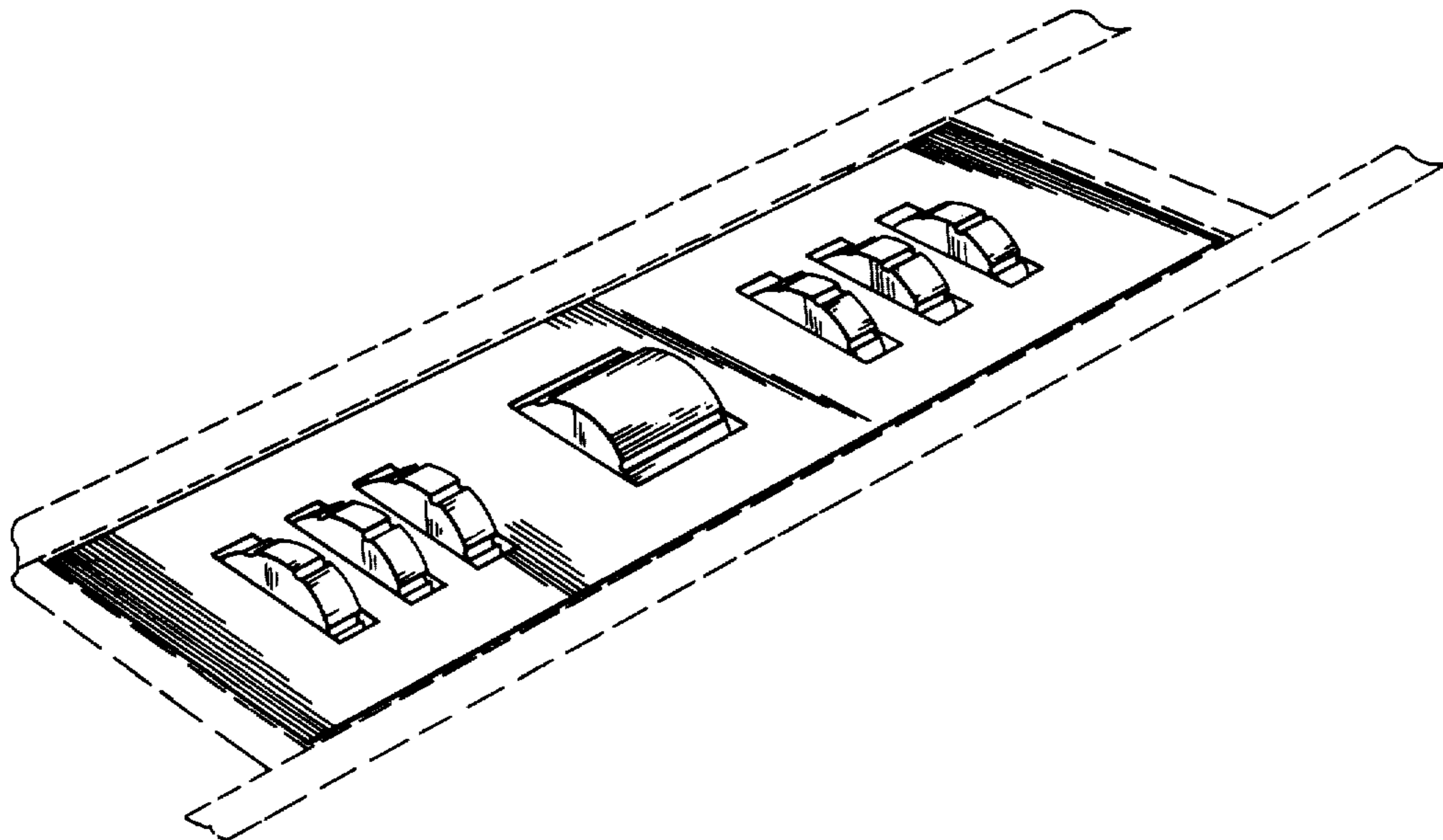

[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for scoring dials for backgammon game, substantially as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is an enlarged detailed perspective view of the scoring dials showing my new design; and FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the inside of a backgammon game having scoring dials showing my new design, with the portion in dotted lines merely showing environmental structure and not material features of the claimed design.



