FIG. 1 is a front, left side perspective view of a briefcase microfiche reader showing our new design in a closed position;

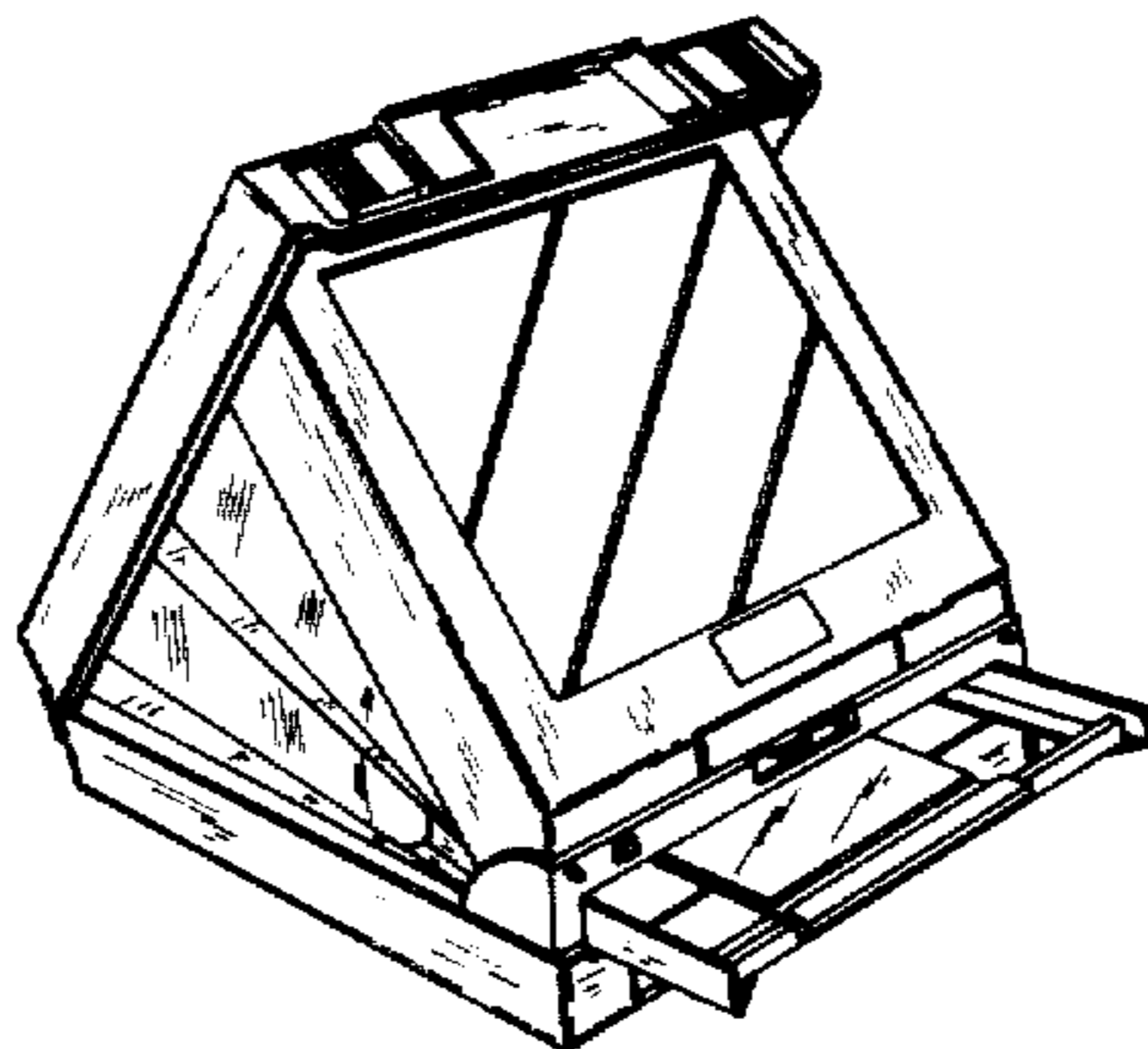
