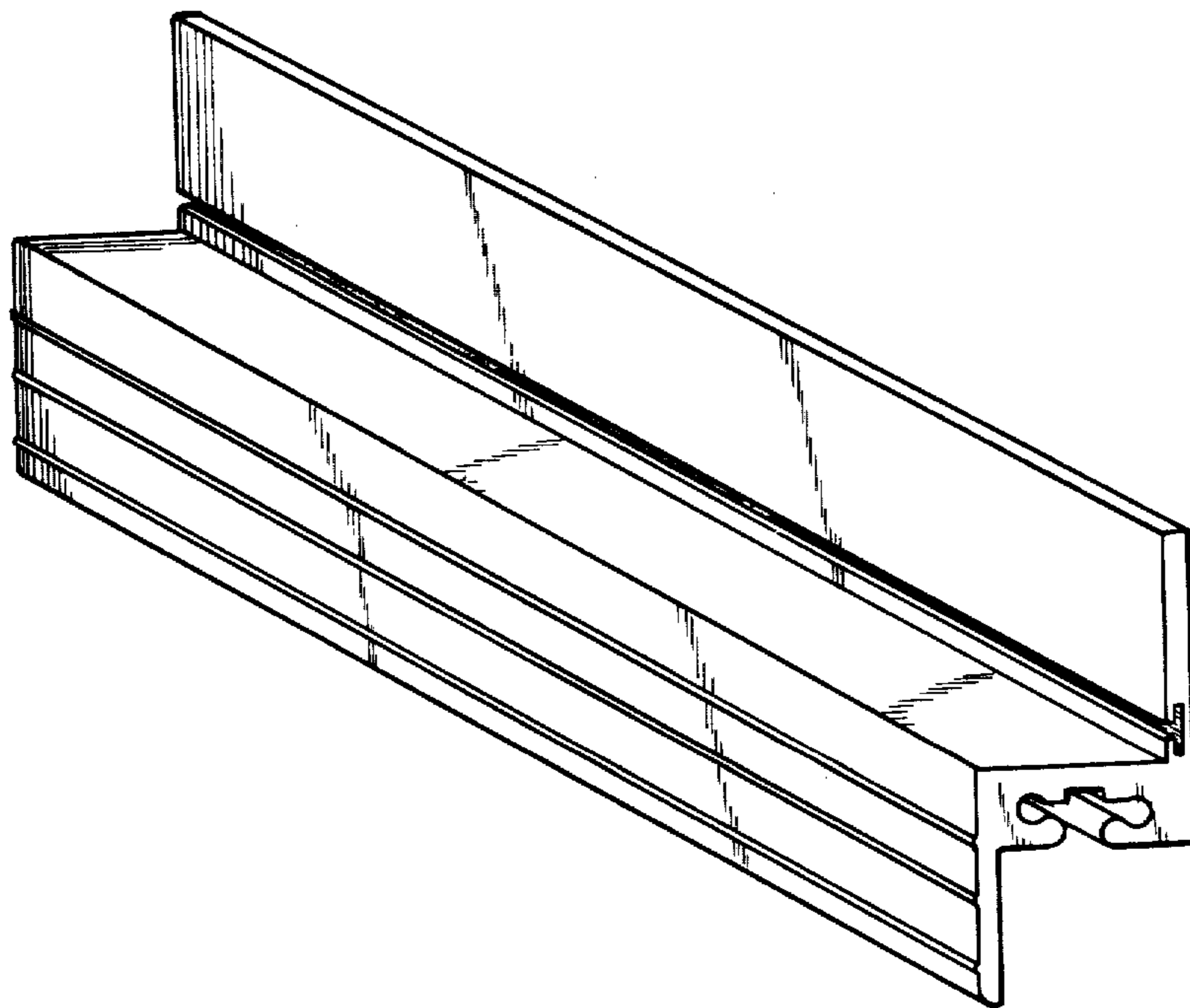

**DESCRIPTION**

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view illustrating a Z-shaped window frame member showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a front elevational view thereof; FIG. 3 is a left-end elevational view of FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a right-end elevational view of FIG. 2; FIG. 5 is a top elevational view thereof; FIG. 6 is a bottom elevational view thereof; and FIG. 7 is a rear elevational view thereof.