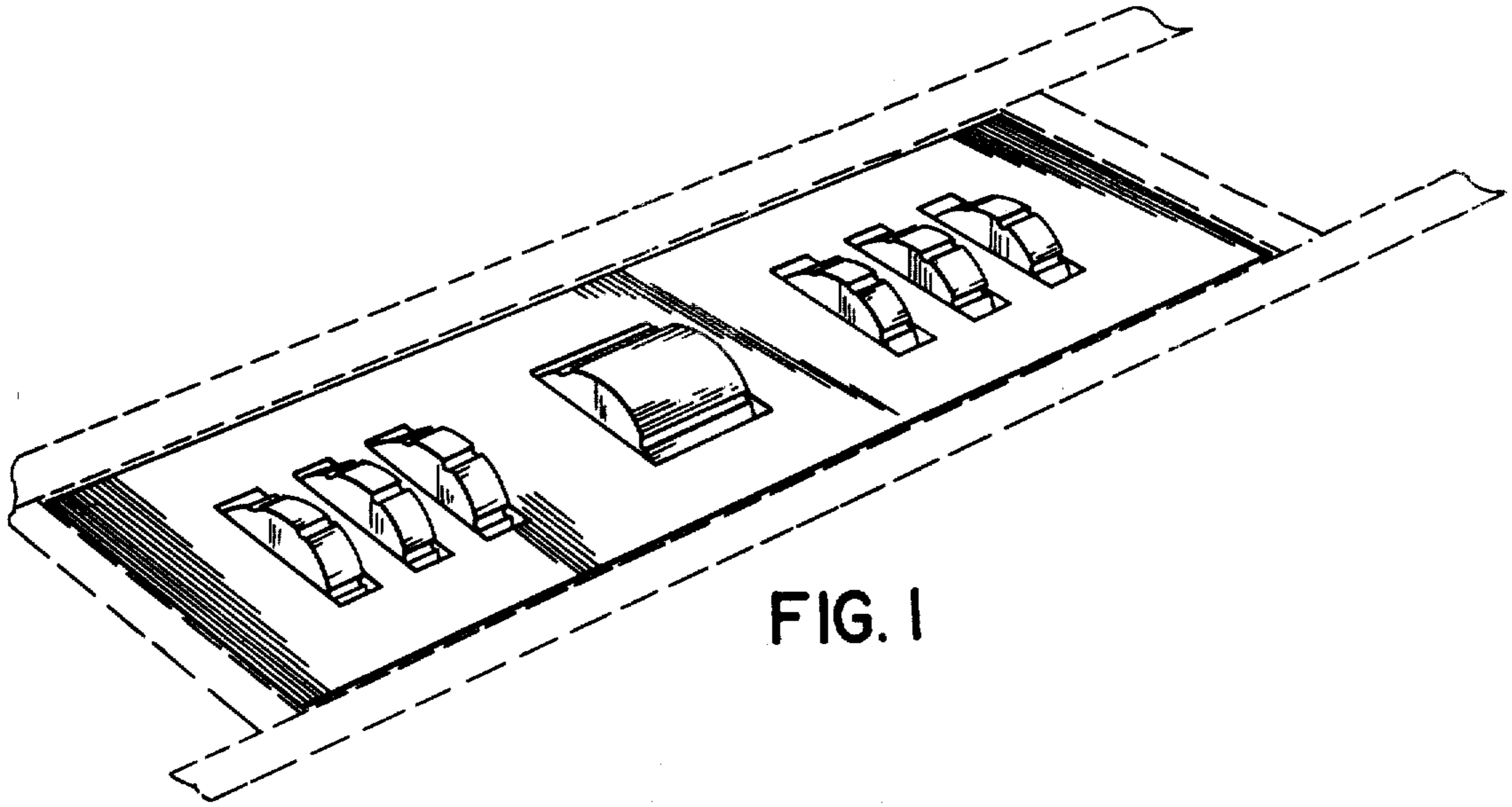

