DESCRIPTION

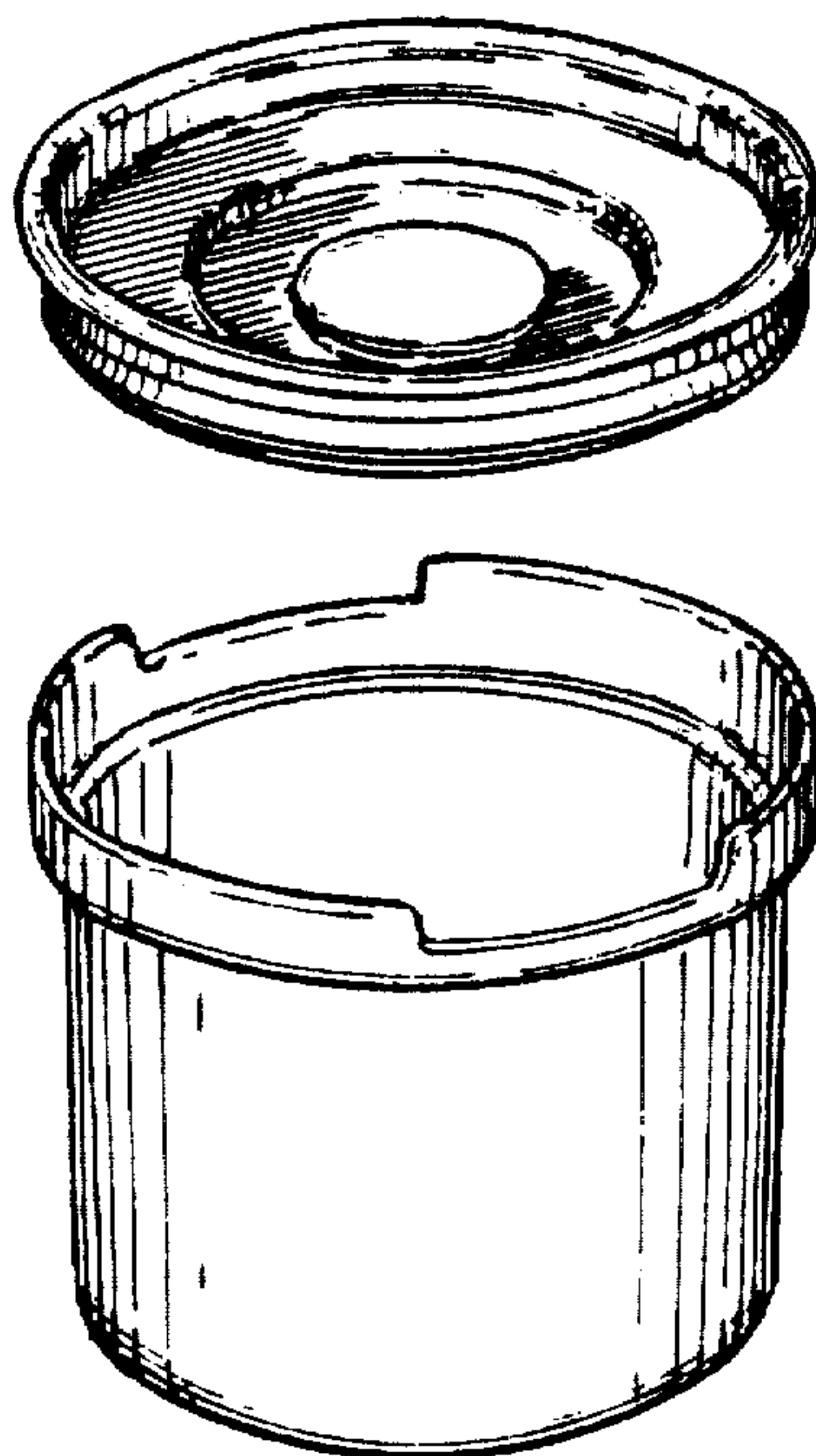
FIG. 1 is an exploded, top perspective view of a covered canister showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view thereof.