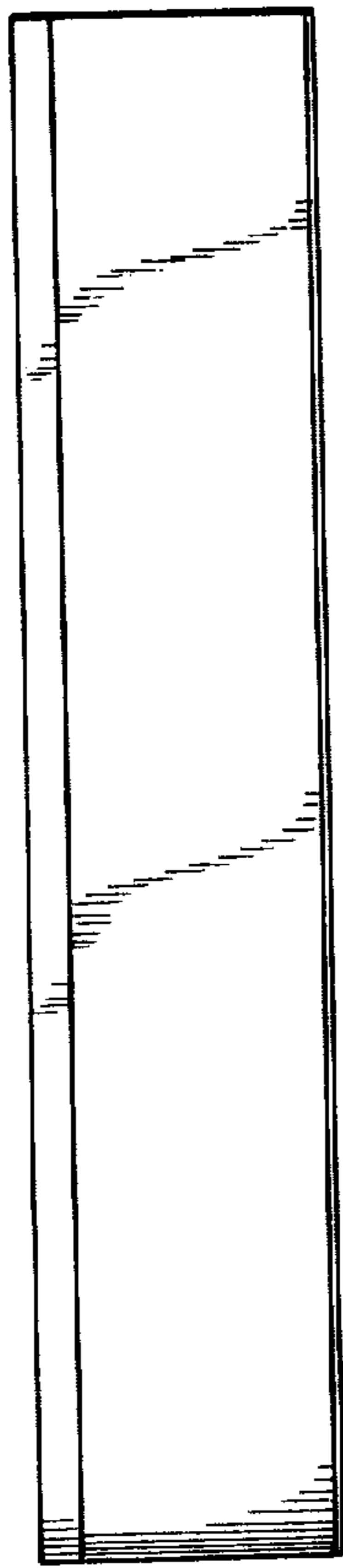

