FIG. 4 is a bottom perspective view of the modified form of my new design.

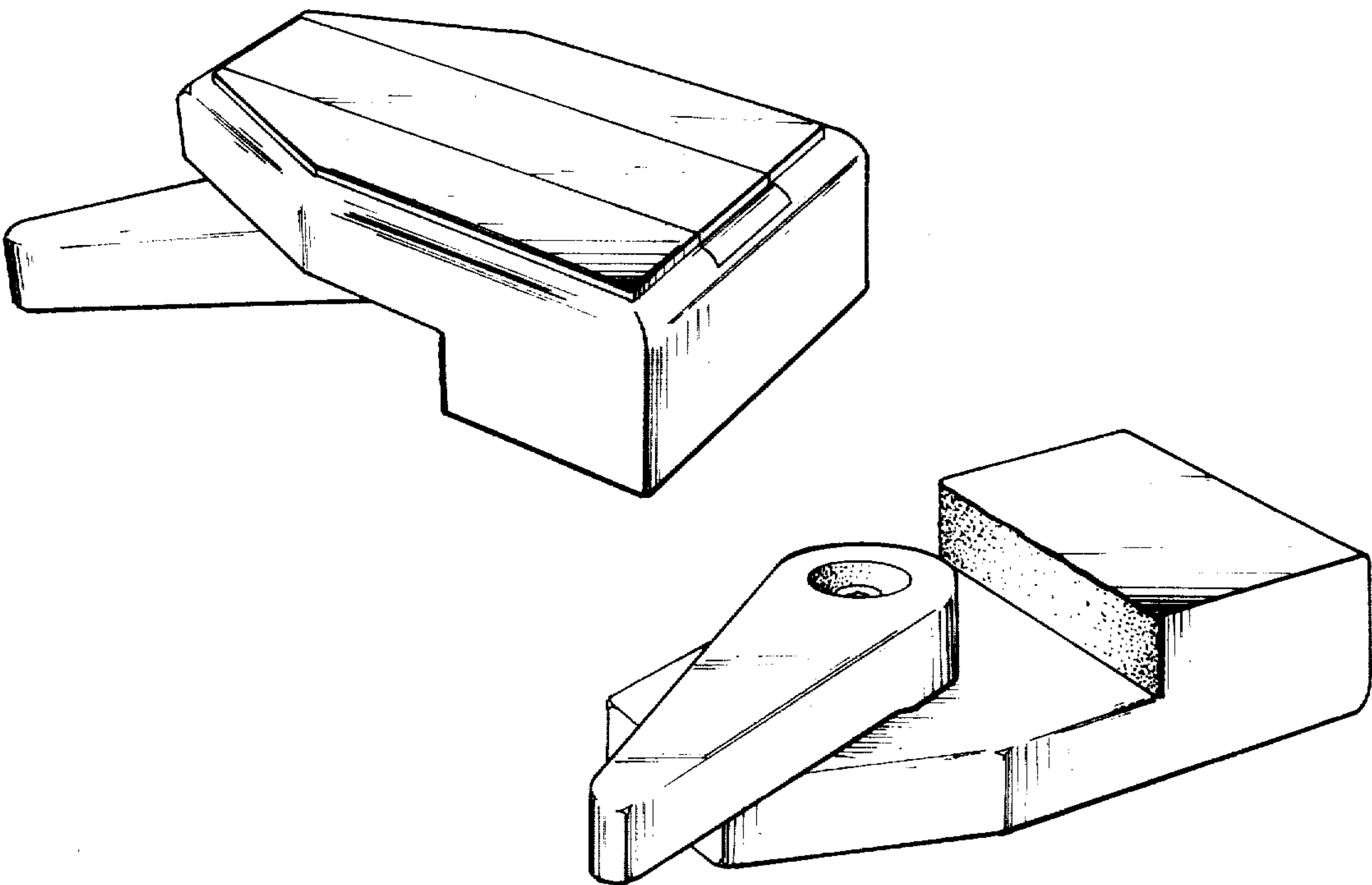

