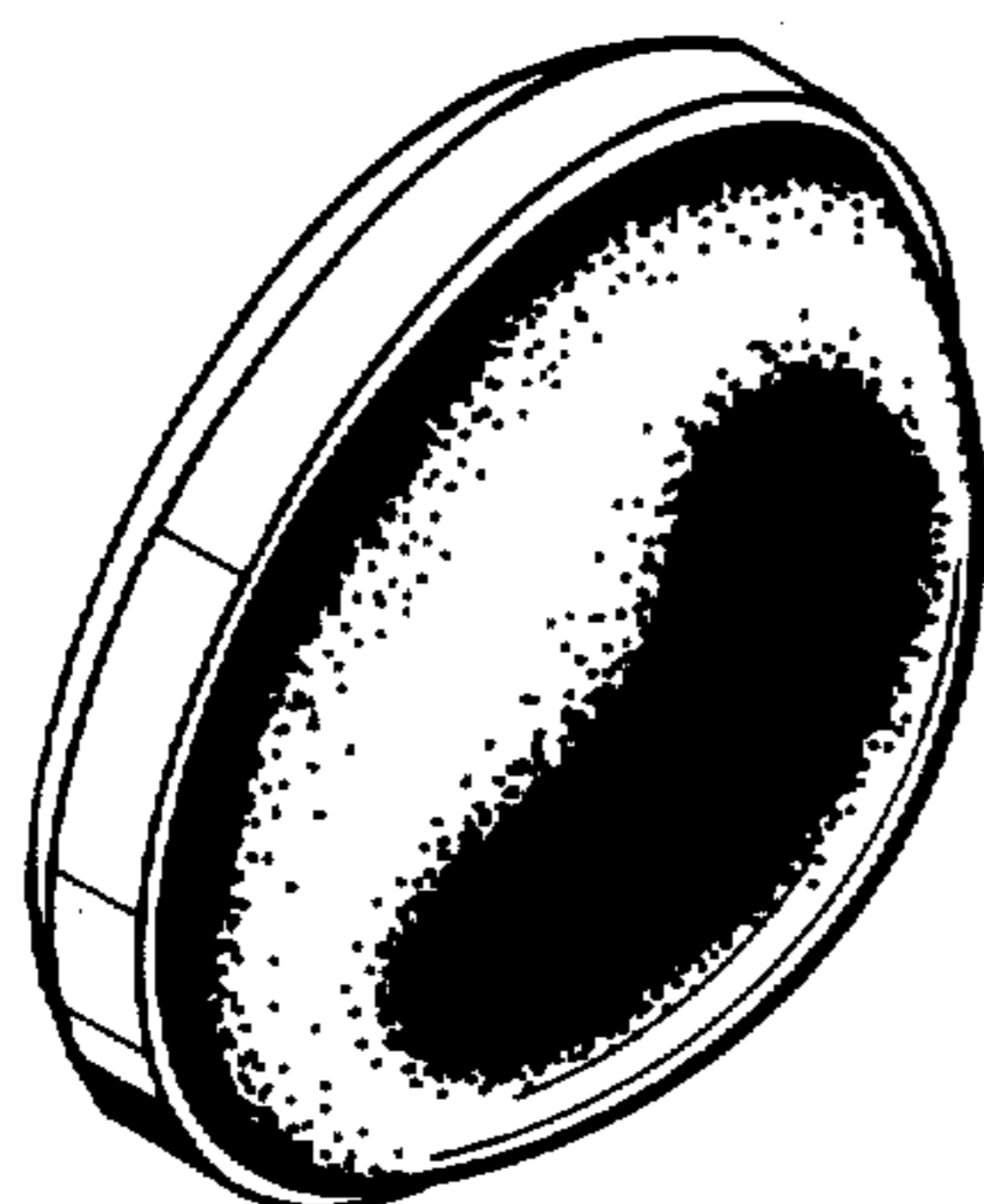
