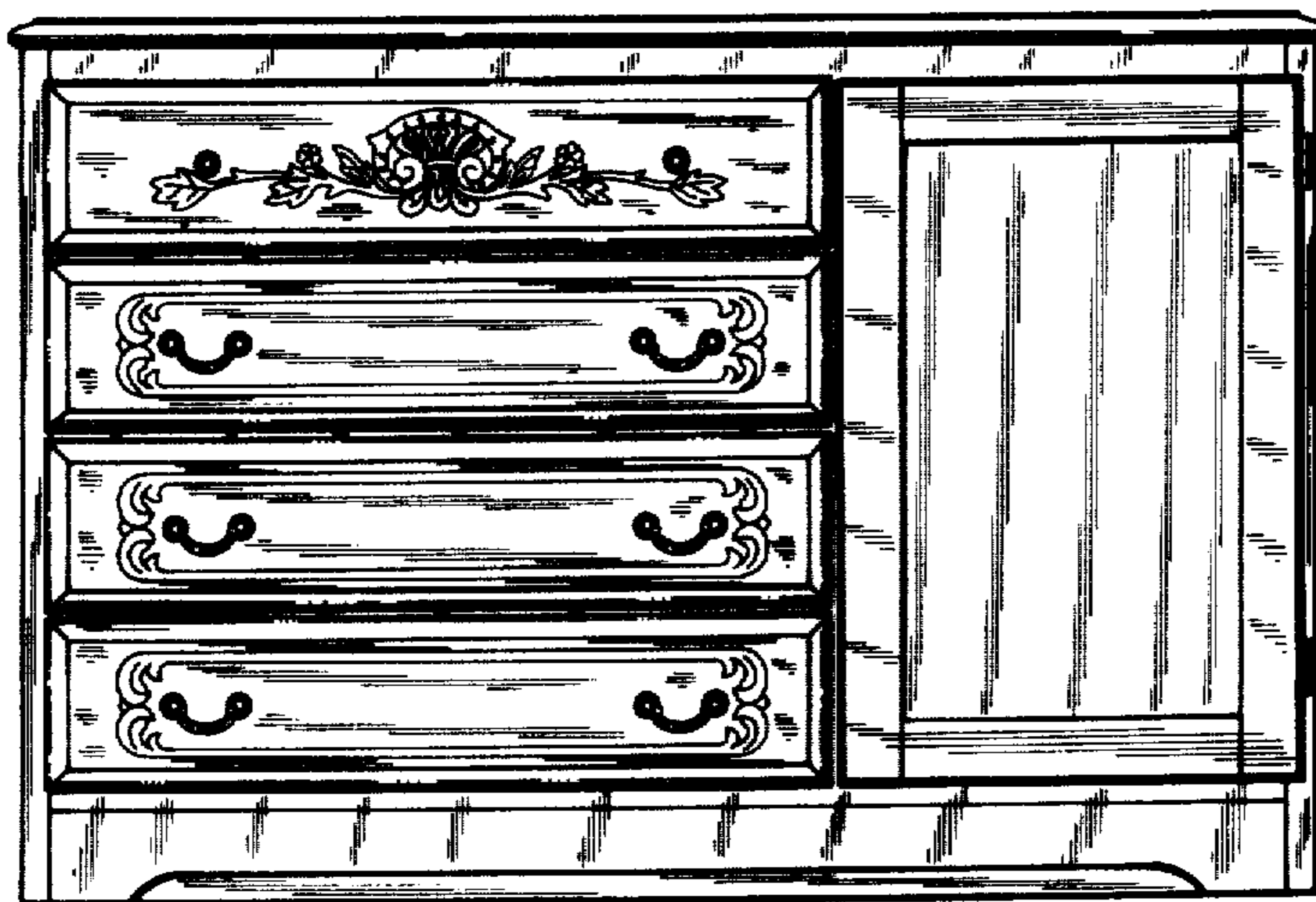
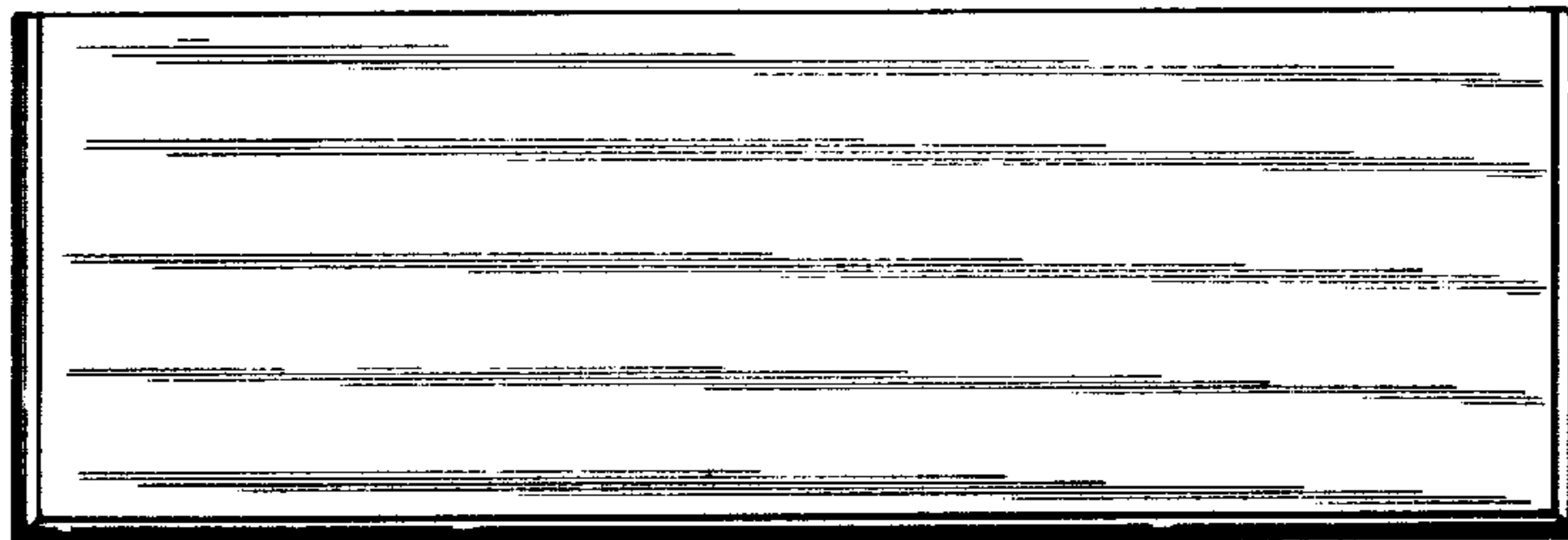

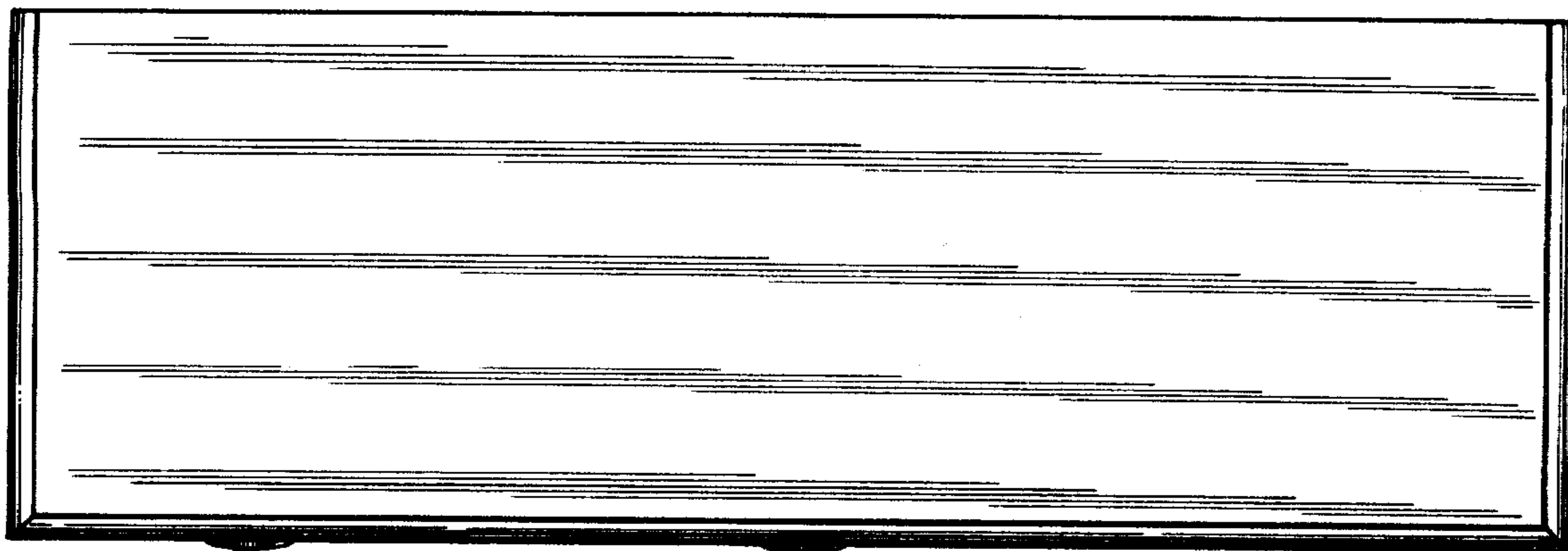
[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a chest or similar article, as shown and described.

