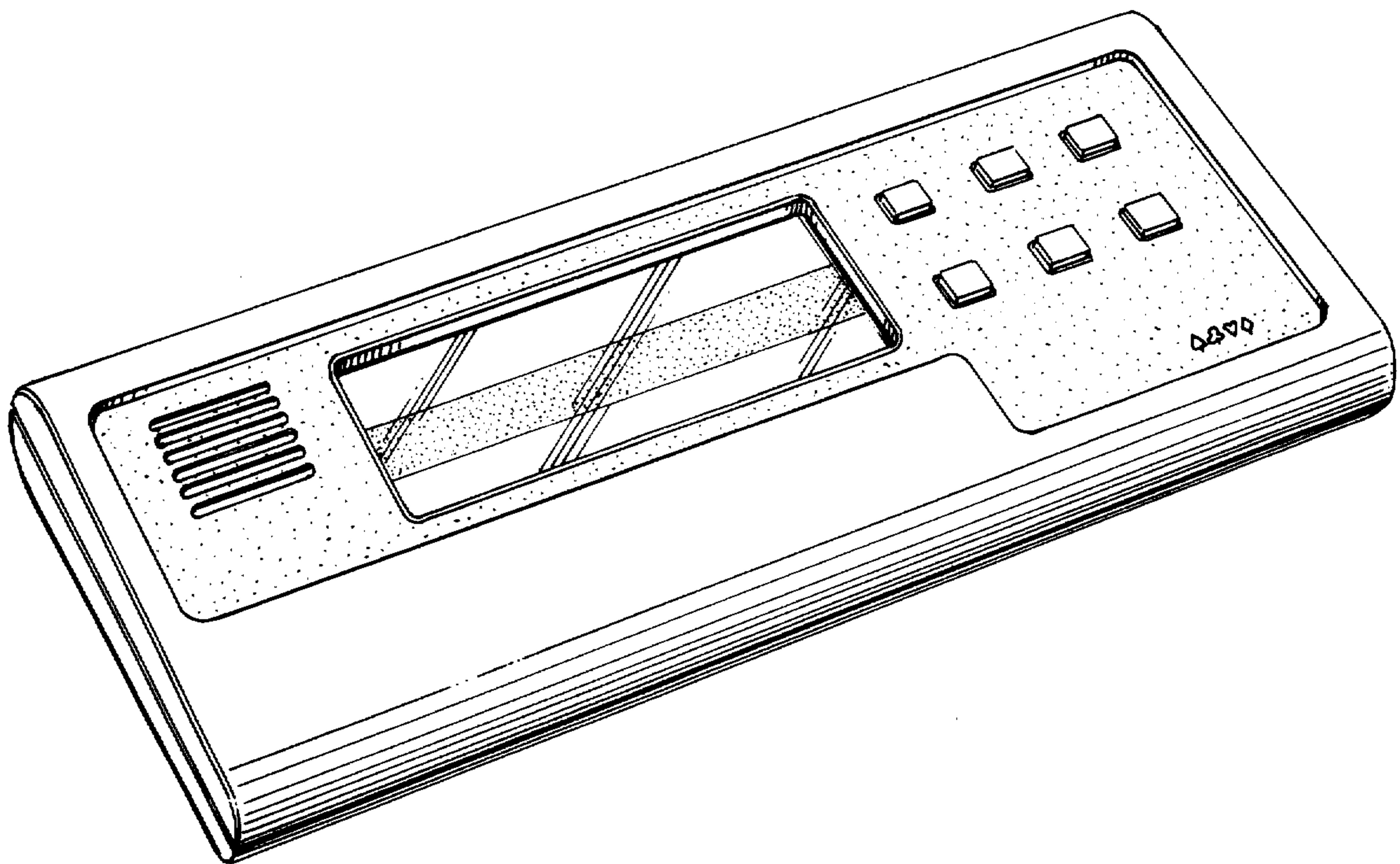

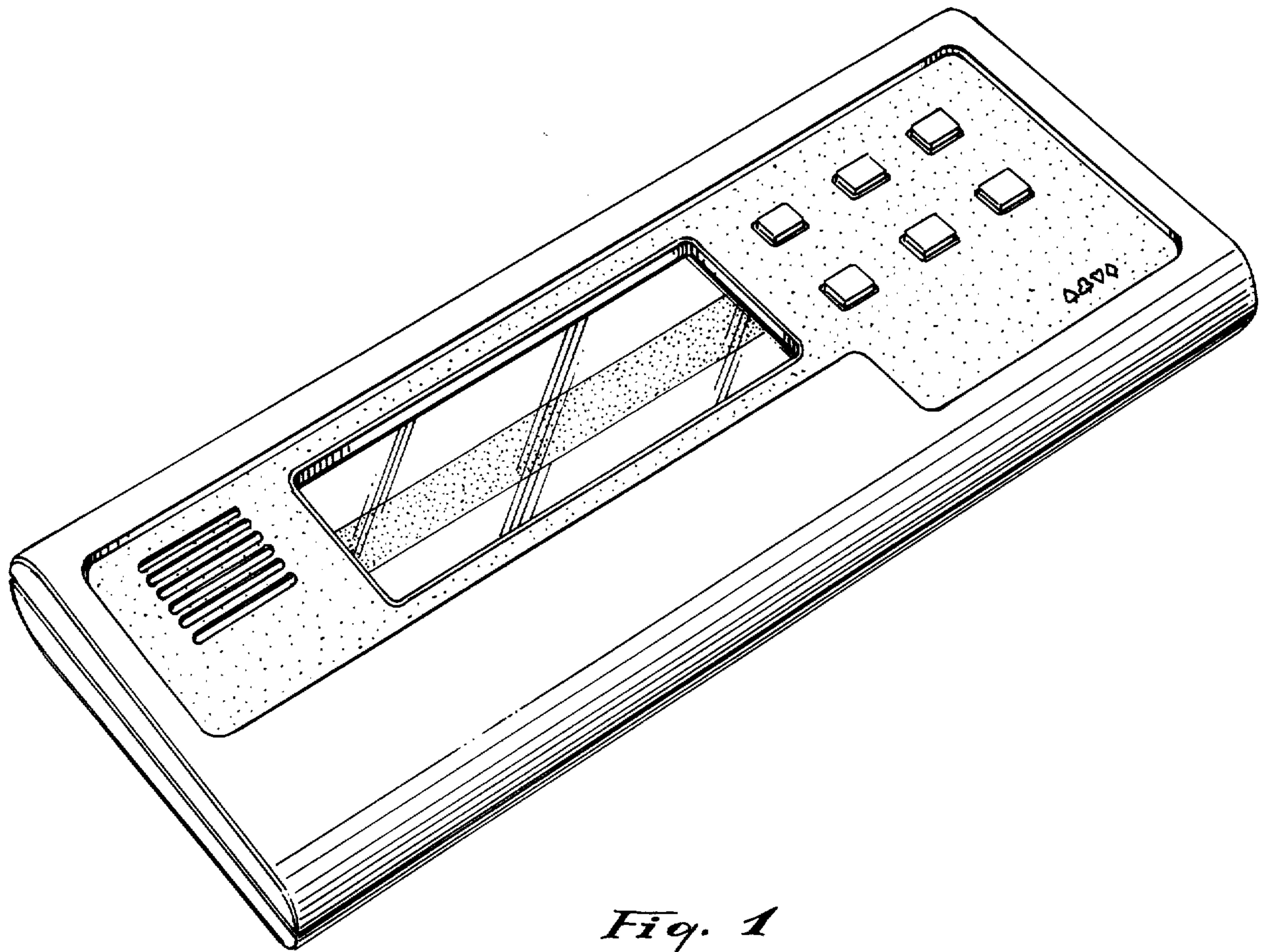
**CLAIM**

game, as shown and described.

