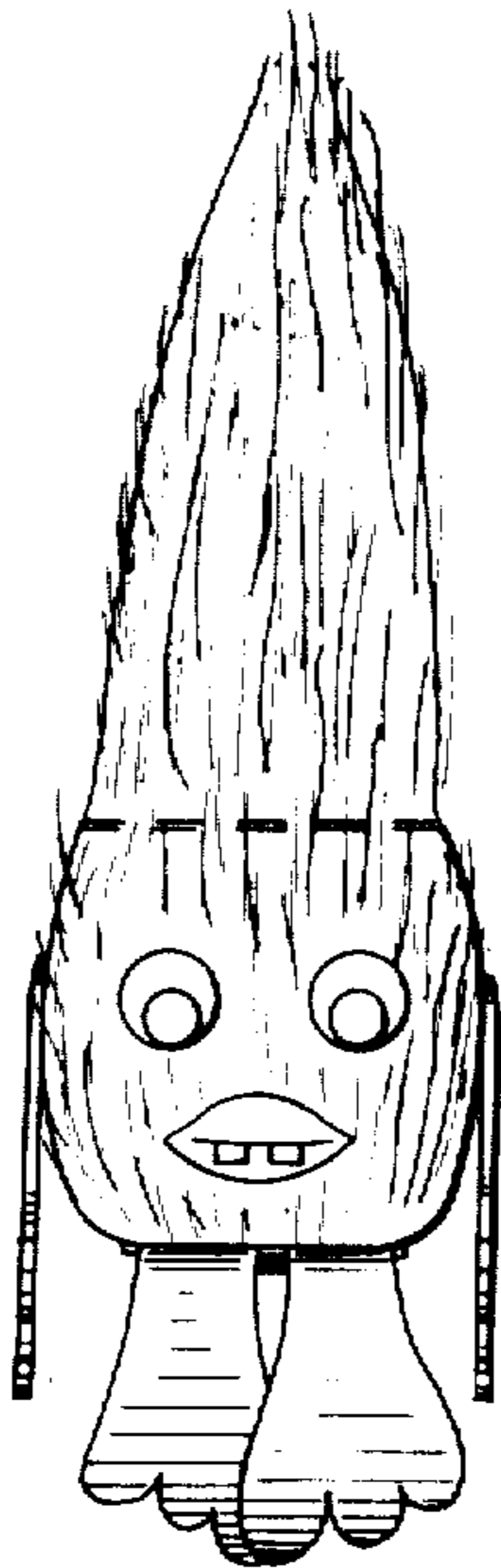

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a bag showing our new design;
 FIG. 2 is a left side elevational view, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;
 FIG. 3 is a rear elevational view of the bag shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom view of the bag shown in FIG. 1;
 FIG. 5 is a top plan view; and
 FIG. 6 is a top plan view shown partially open.



