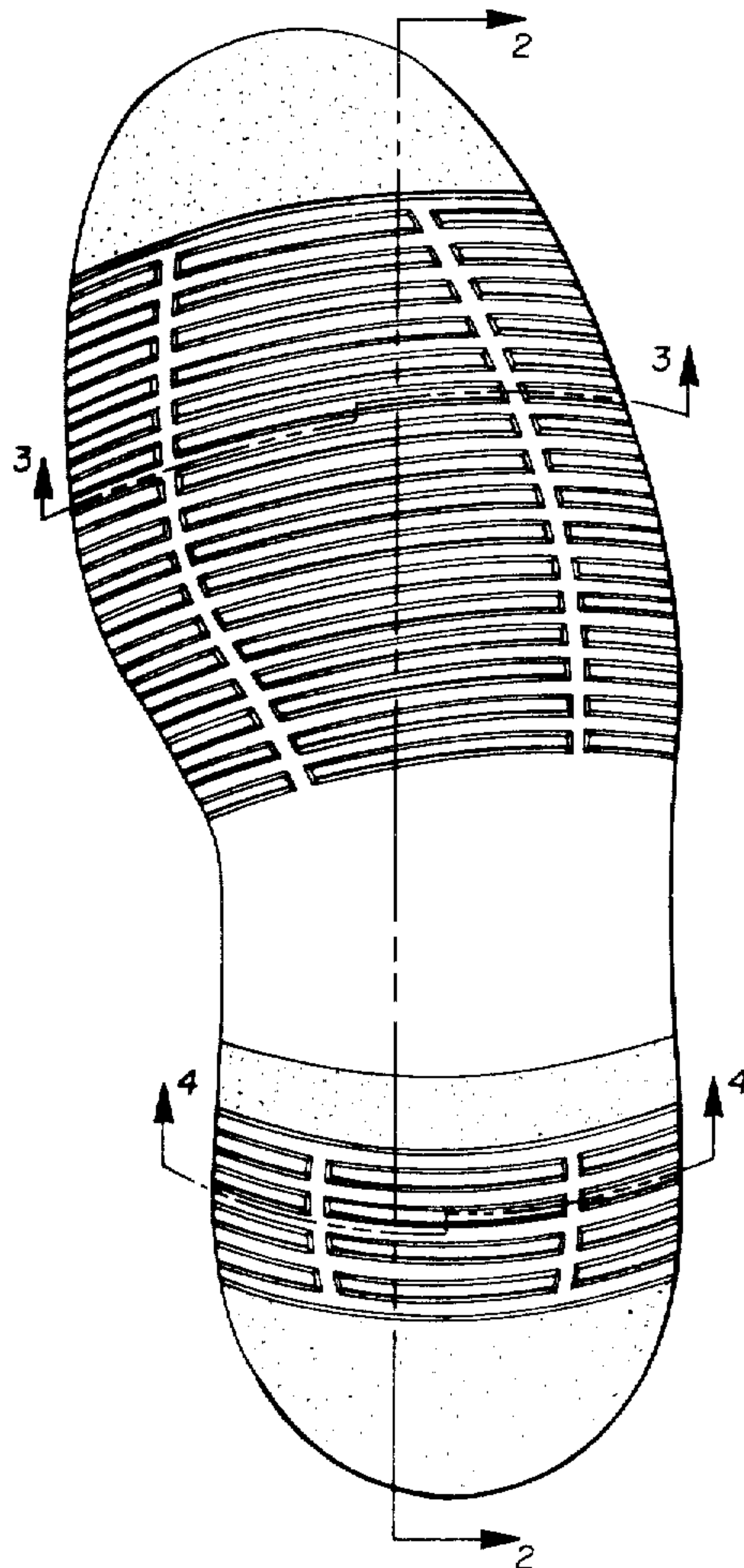

The ornamental design for a shoe sole, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a bottom plan view of a shoe sole showing our new design, the top, not shown, is flat, plain and unornamented;
 FIG. 2 is a cross-sectional view as taken from line 2-2 of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view as taken from line 3-3 of FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a cross-sectional view as taken from line 4-4 of FIG. 1.



