[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a pastry shell, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of the pastry shell showing our new design;  
FIG. 2 is a perspective view of one side of the pastry shell;  
FIG. 3 is a cross-sectional view of the pastry shell along line 3—3 of FIG. 1;  
FIG. 4 is an elevational view of the top of the pastry shell;  
FIG. 5 is an elevational view of one end of the pastry shell.

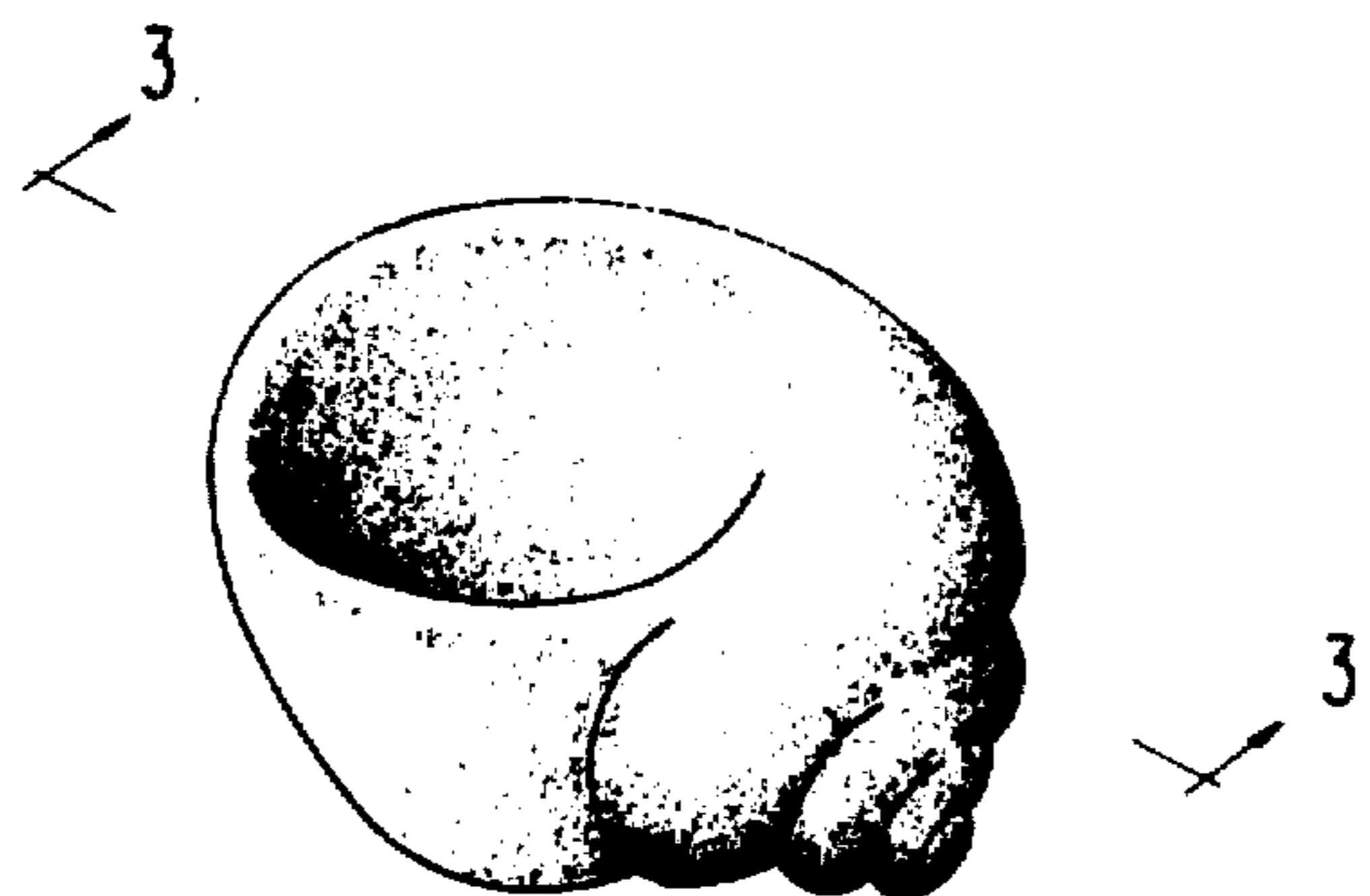