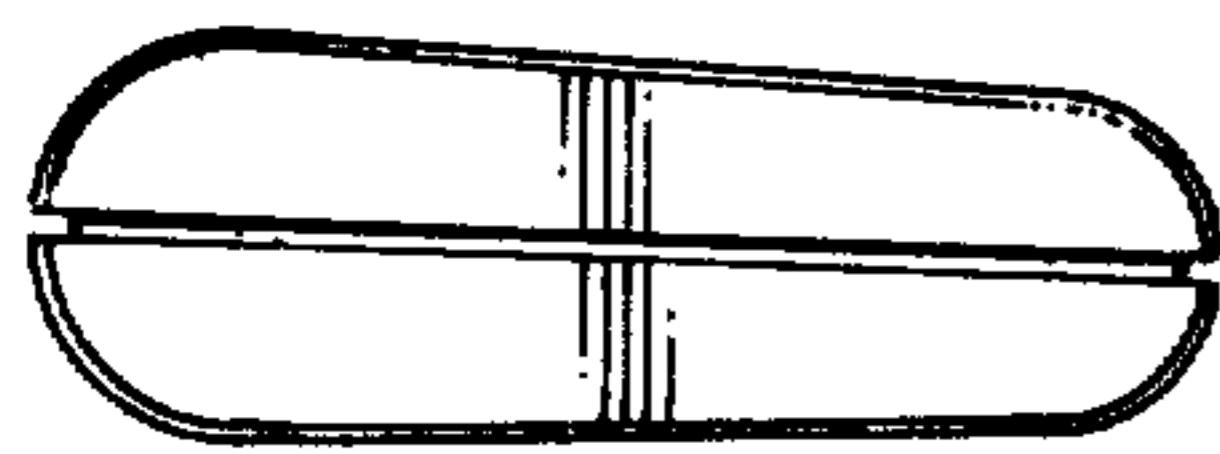
**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof.