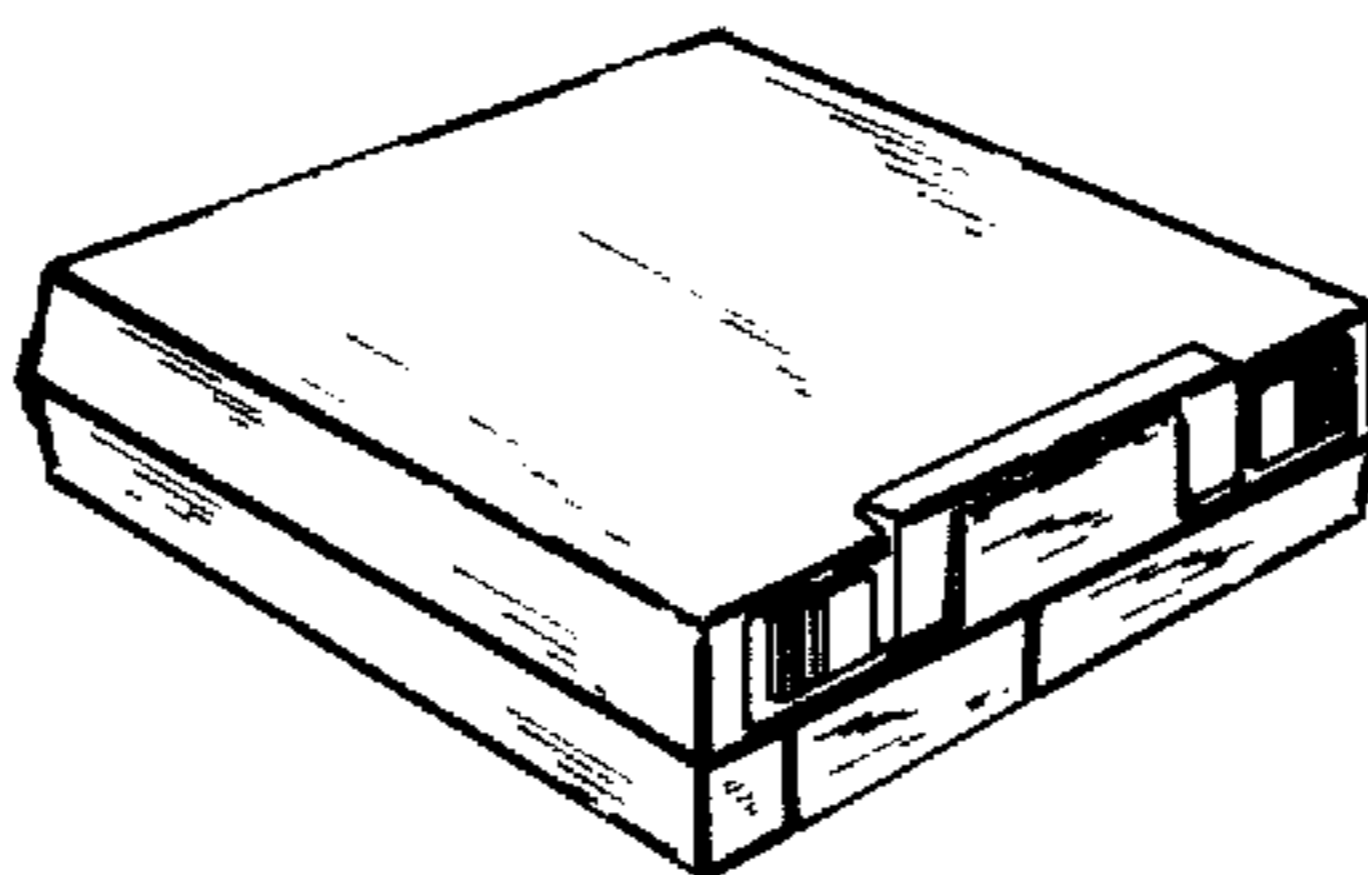
FIG. 2 is a front, left side perspective view in an opened position;

FIG. 6 is a bottom plan view.



