DESCRIPTION

FIG. 5 is a rear perspective view thereof, the leads being broken away for convenience of illustration.

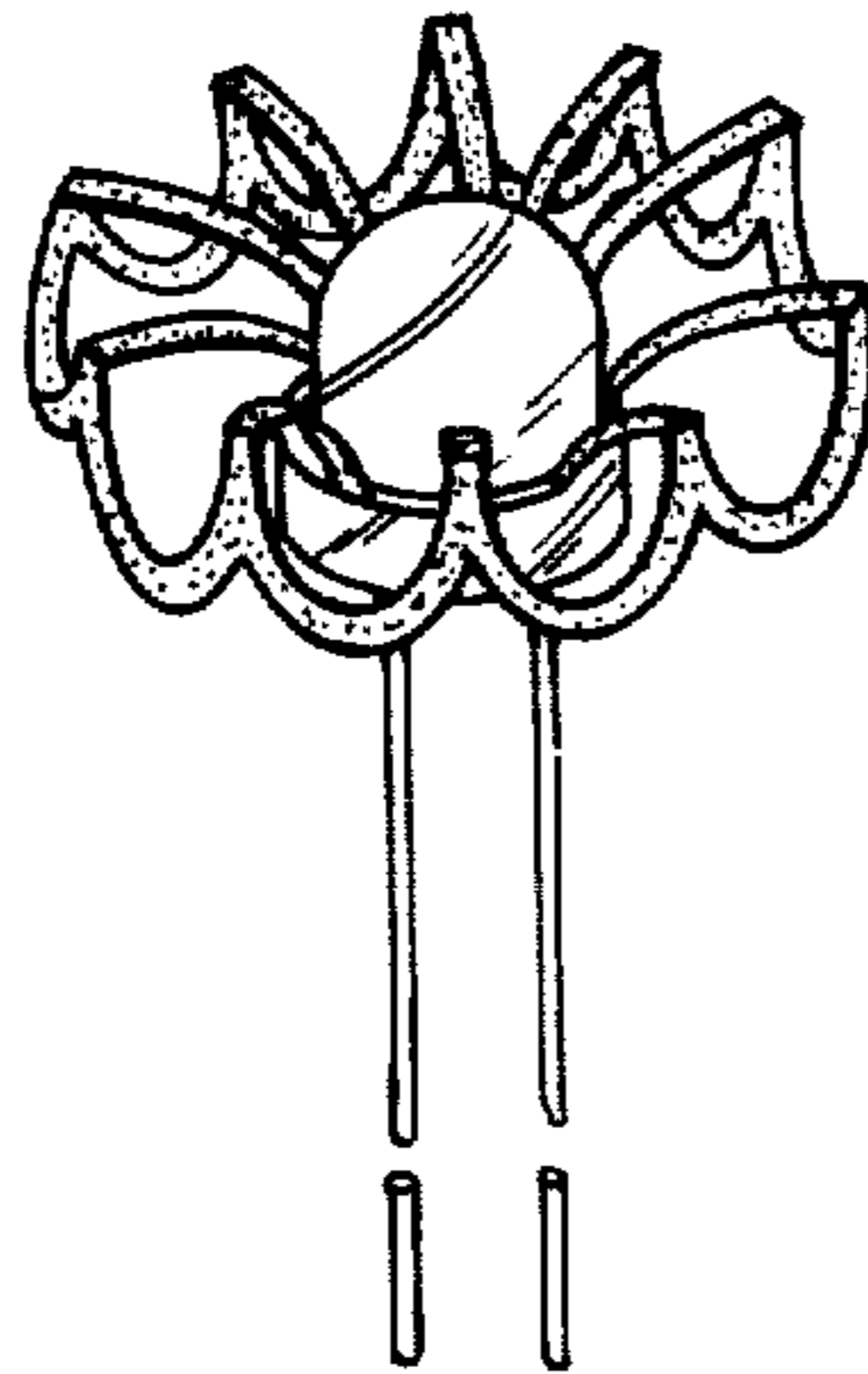

