FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view thereof;

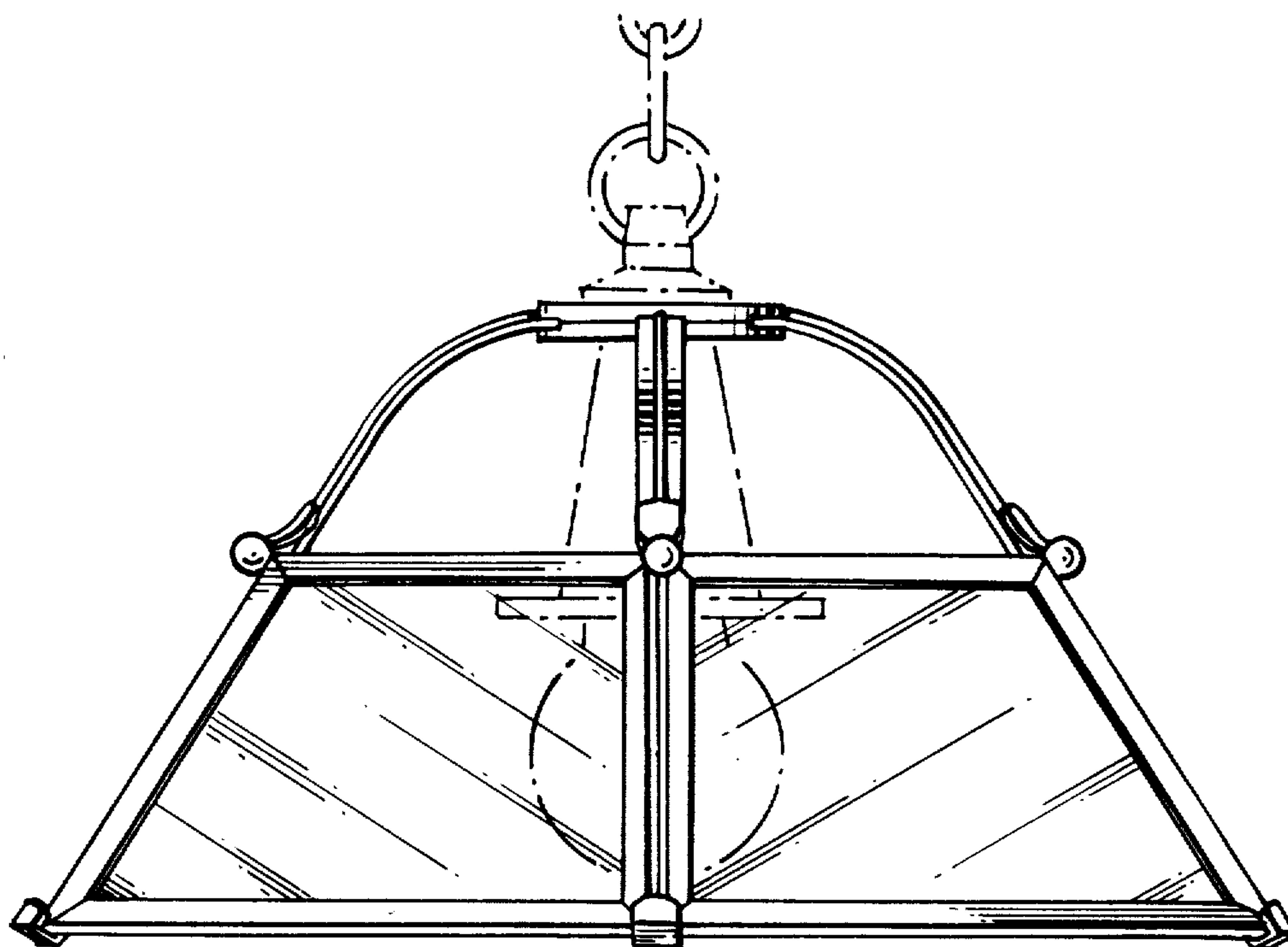
FIG. 5 is a side elevational view of a second embodiment of our new design;

The broken lines are shown in FIG. 2 for illustrative purposes only.