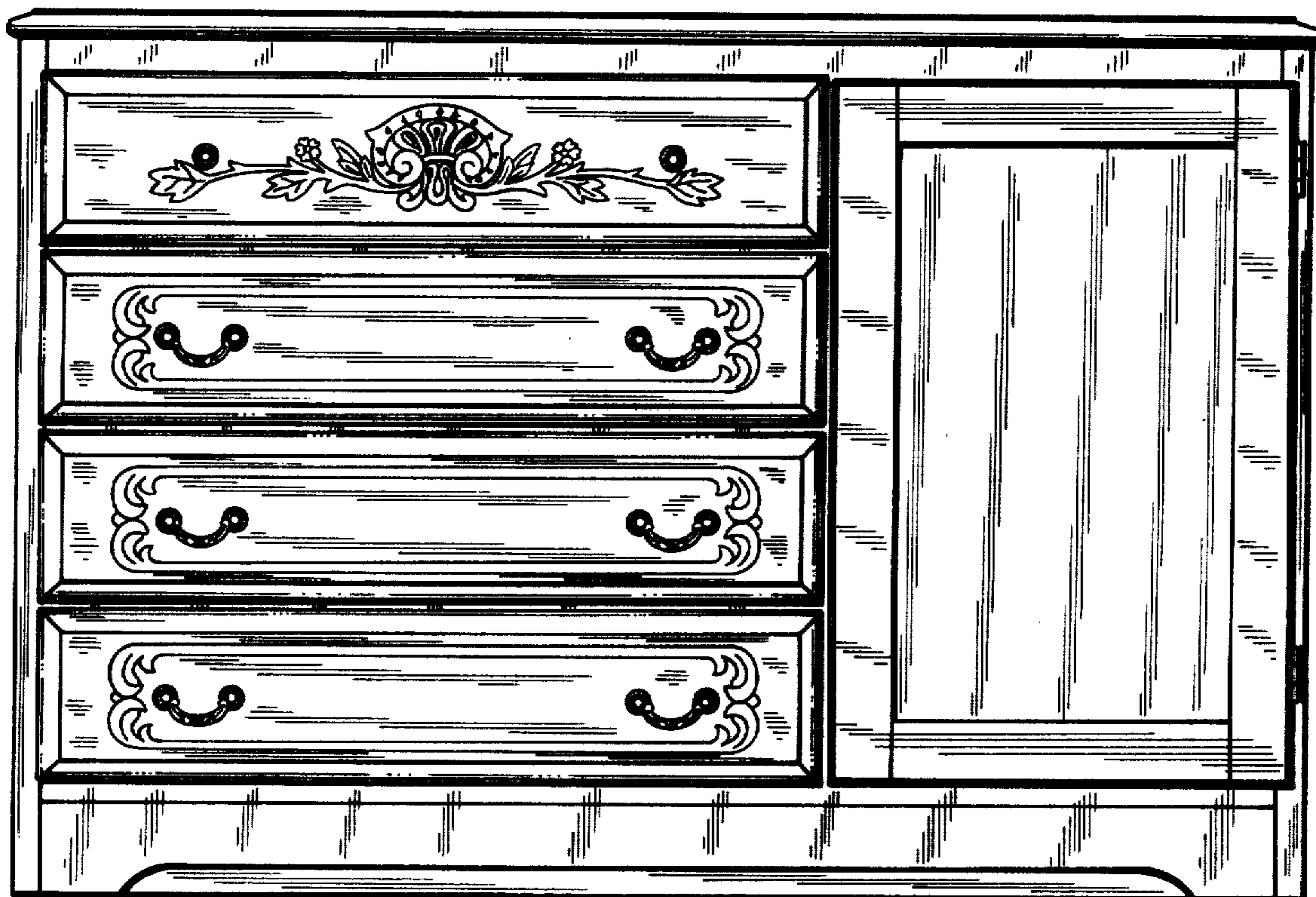