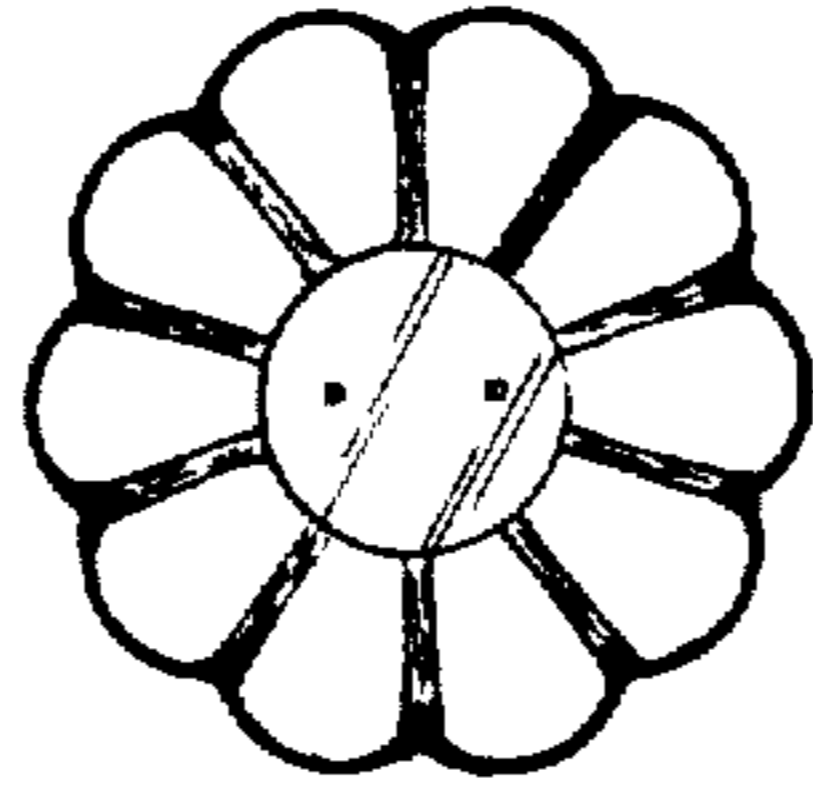