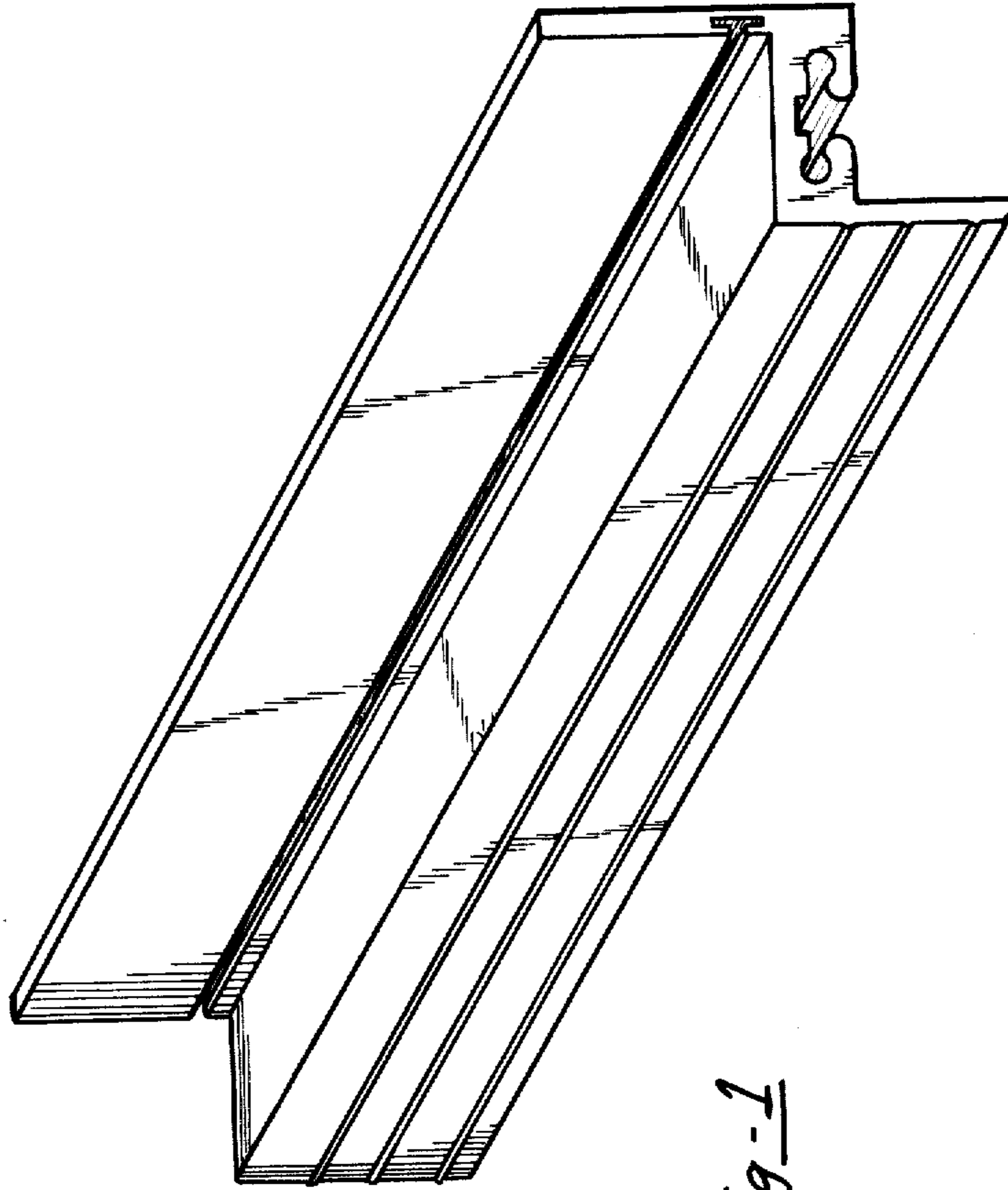

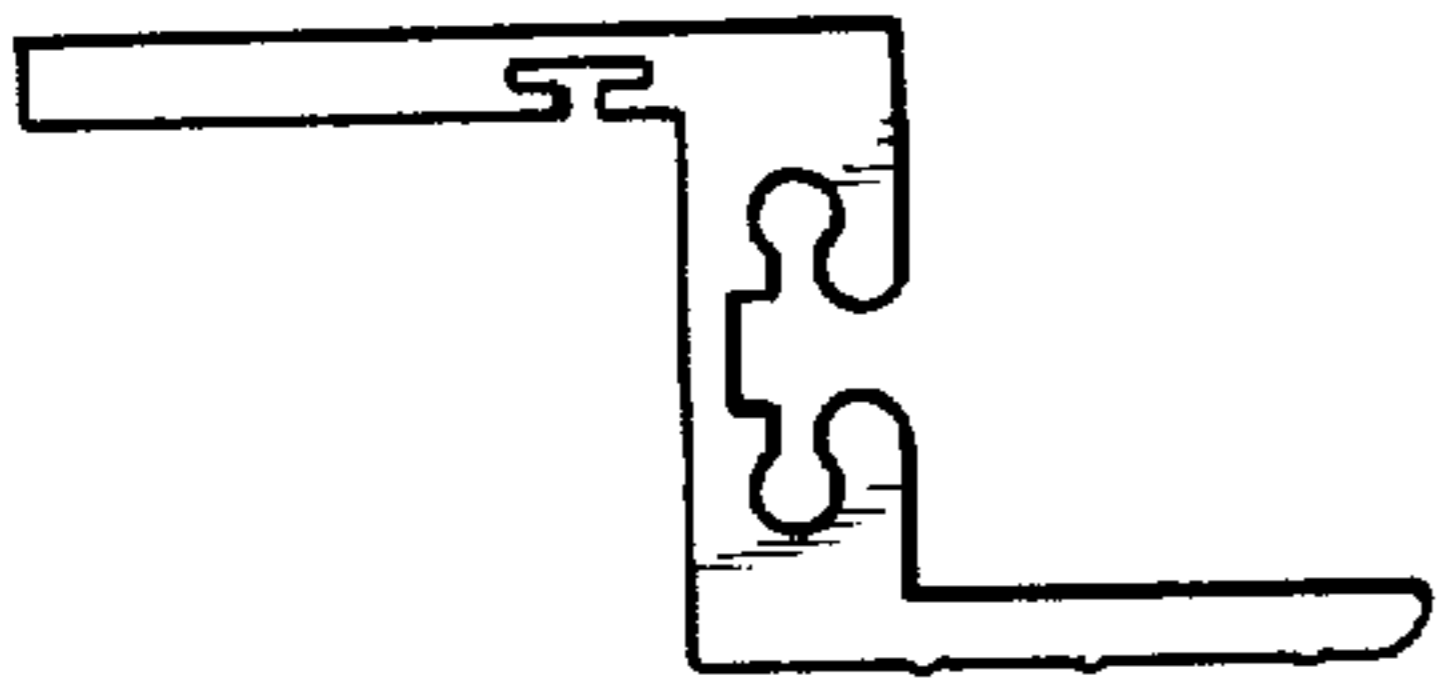