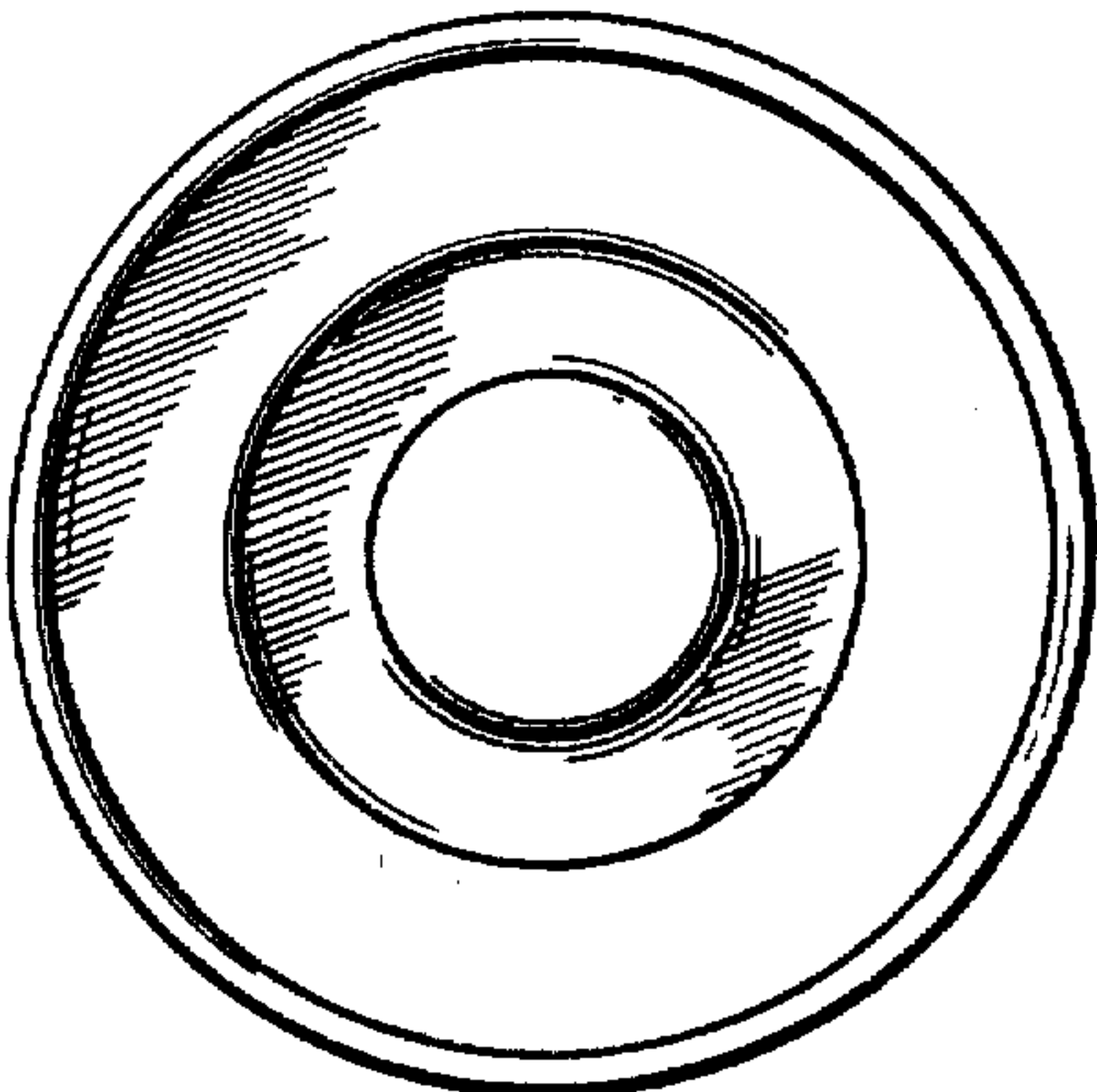