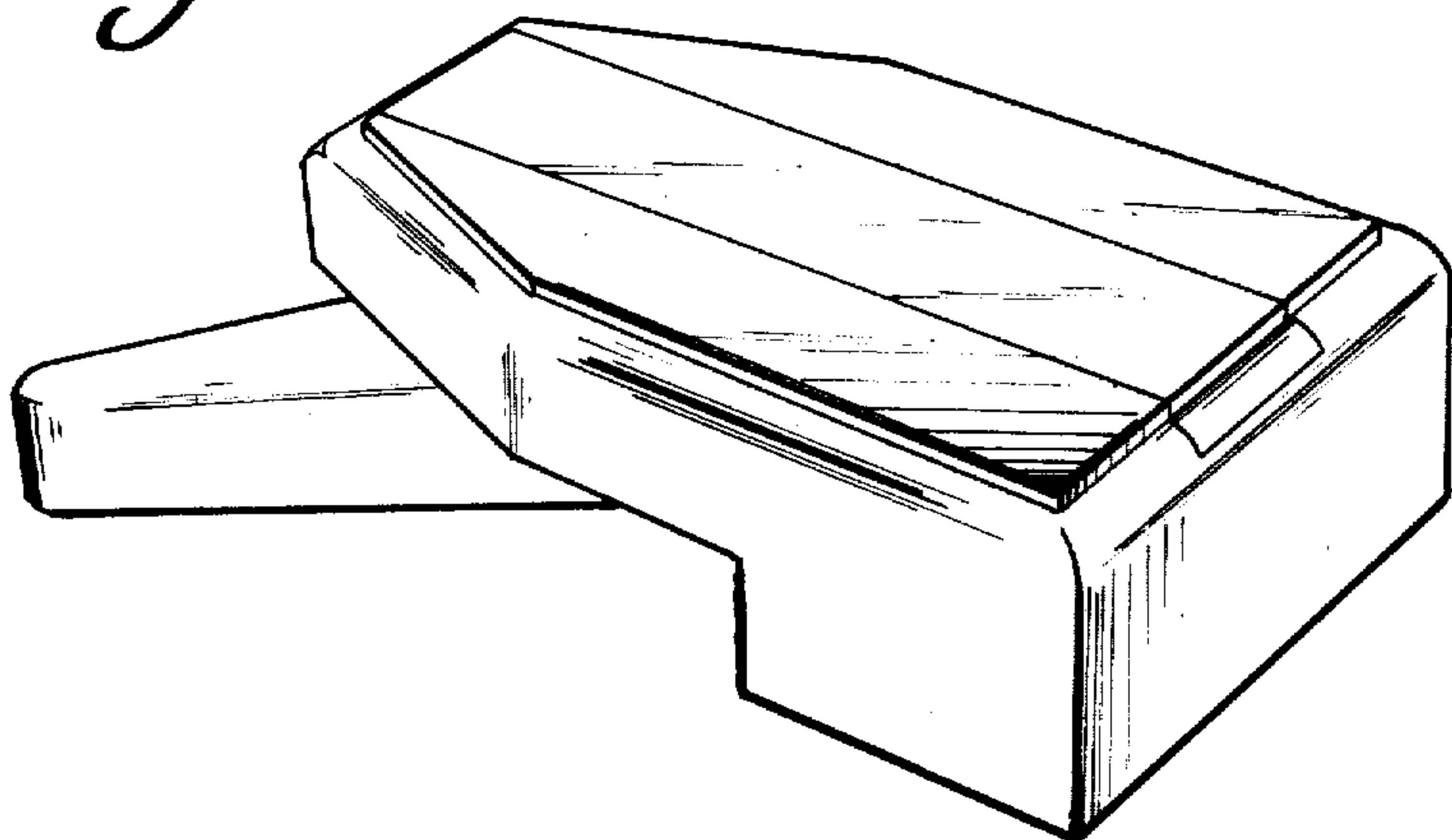

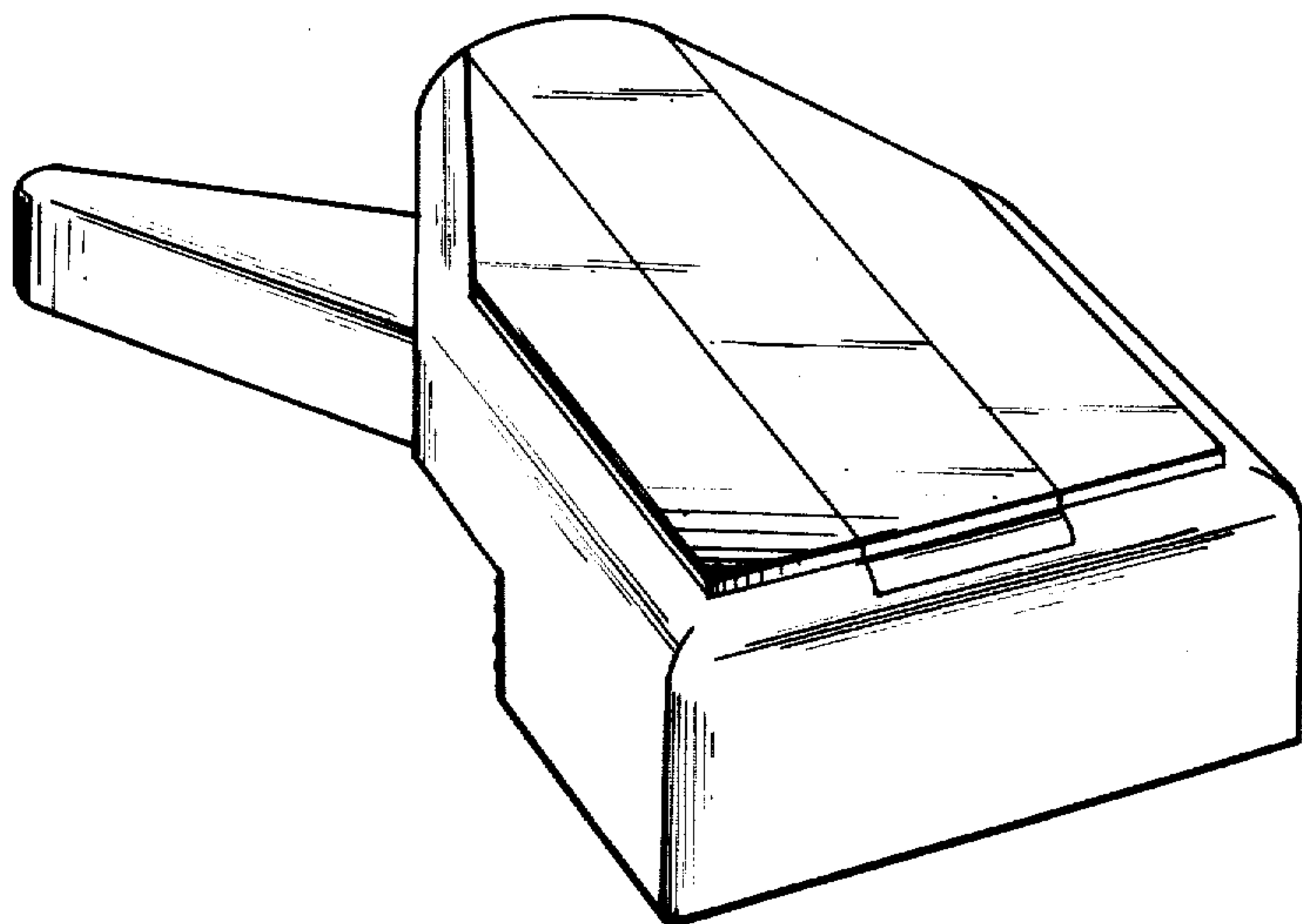