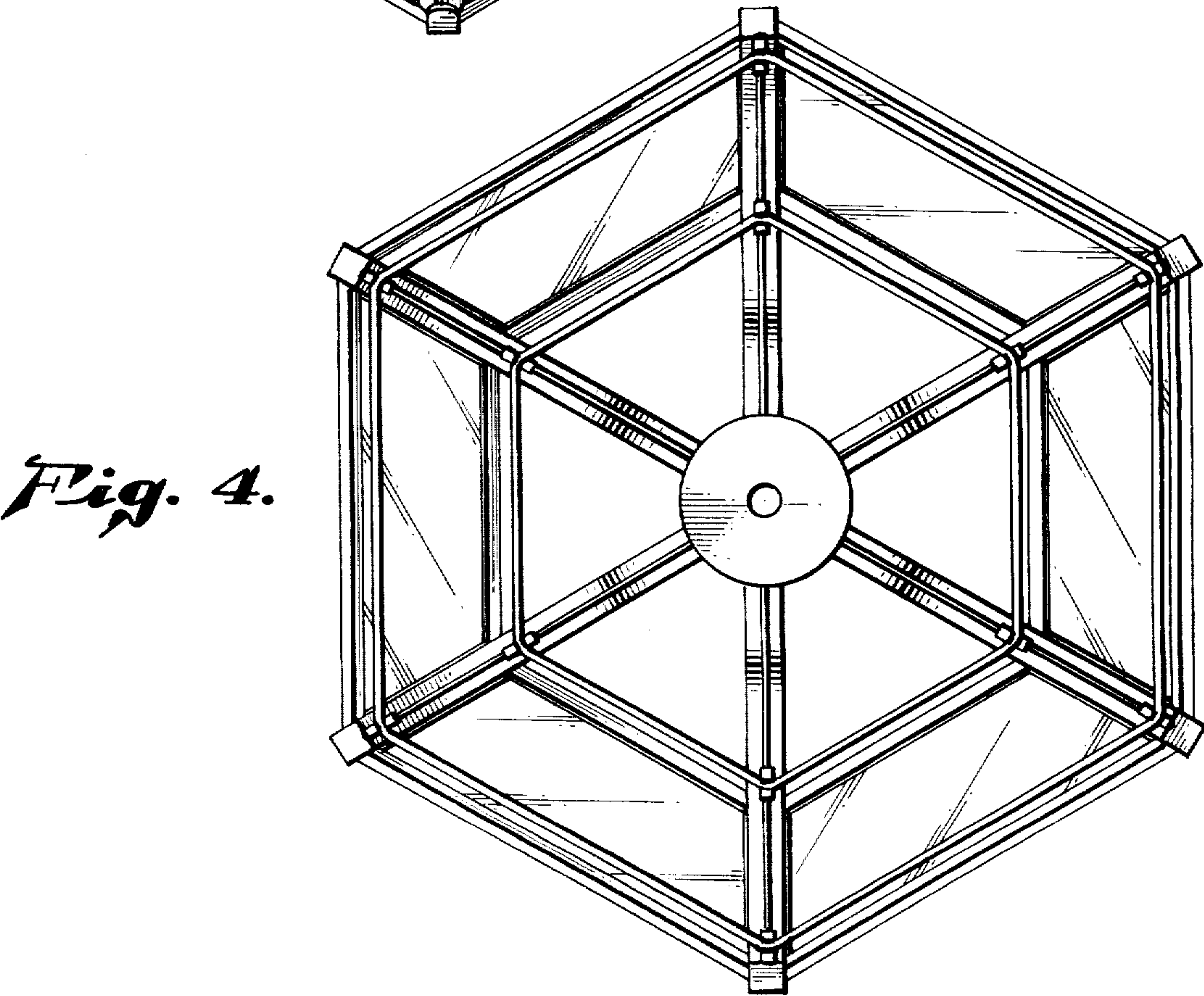
