DESCRIPTION

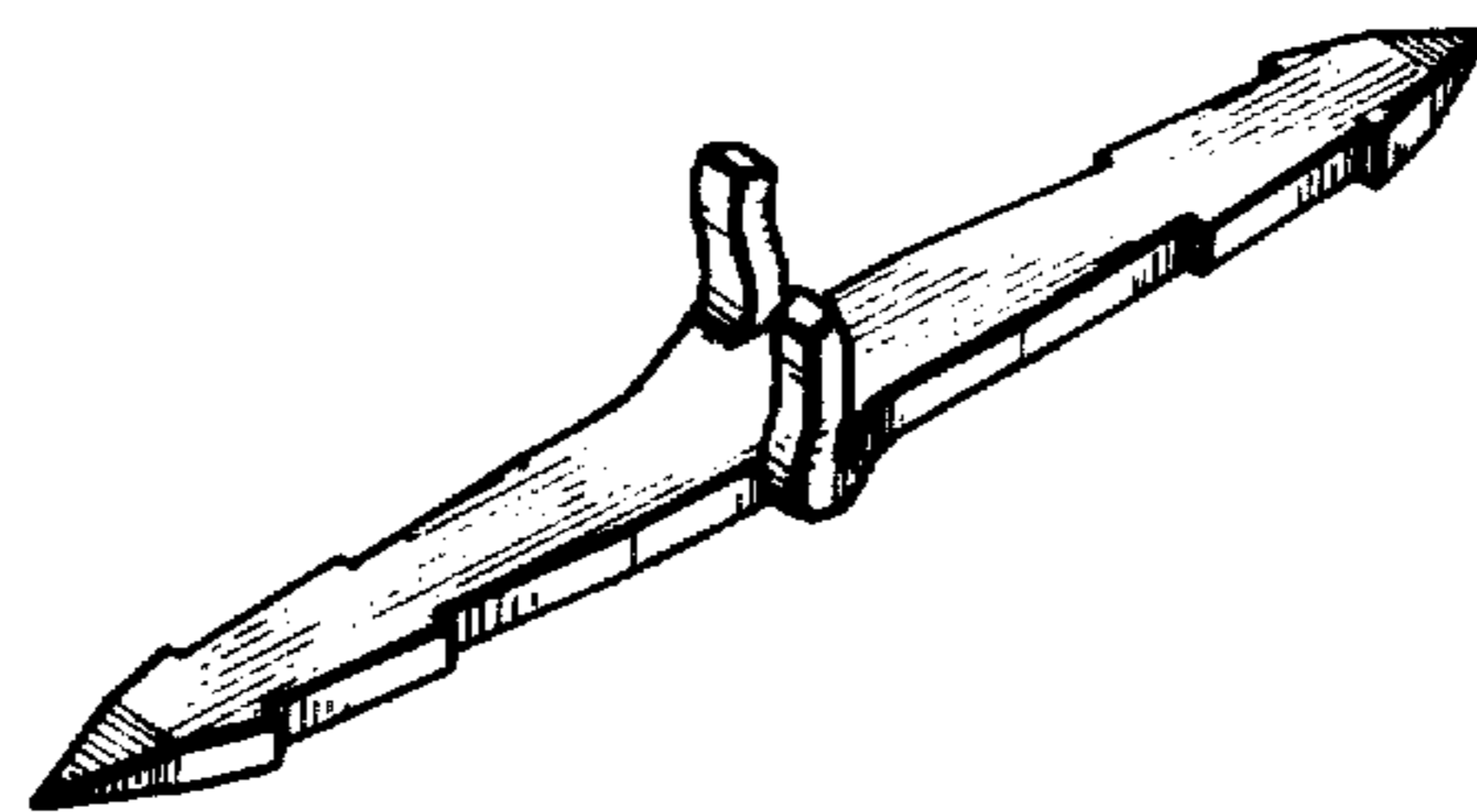
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a blind nail, showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is an elevational view of one end, the opposite end being a mirror image thereof.