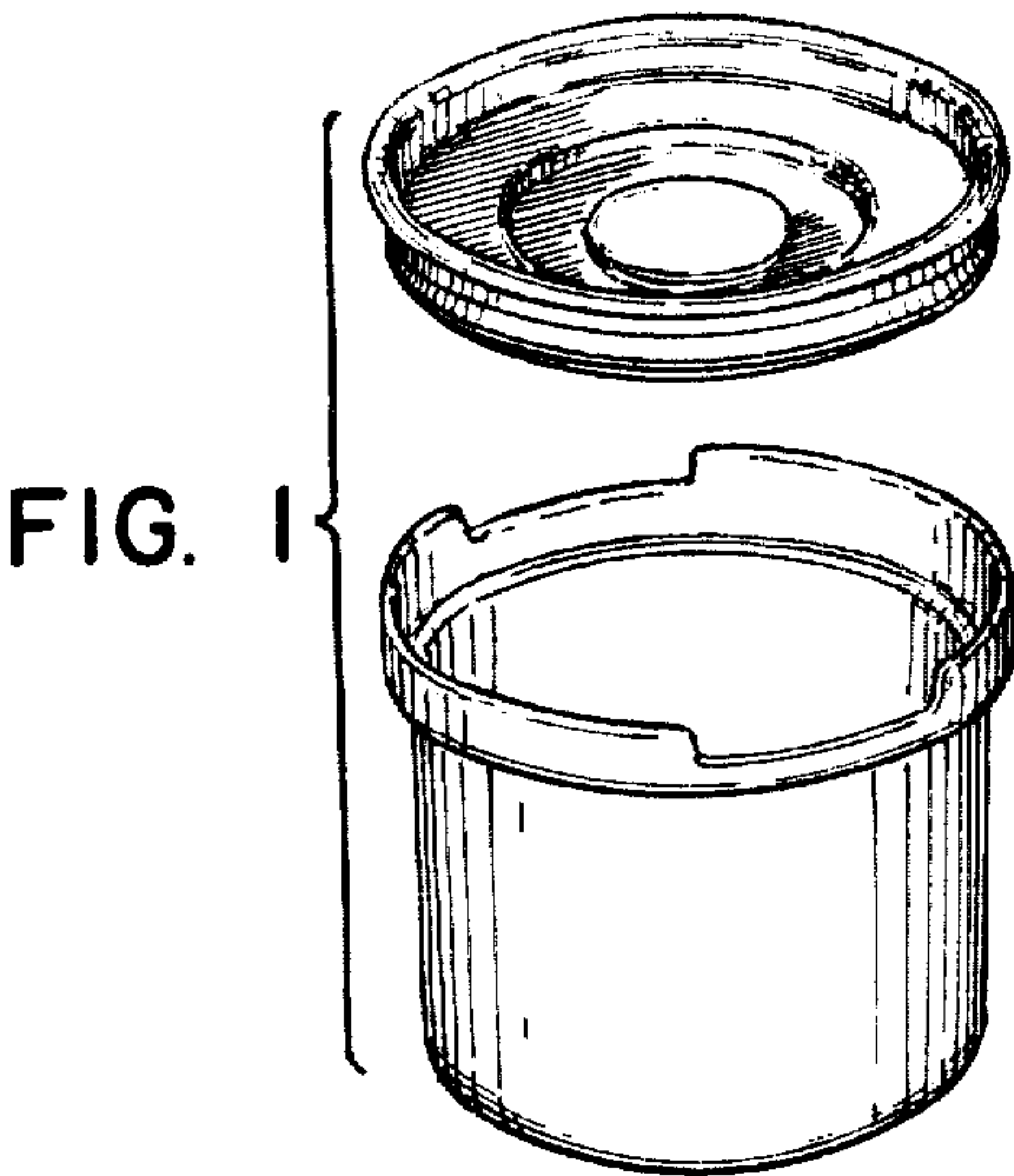