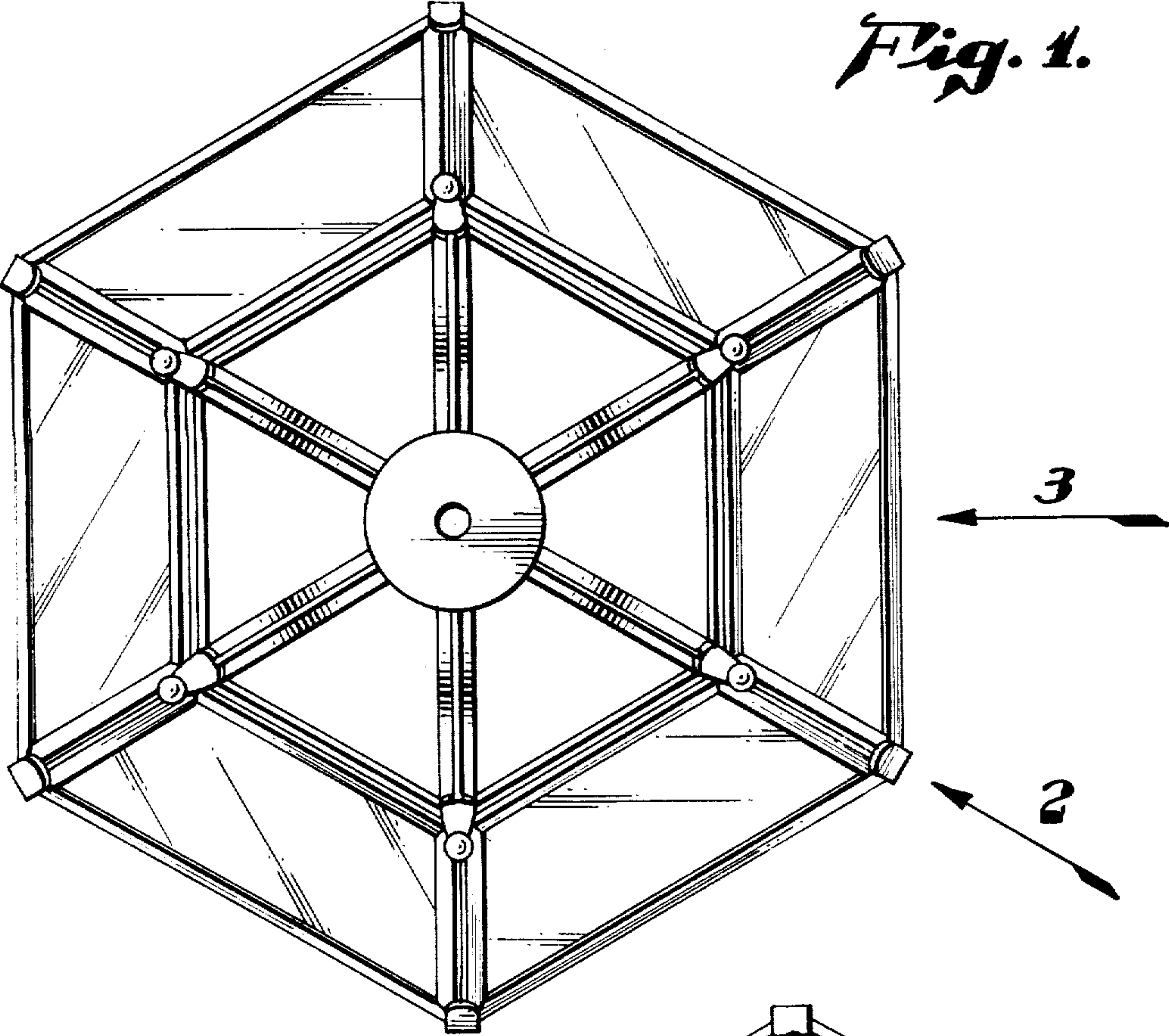