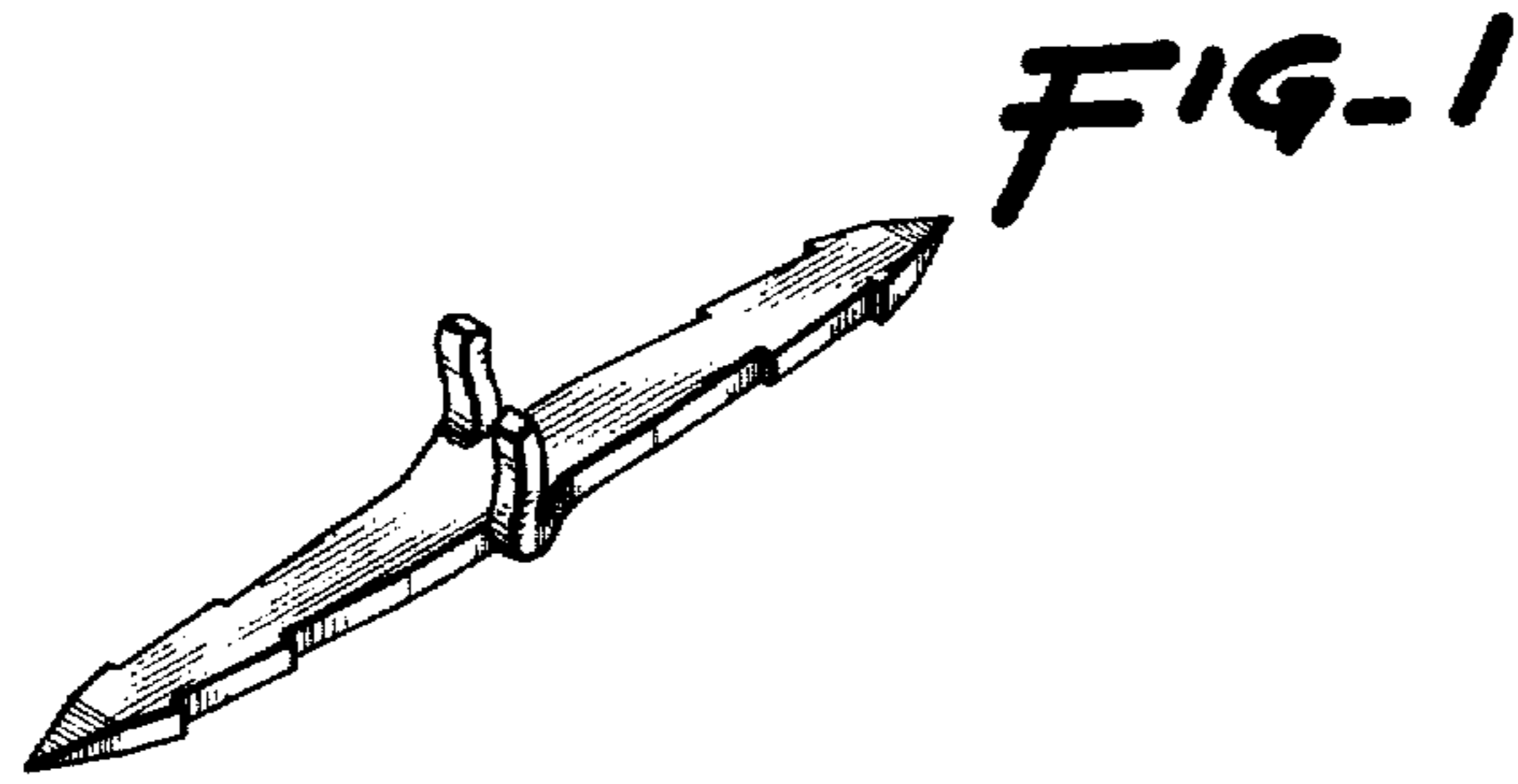