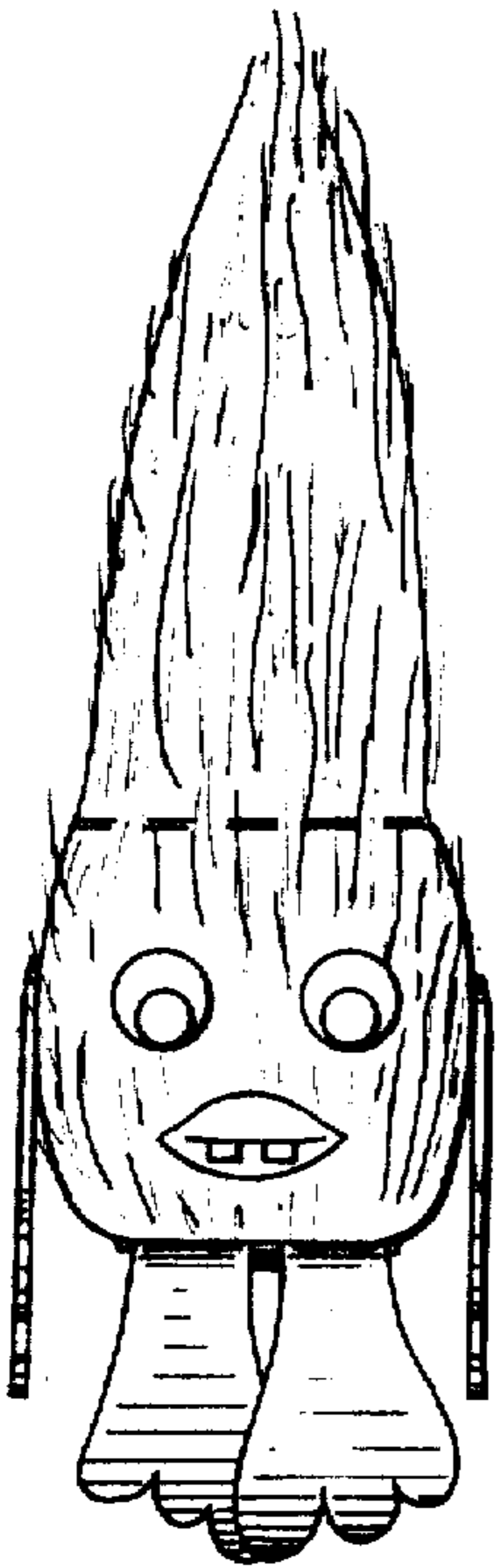

