FIG. 2 is a bottom rear perspective view the showing of a visor in broken lines is for illustrative purposes only.

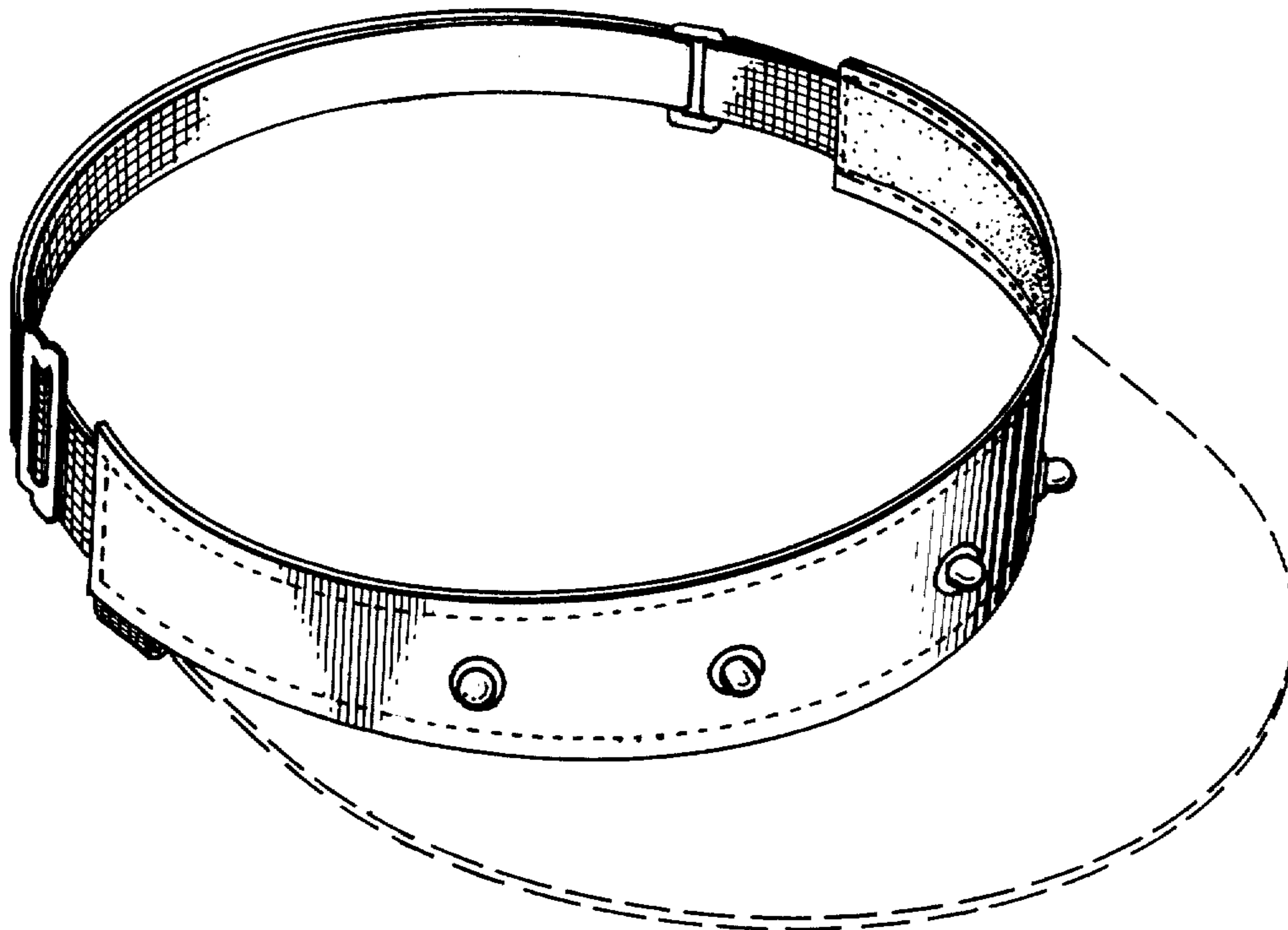

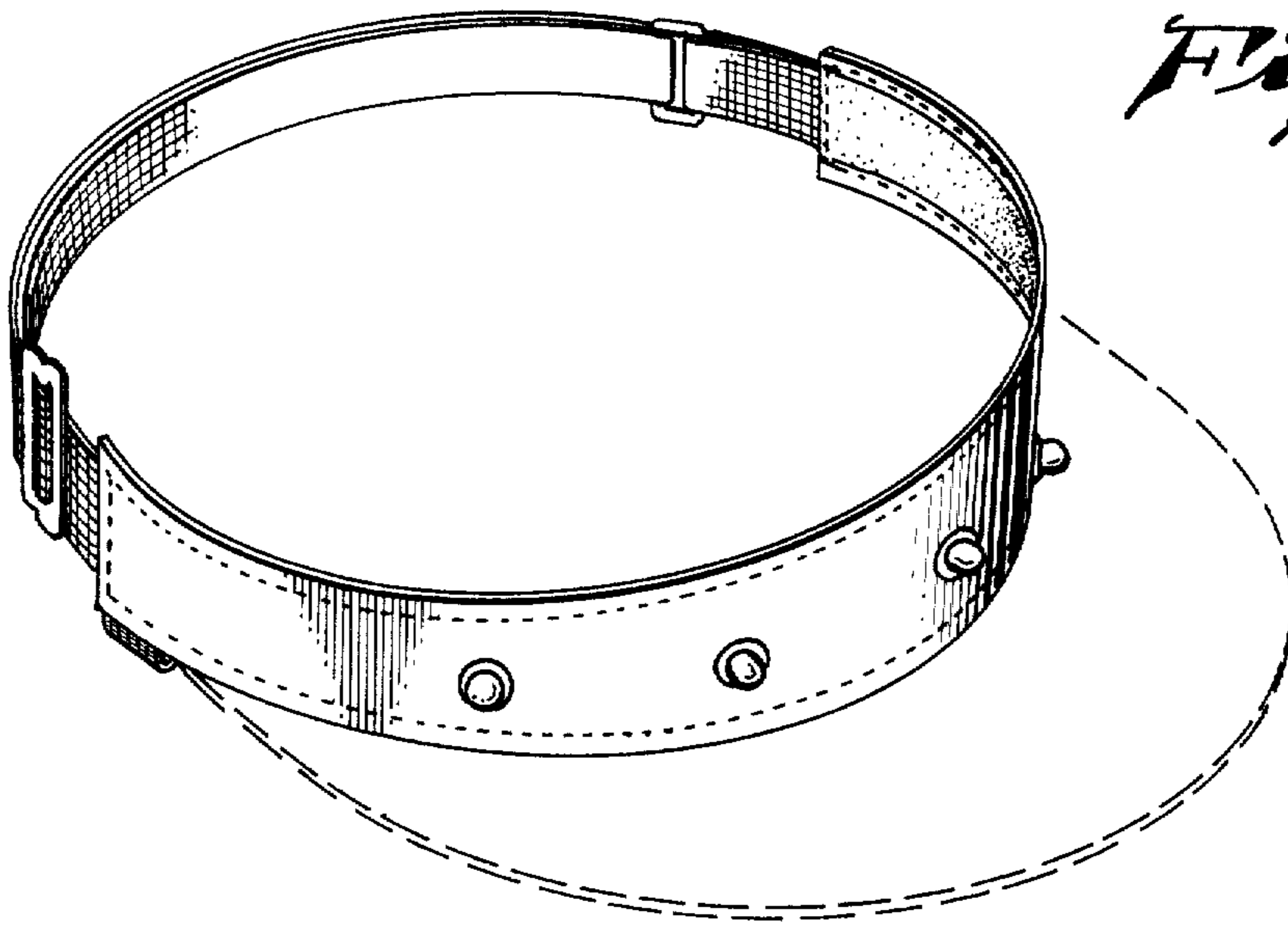
