[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a display holder for a cap, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a display holder for a cap showing my new design;
FIG. 2 is a front elevational view;
FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view;
FIG. 4 is a side elevational view; and
FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view thereof.
The dash-dot lines seen in FIG. 2 are printed on the holder.

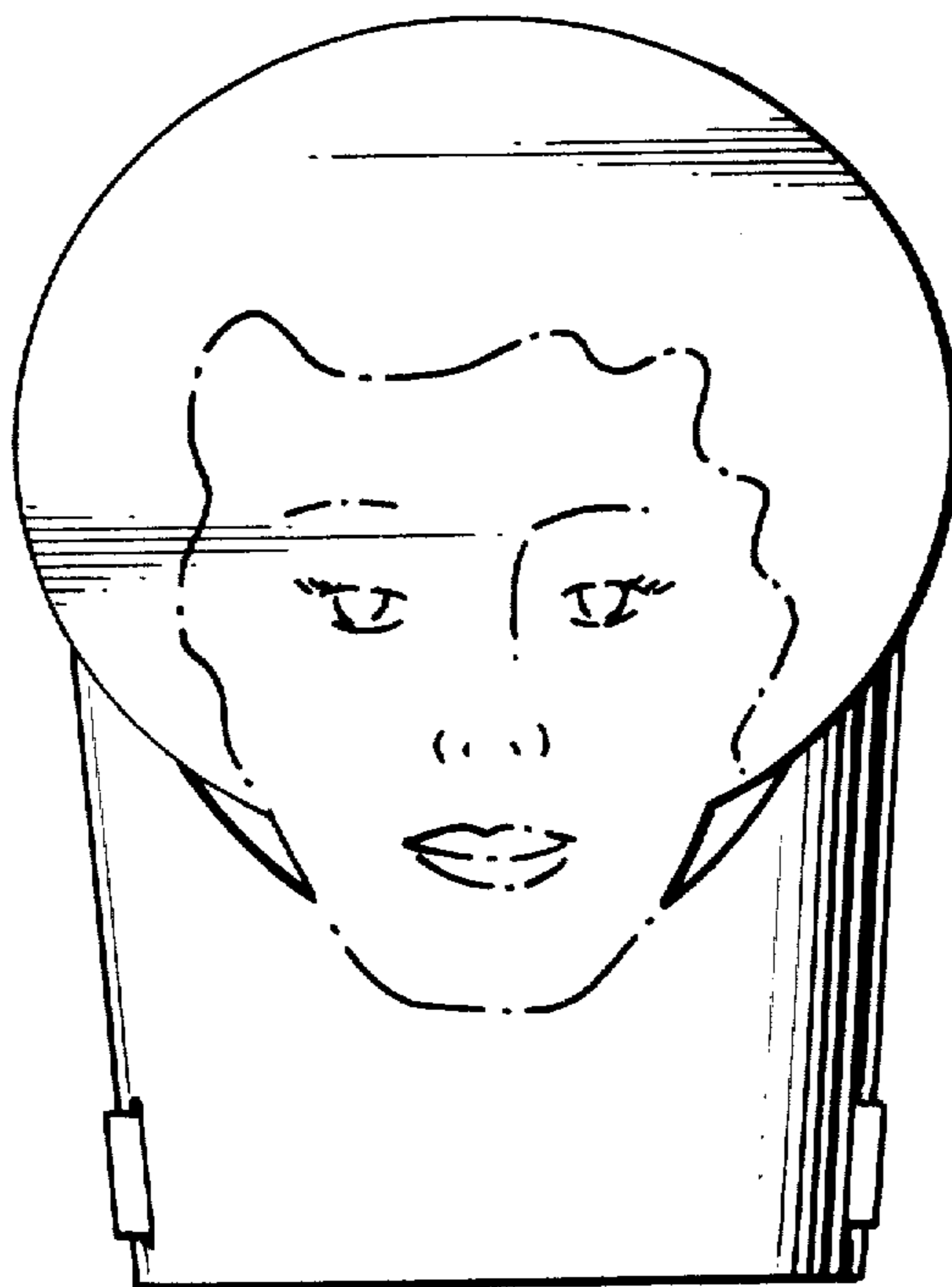