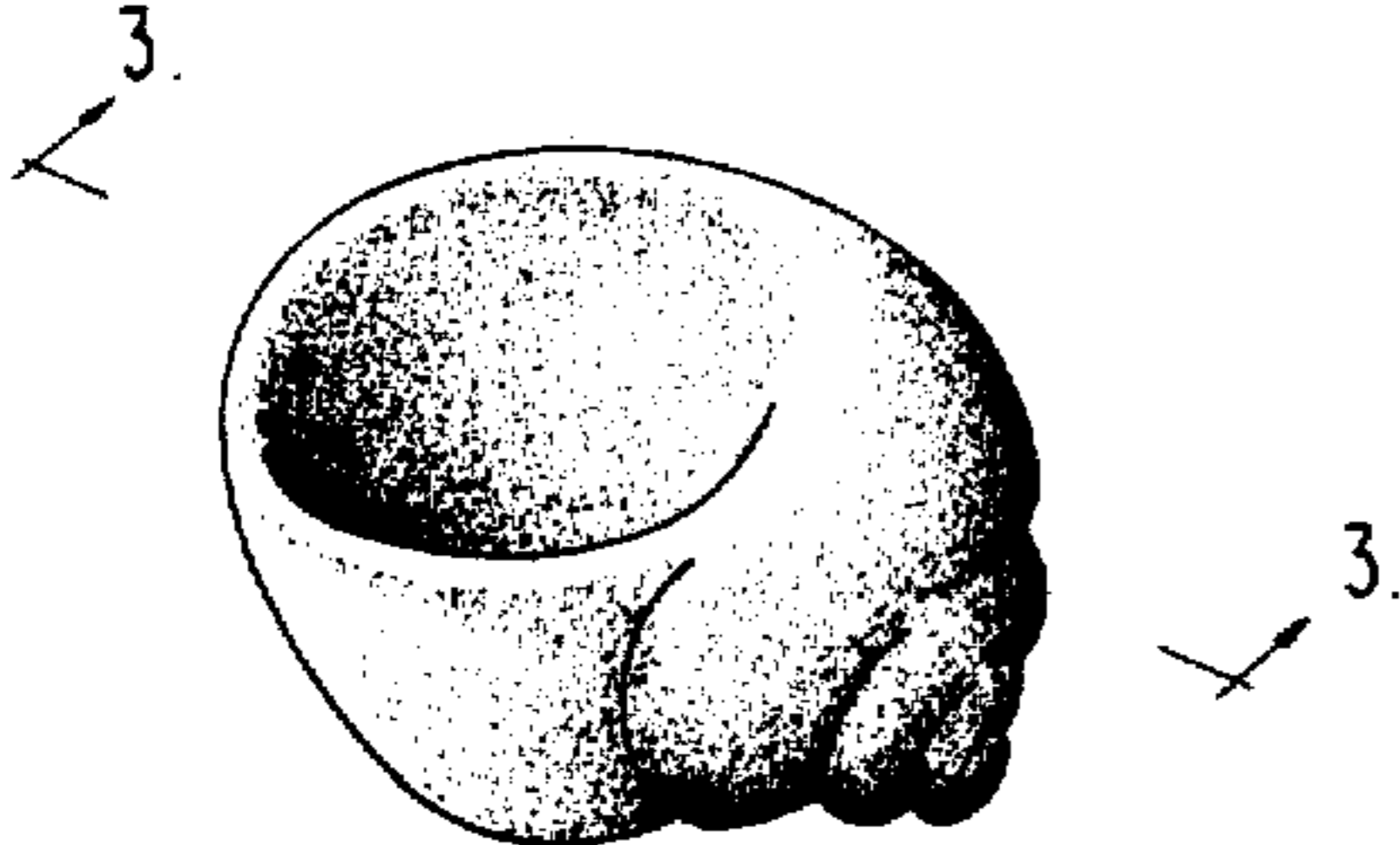

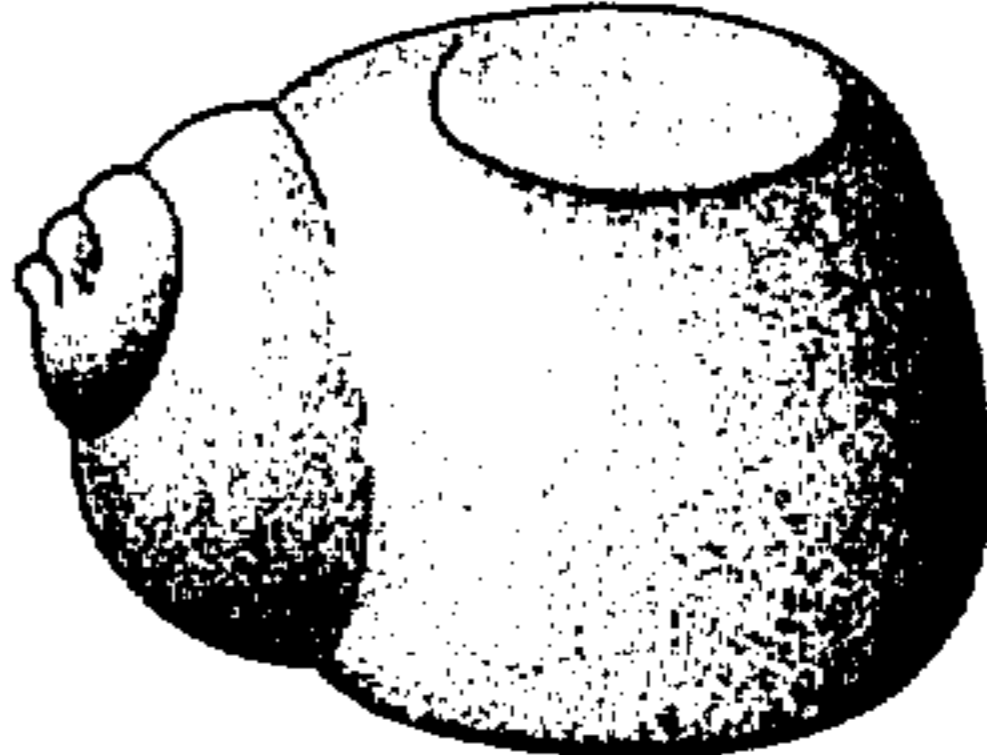

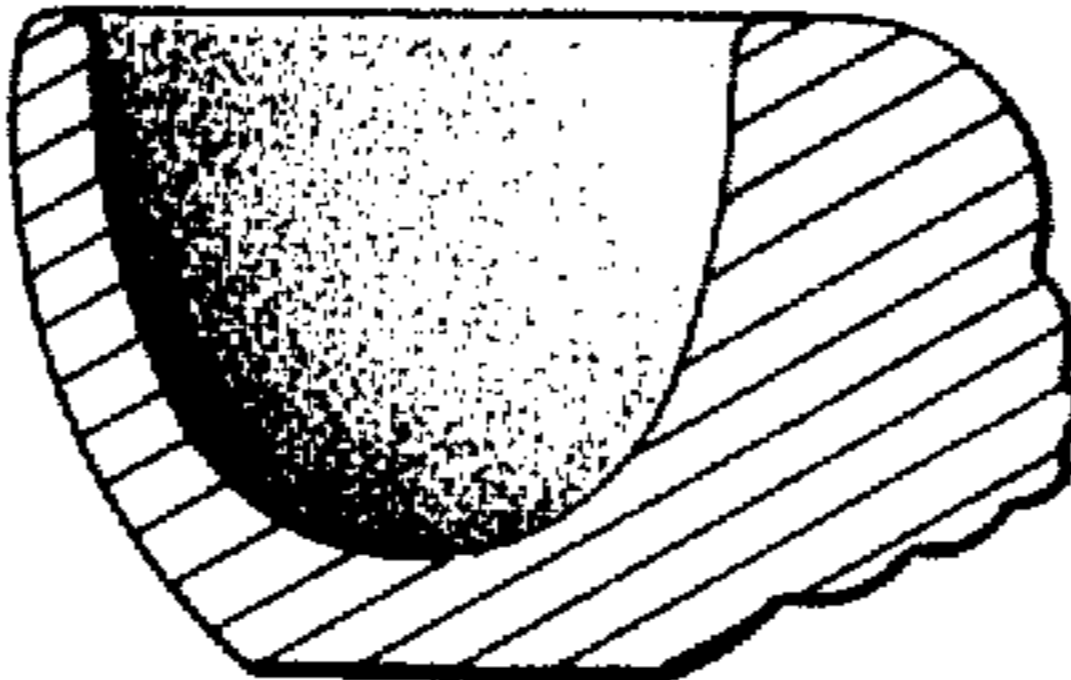

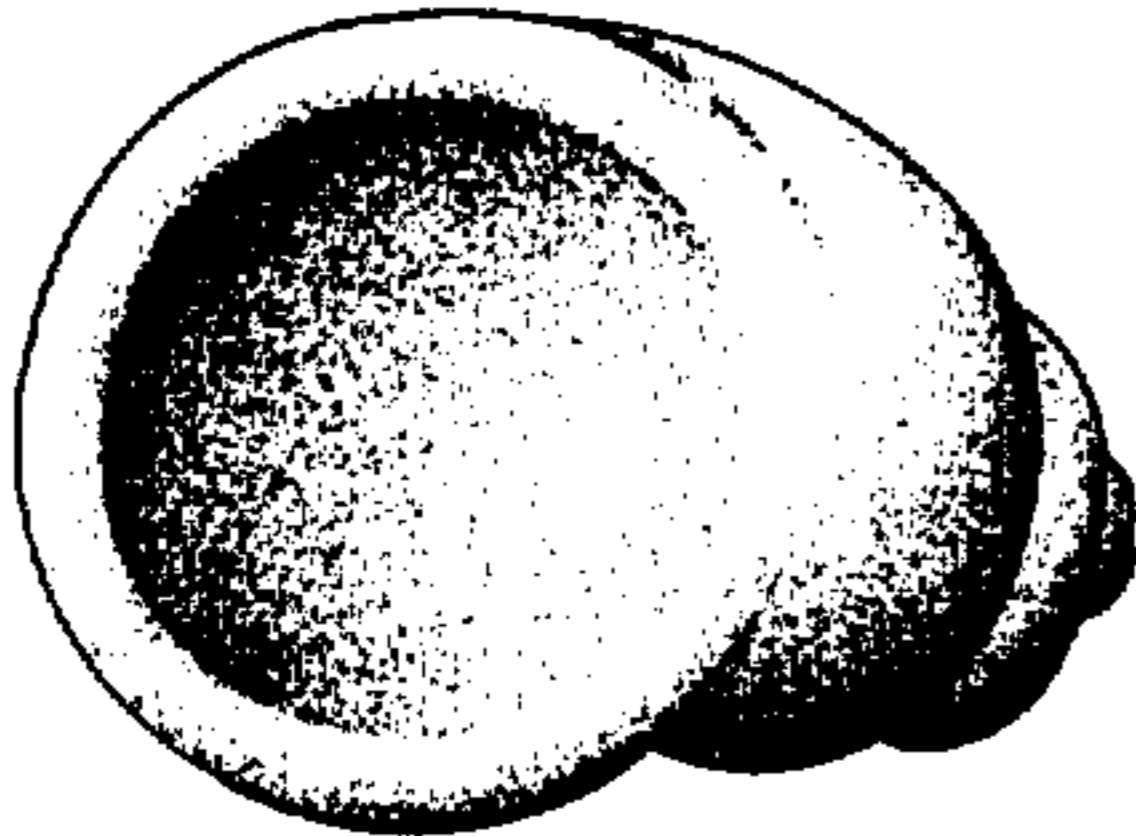