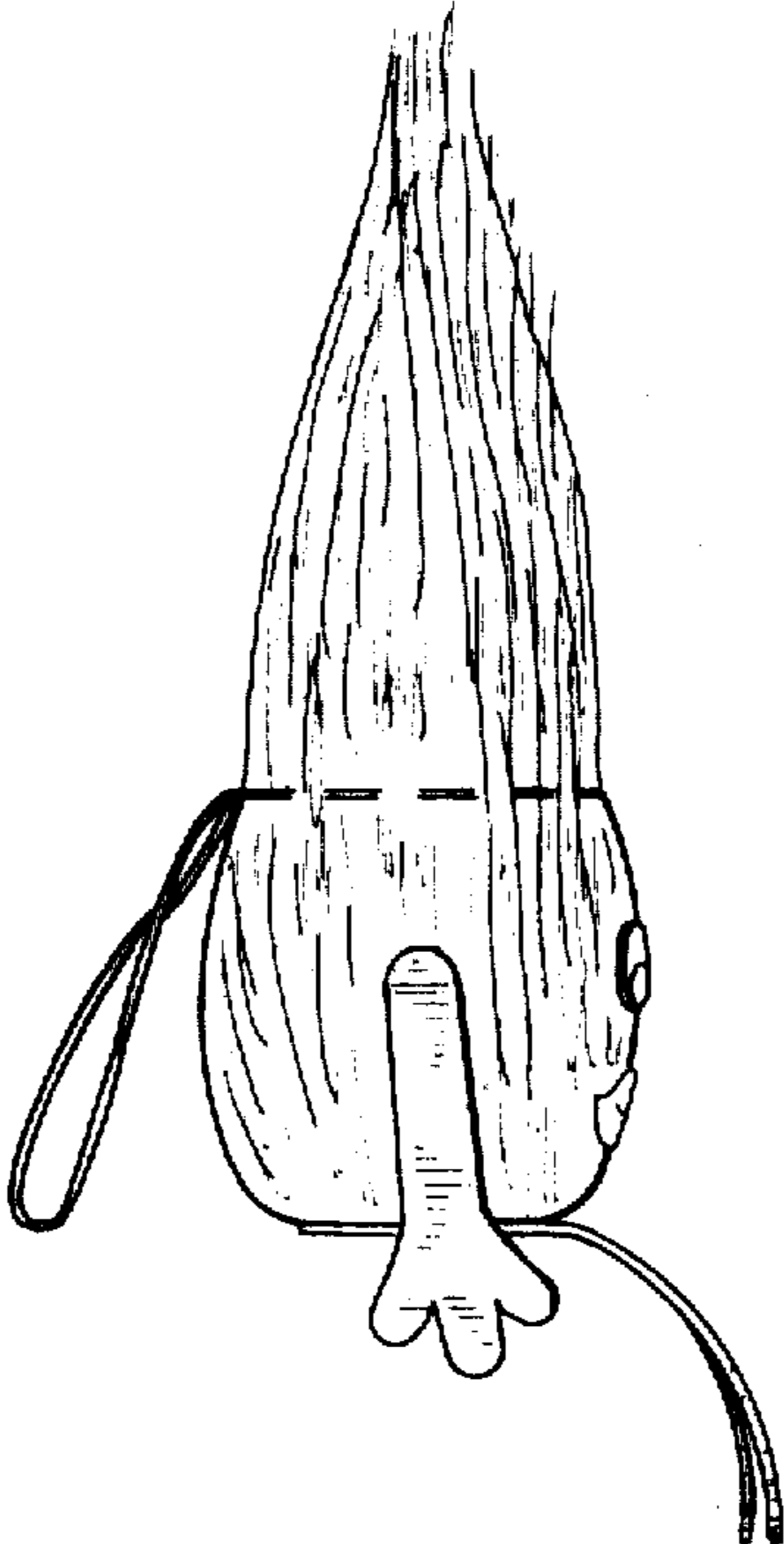

