The ornamental design for a creamer pitcher, as shown and described.

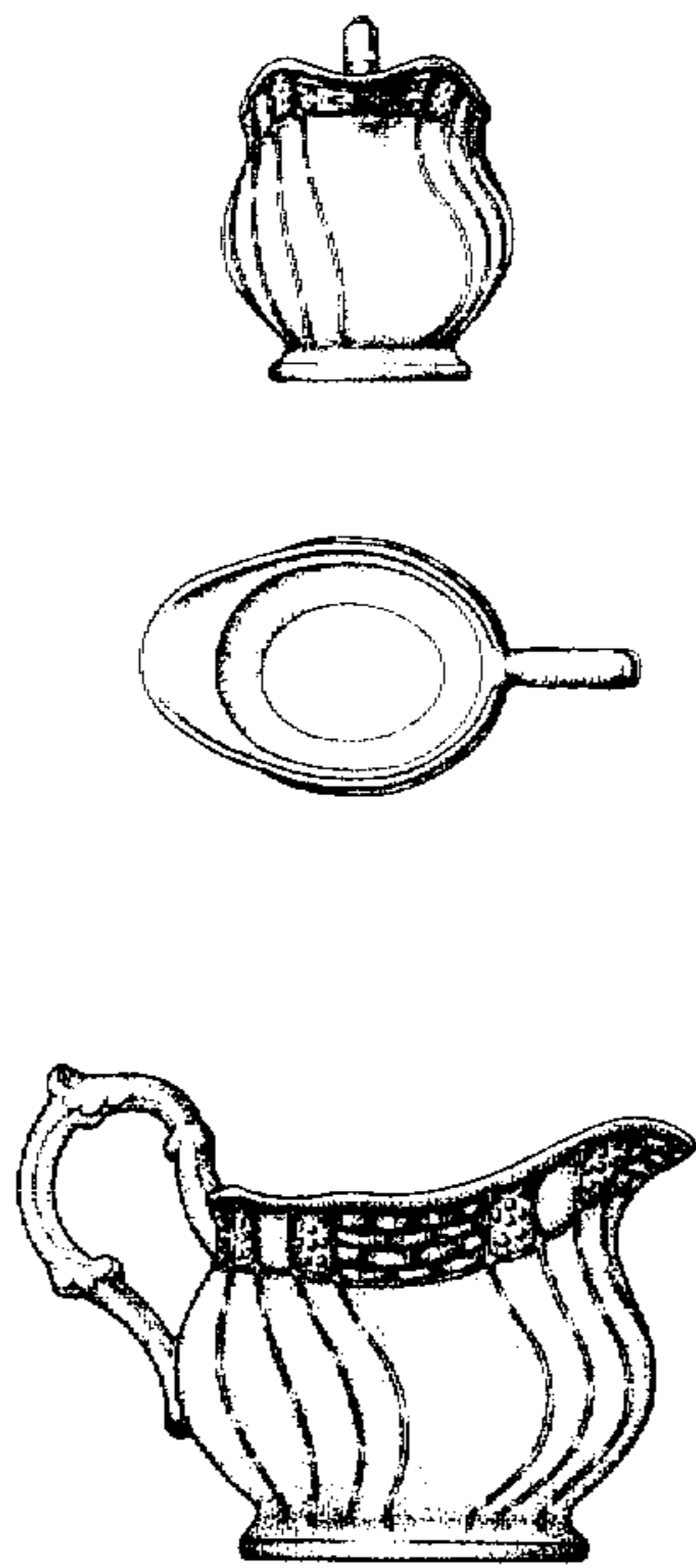

 FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.



