DESCRIPTION

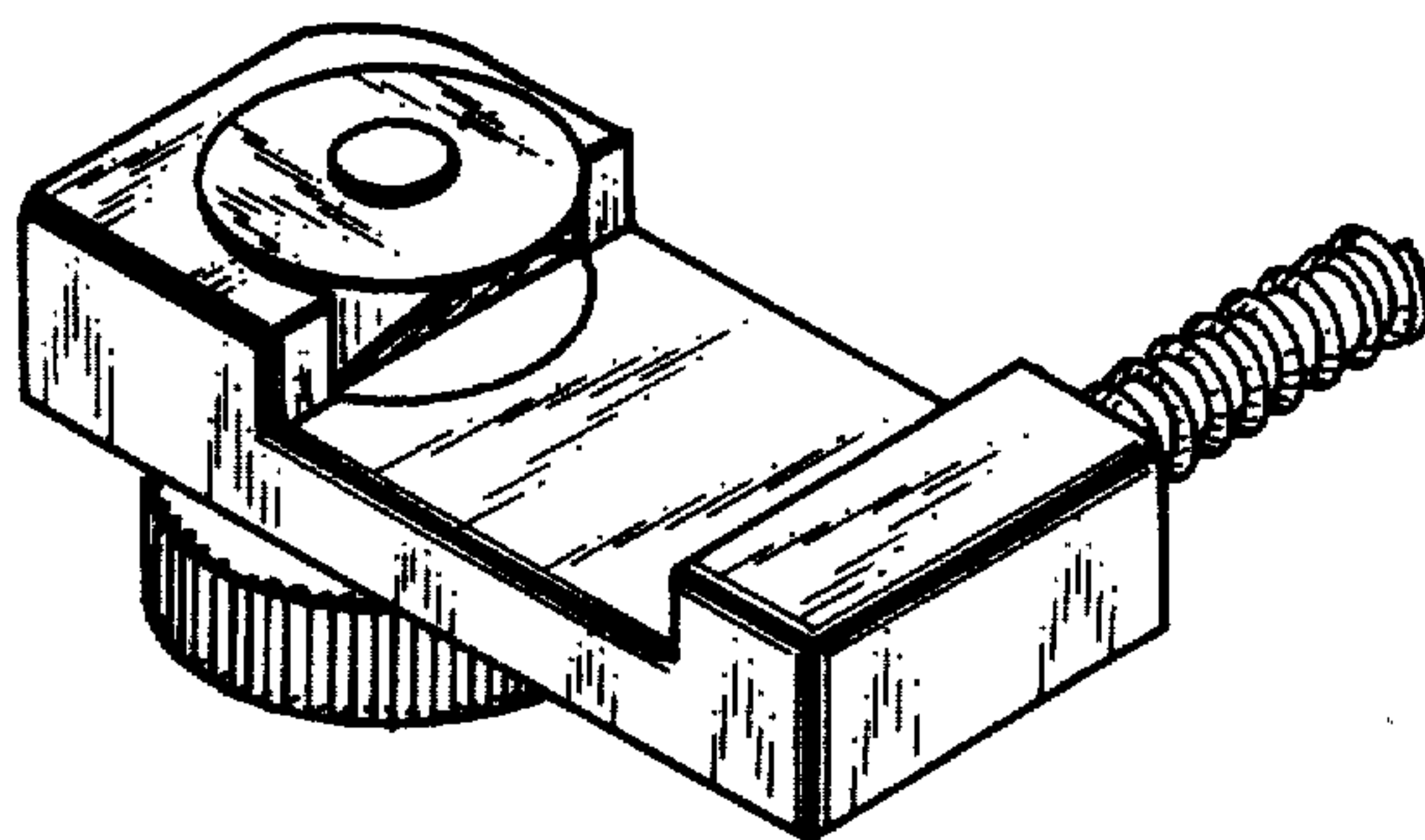
FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a pressure-sensitive caliper attachment showing my new design, with a caliper being shown in broken lines for illustrative purposes only;

FIG. 5 is a bottom plan view.



