for illustrative purposes only.

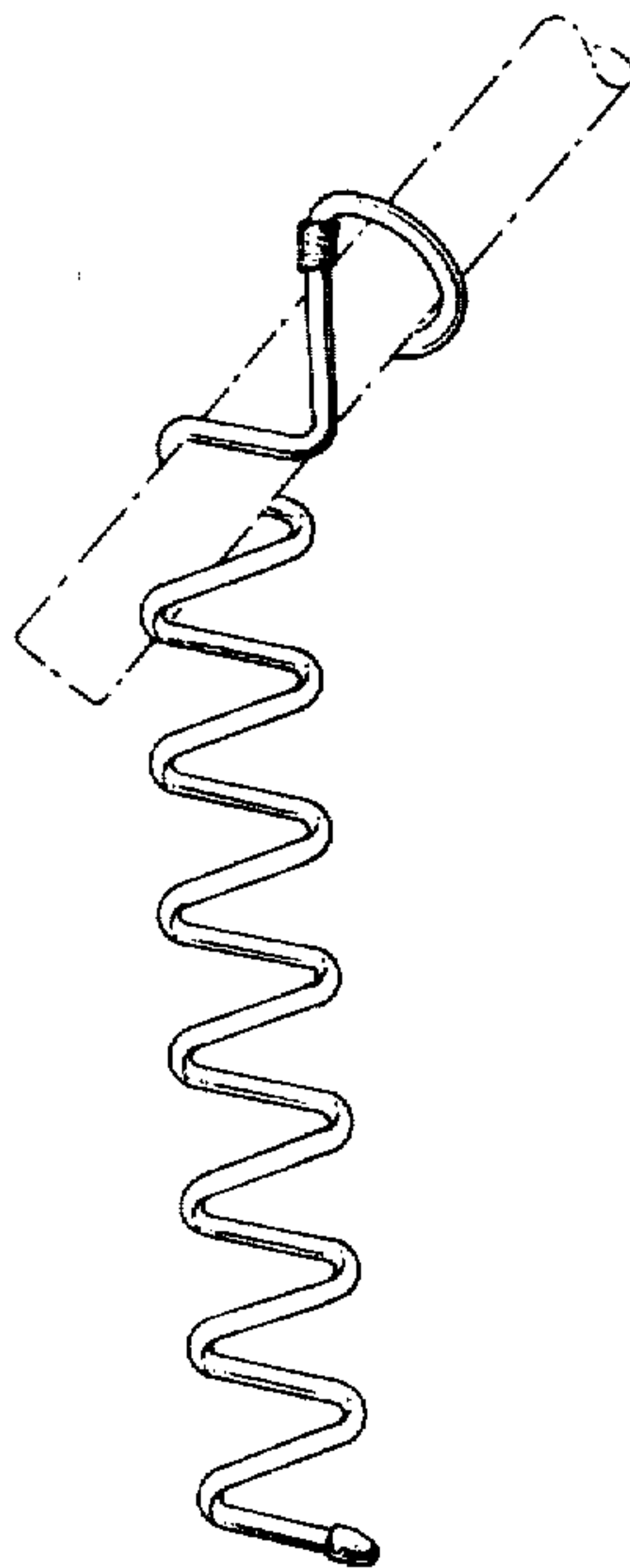