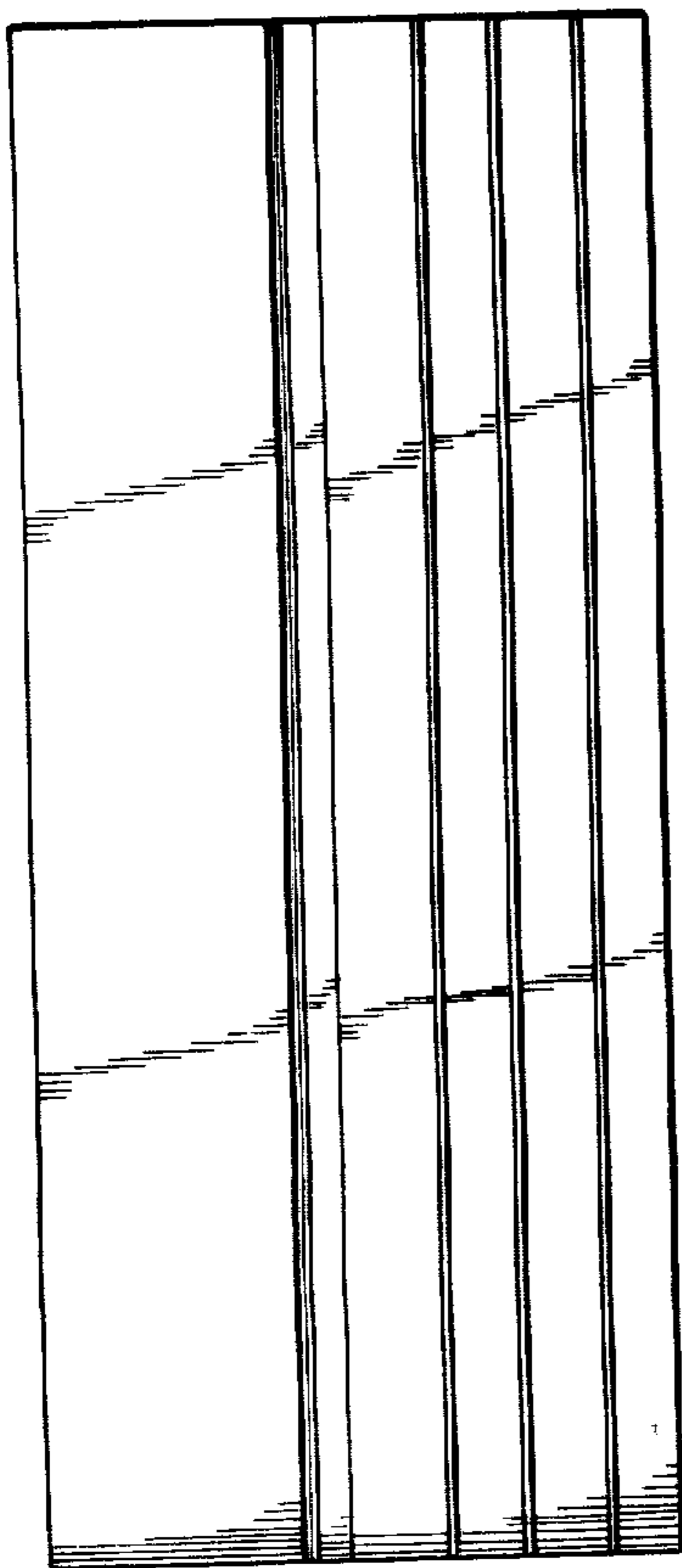