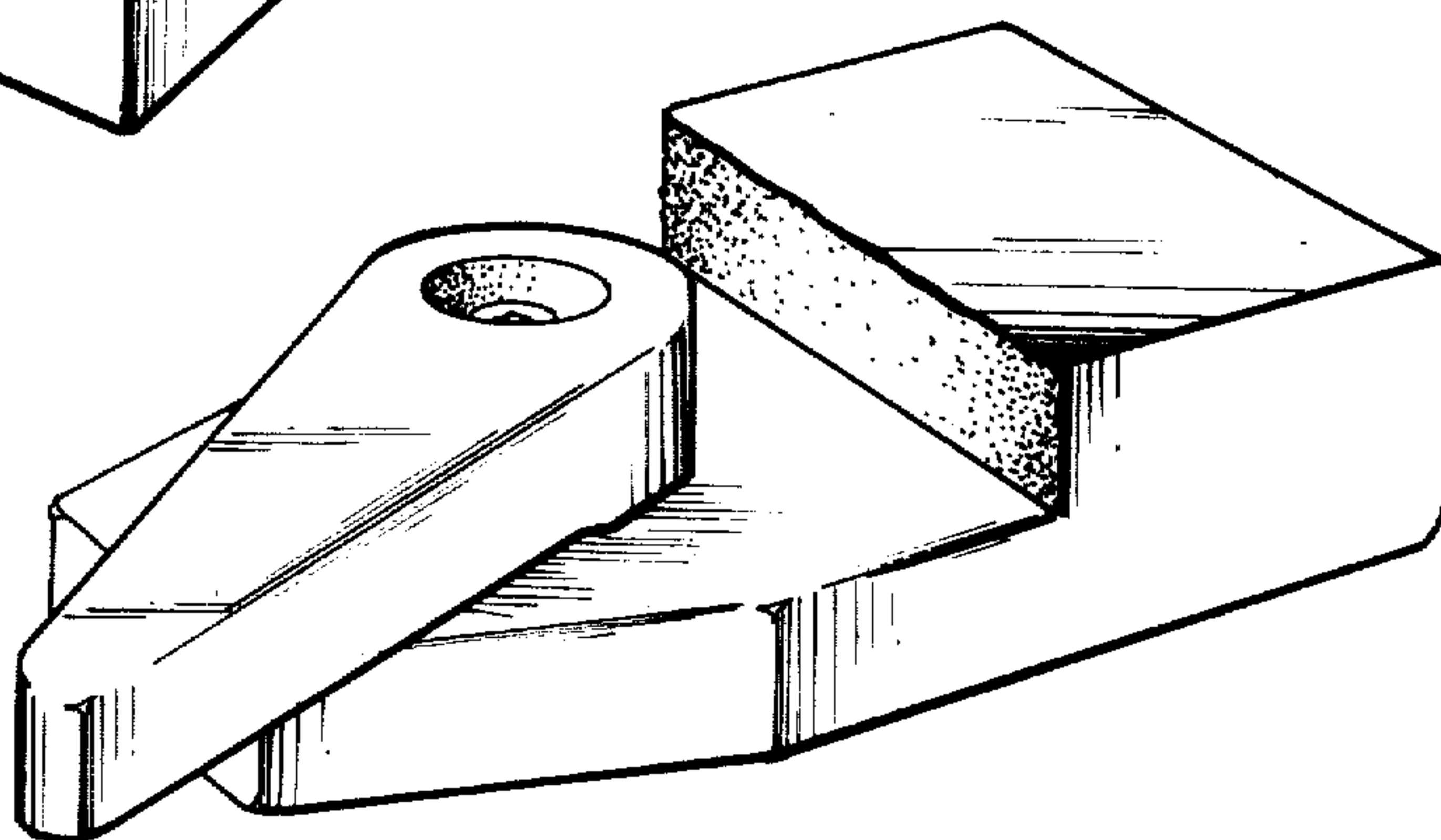