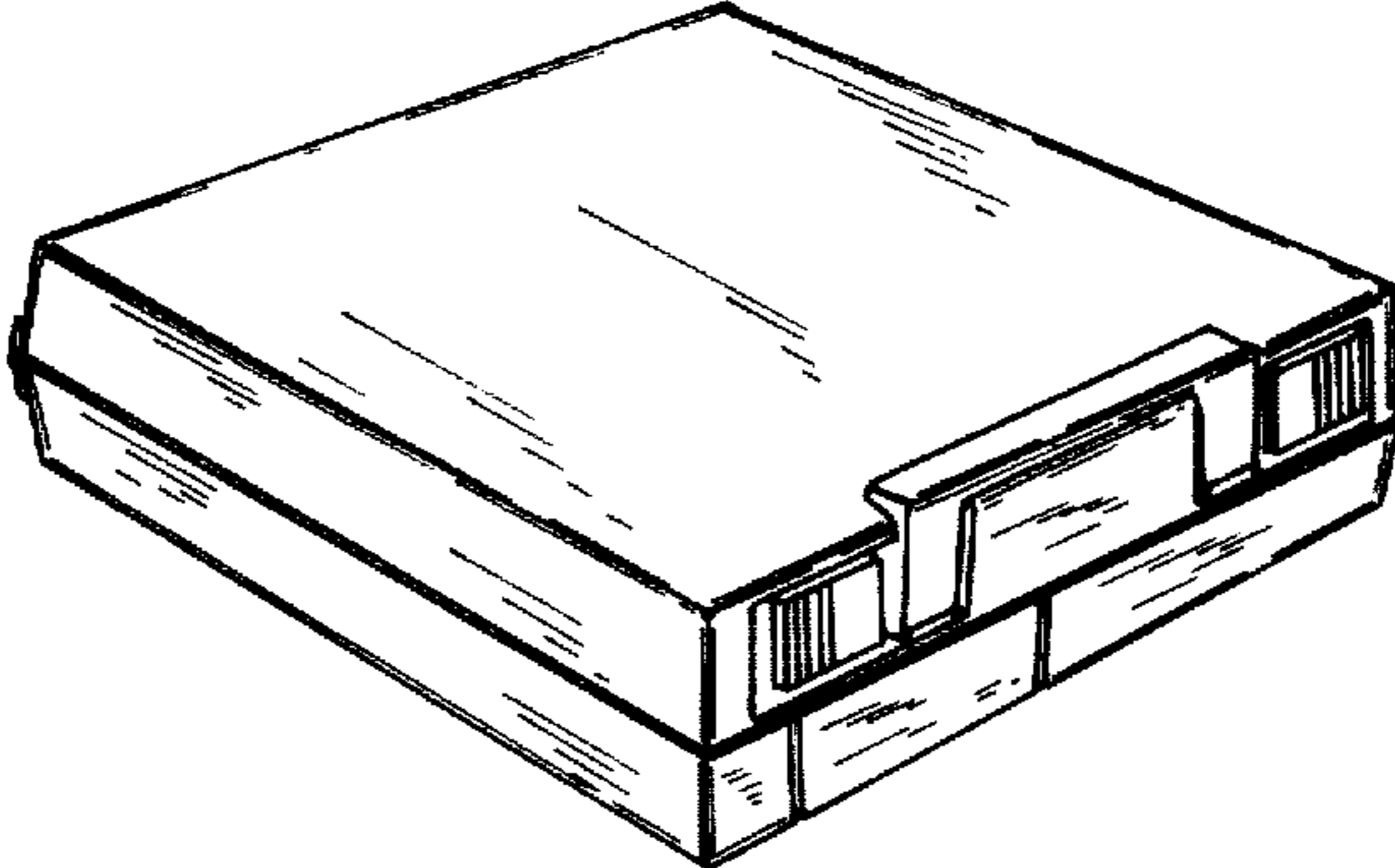

