The ornamental design for a case for shoe shining articles or the like, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a case for shoe shining articles or the like showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image of the side shown; FIG. 2 is a perspective view thereof in an open position; and FIG. 3 is a rear perspective view thereof.

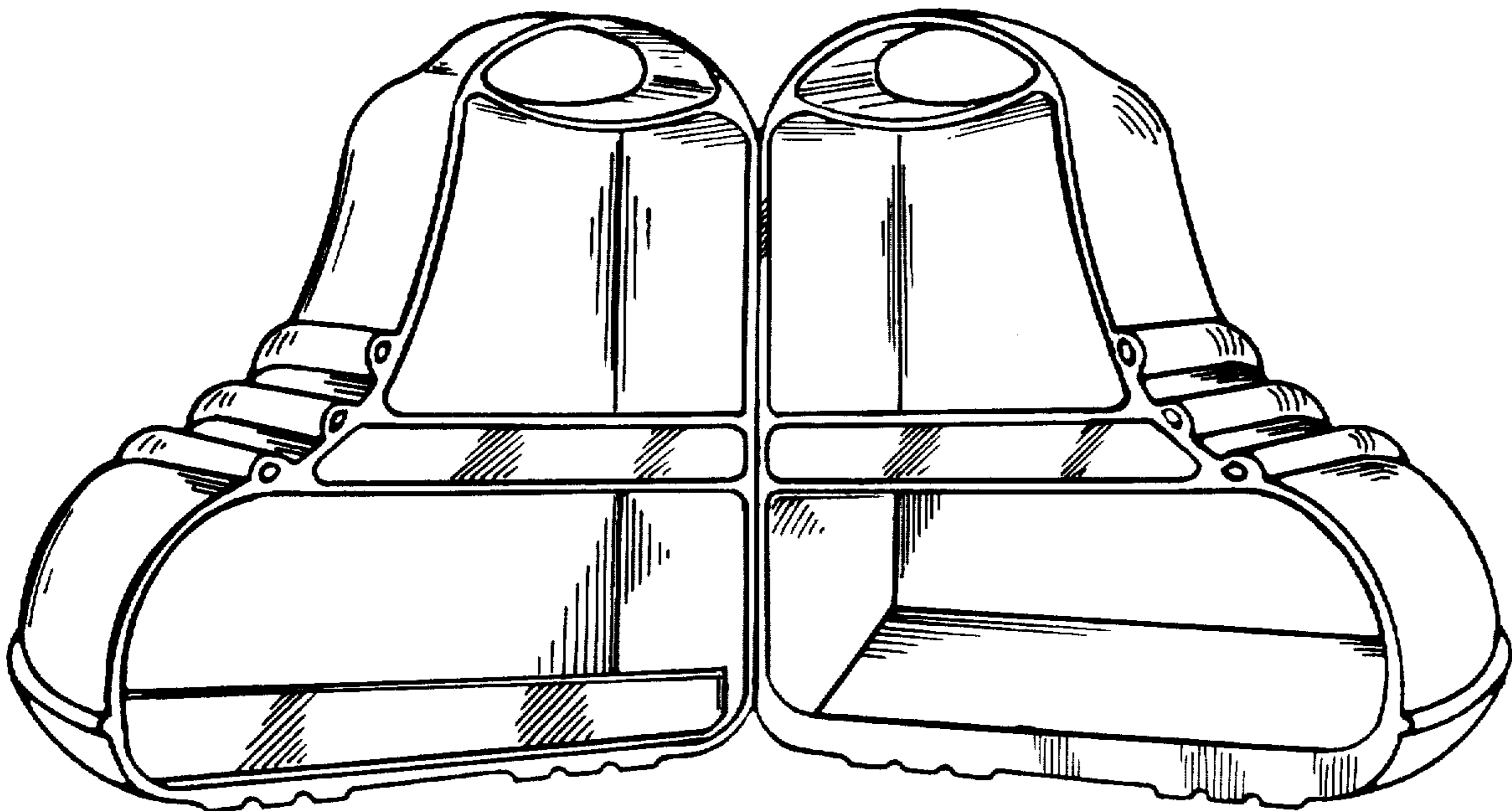

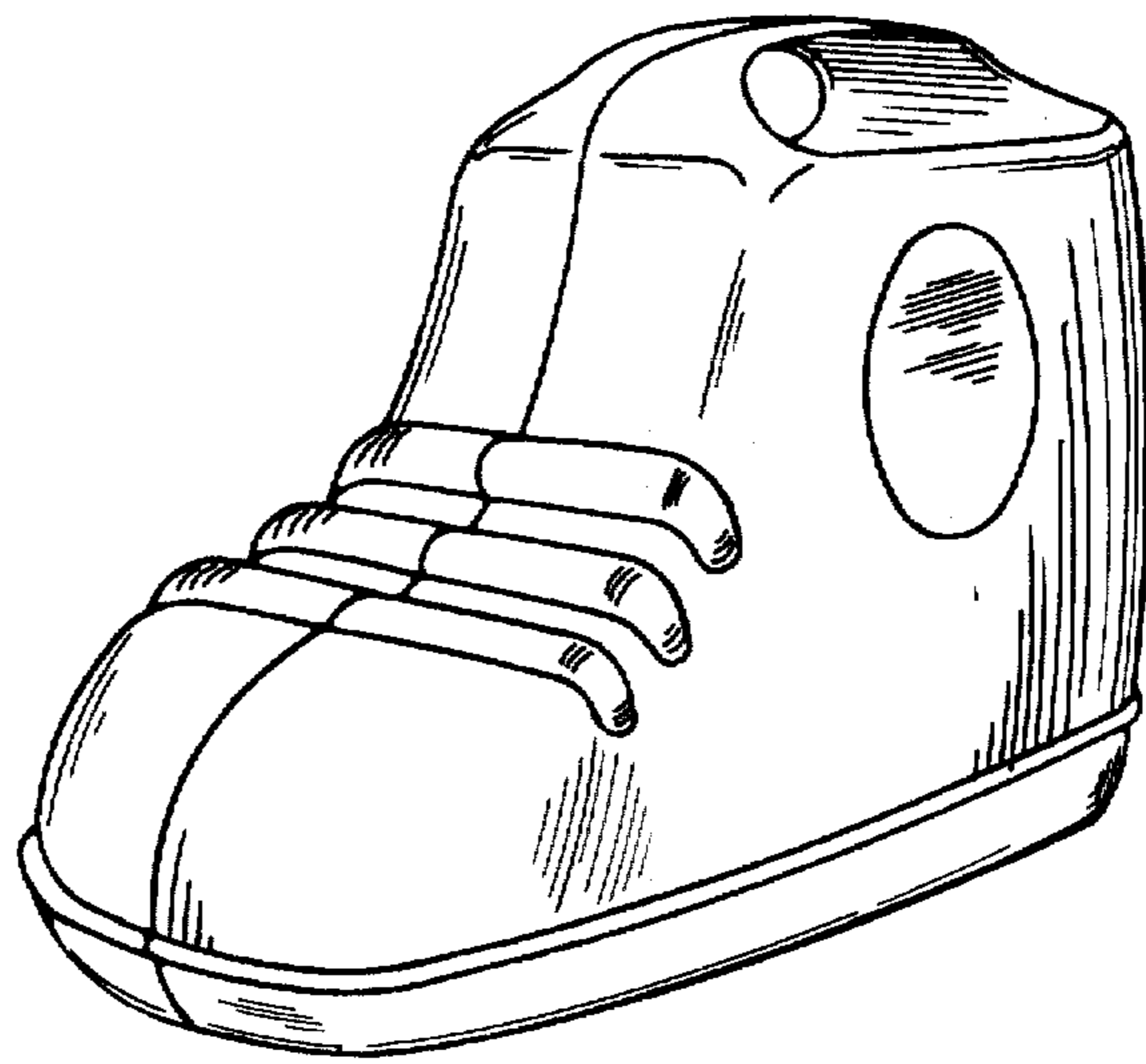

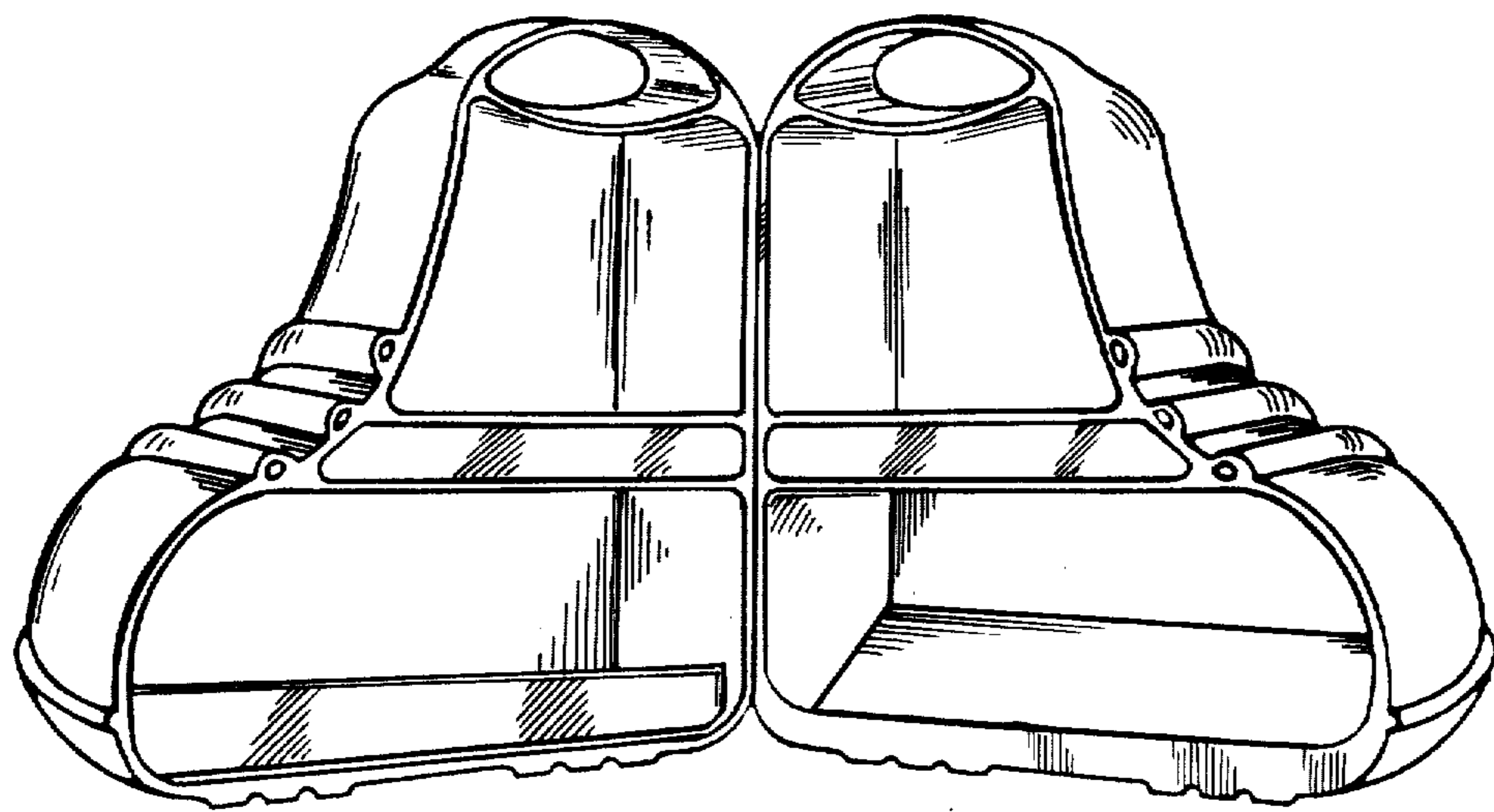
