
The ornamental design for a warning light with cylindrical lens, substantially as shown and described.

FIG. 1 is a side elevation view of a warning light with cylindrical lens showing my novel design, the opposite being a mirror image;


FIG. 2 is a top view thereof; and


FIG. 3 is a bottom view thereof.