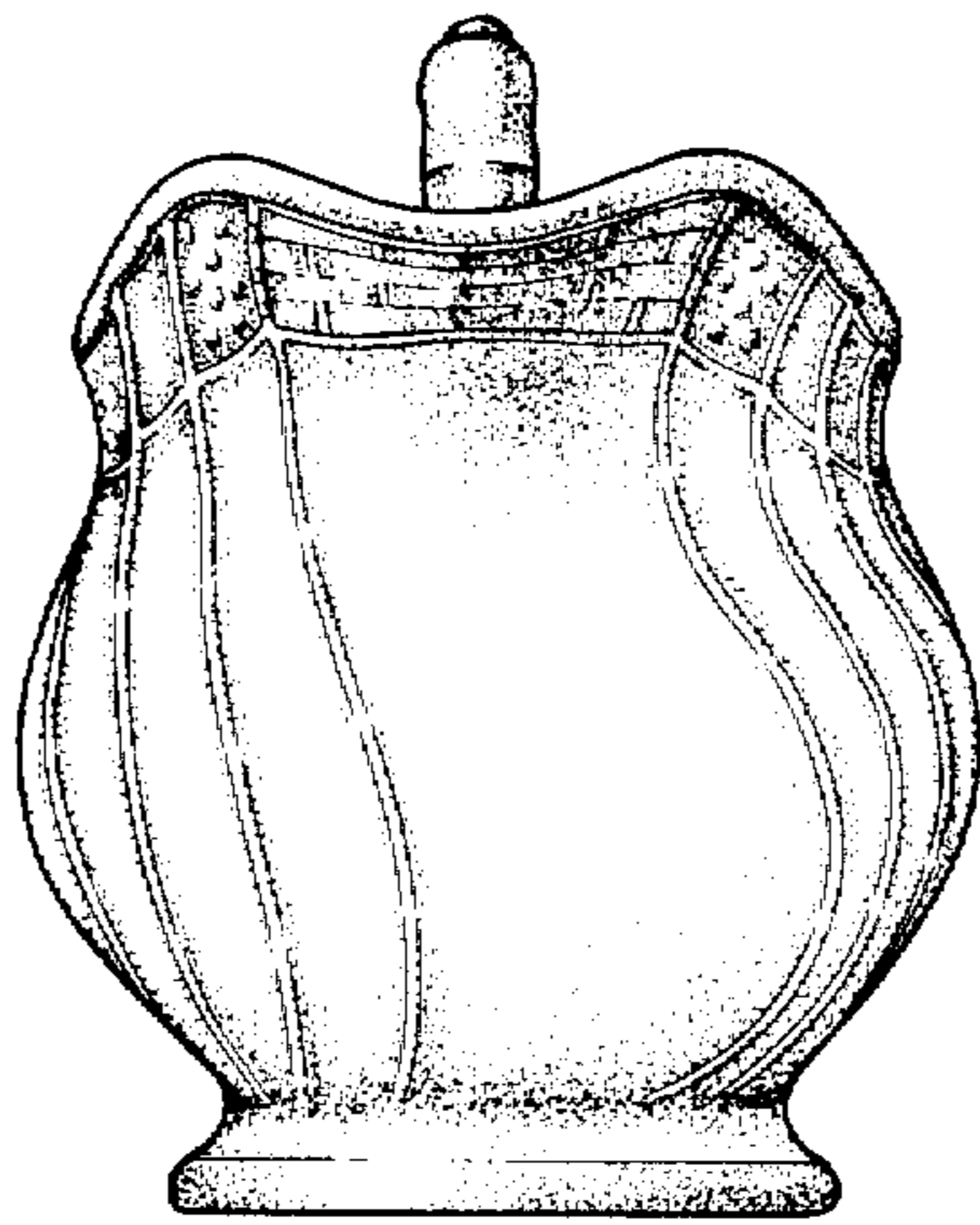

