[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a vacuum cleaner tool, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a vacuum cleaner tool showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;
FIG. 3 is another left side elevational view thereof, showing the tool oriented to clean a vertical surface;
FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof;
FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and
FIG. 7 is a bottom plan view thereof.
The fragmentary broken line representation of stairs in FIGS. 1, 2 and 3 and a vacuum wand in FIG. 3 is for purposes of illustration only.

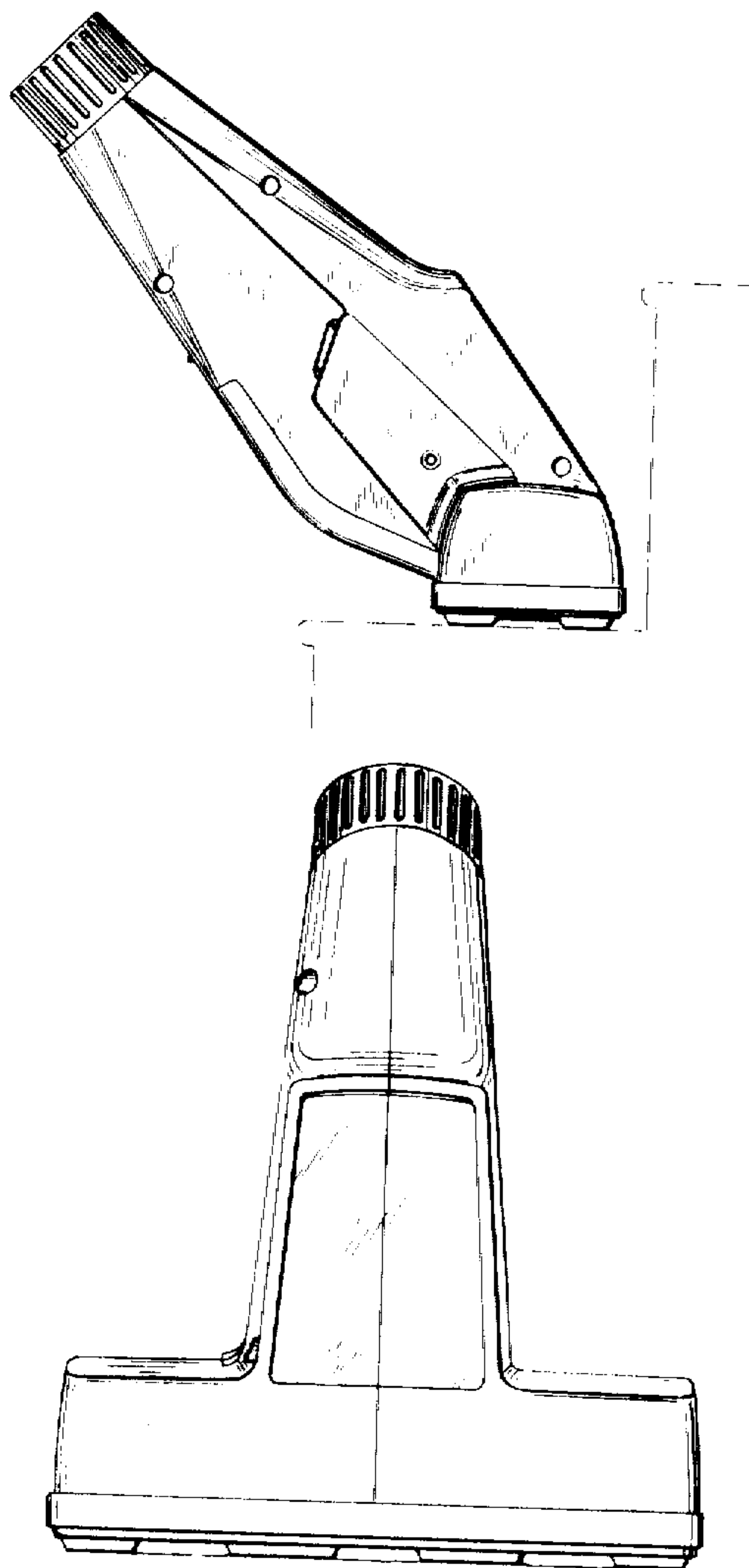

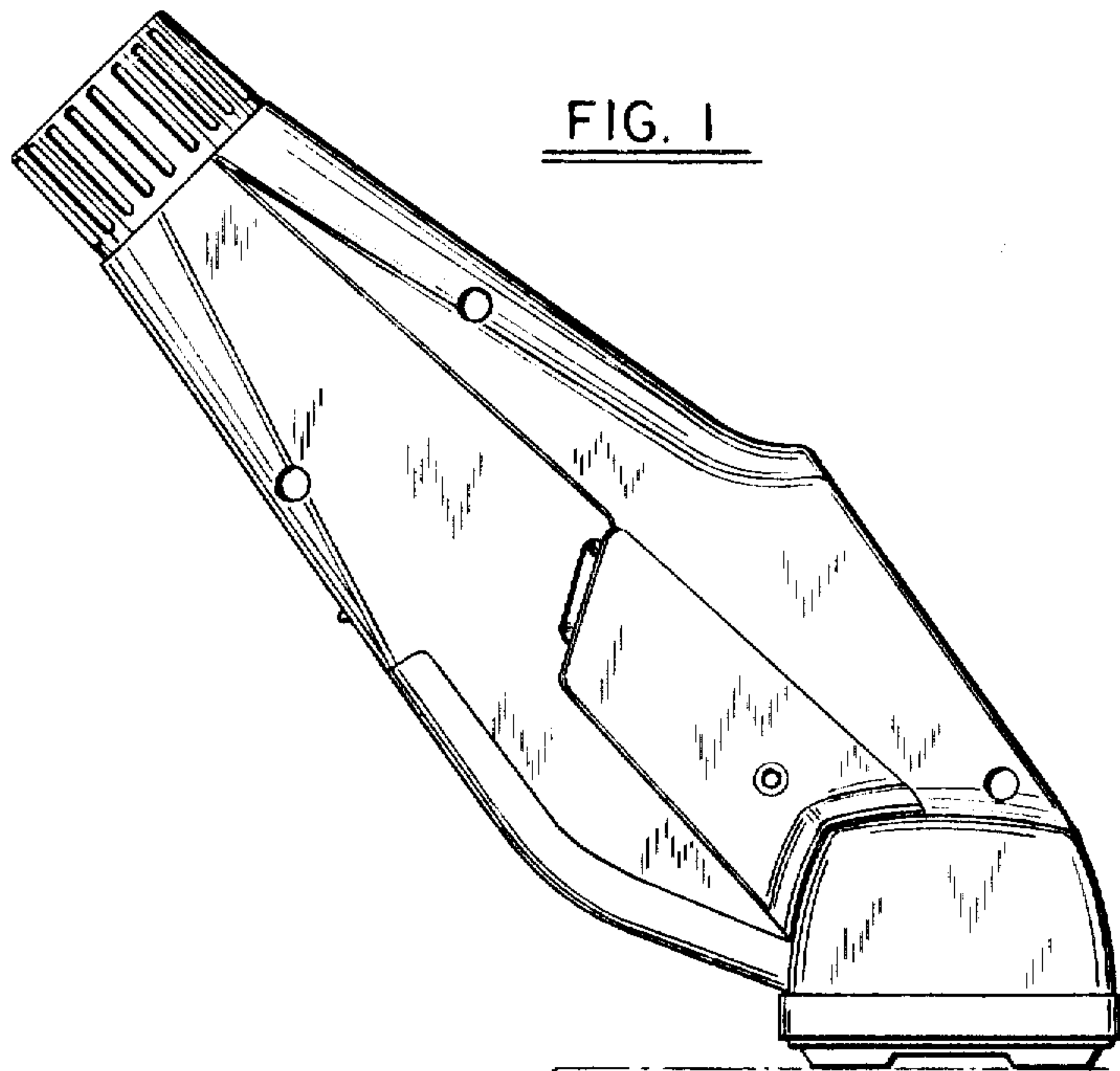

