FIG. 2 is a right side elevational view thereof;


FIG. 3 is another left side elevational view thereof, showing the tool orintated to clean a vertical surface;


FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;


FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a top plan view thereof; and