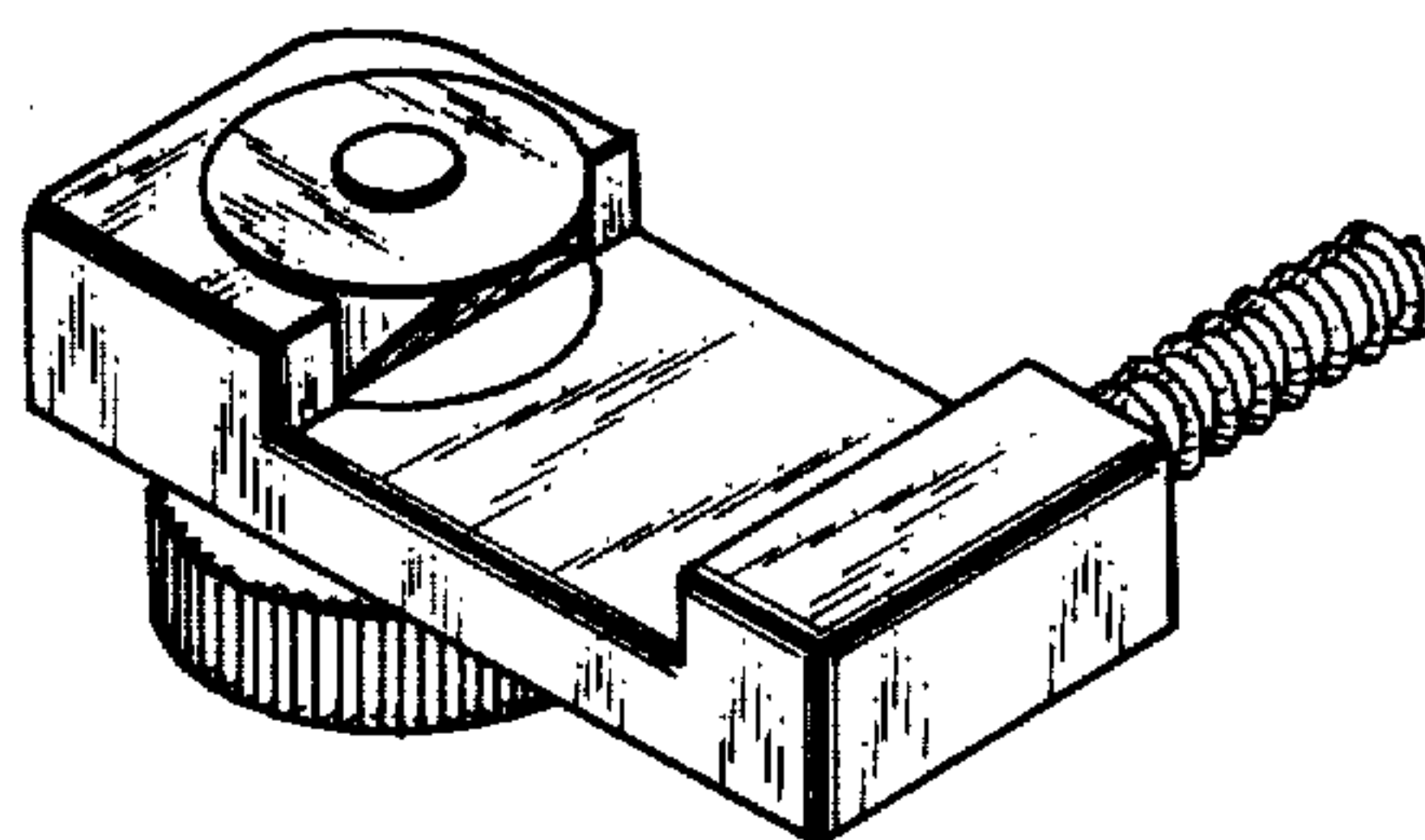
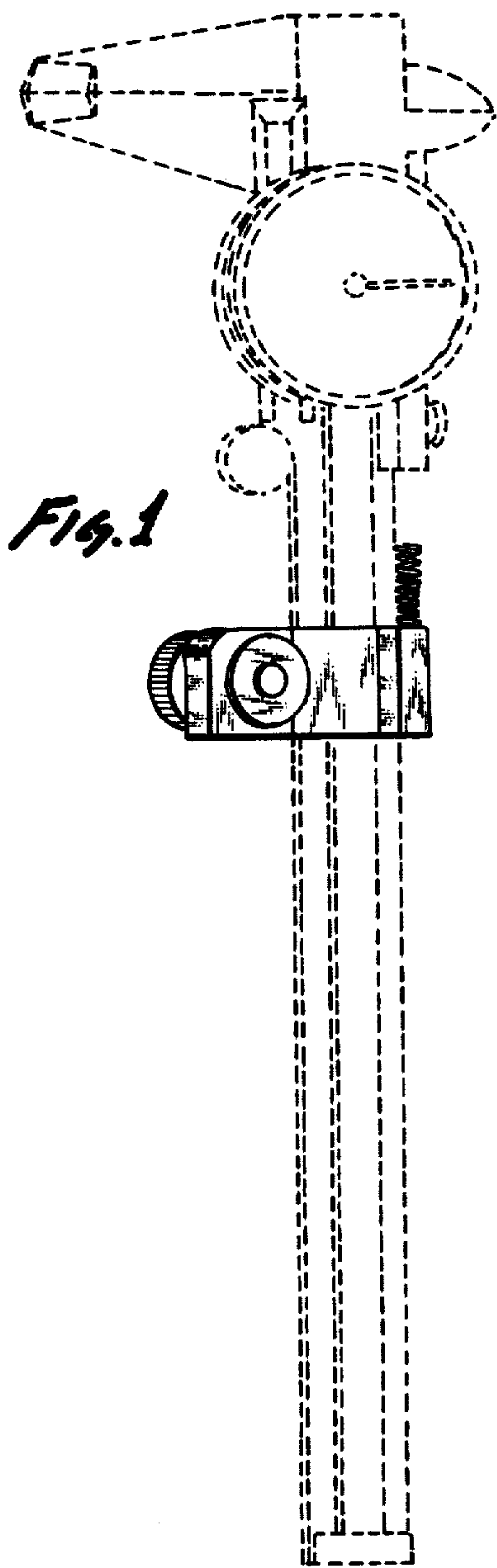