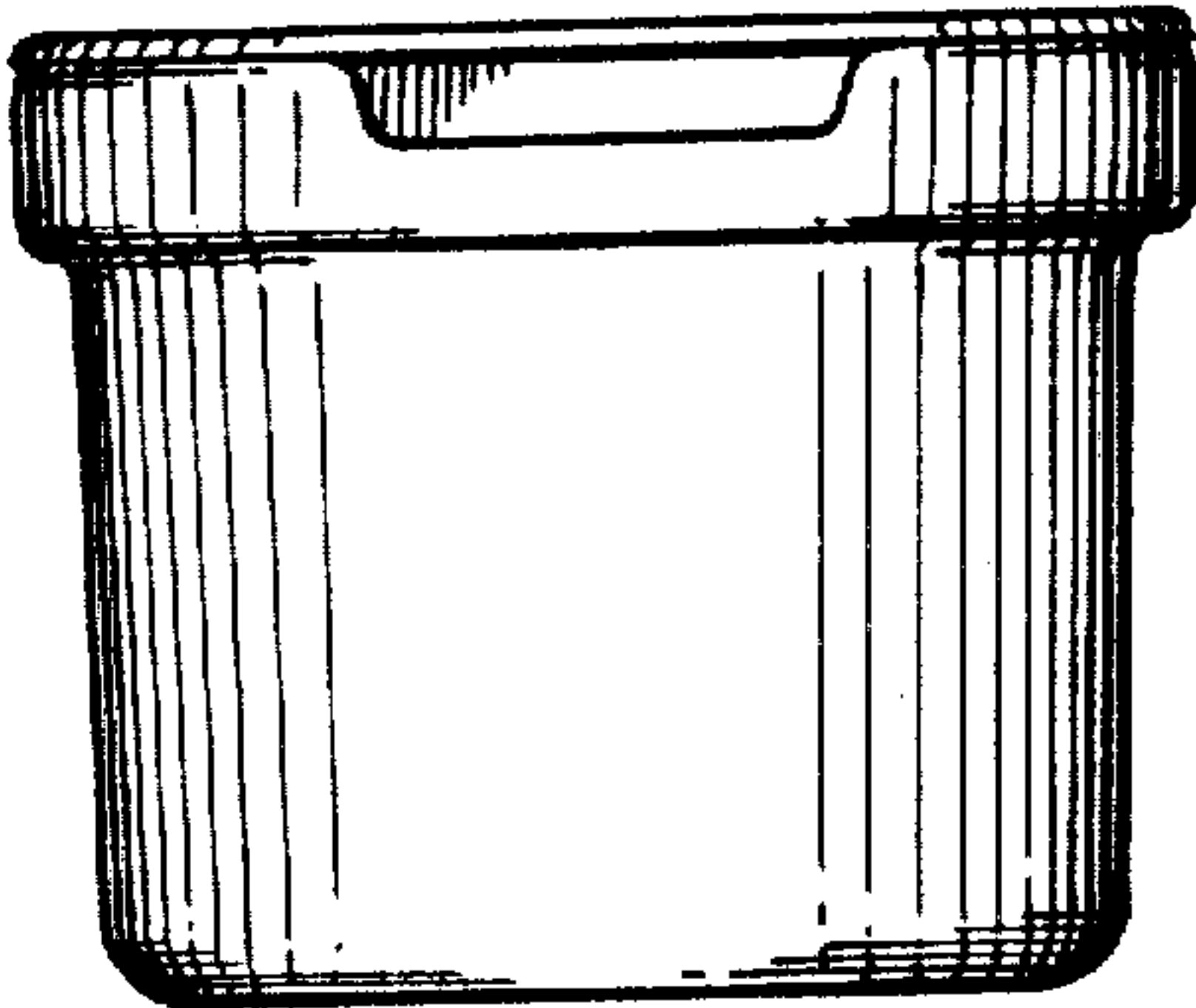