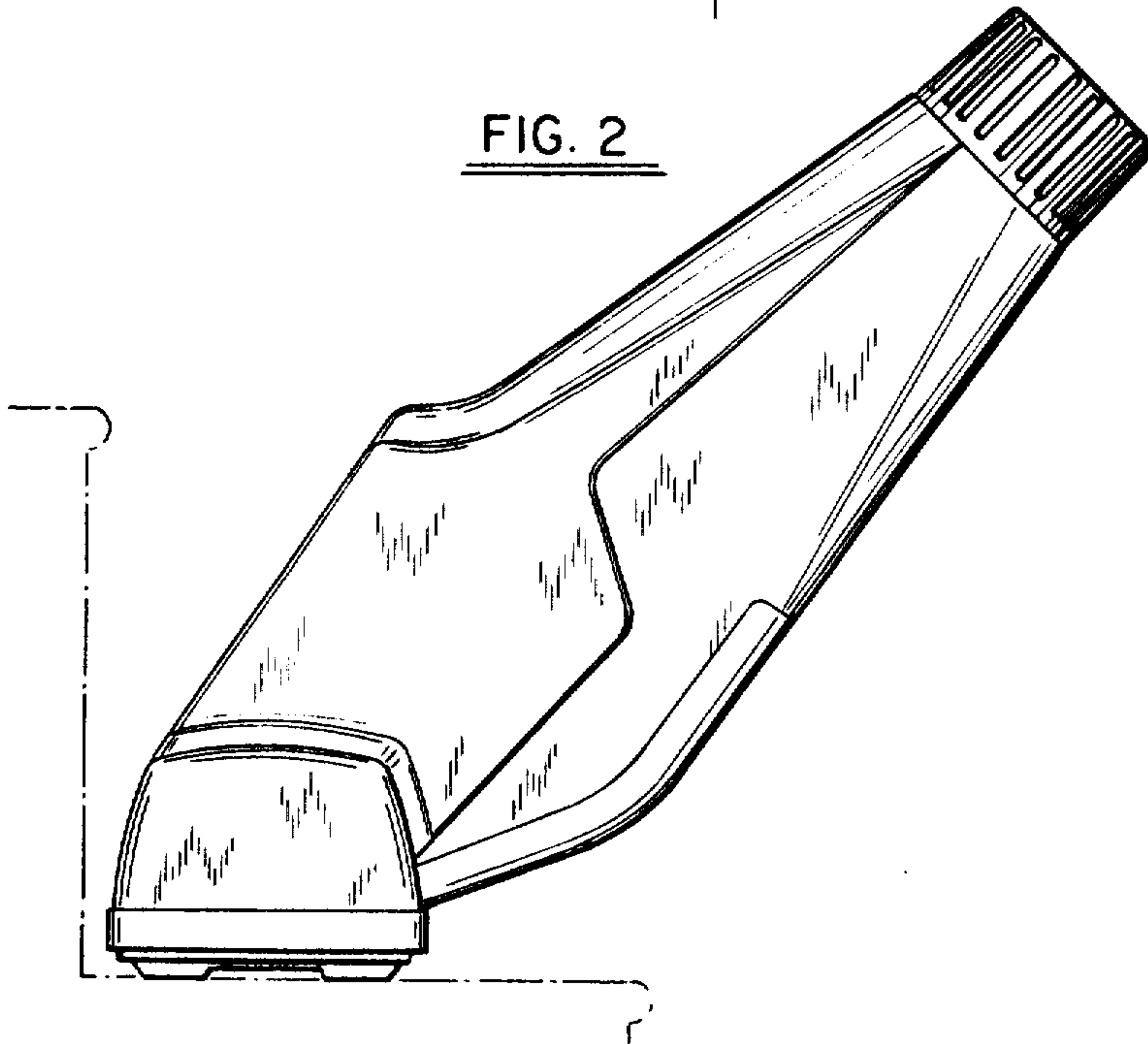
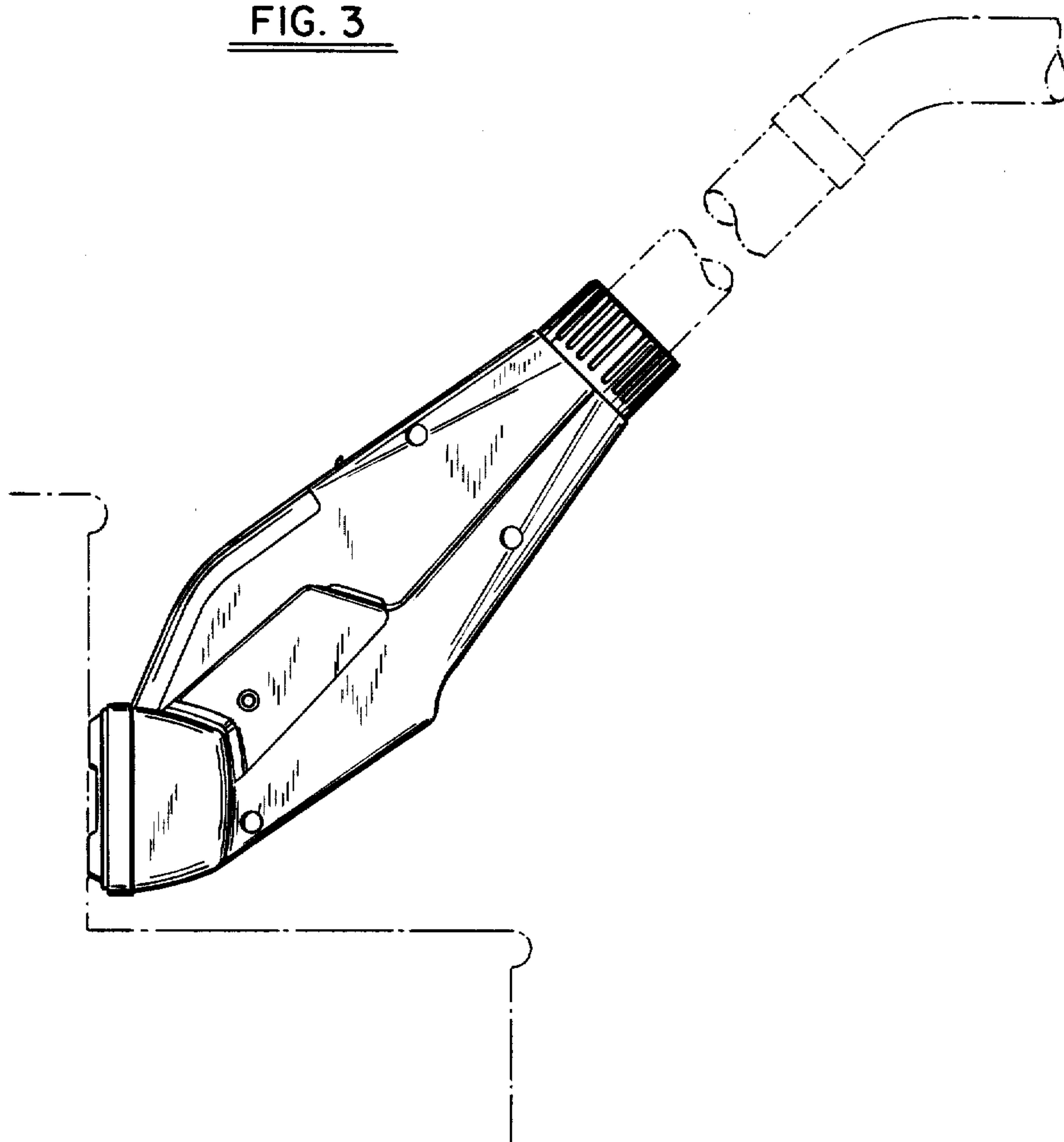

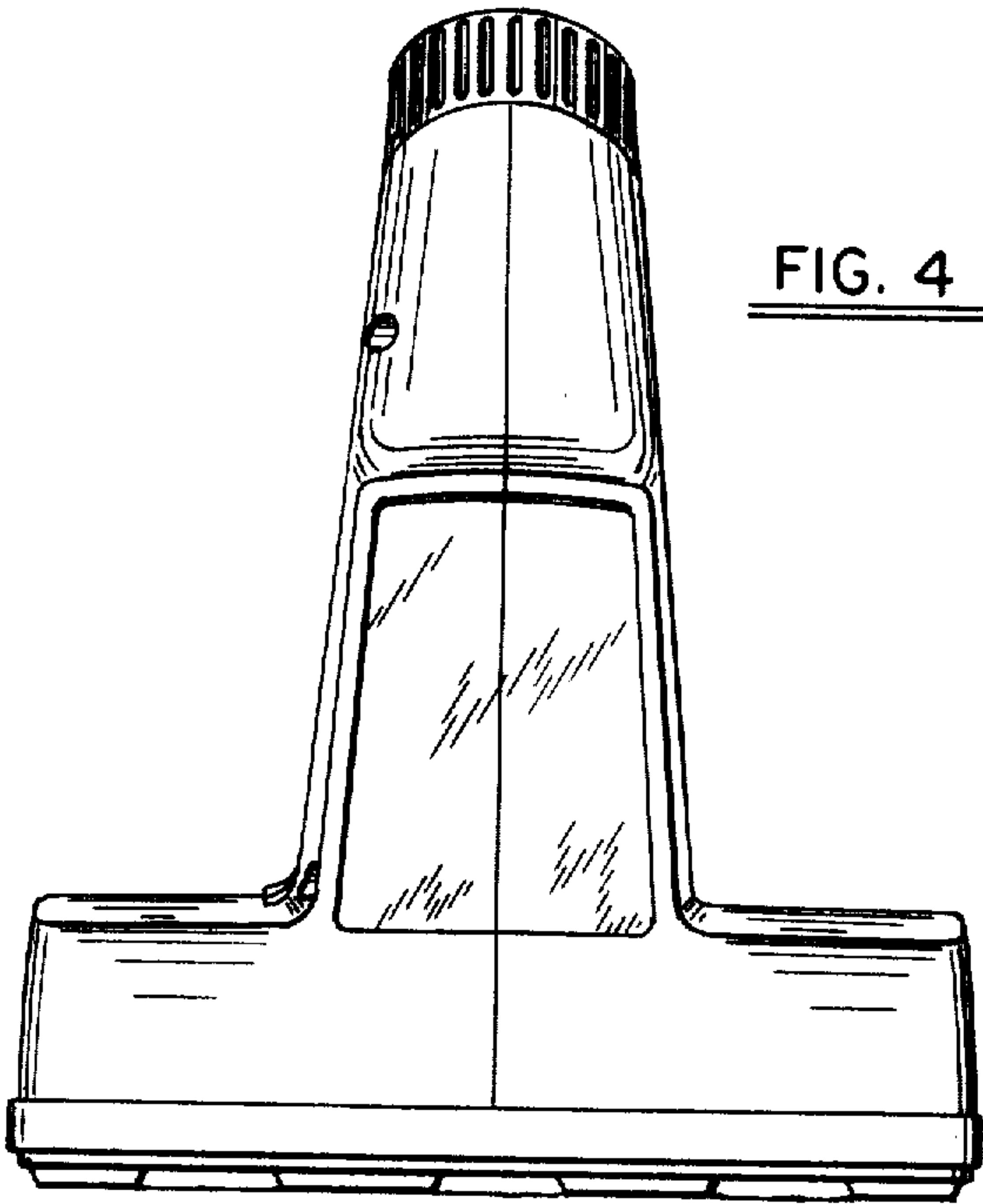