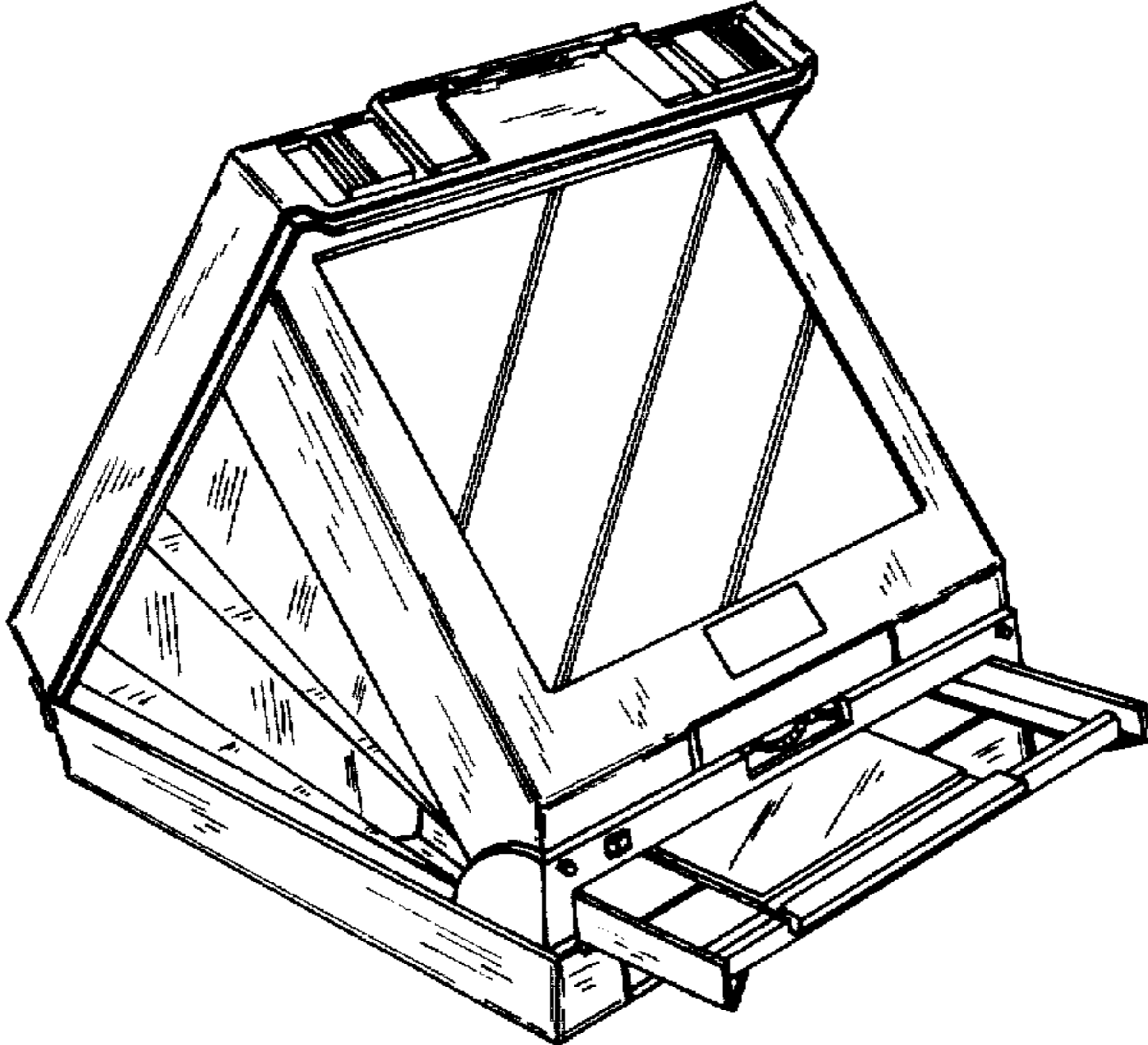