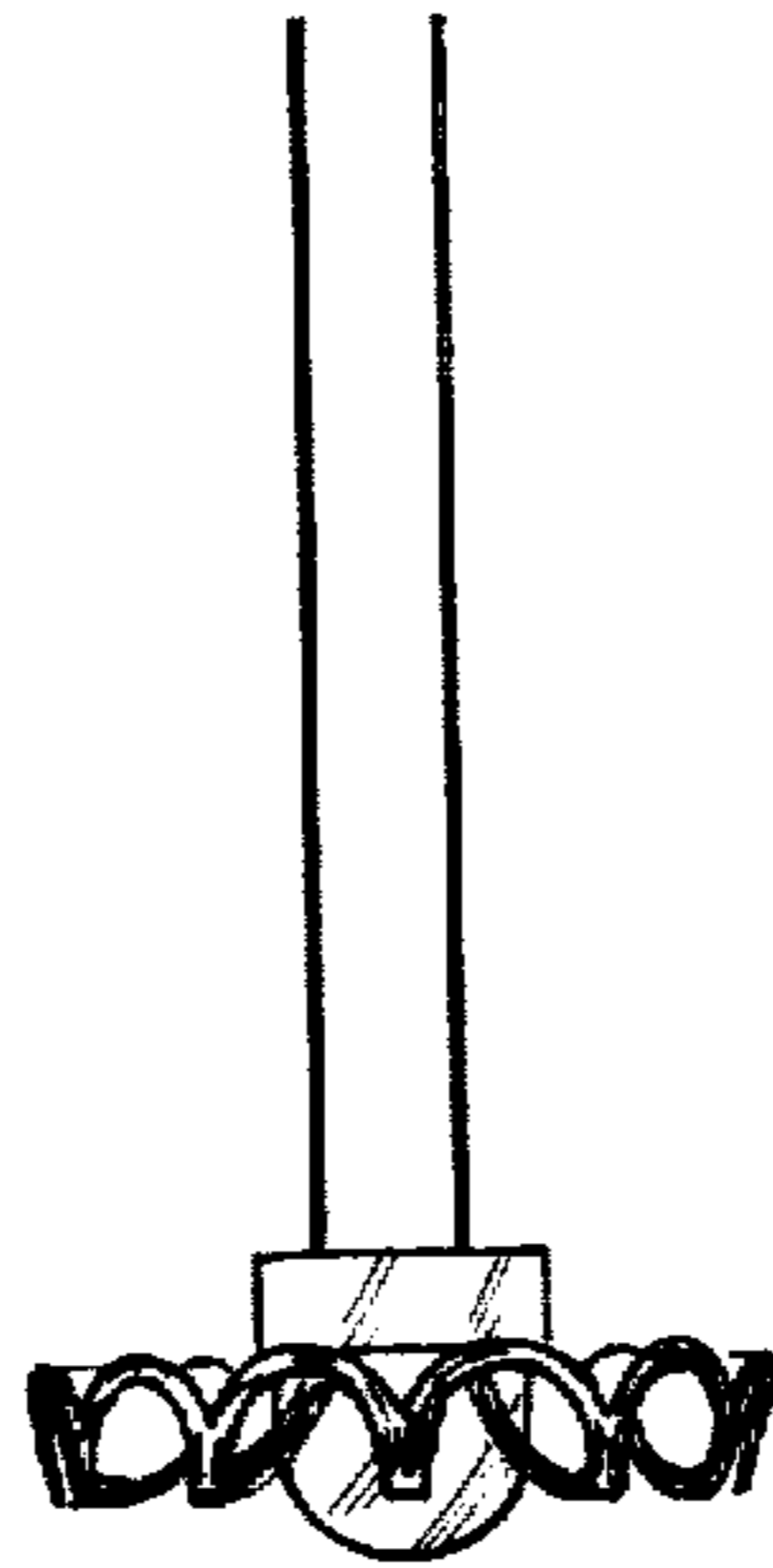

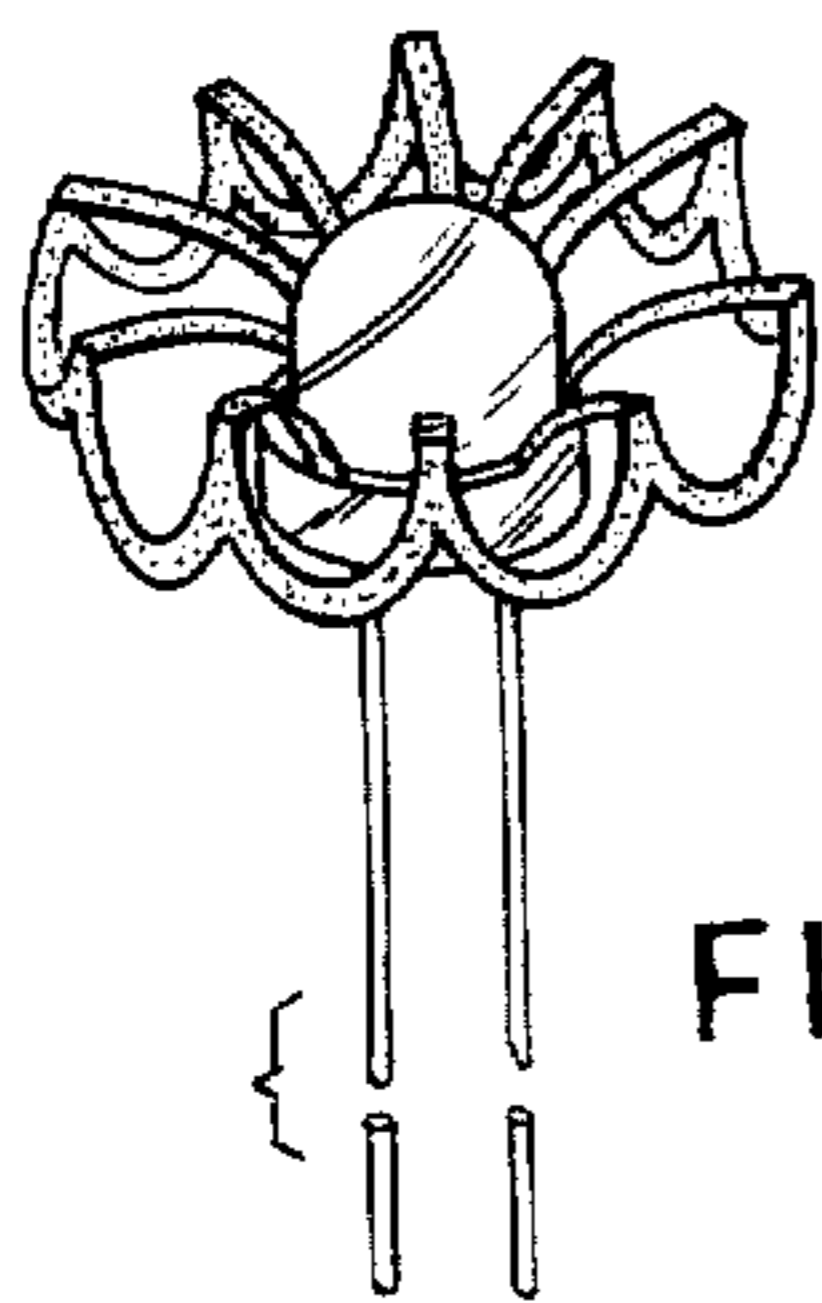