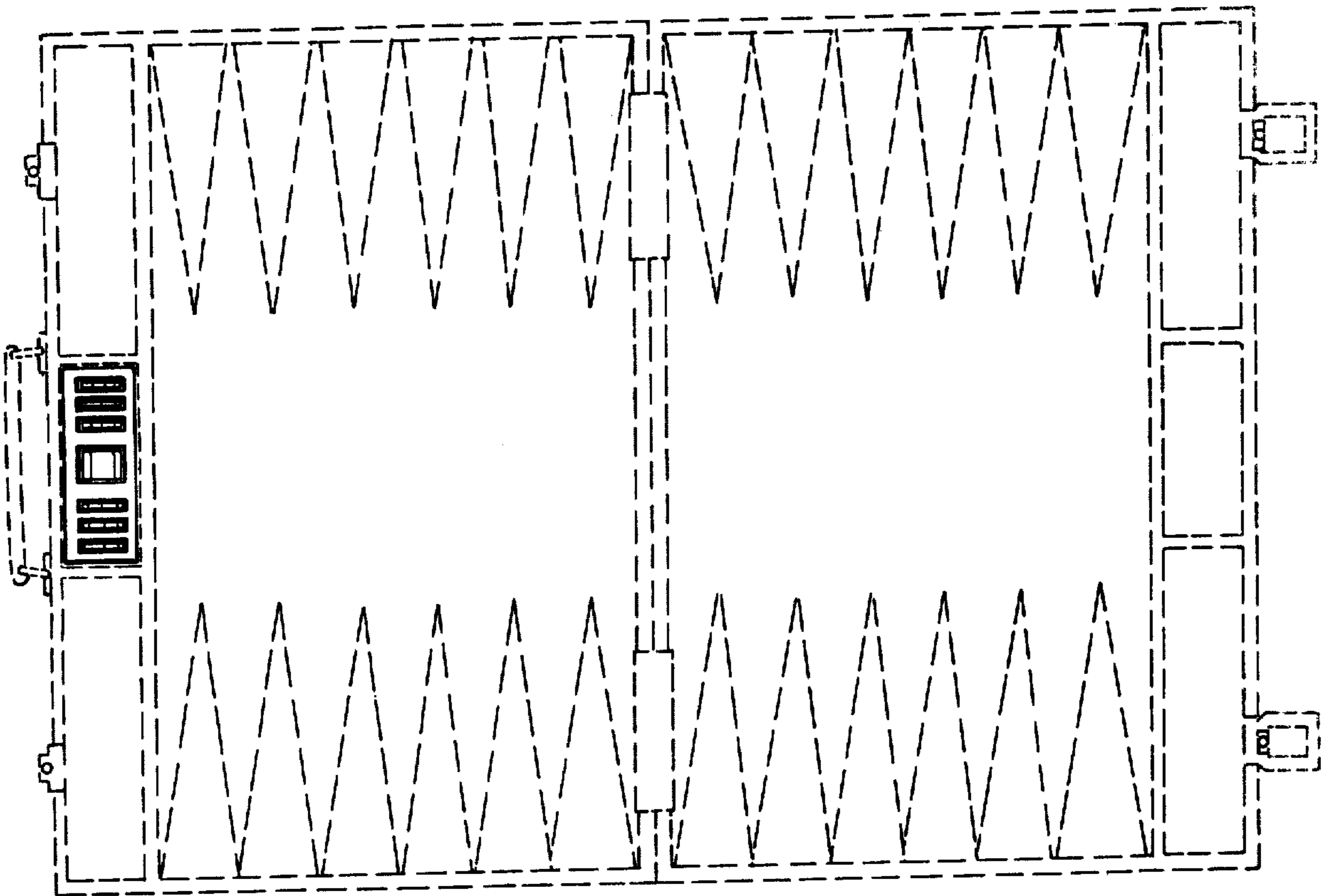
