DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the pocket portfolio showing my new design.

FIG. 2 is a top plan view of the pocket portfolio;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view thereof;

FIG. 4 is a front elevational view thereof;

FIG. 5 is a front elevational view thereof shown in open position.

FIG. 6 is a developed plan view of the portfolio; and

FIG. 7 is an alternate developed plan view of the portfolio.

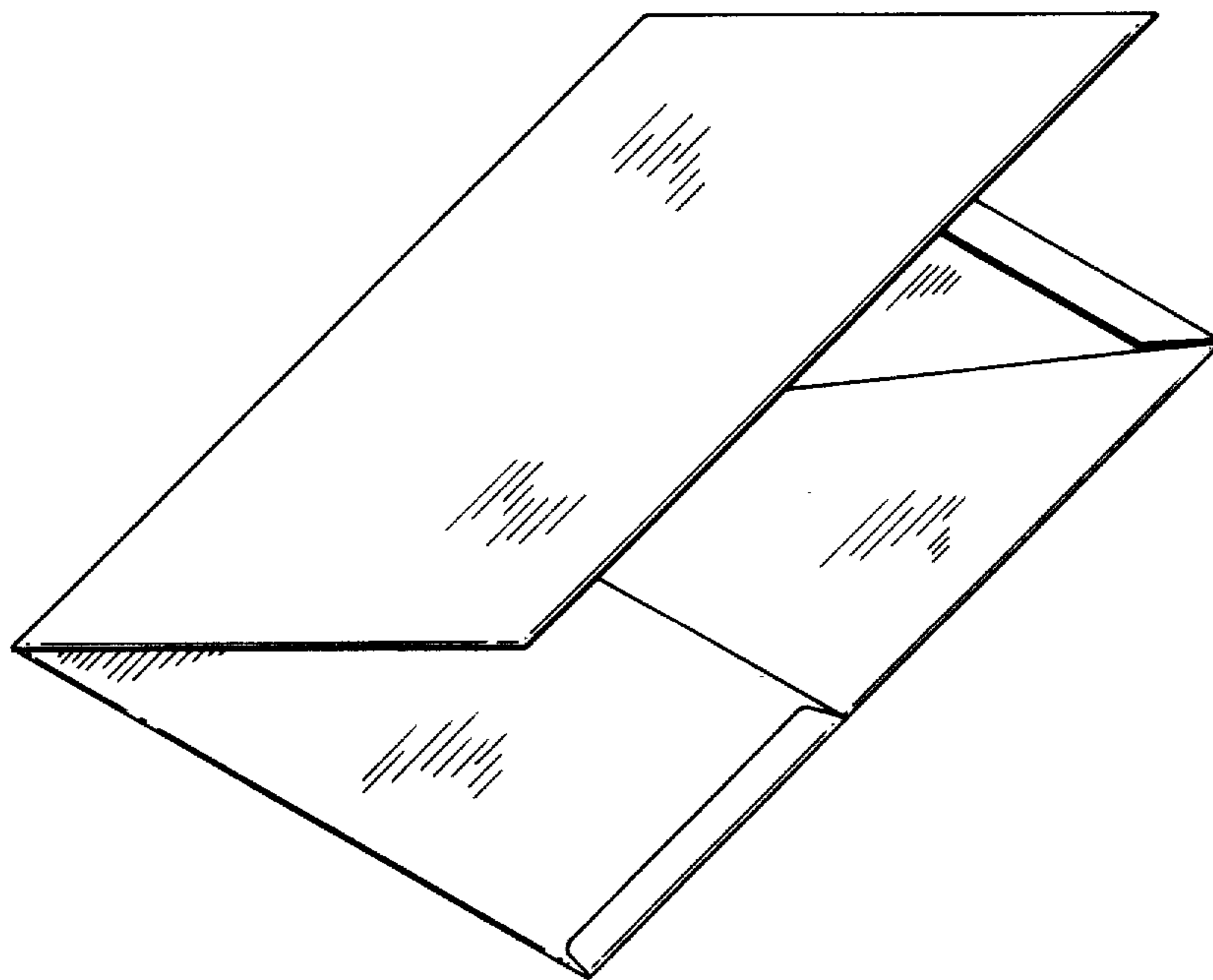

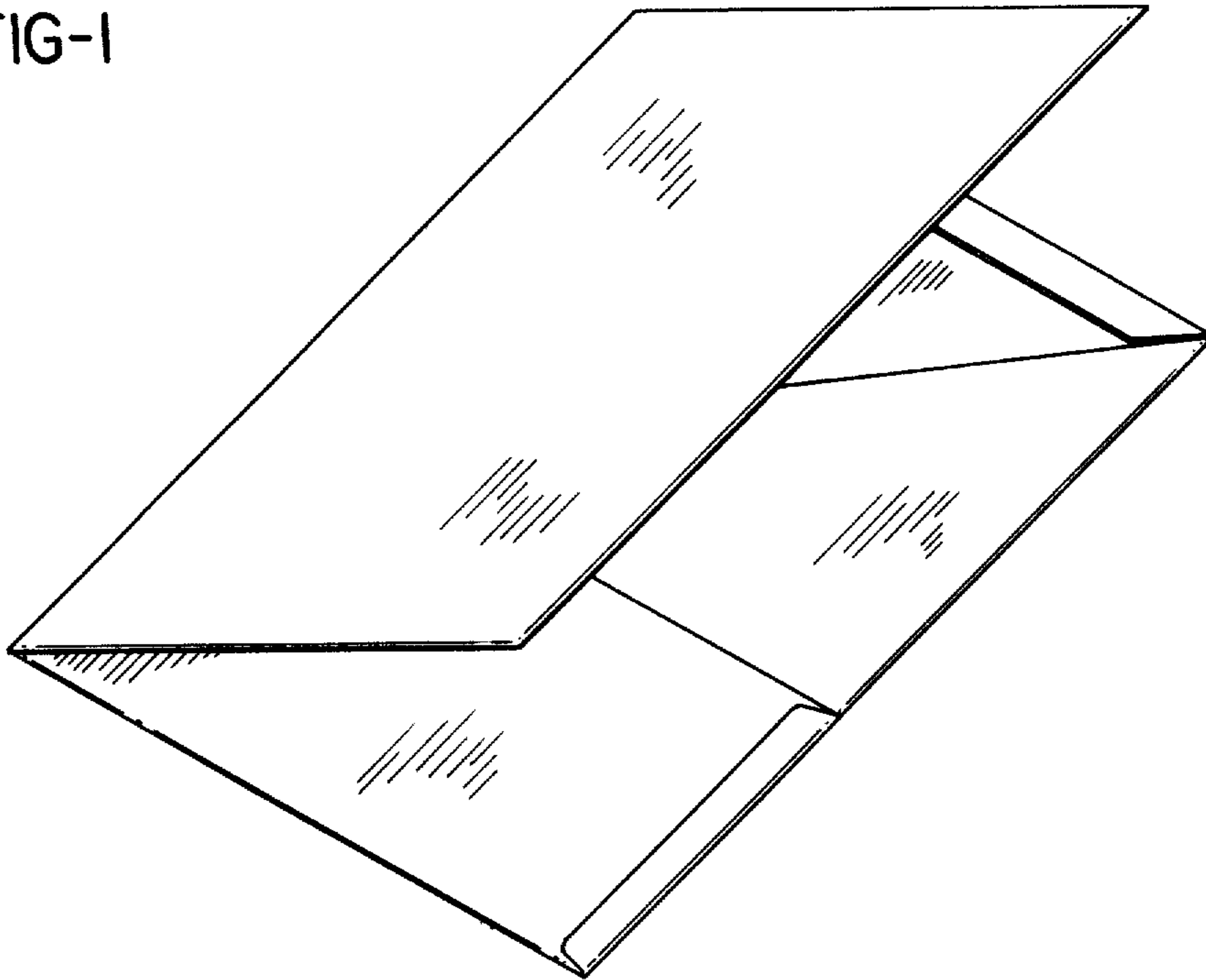

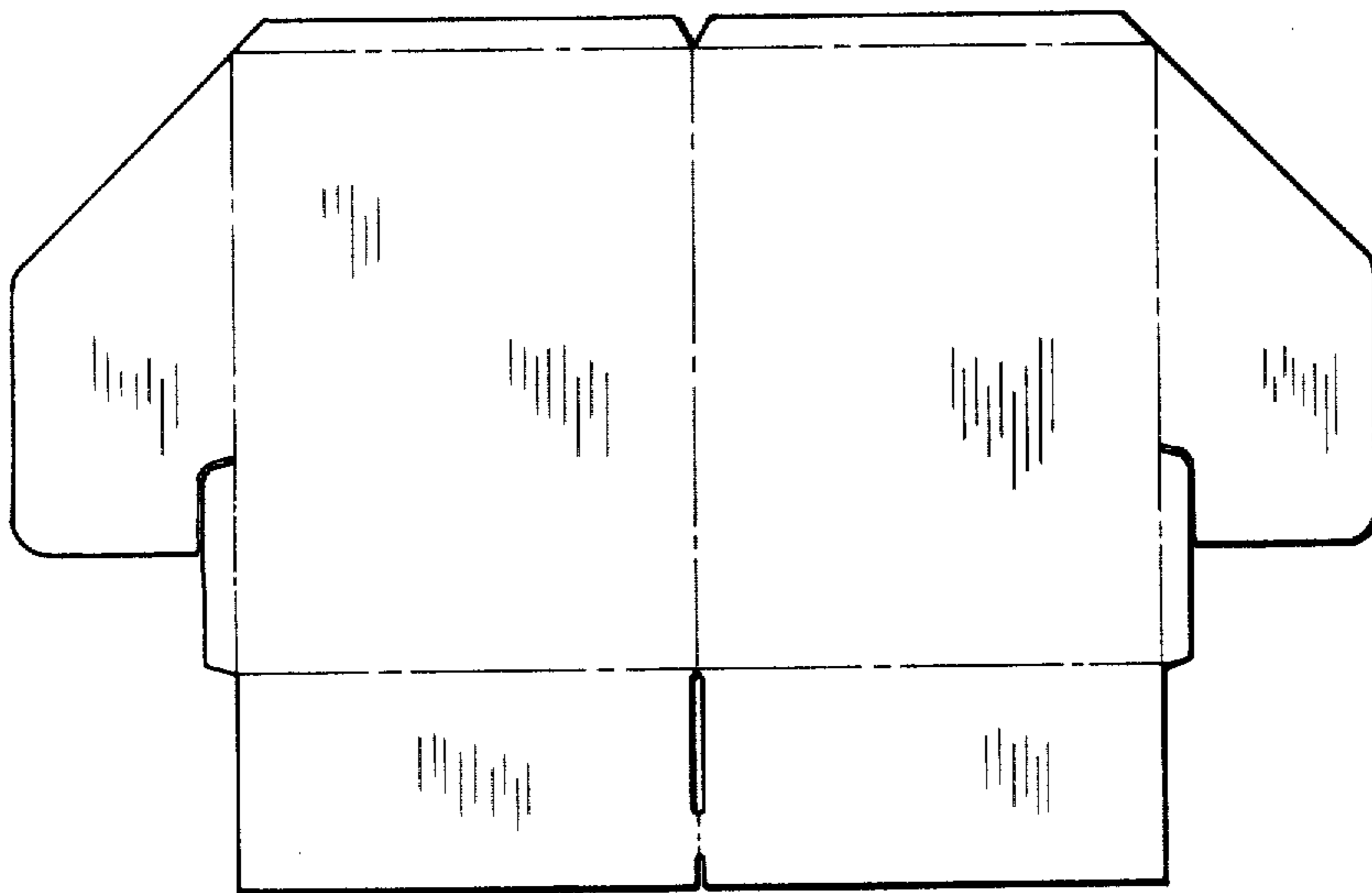