DESCRIPTION

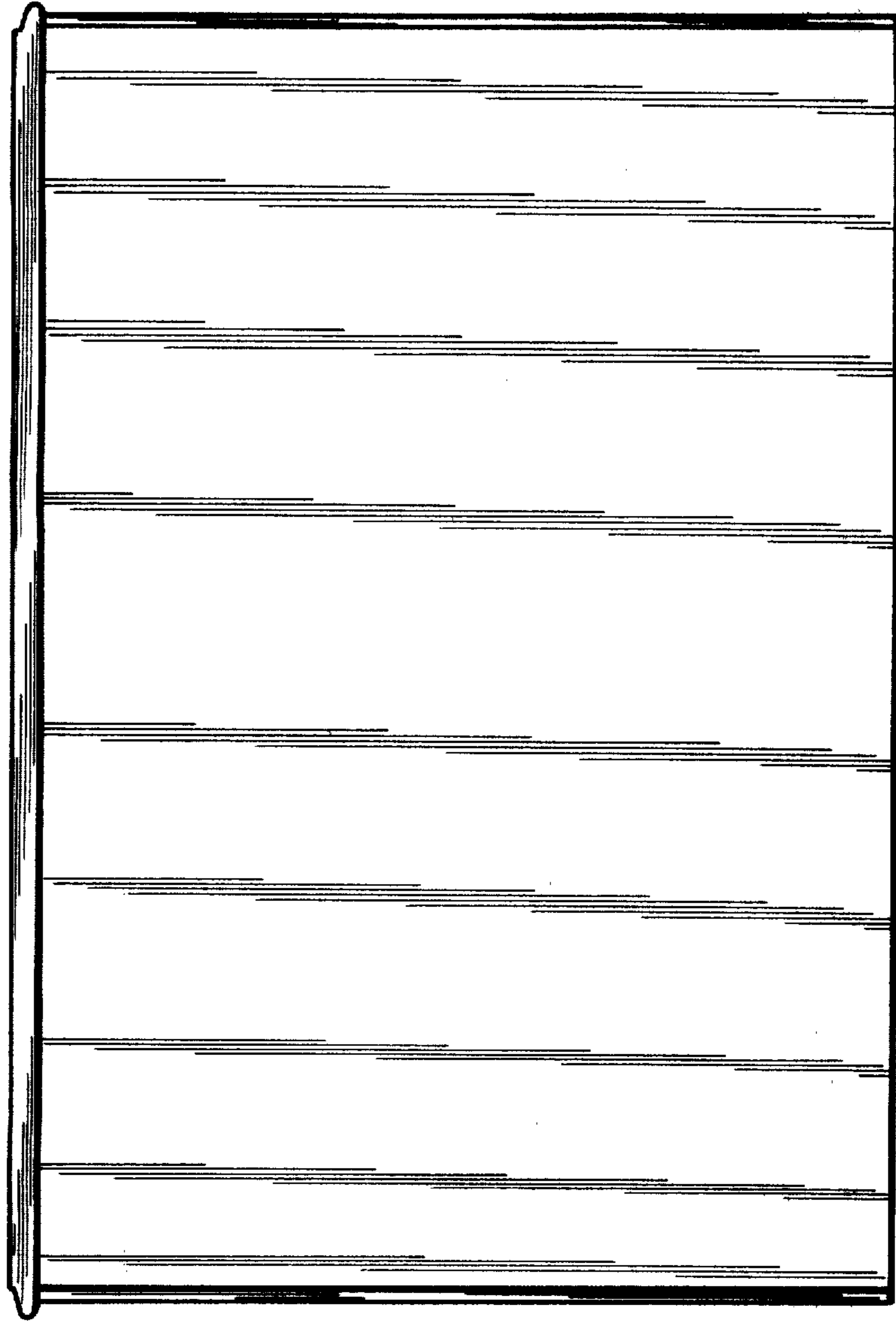