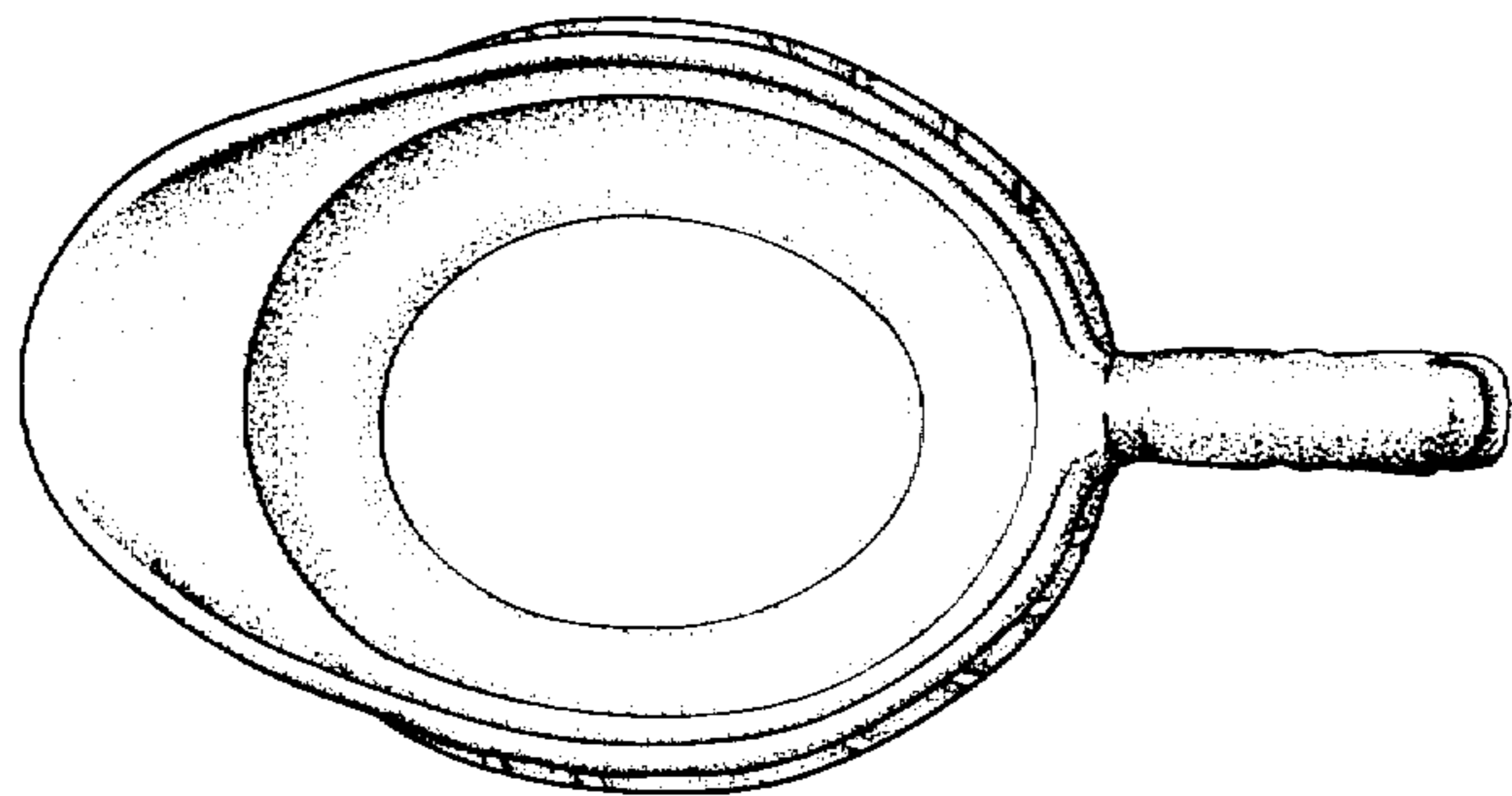

