DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a left front elevated perspective view of a typewriter showing our new design;

FIG. 2 is a right front elevated perspective view thereof;

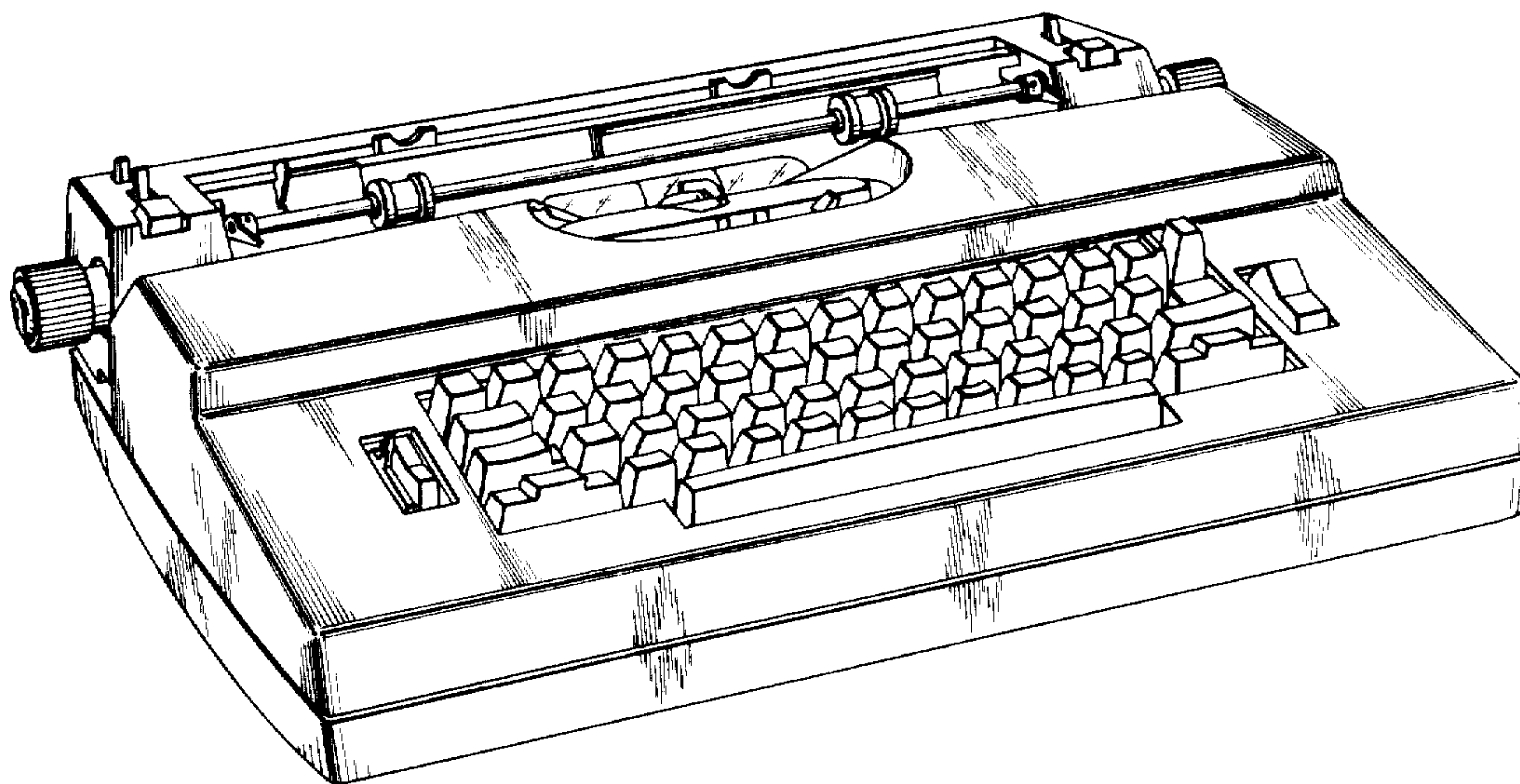
FIG. 3 is a right rear elevated perspective view thereof;

FIG. 7 is a partial sectional view taken on line 7—7 of FIG. 5.