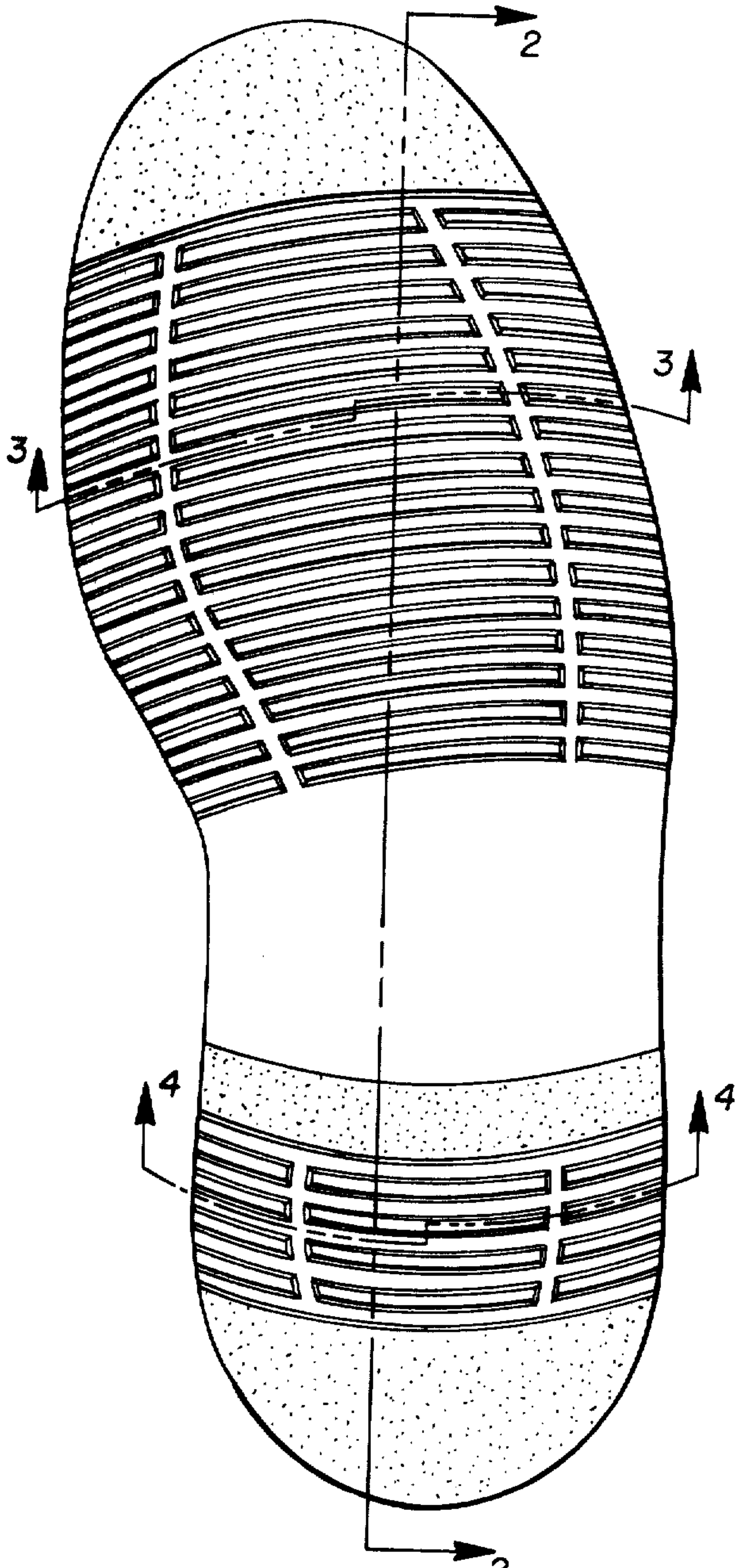

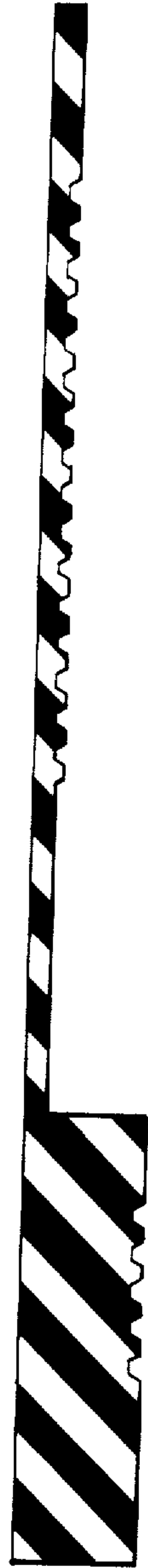