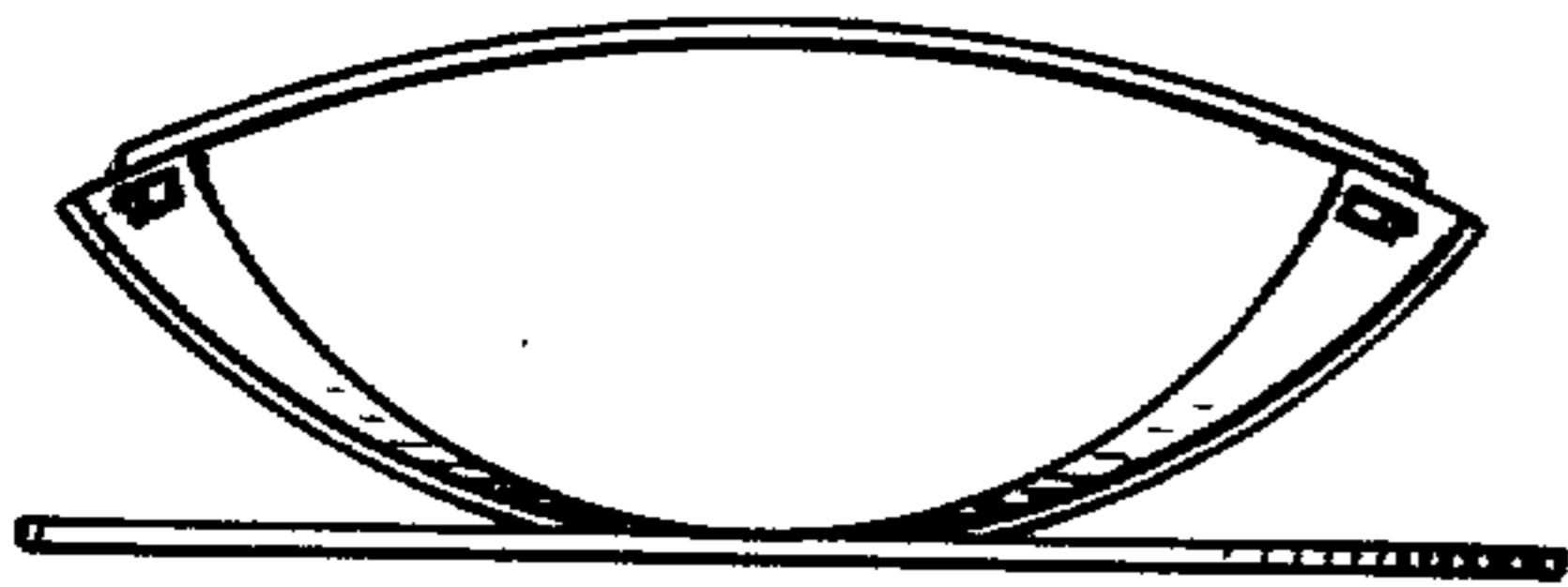

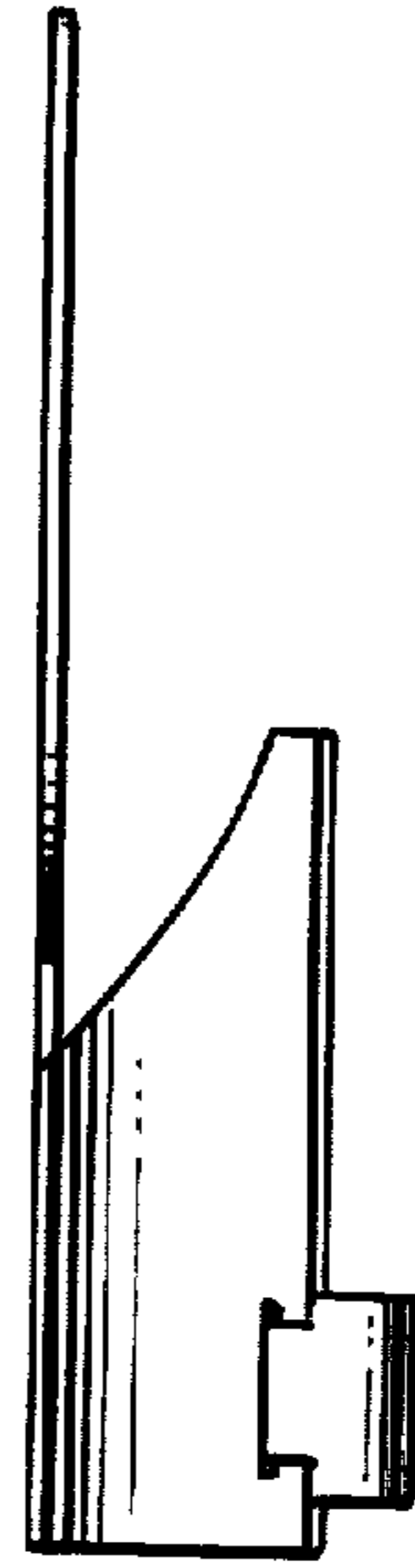

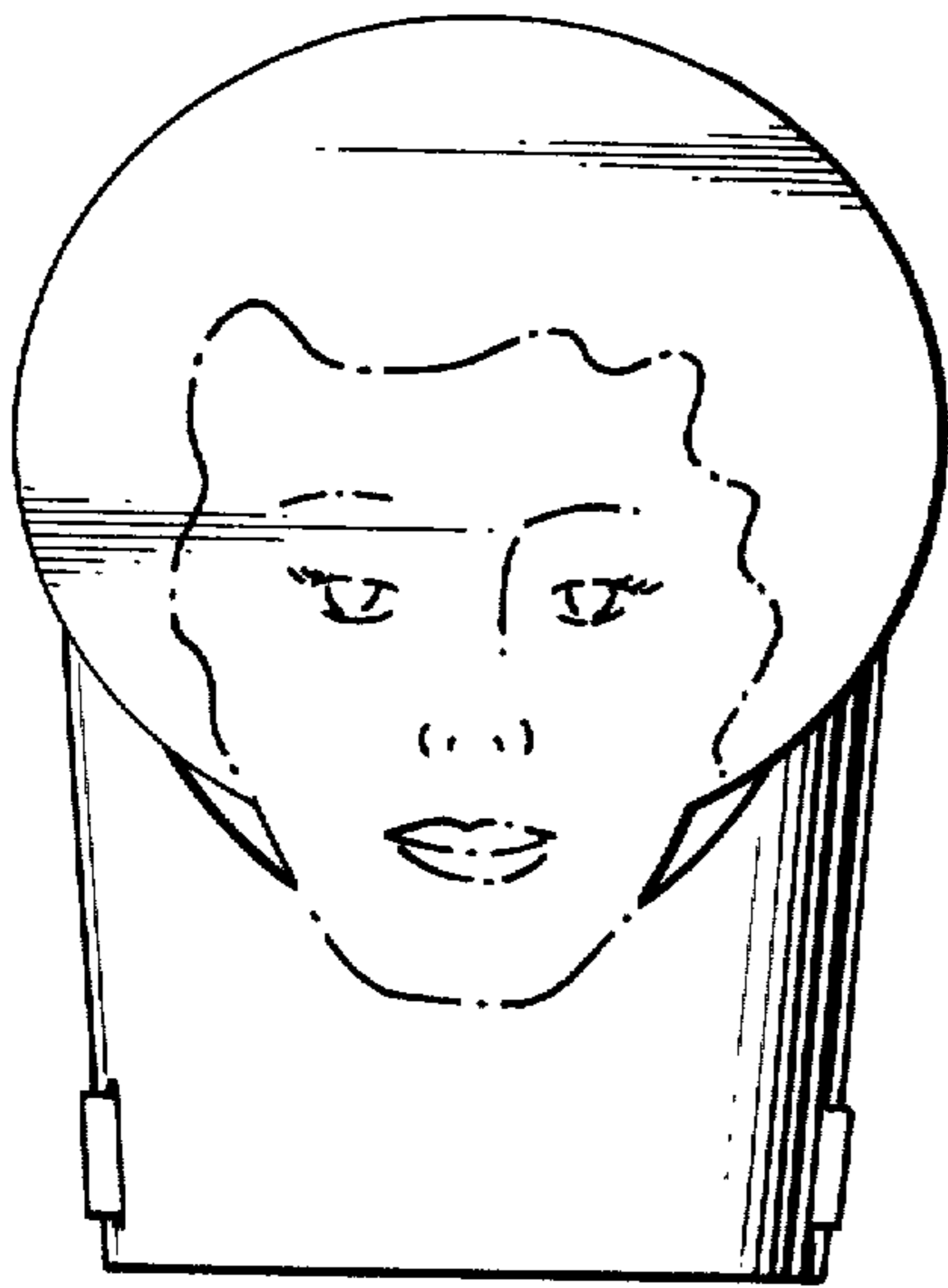

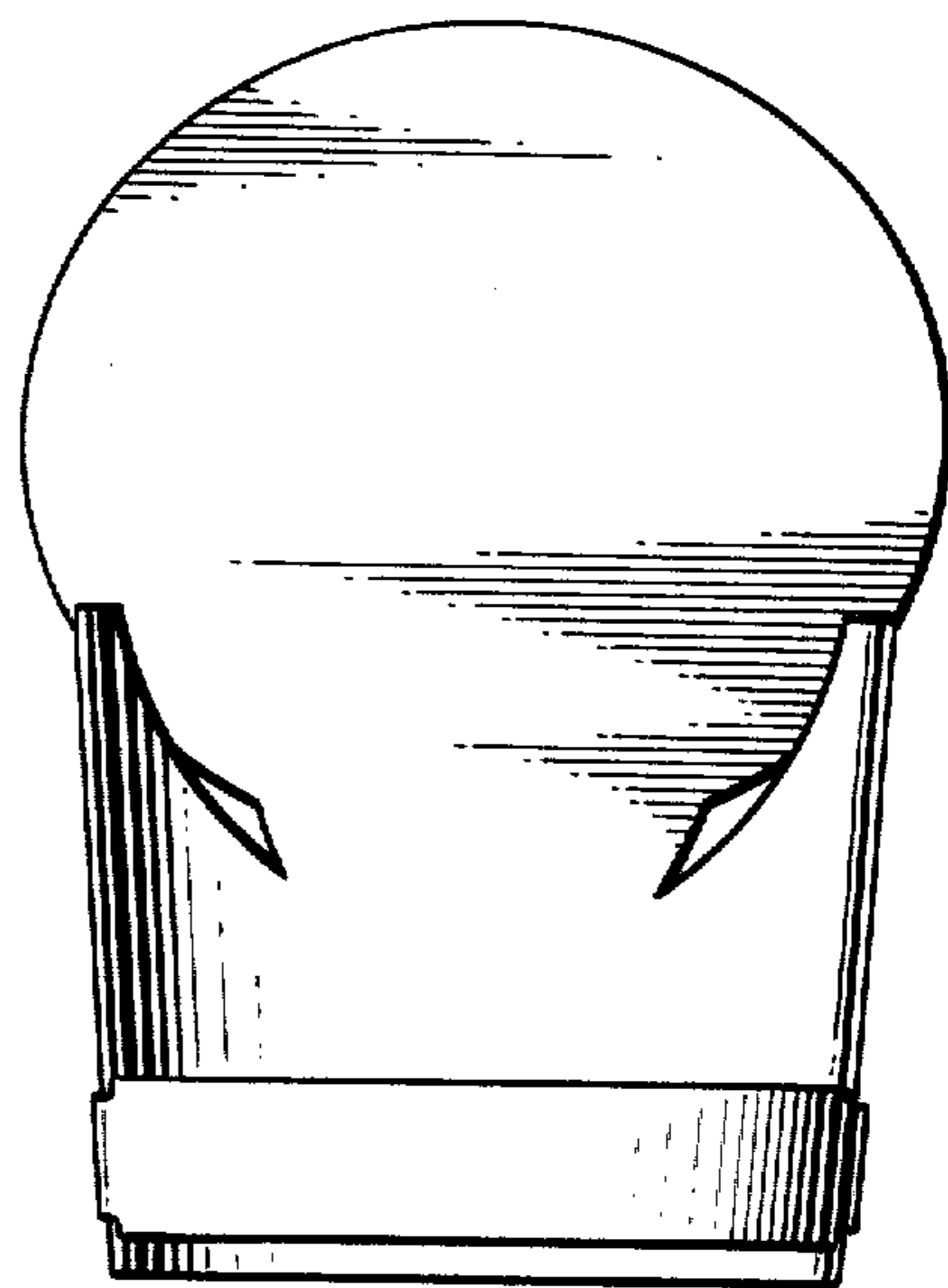