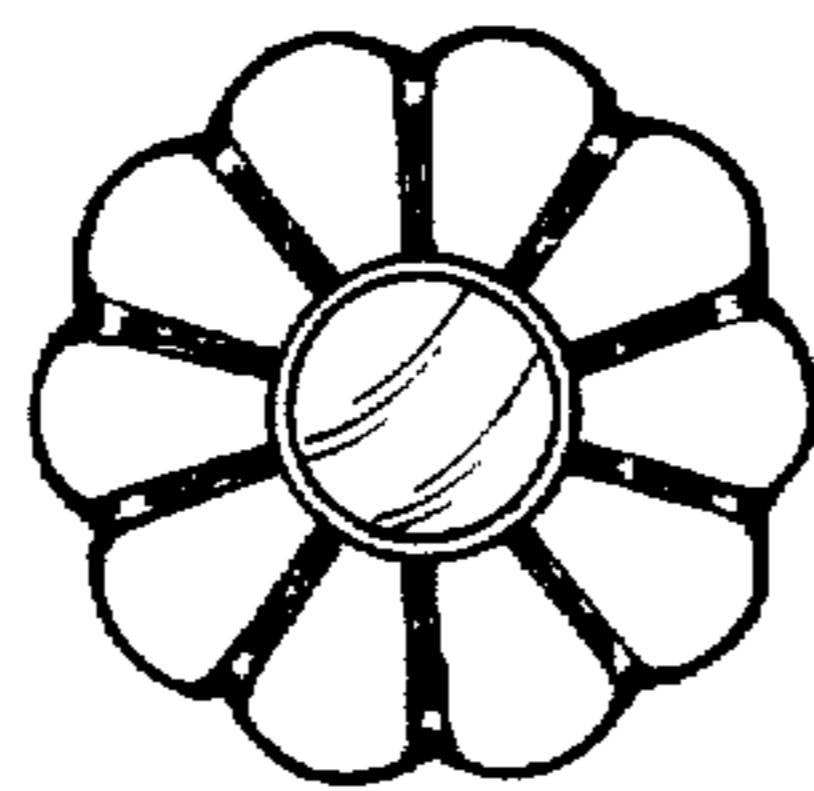

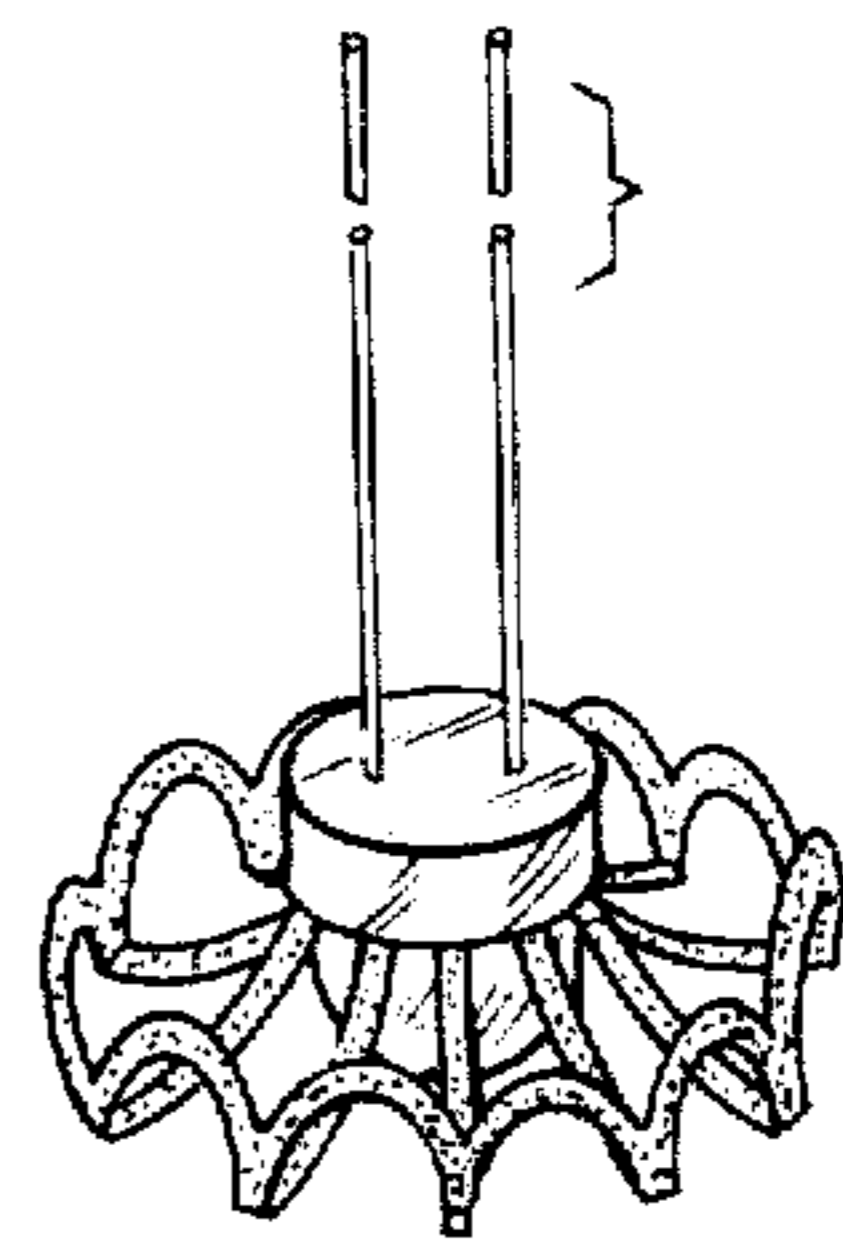