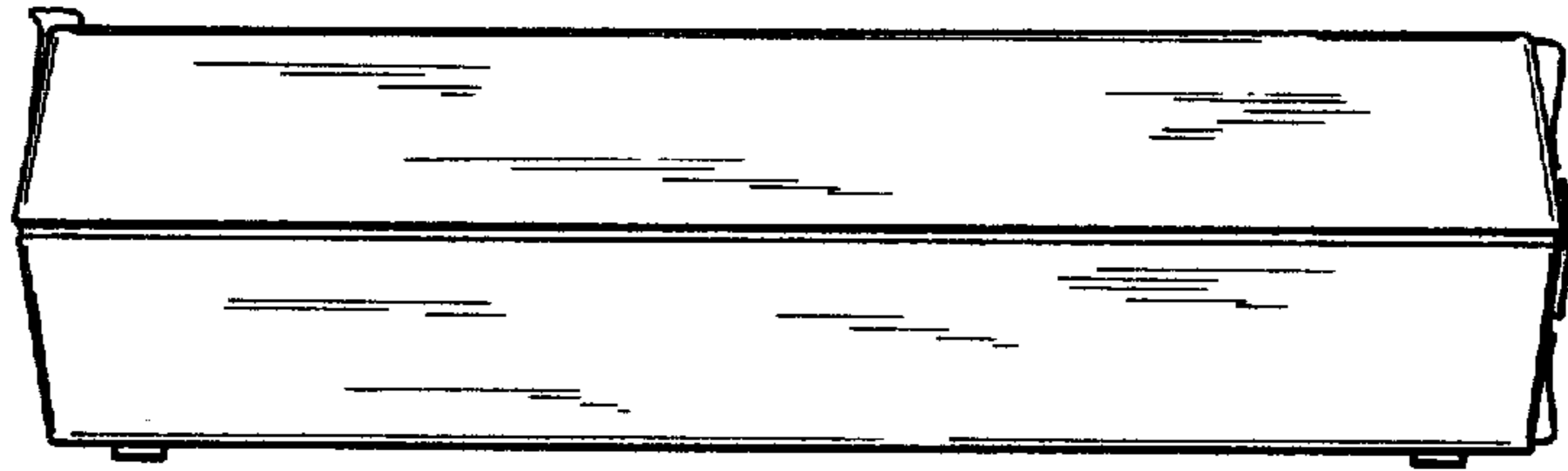

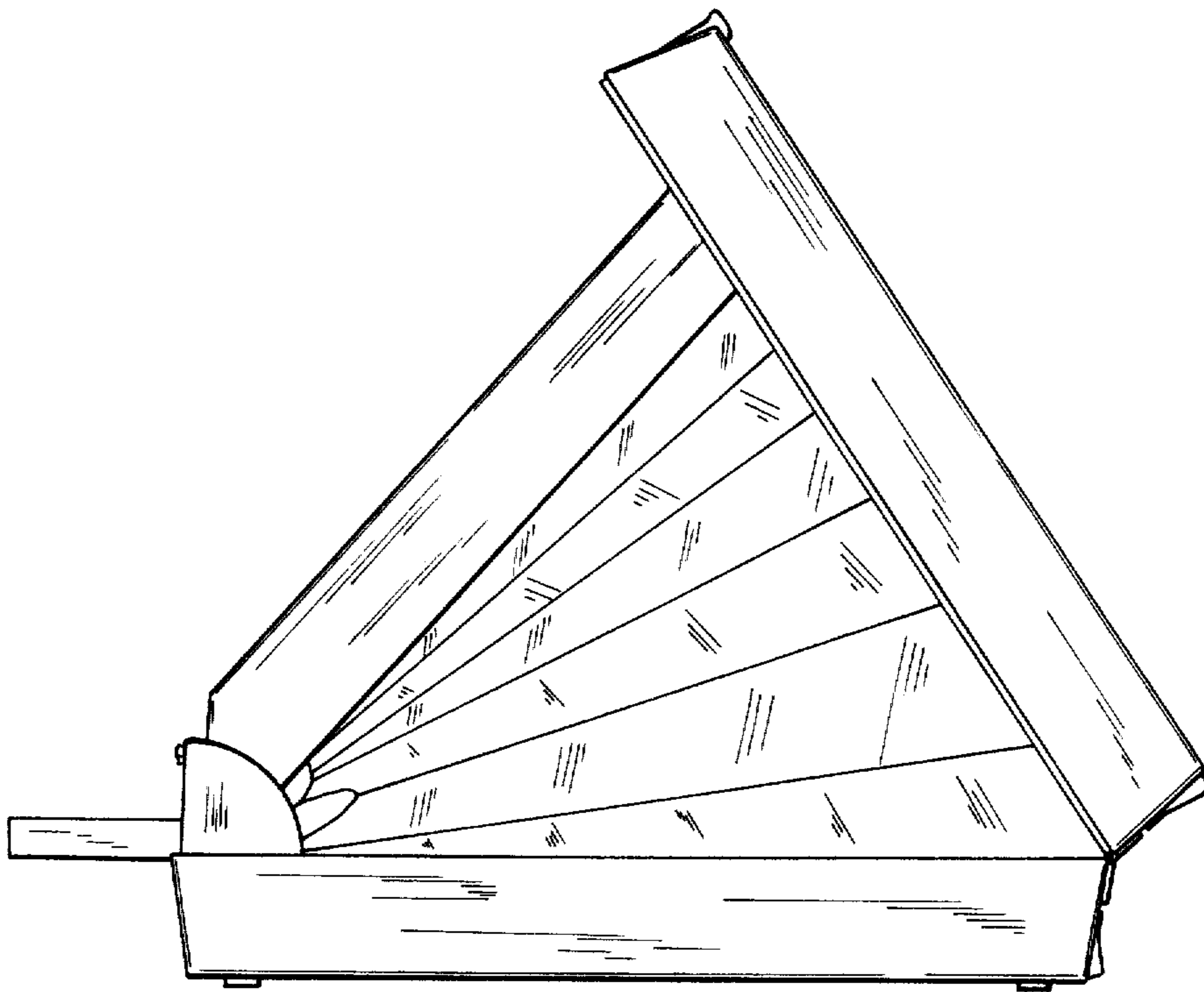