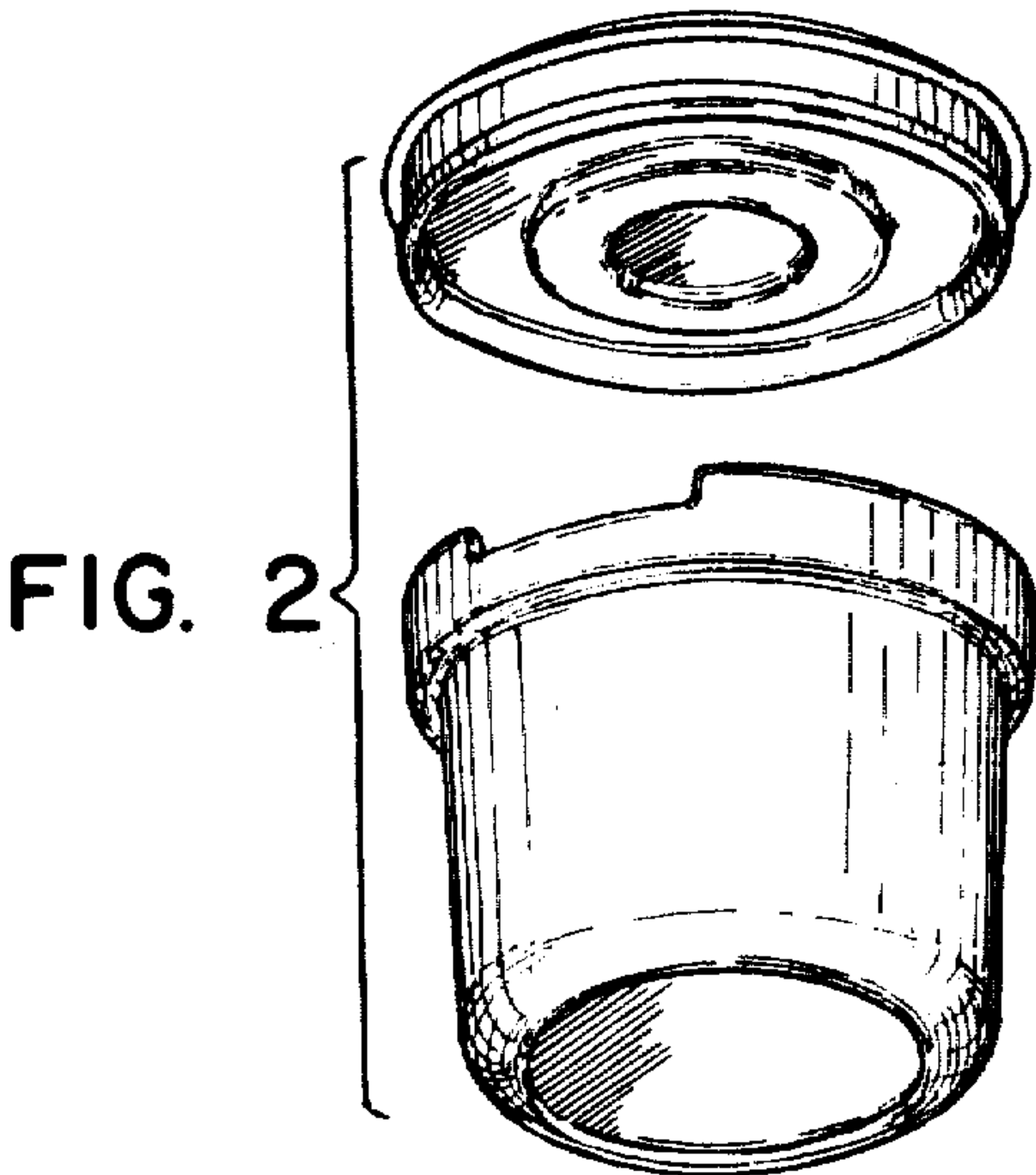