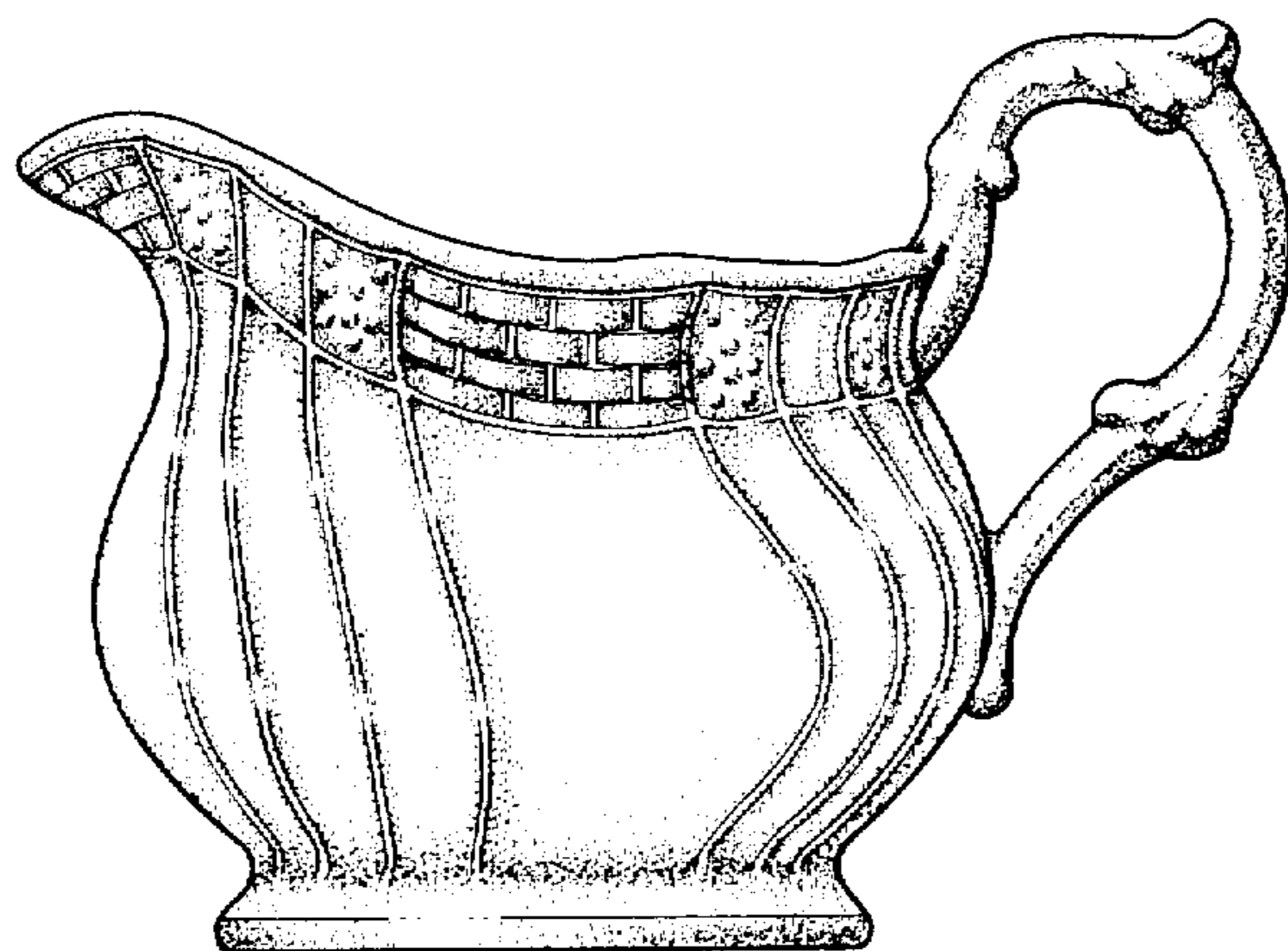

