The ornamental design for a tie down bracket for a luggage rack, as shown and described.


DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective, frontal view of a tie down bracket for a luggage rack showing my new design; FIG. 2 is a top plan view thereof on a reduced scale; FIG. 3 is a bottom plan view thereof on a reduced scale; FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof on a reduced scale;

FIG. 5 is a side elevational view thereof on a reduced scale;

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view thereof on a reduced scale; and

FIG. 7 is a side elevational view thereof on a reduced scale as seen from the side opposite that of FIG. 5.