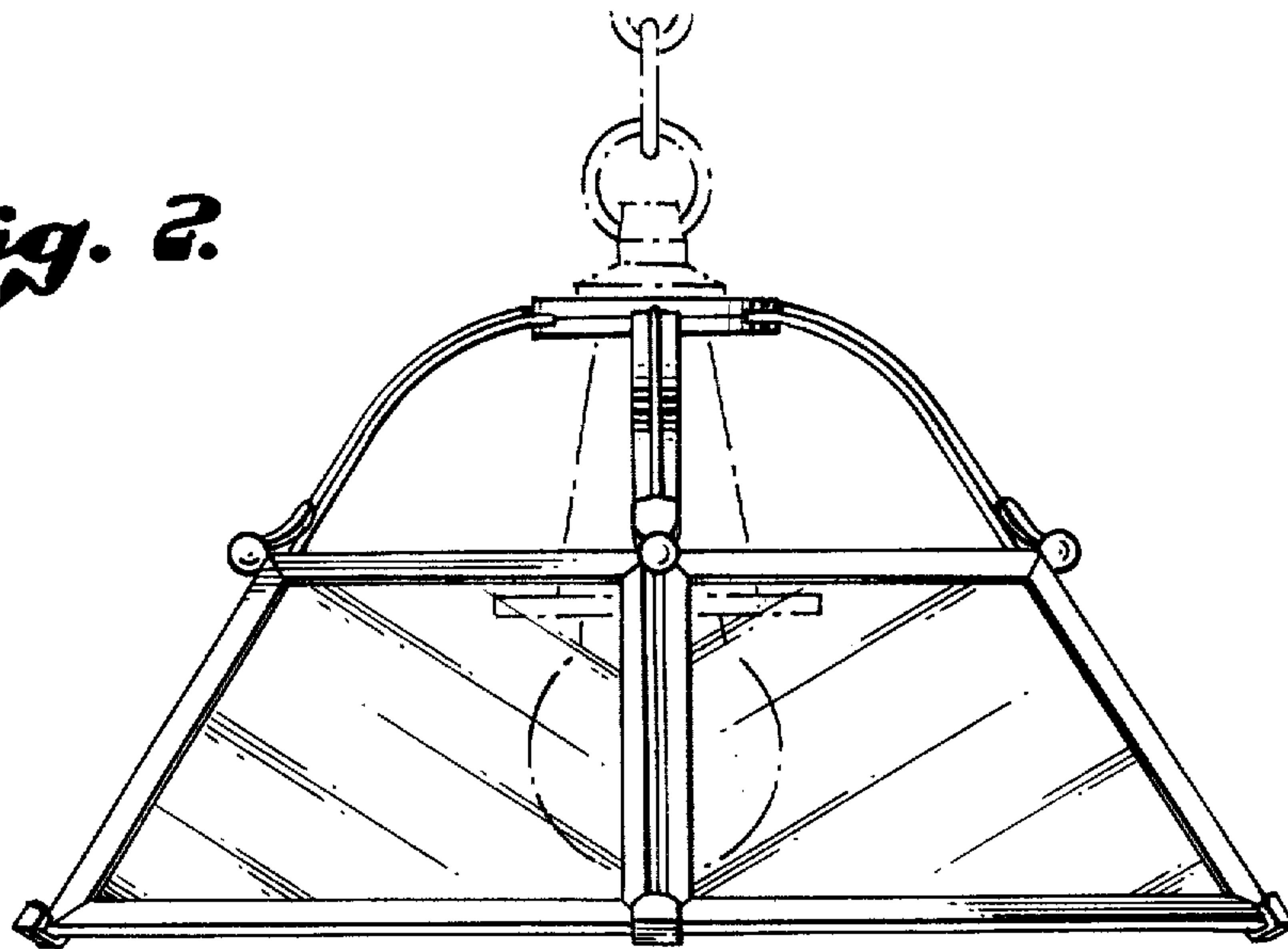