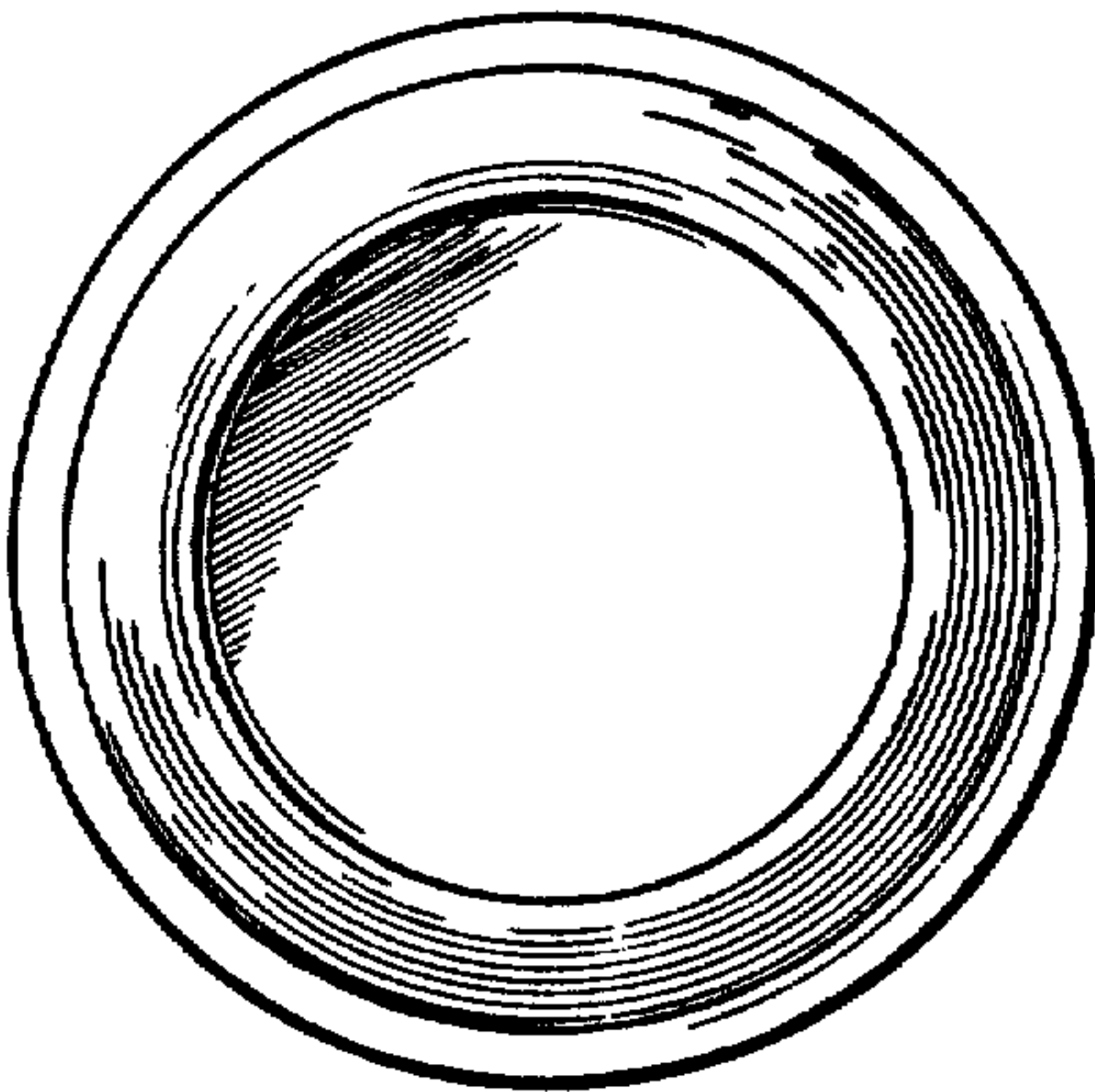