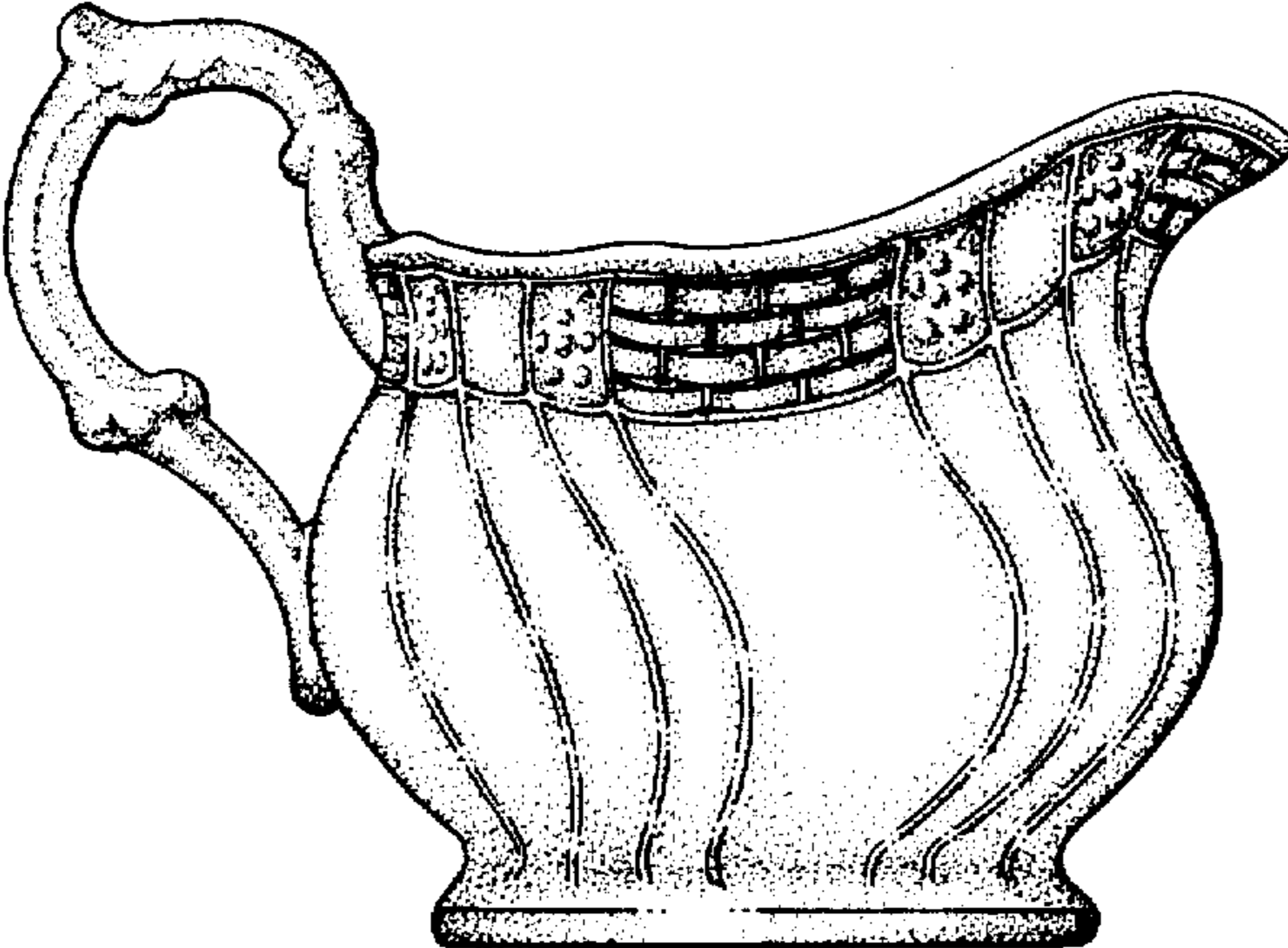

