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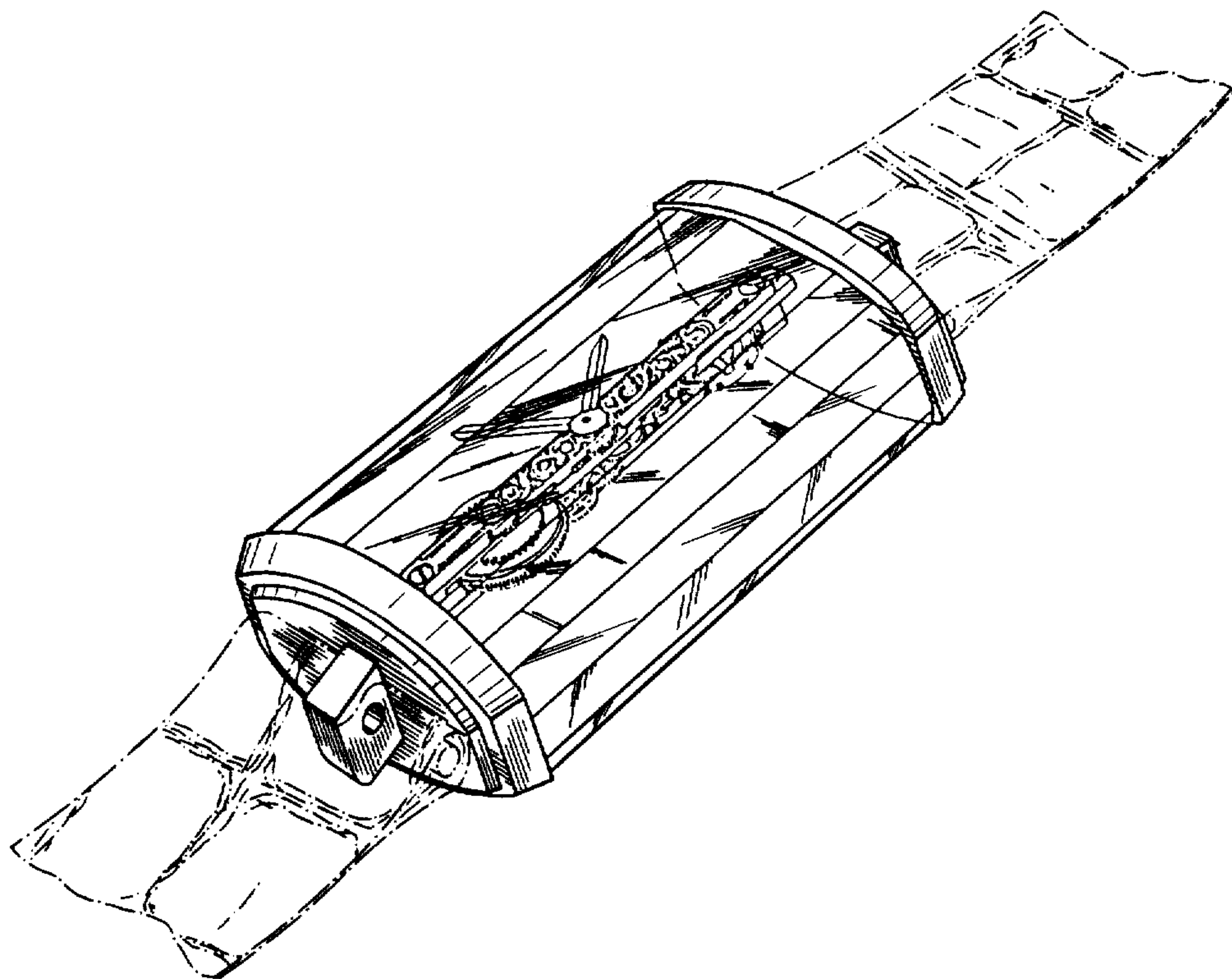

[57] CLAIM
The ornamental design for a wristwatch, as shown and

The FIGURE is a front perspective view of a wrist-
watch showing our new design, the band portions
shown in broken lines are environmental and form no
part of the claimed design.