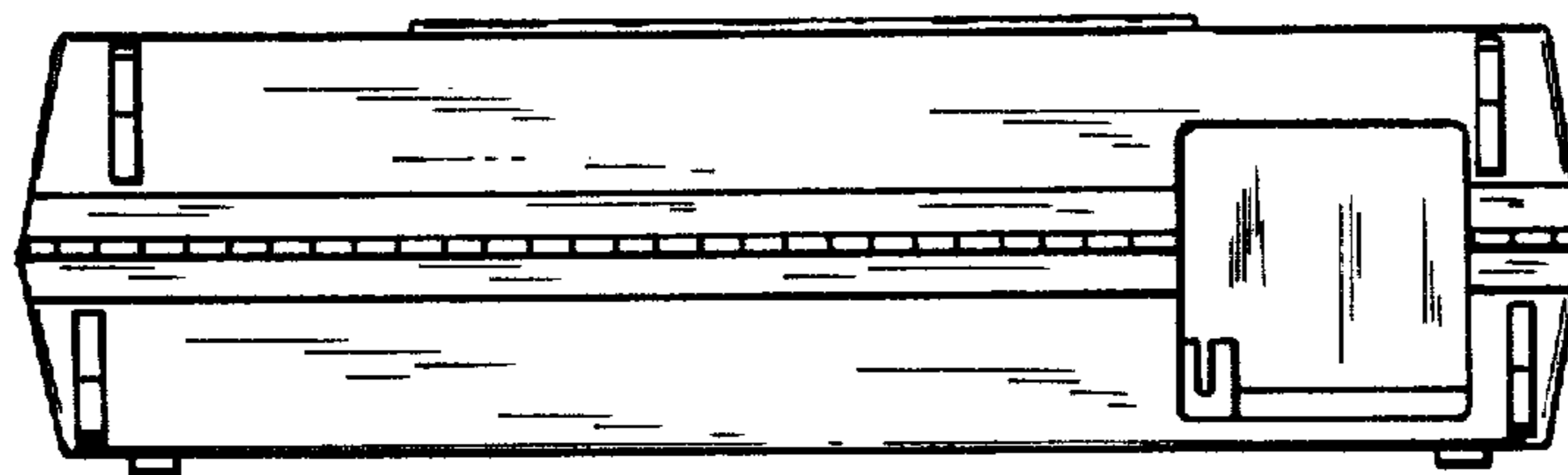