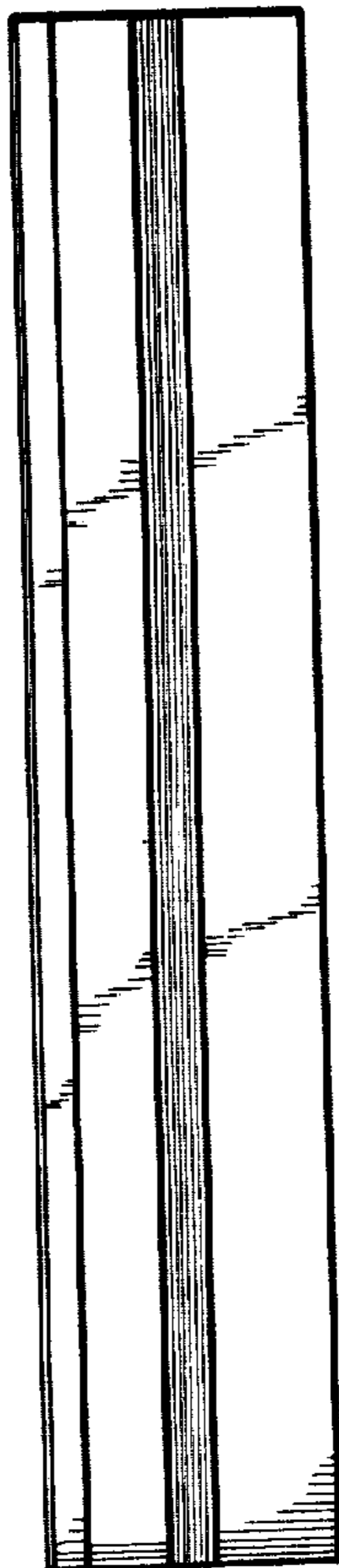

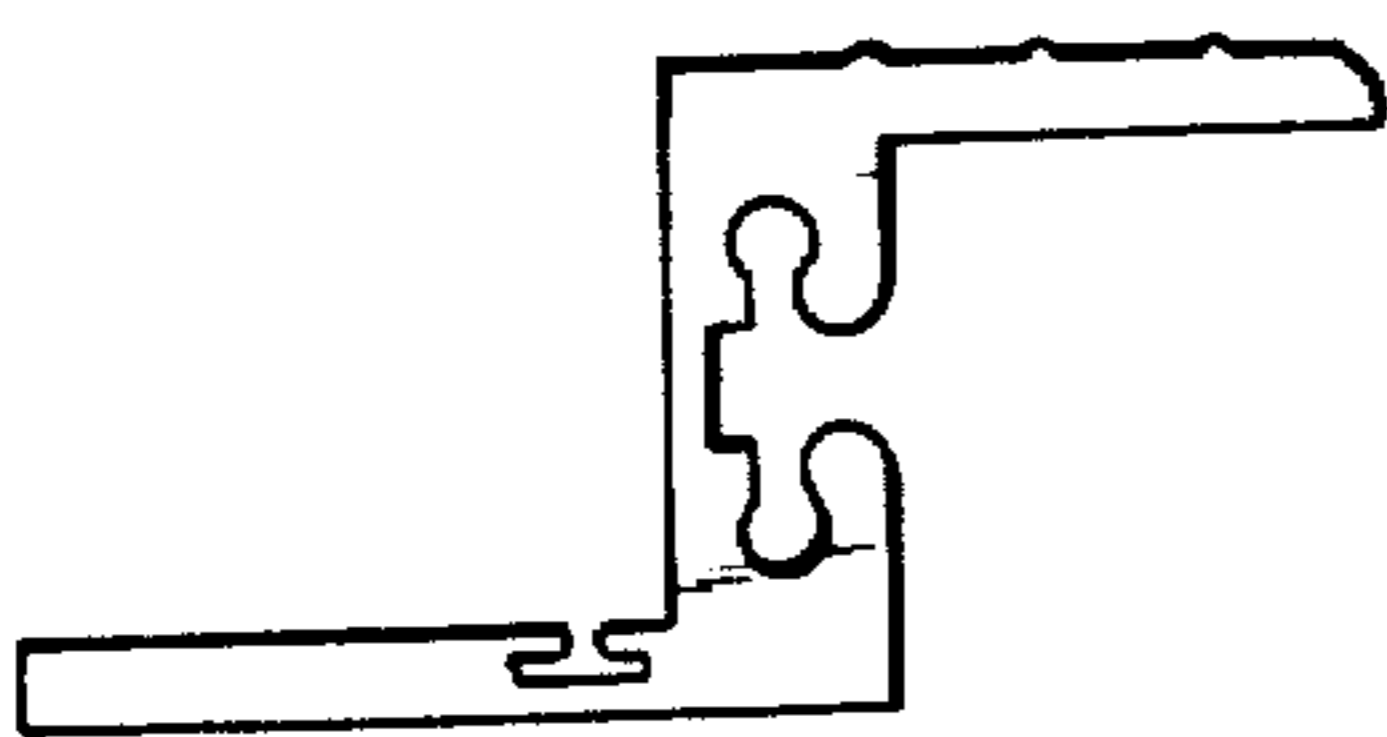