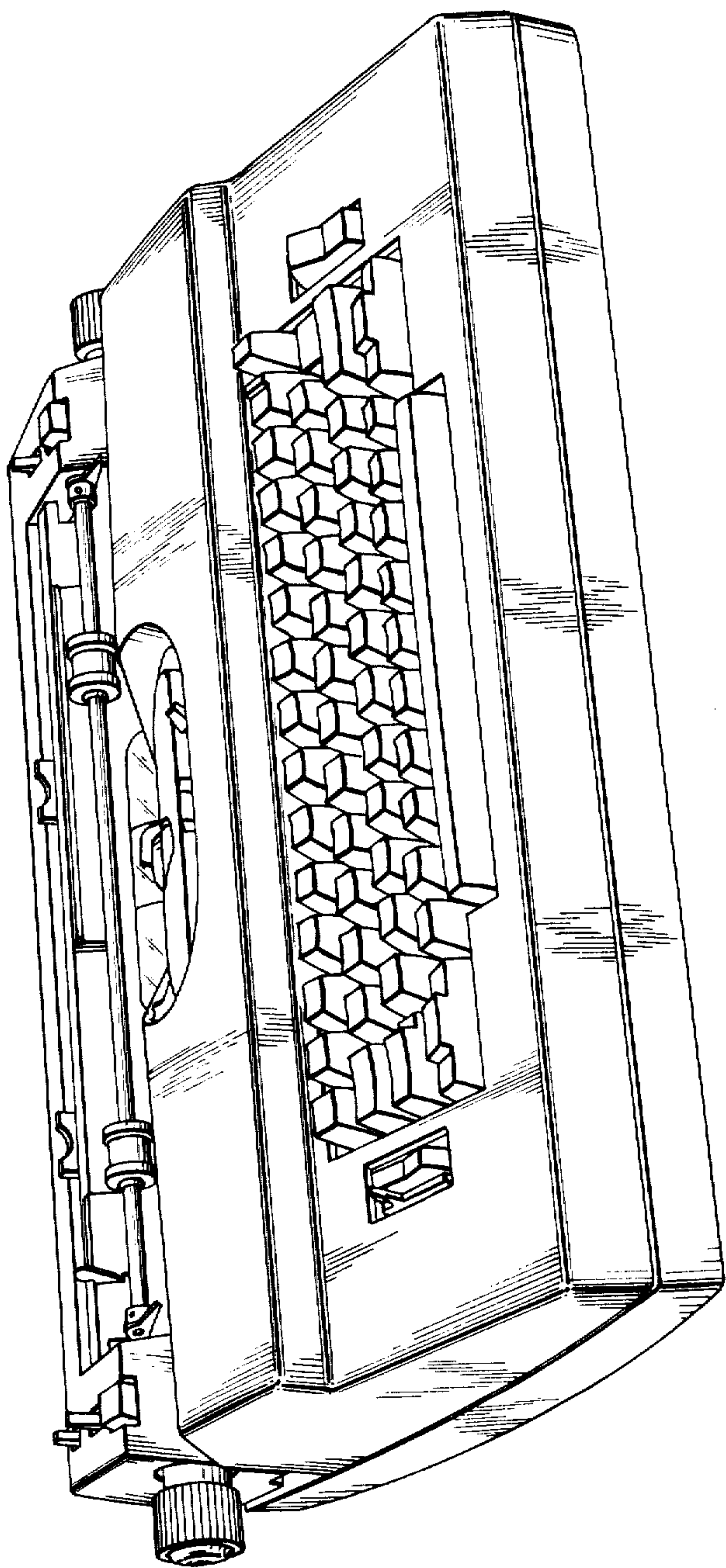