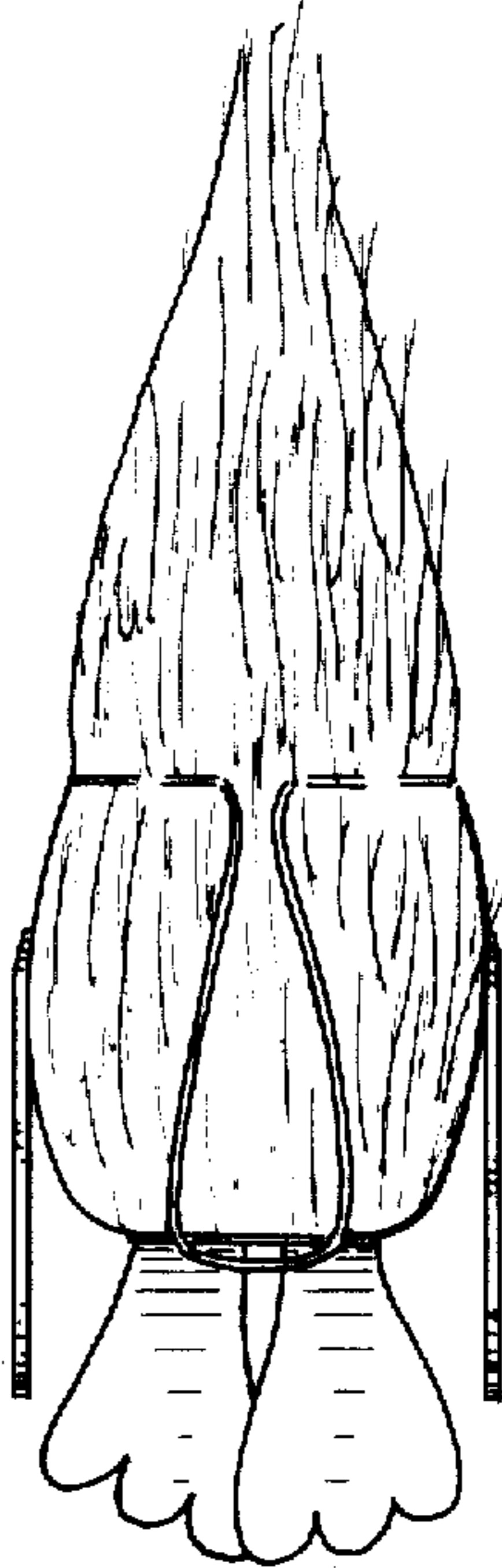

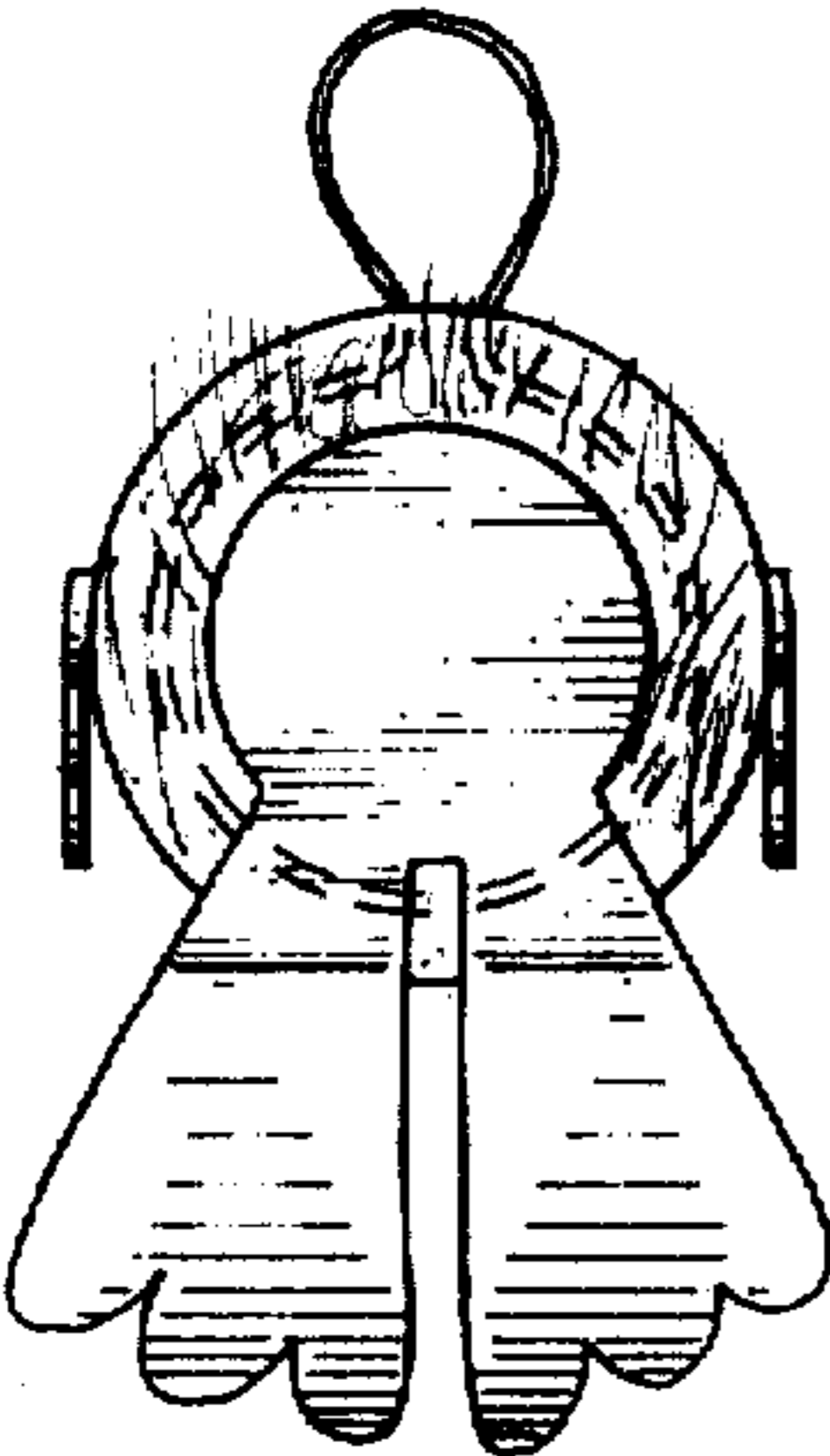