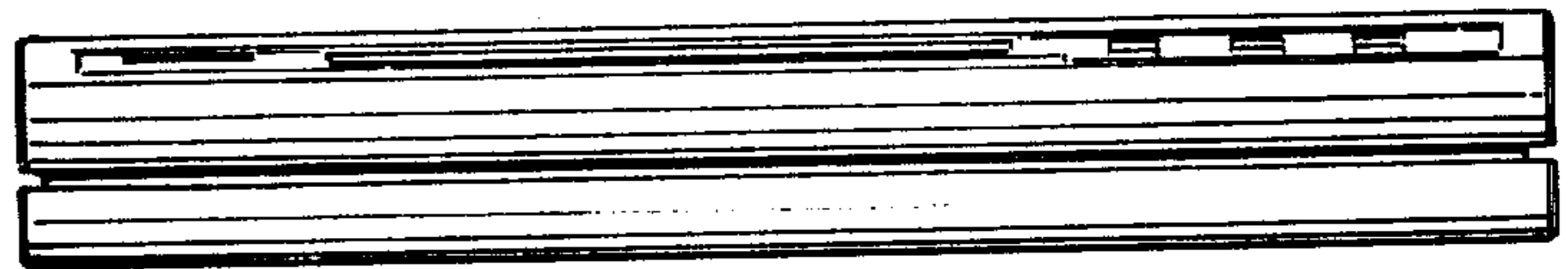




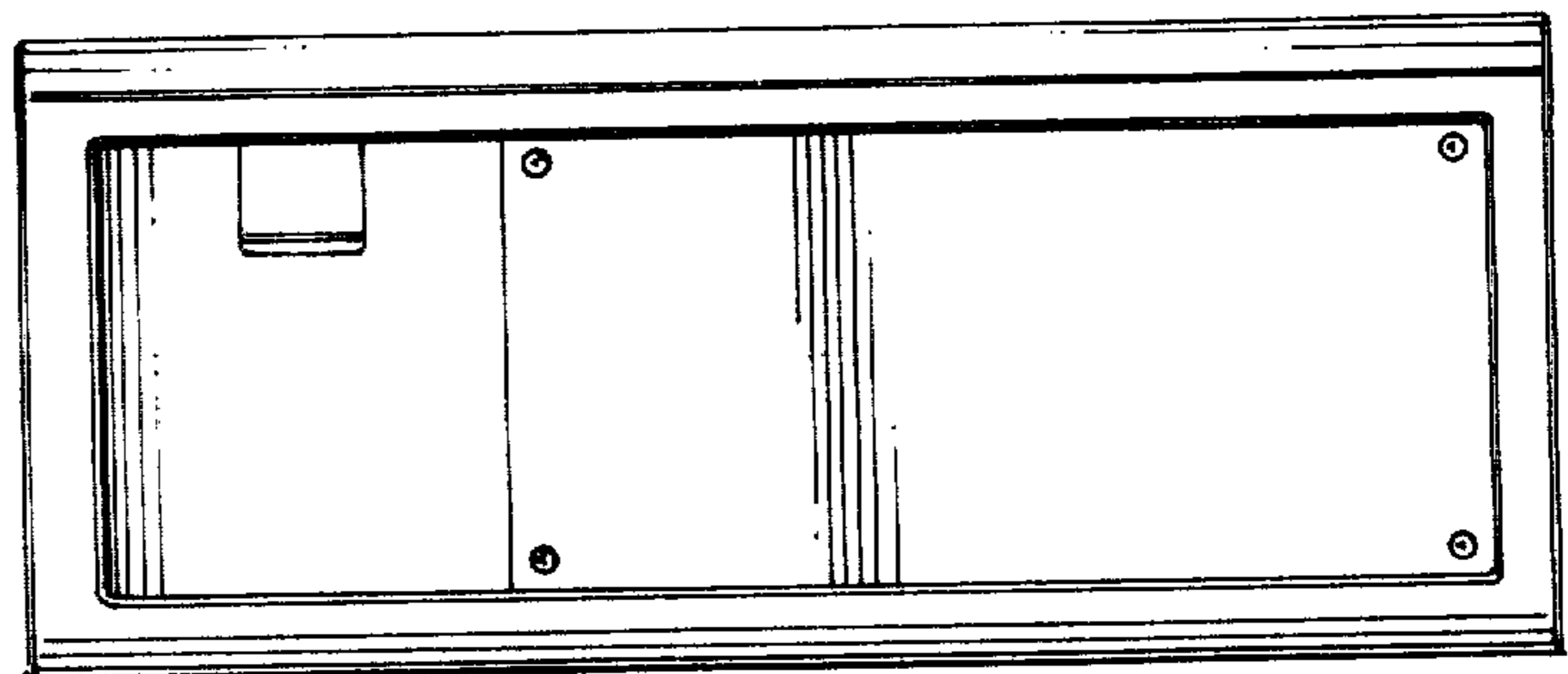