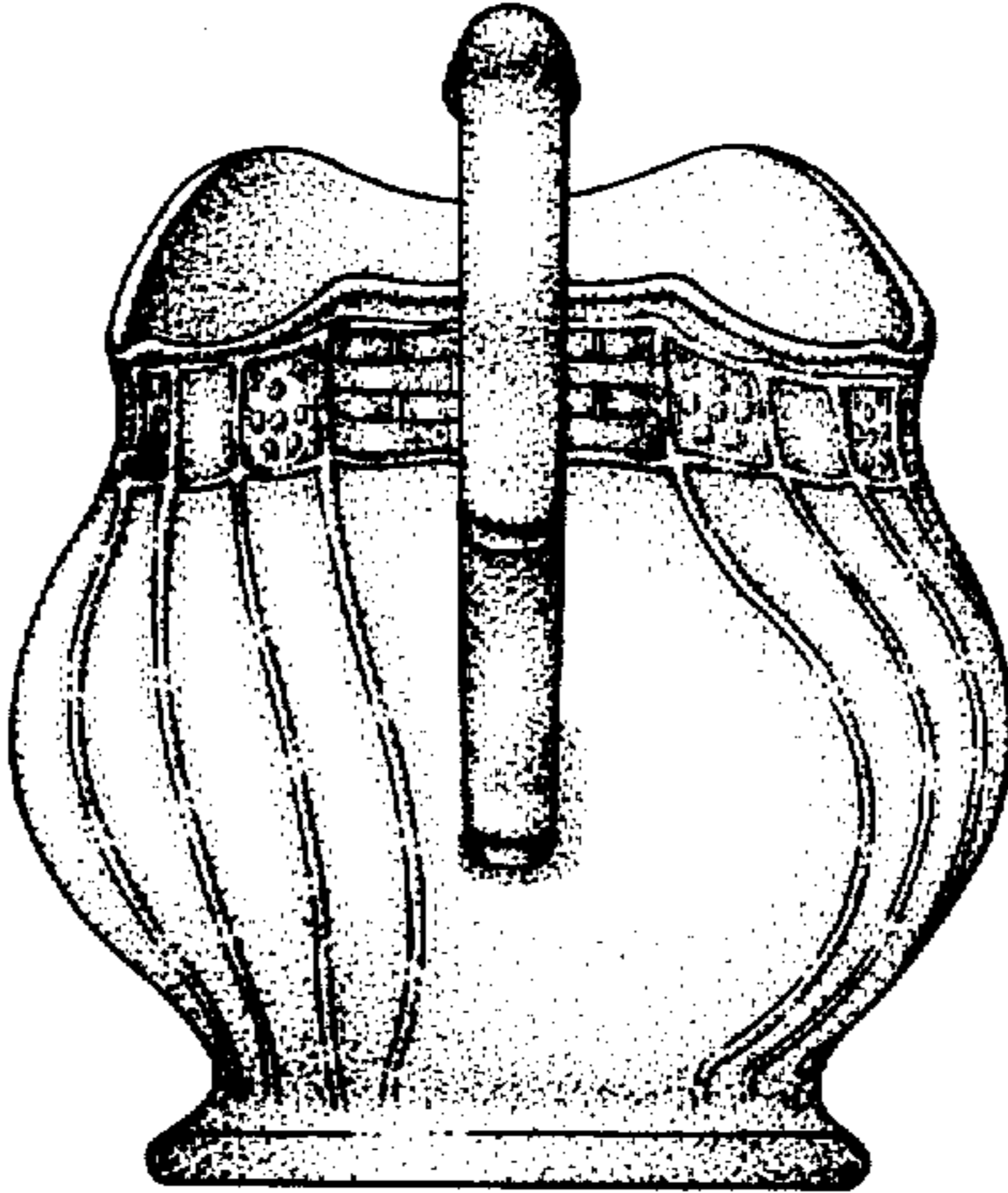