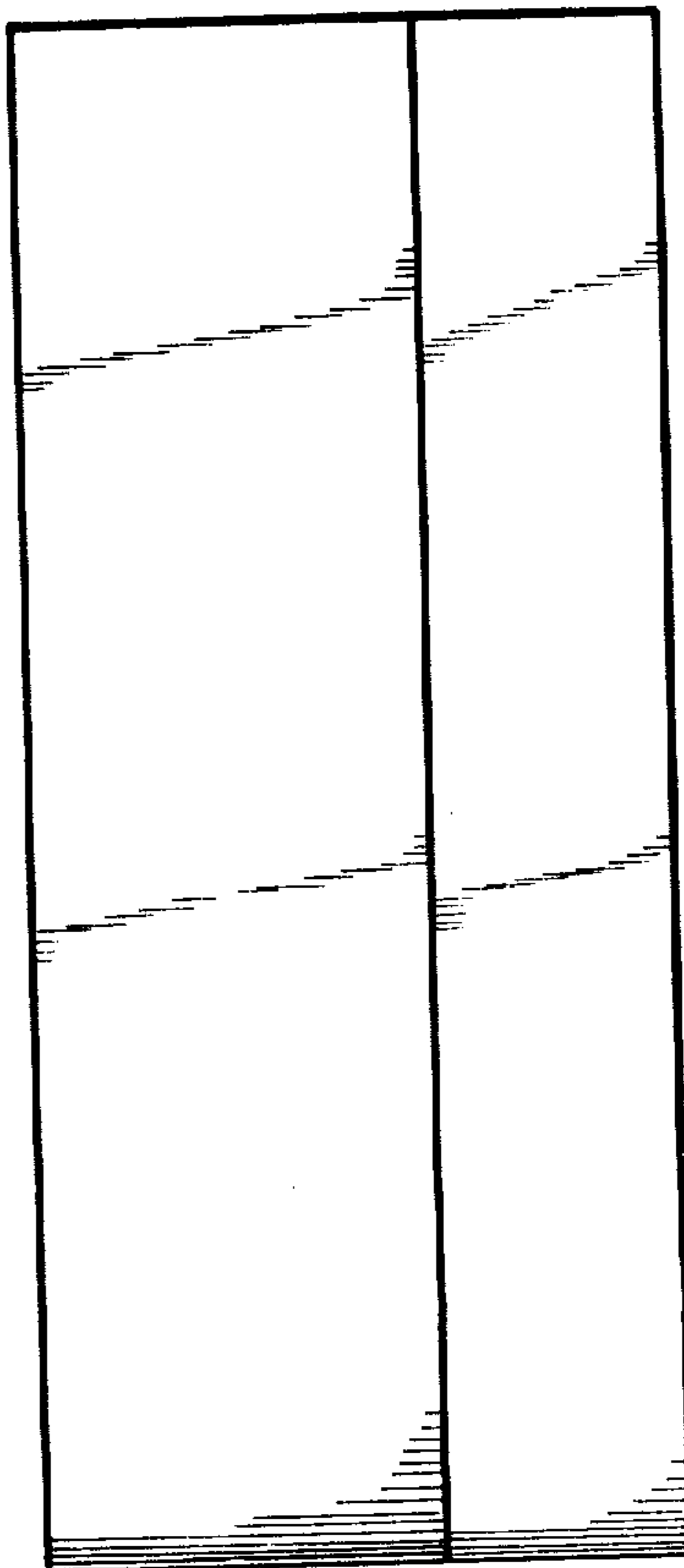
