[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a grill cleaner device, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a top plan view of a grill cleaner device, showing my new design, the opposite side being a mirror image thereof;

FIG. 2 is a developmental view taken substantially in the plane of line 2-2 in FIG. 1;

FIG. 3 is a developmental view taken substantially in the plane of line 3-3 in FIG. 1;

FIG. 4 is a developmental view taken substantially in the plane of line 4-4 in FIG. 1;

FIG. 5 is a developmental view taken substantially in the plane of line 5-5 in FIG. 1; and

FIG. 6 is a developmental view taken substantially in the plane of line 6-6 in FIG. 1.

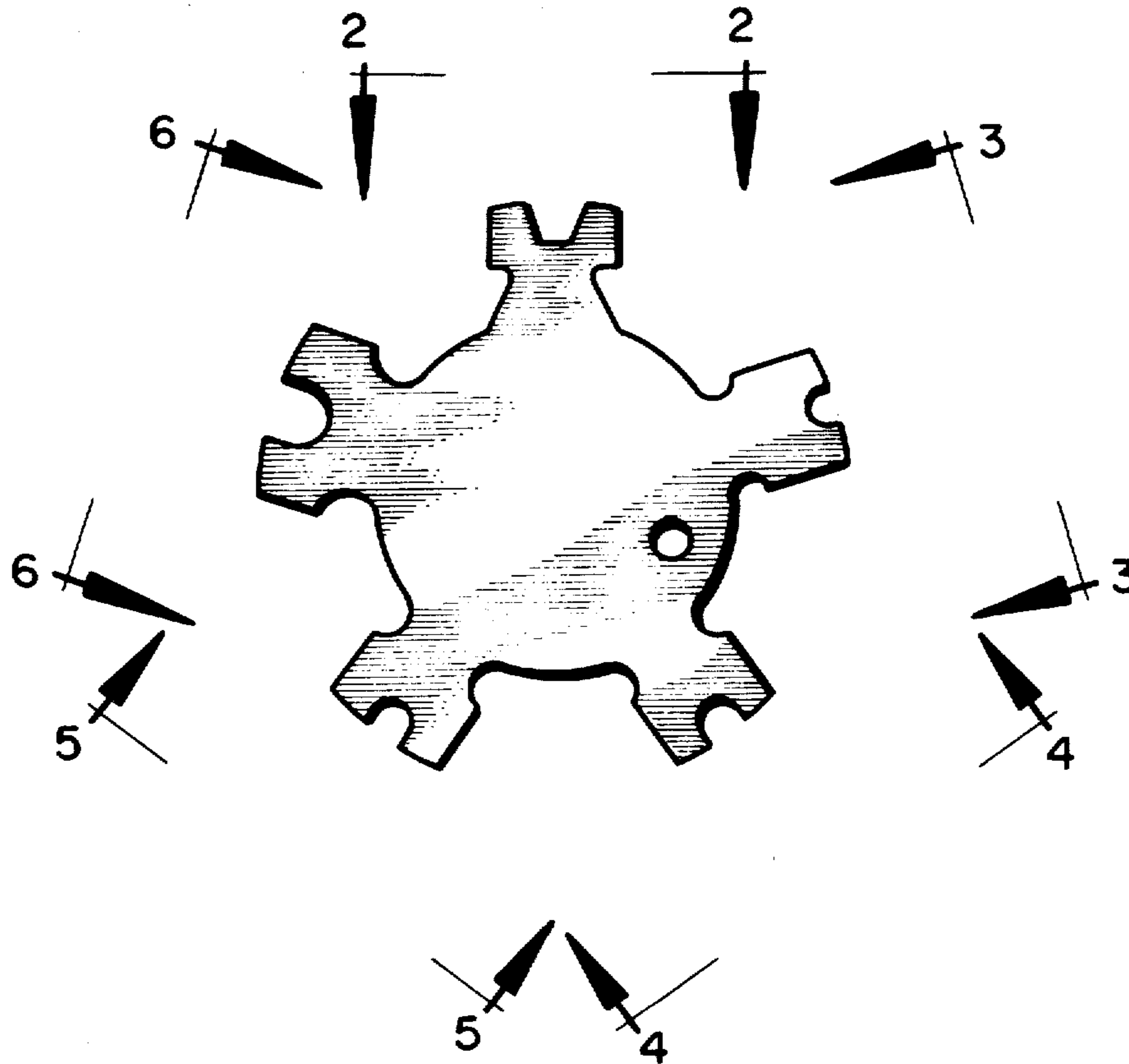

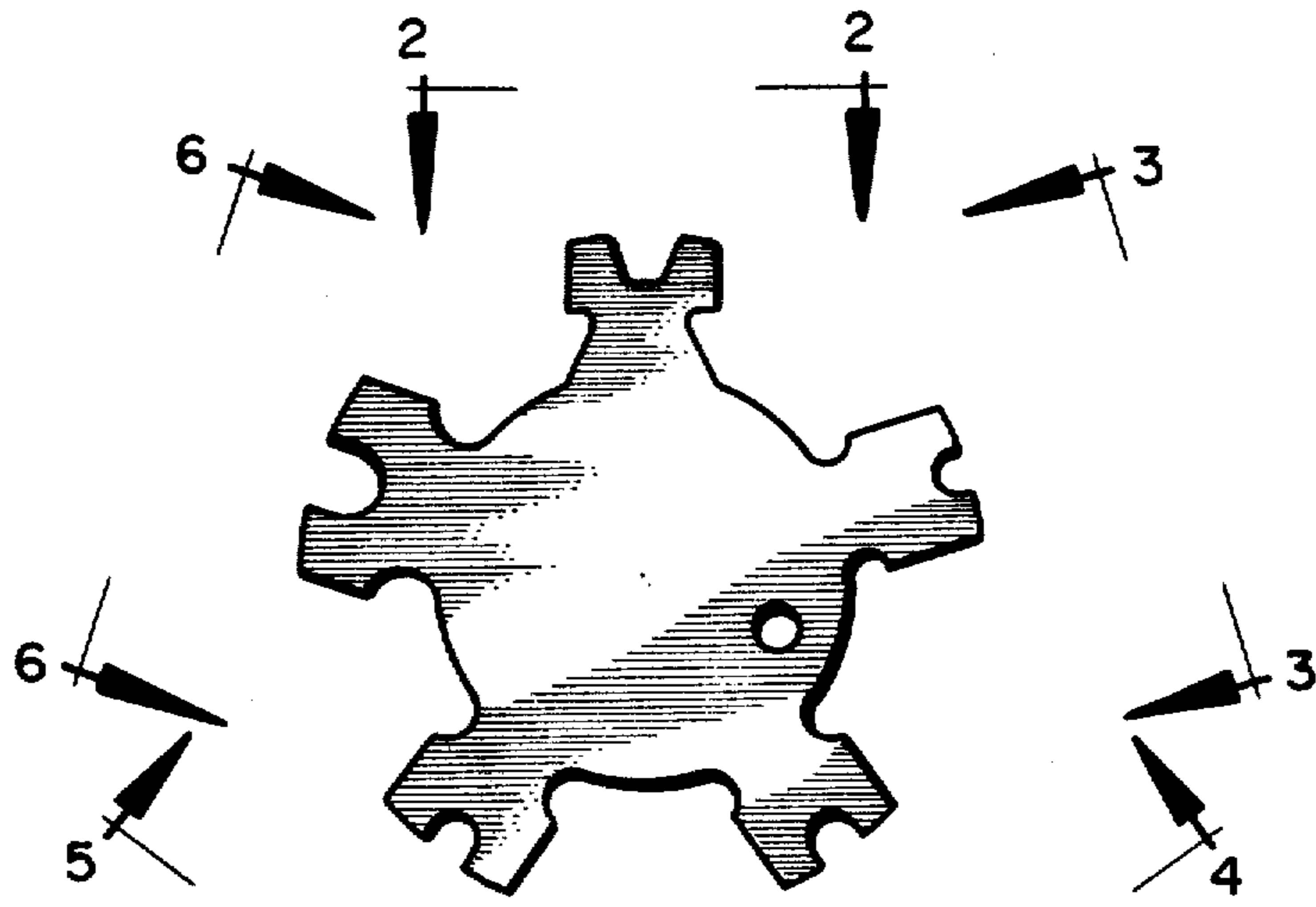