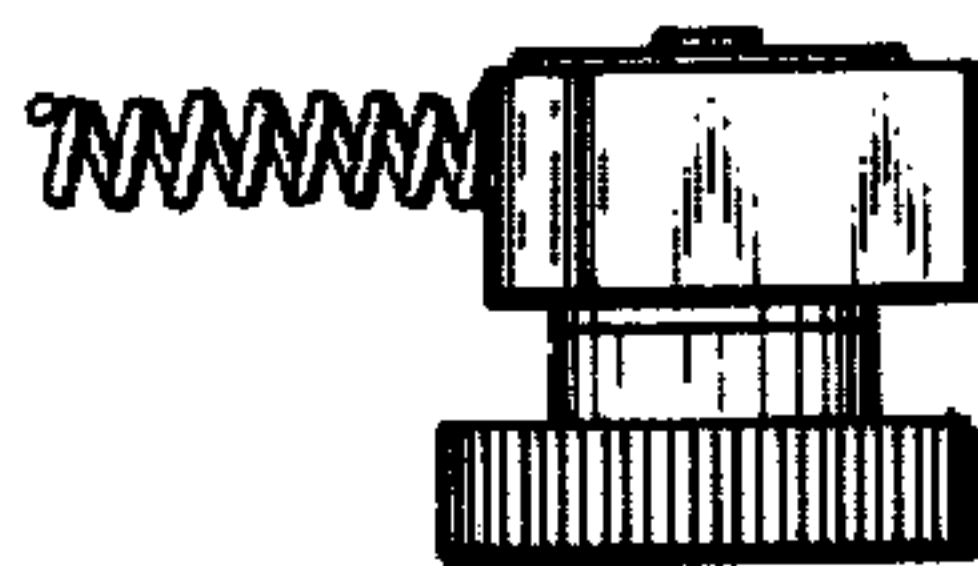
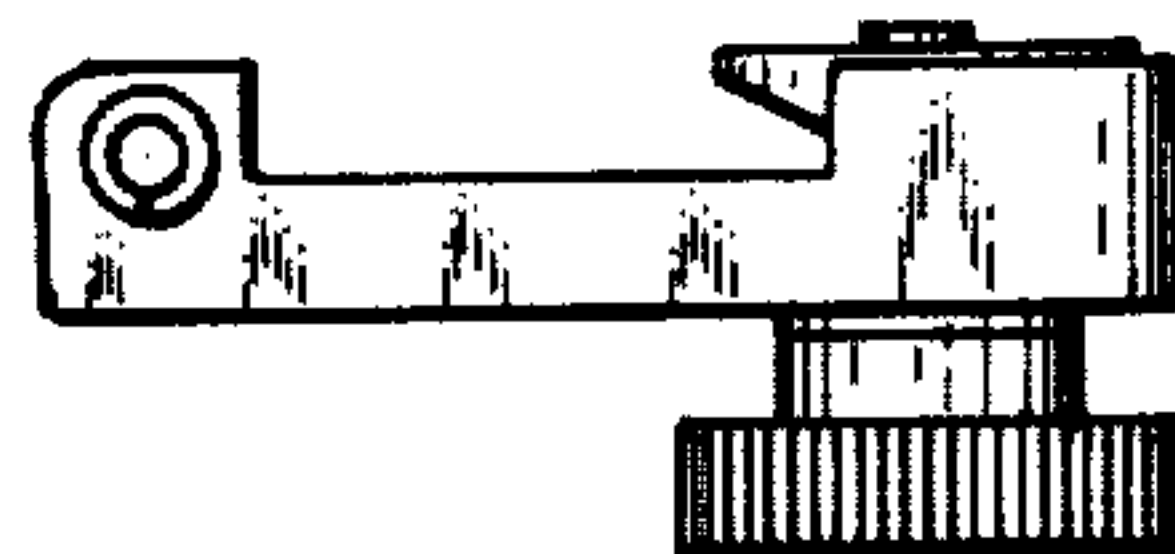
