DESCRIPTION

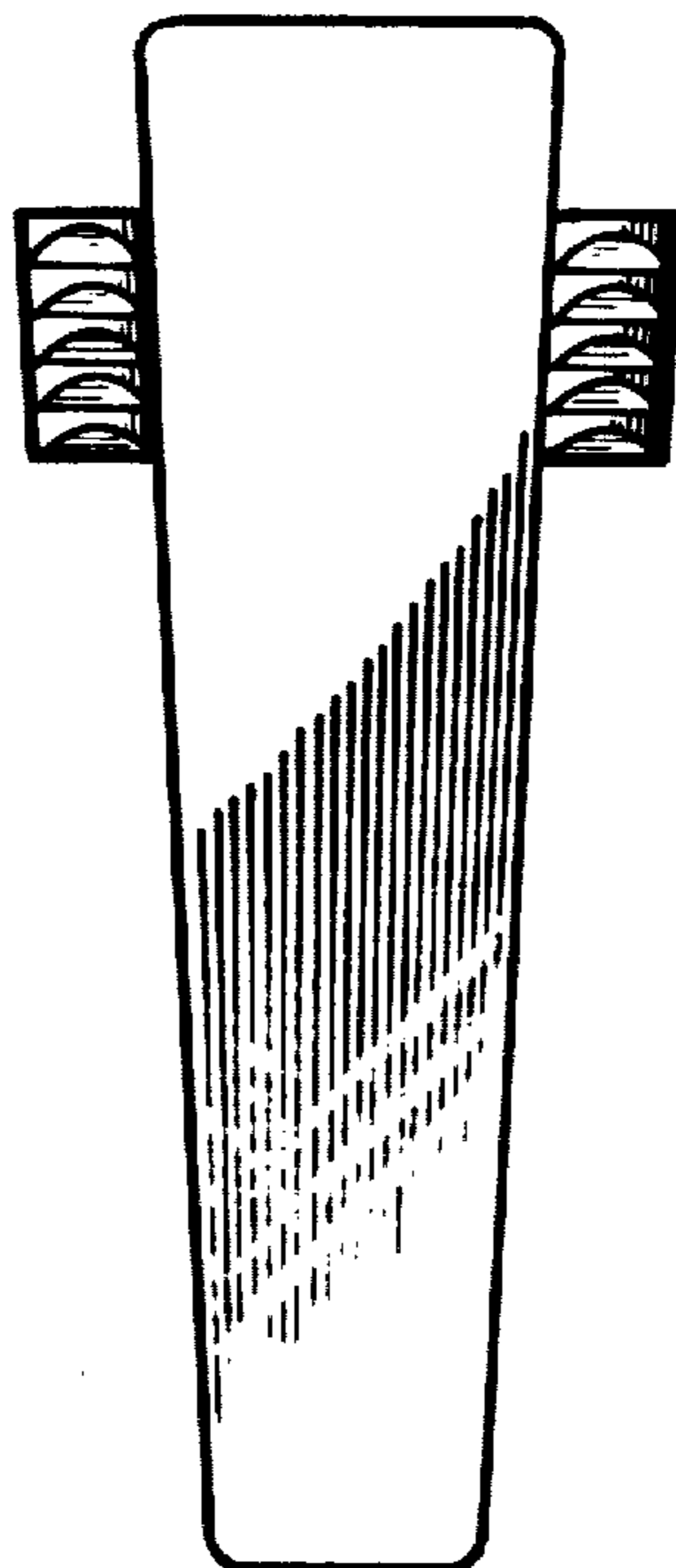
FIG. 1 is a left side elevational view of a combined clip and sliders for a writing instrument showing my new design;

FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view.



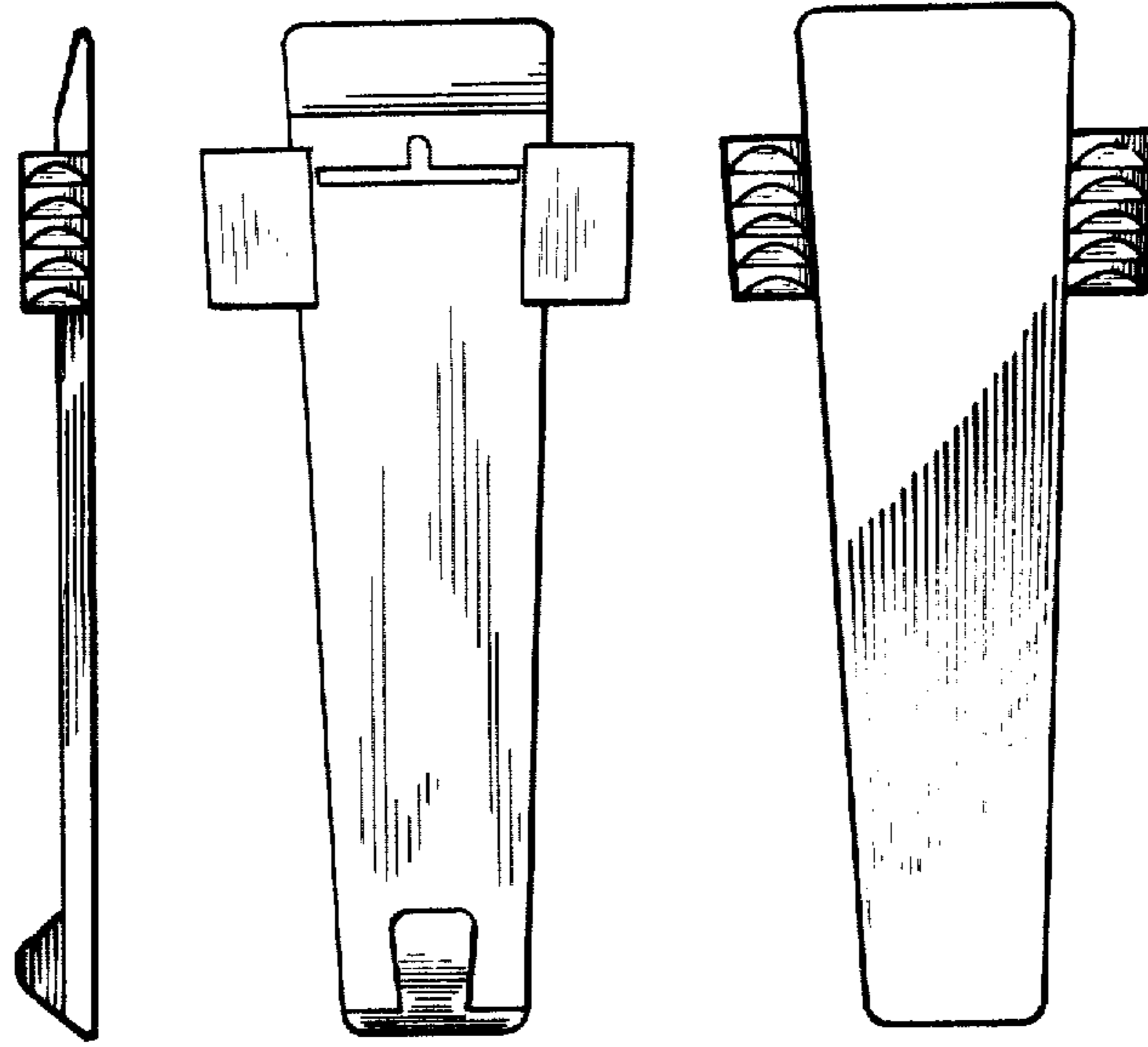


Fig. 1 *Fig. 5* *Fig. 2*