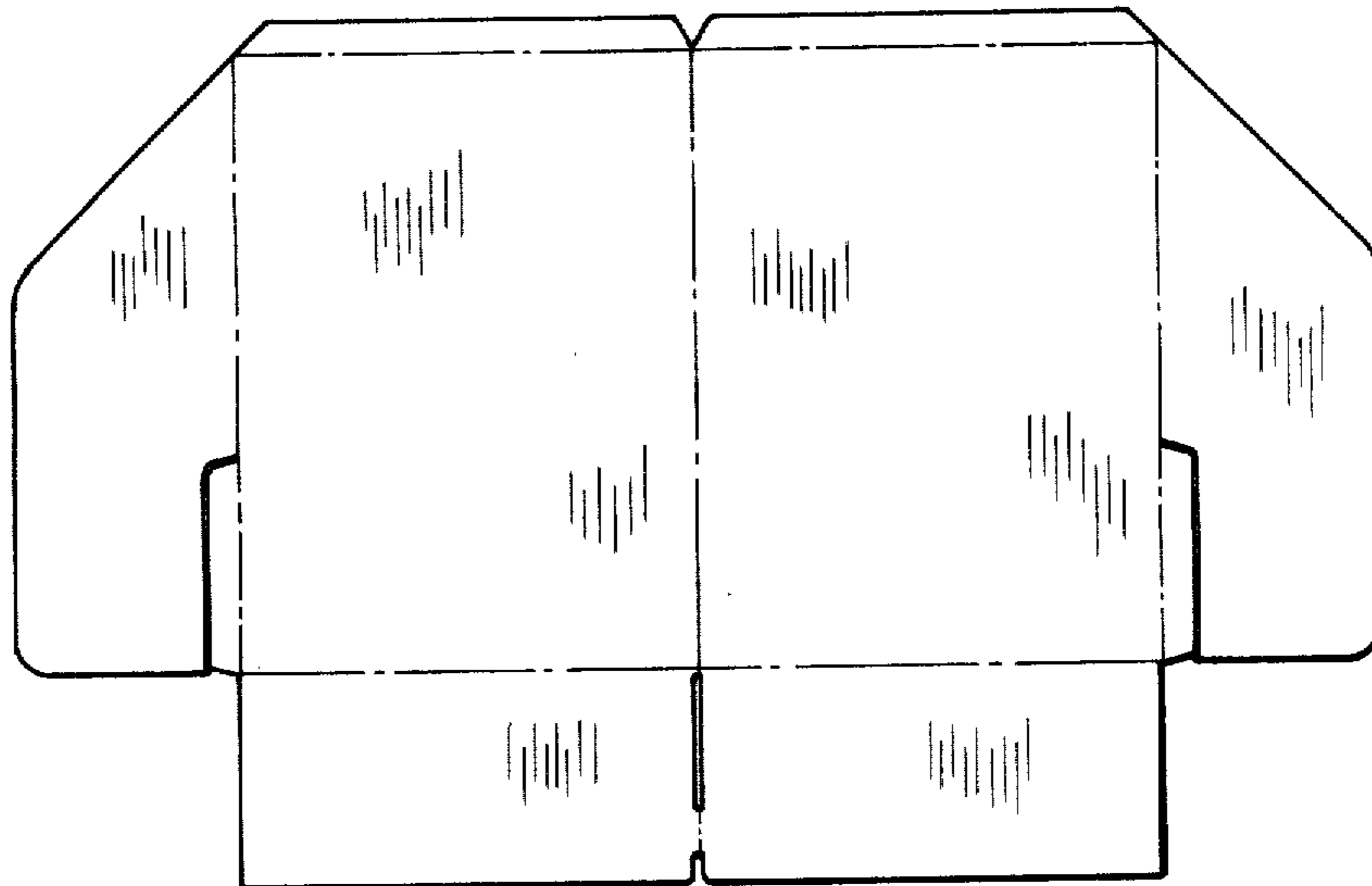

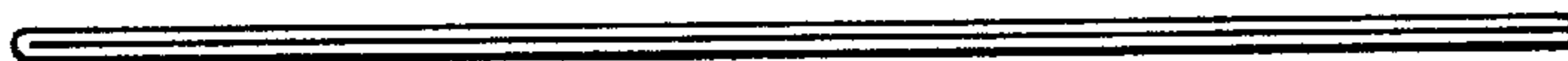

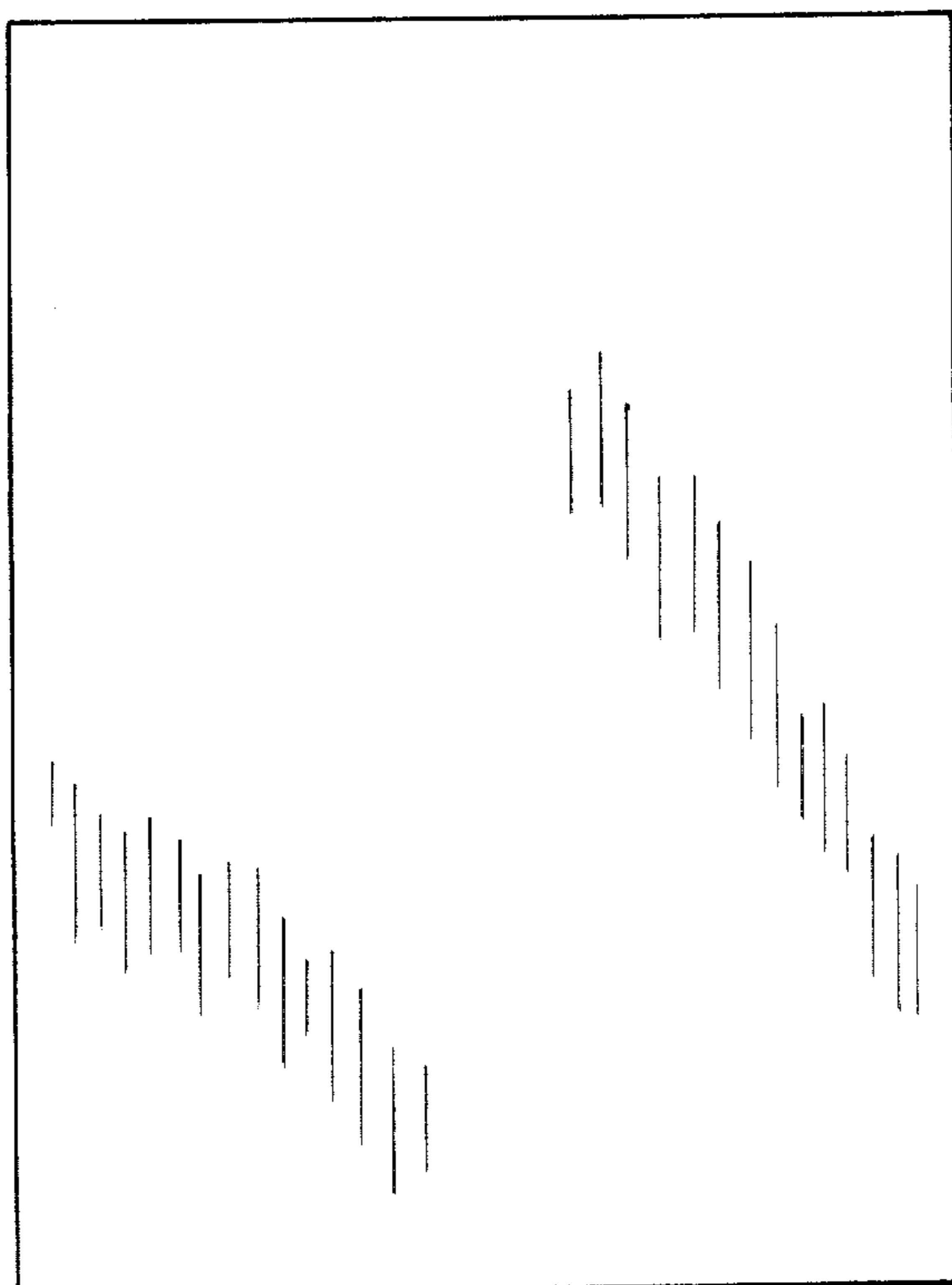