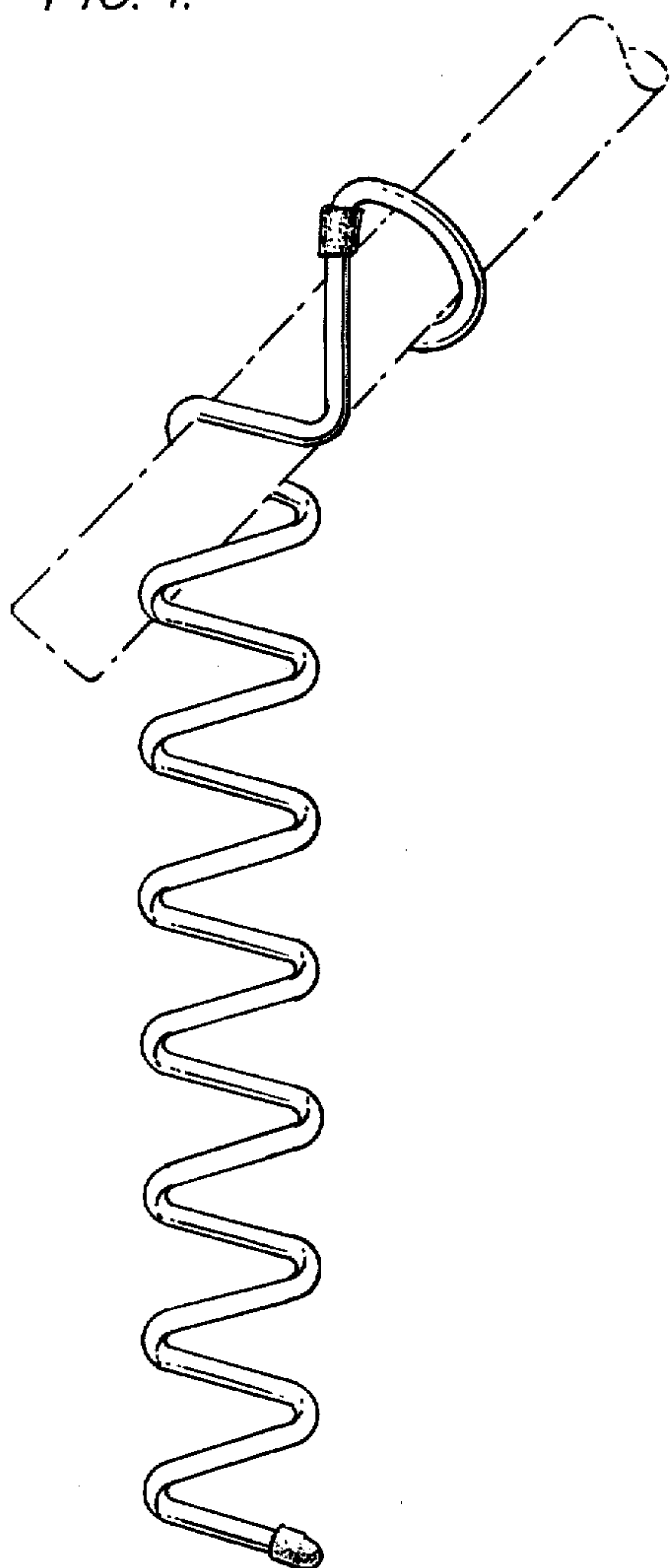

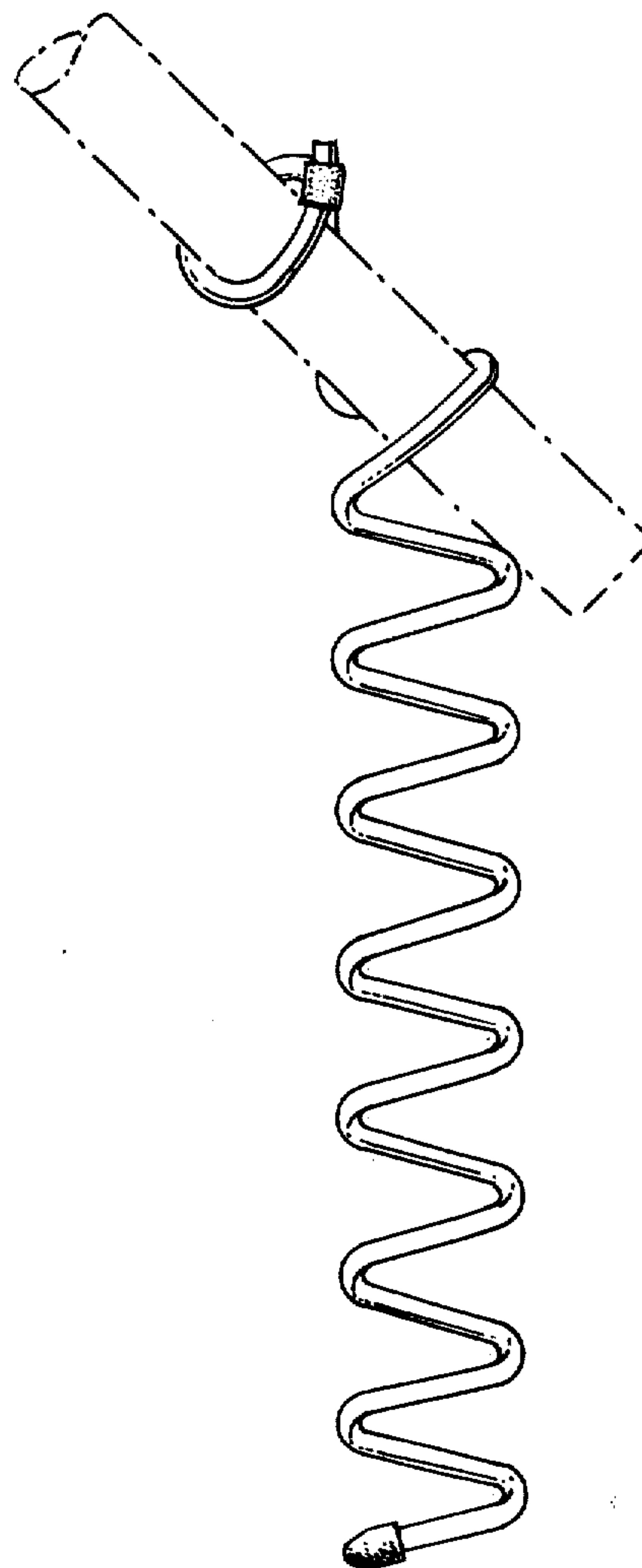