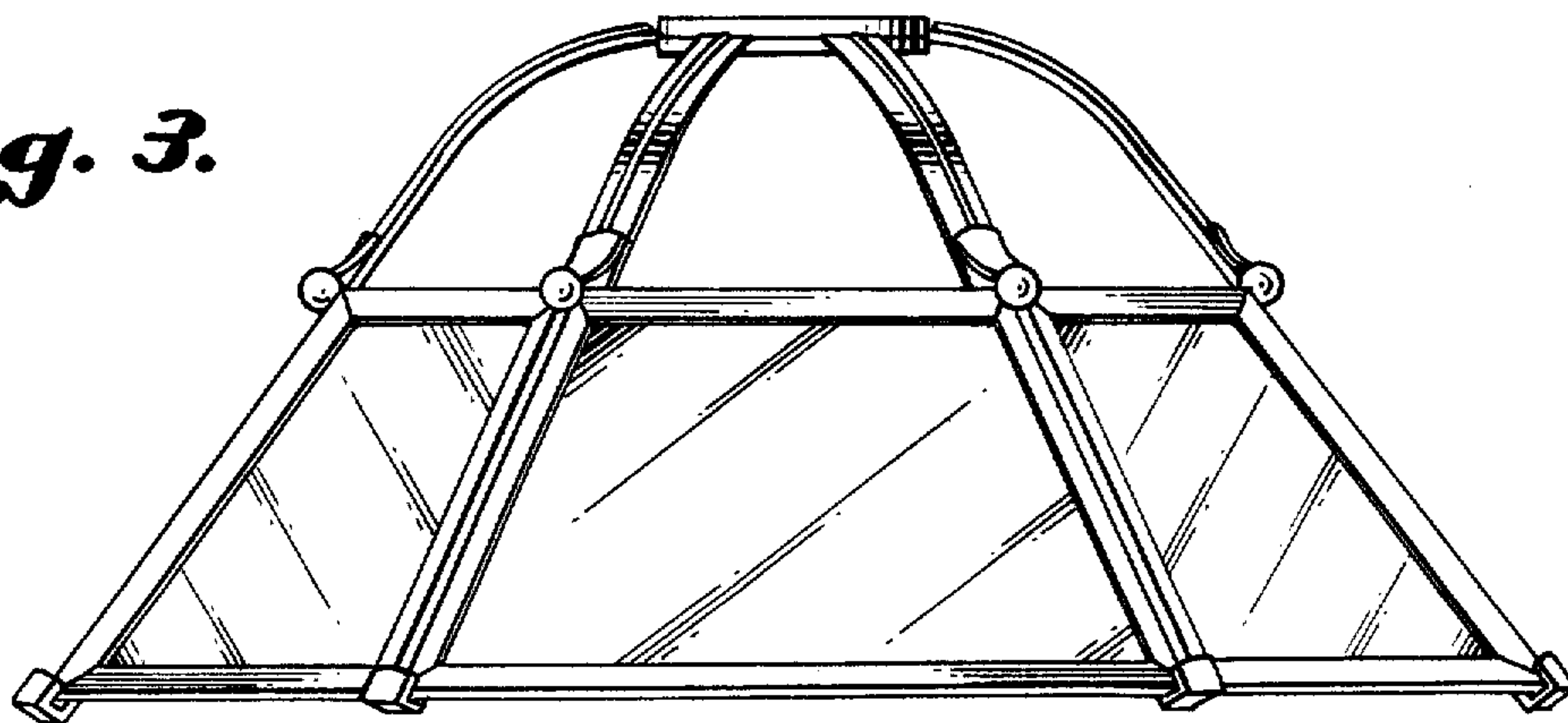

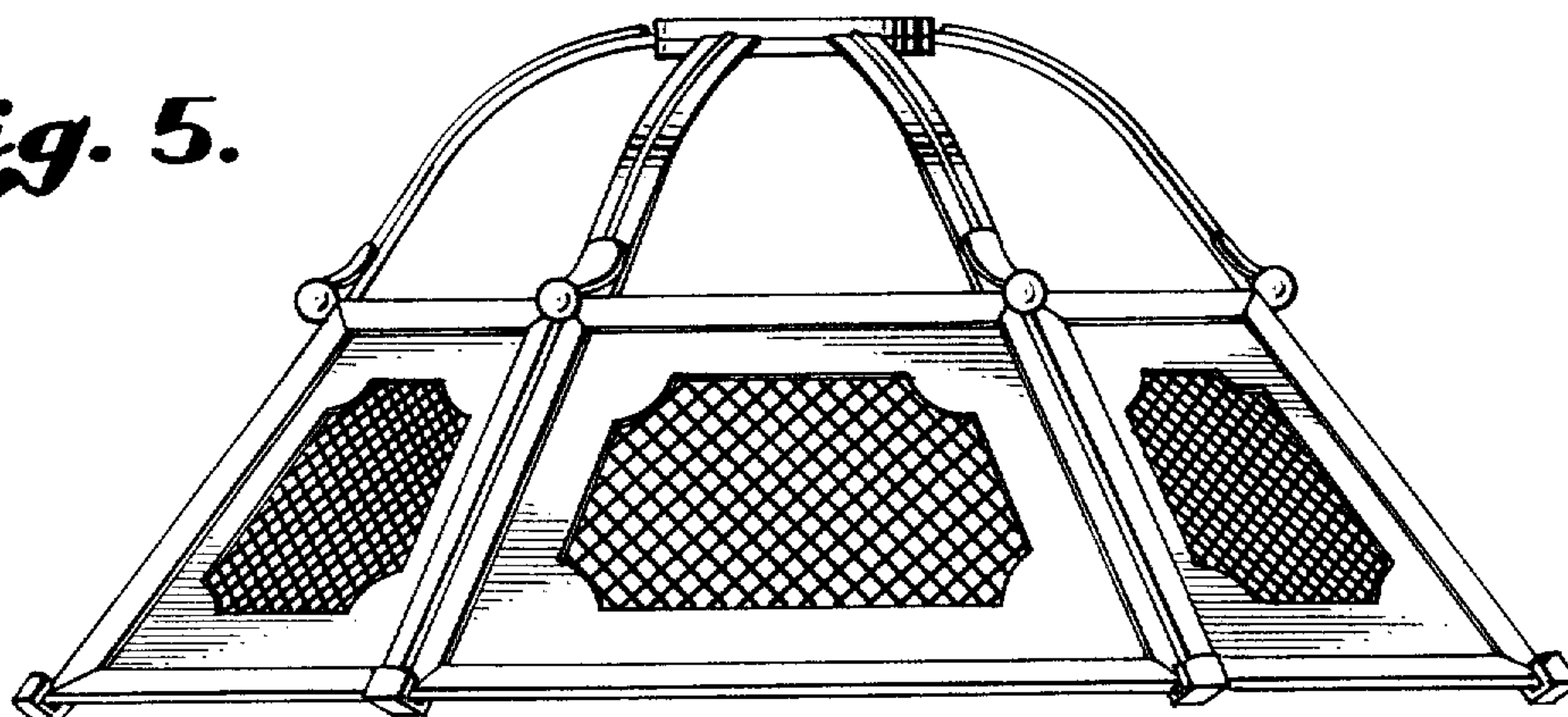