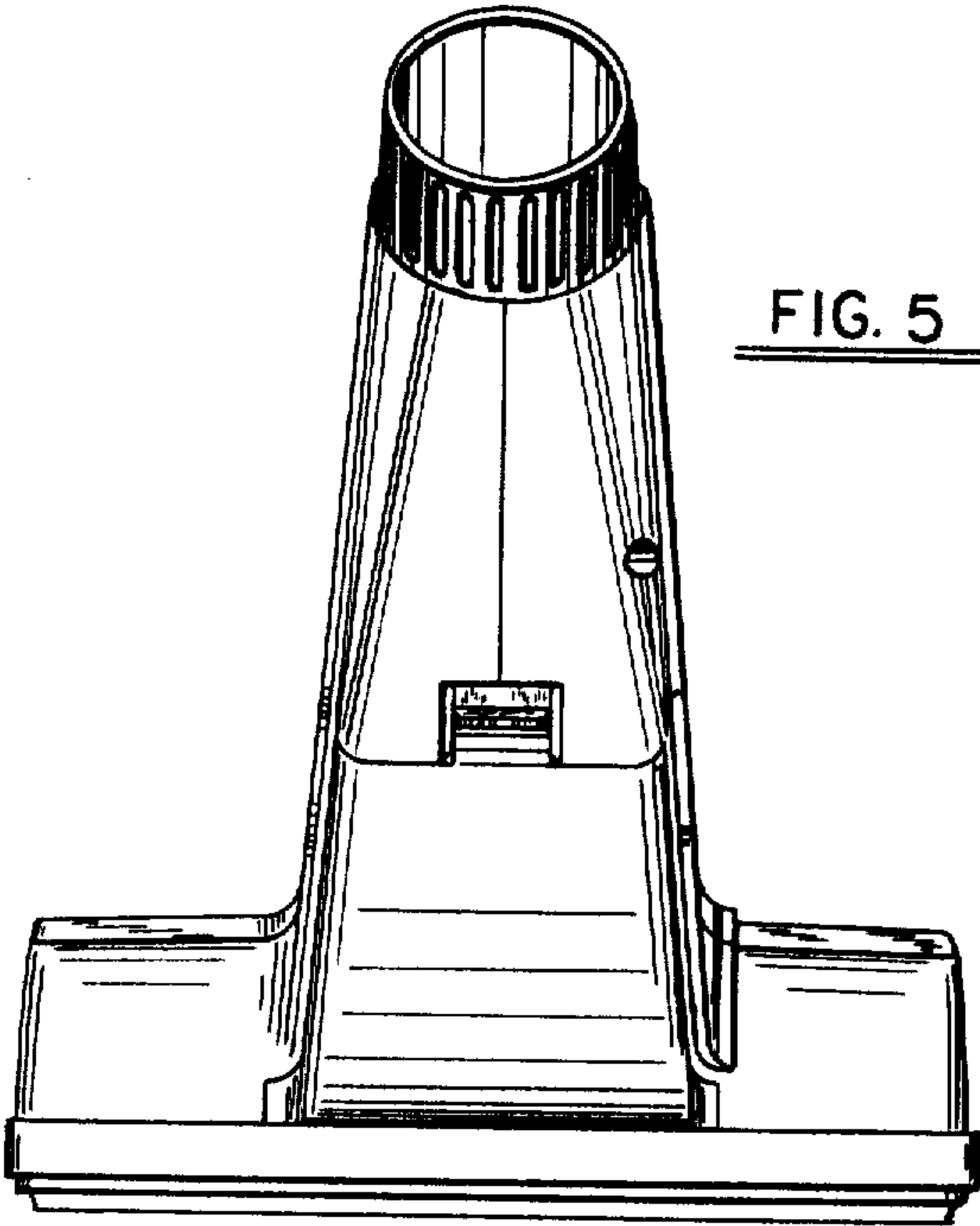

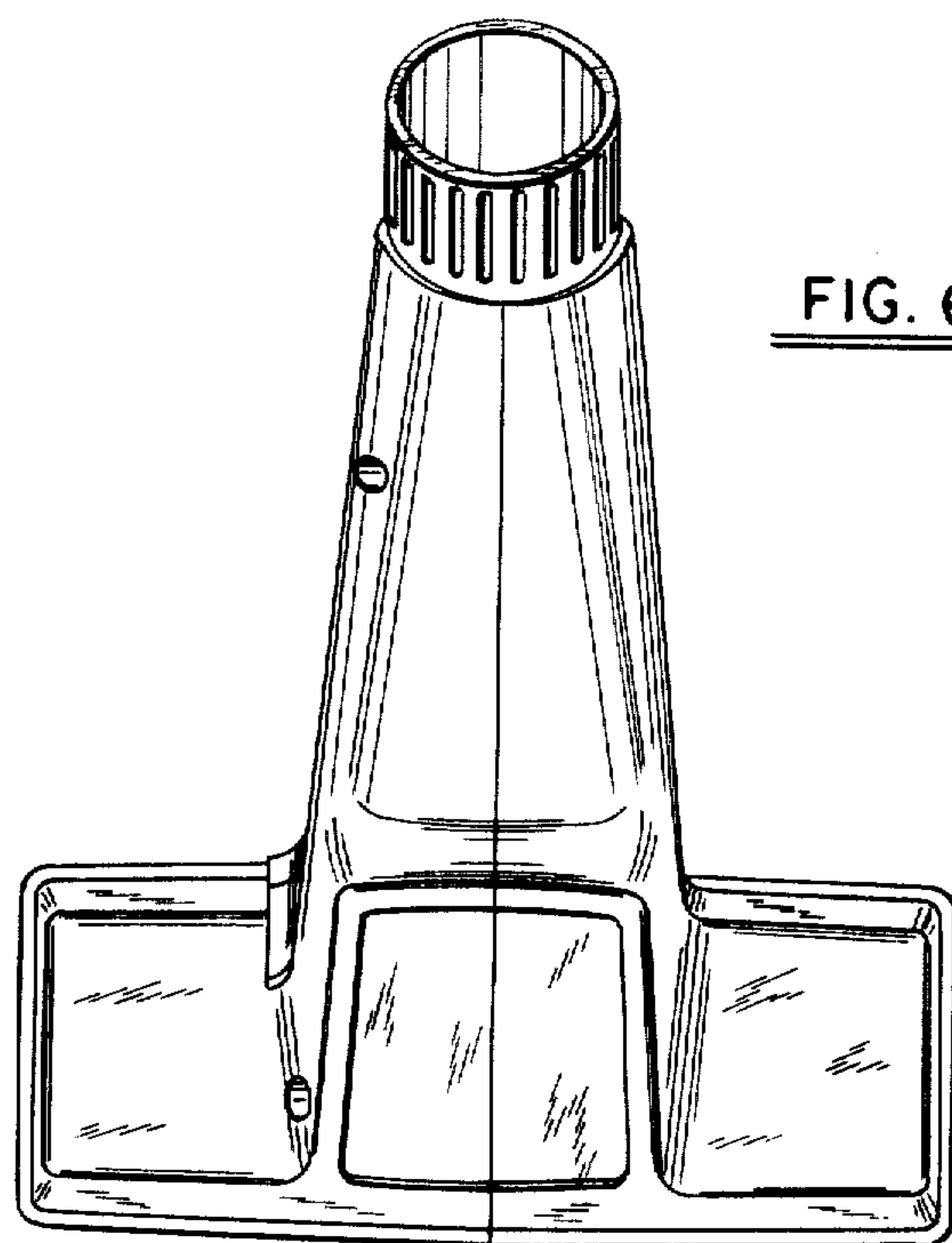

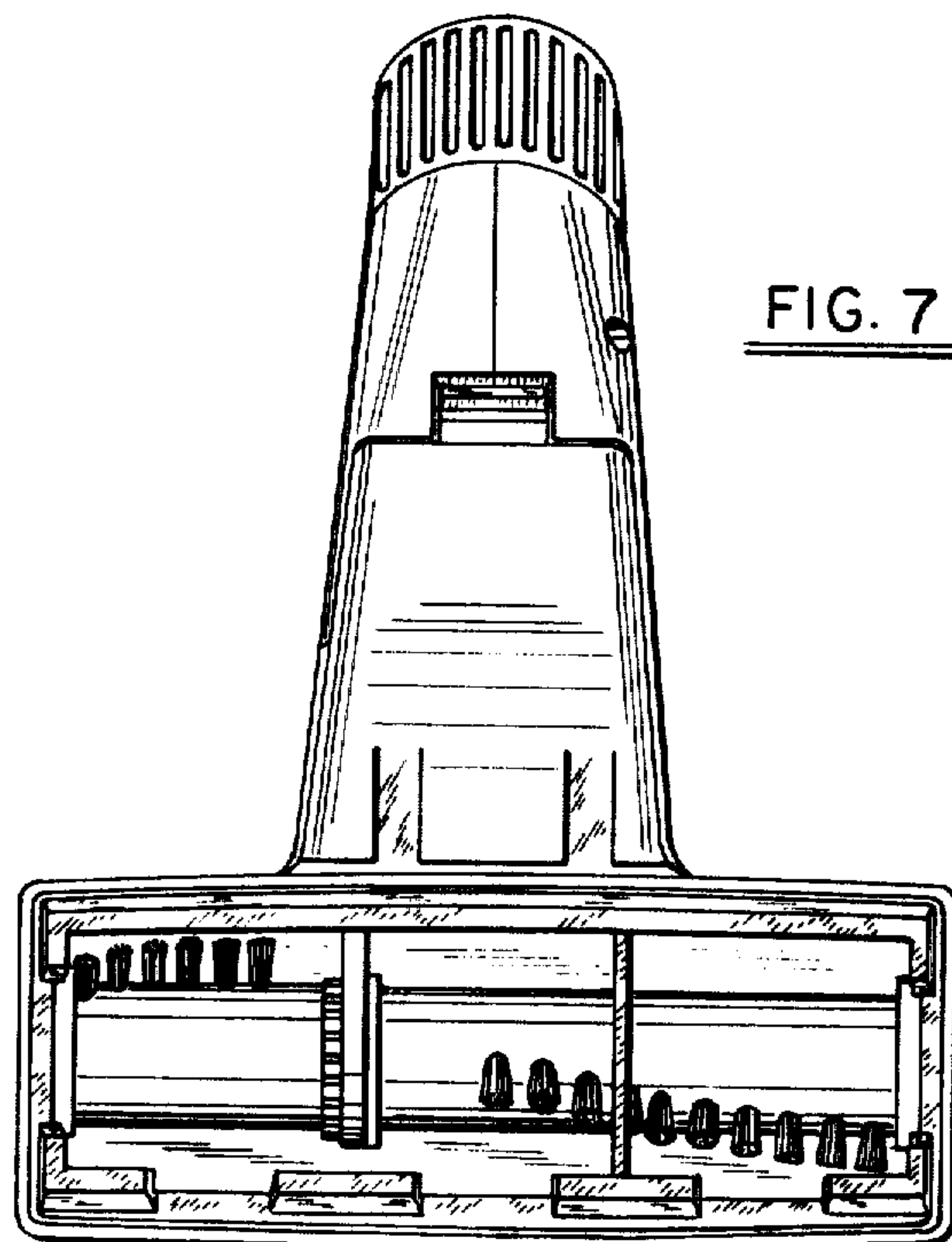