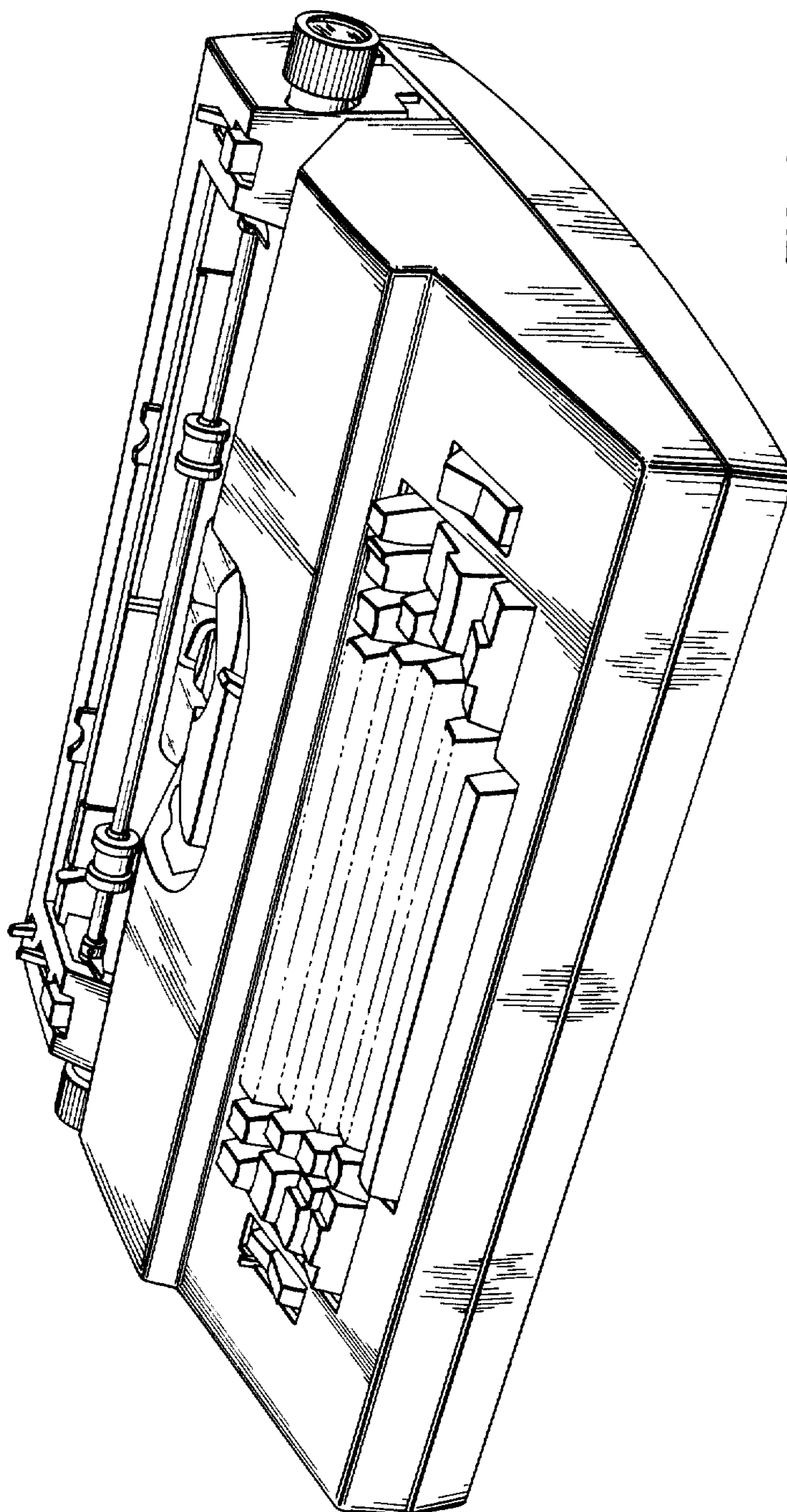

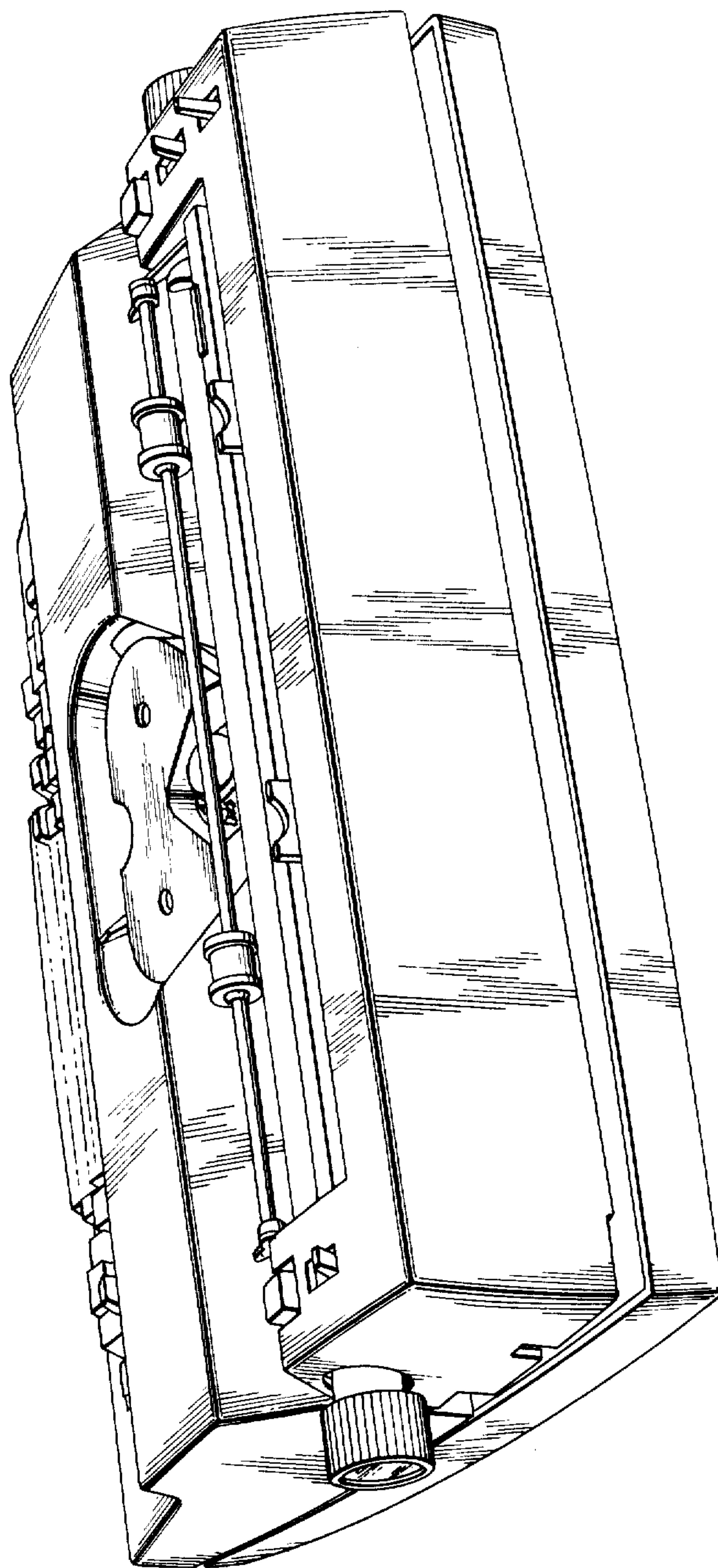