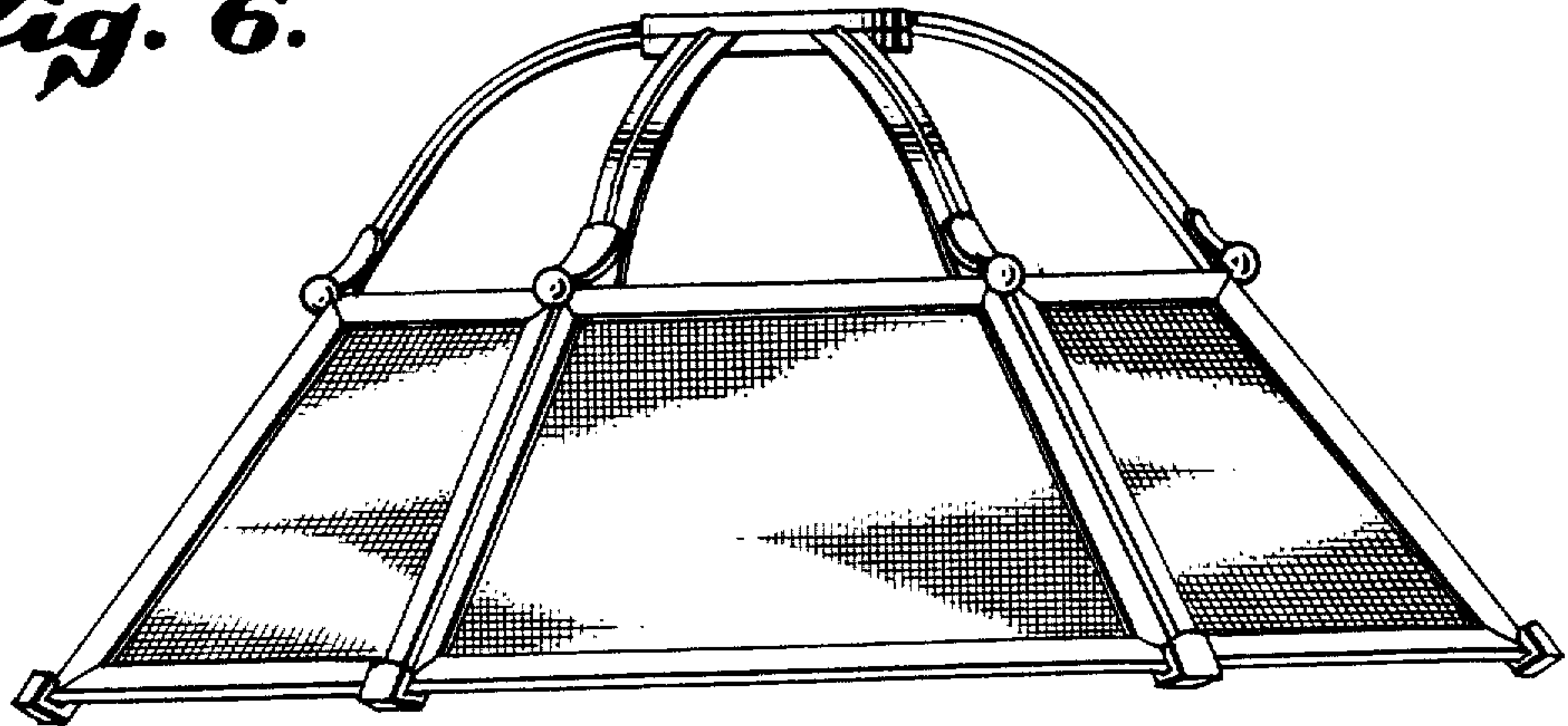