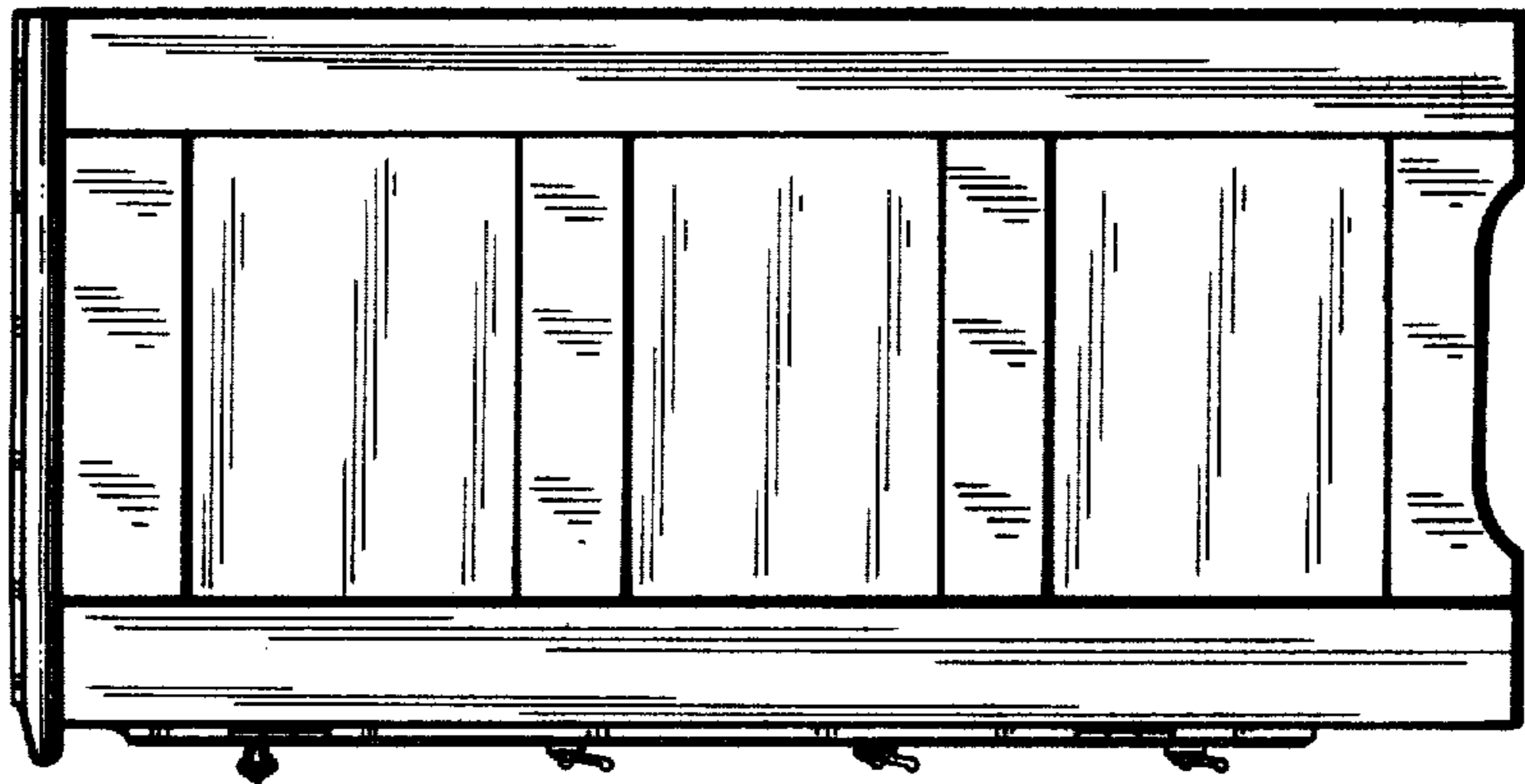