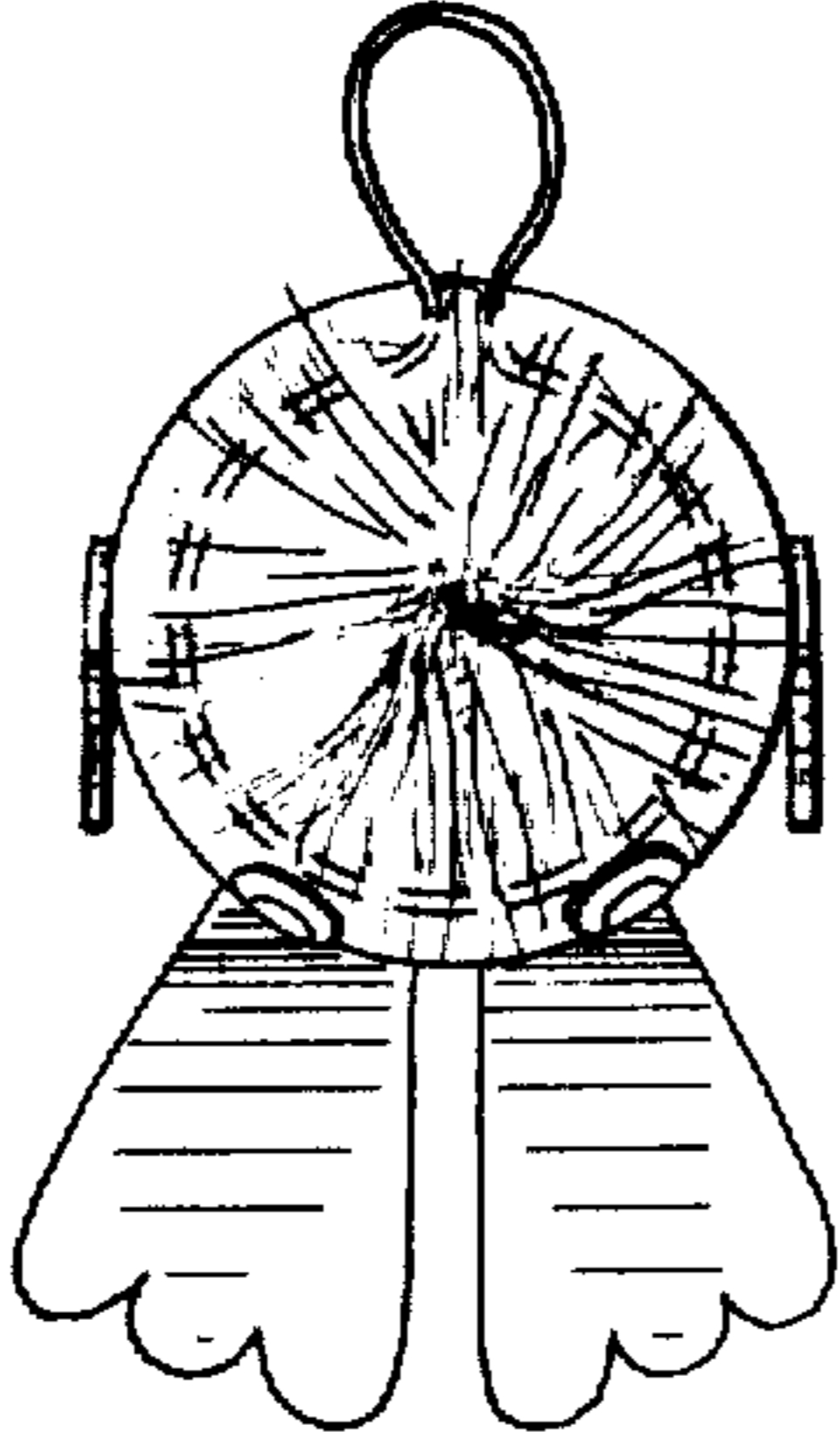