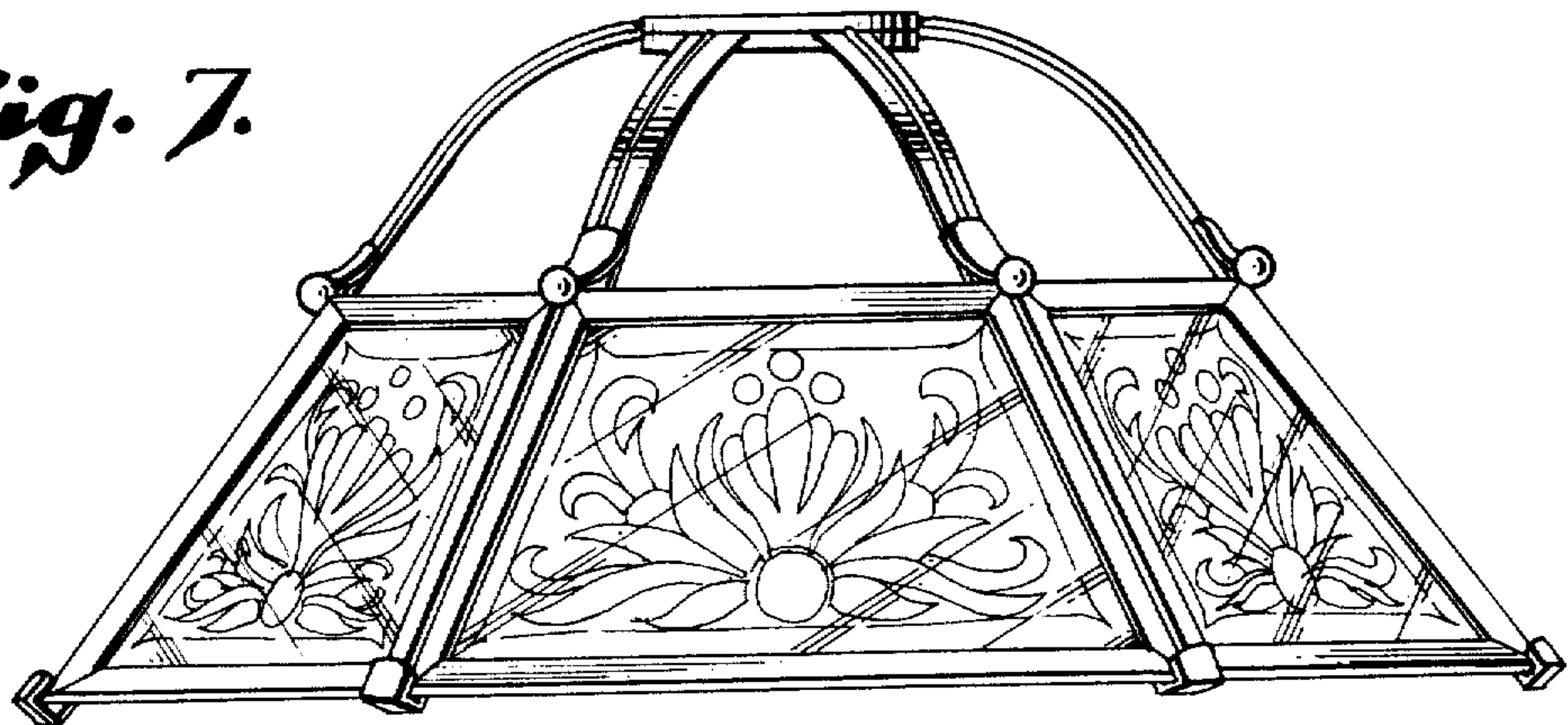