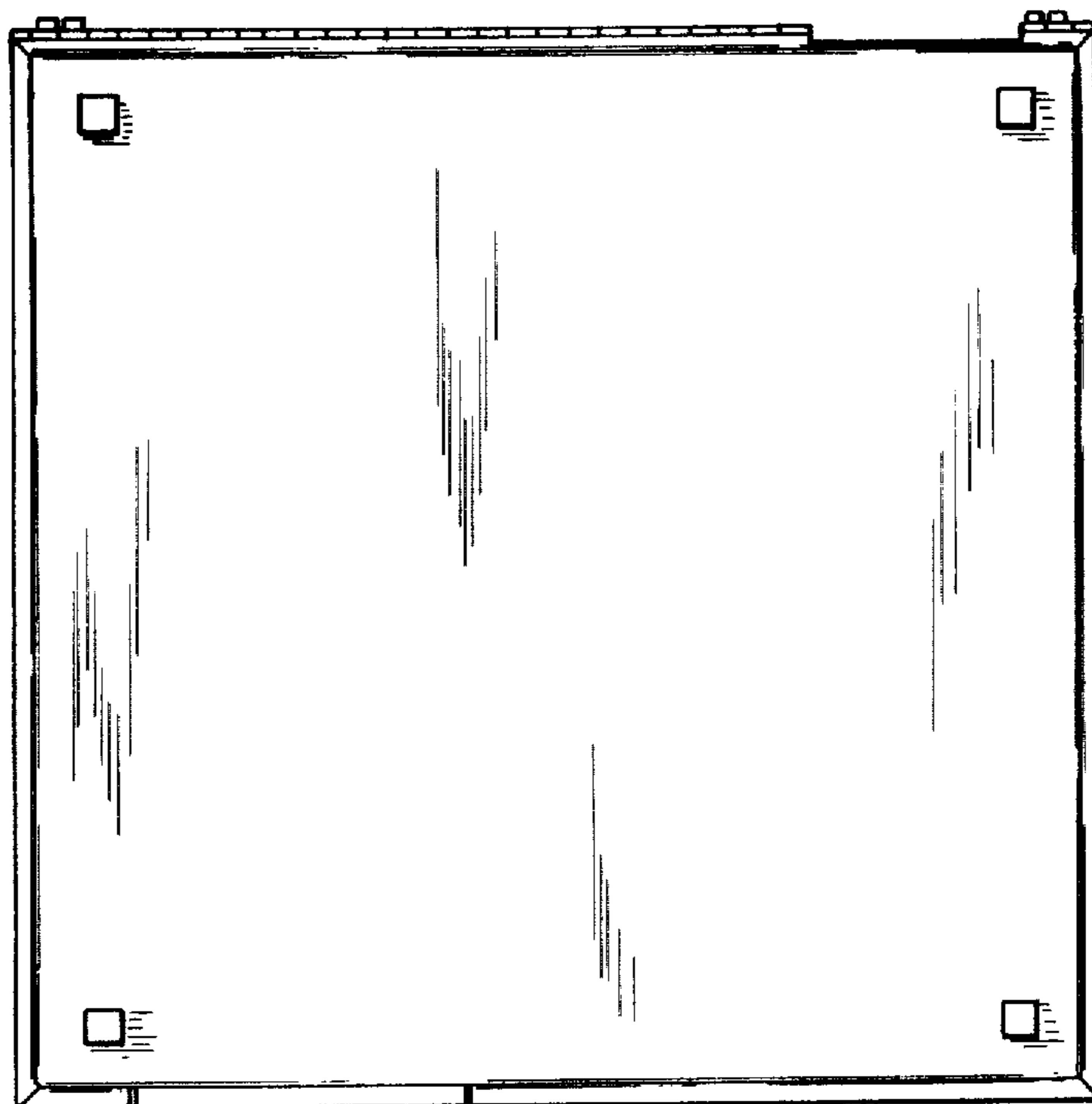