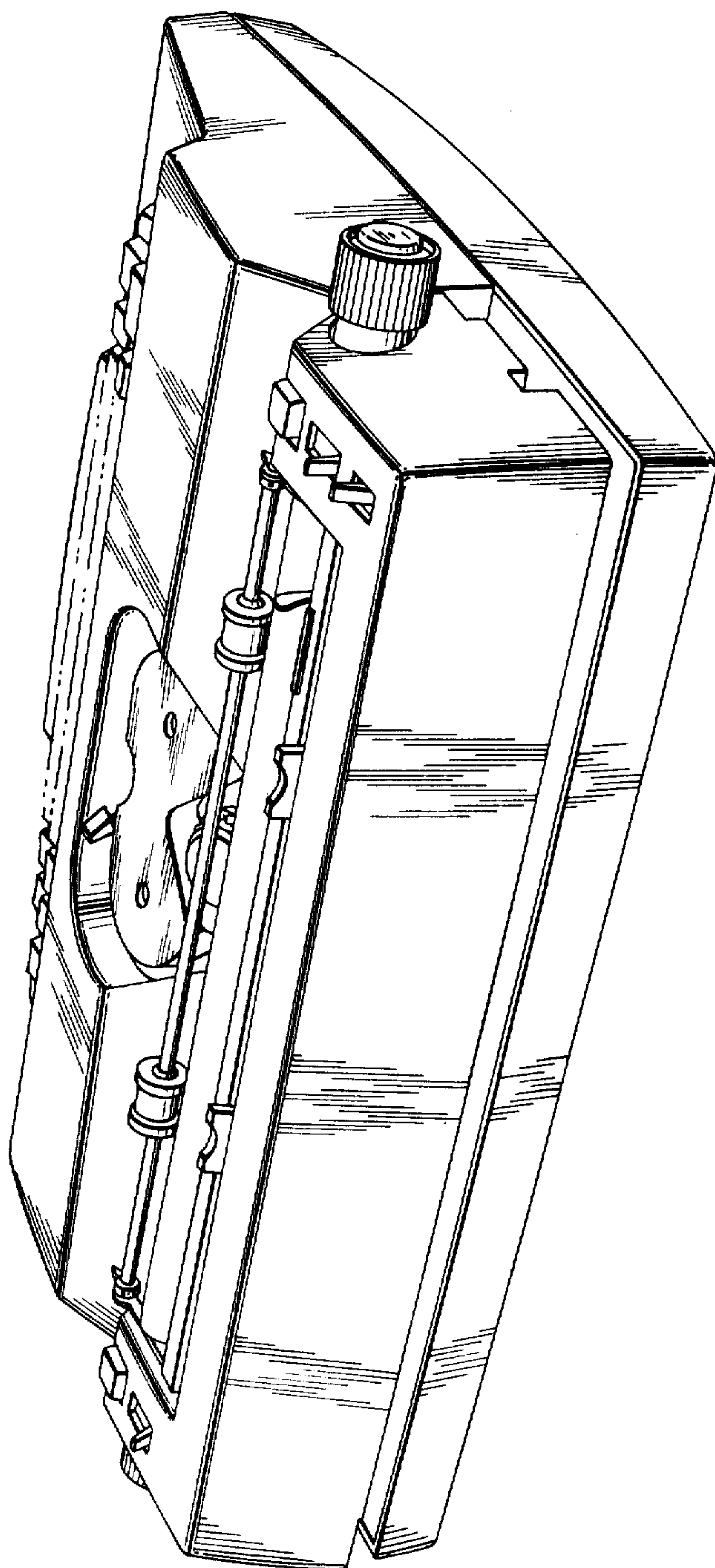
