CLAIM

The ornamental design for a tumbler or similar article, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a tumbler or similar article showing my new design in the size and proportions of a water glass;


FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof;

FIG. 2 is a sectional view thereof taken along the lines 2-2 of FIG. 5;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof, with the other side being a mirror image;

FIG. 4 is a top plan view thereof;


FIG. 6 is a side elevational view of a tumbler or similar article showing my new design in the size and proportions of an on-the-rocks glass, with the other side being a mirror image;


FIG. 8 is a bottom plan view of the tumbler of FIG. 6; and

FIG. 7 is a sectional view of the tumbler of FIG. 6 taken along the lines 7—7 of FIG. 8;