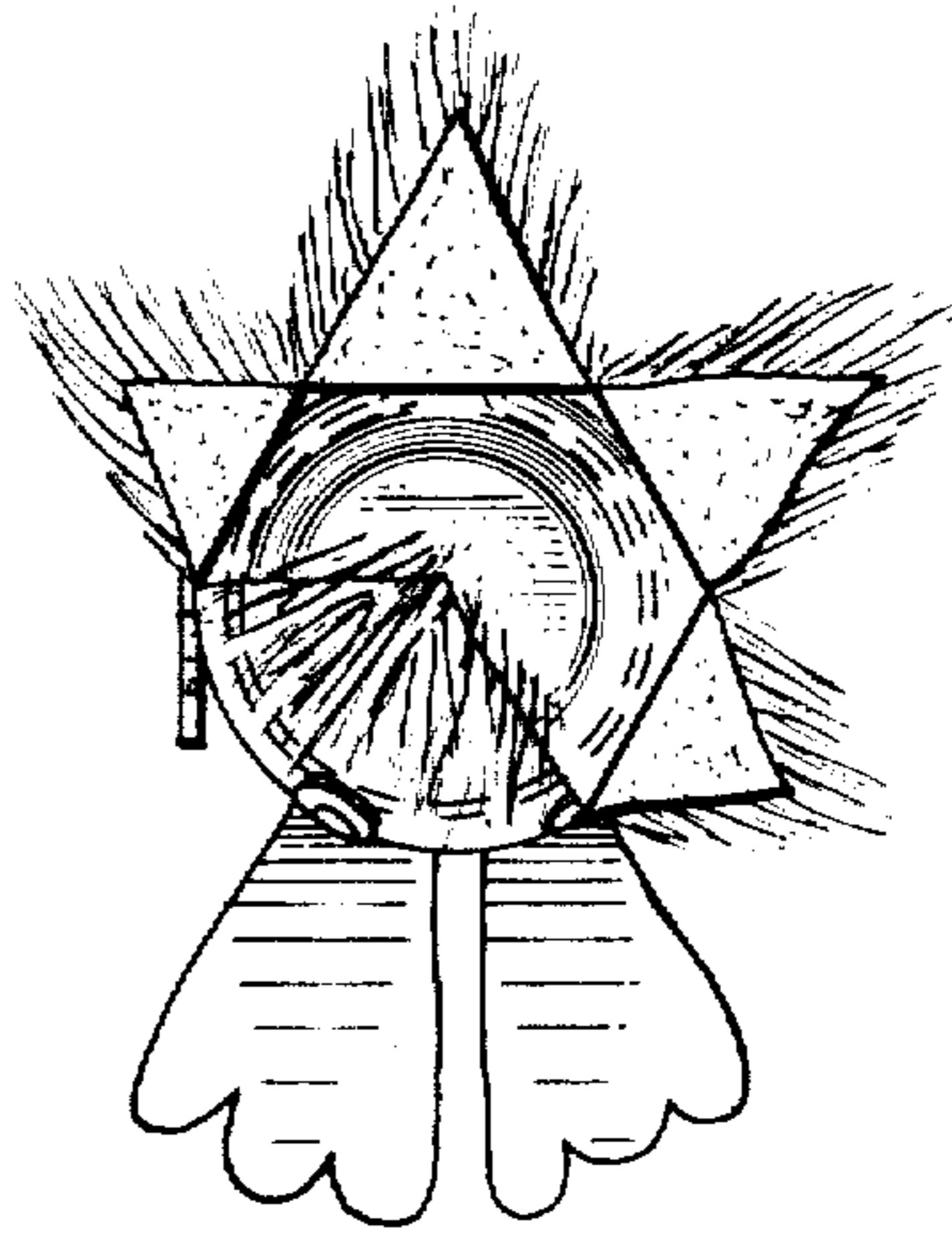
