FIG. 2 is a top or bottom plan view thereof.

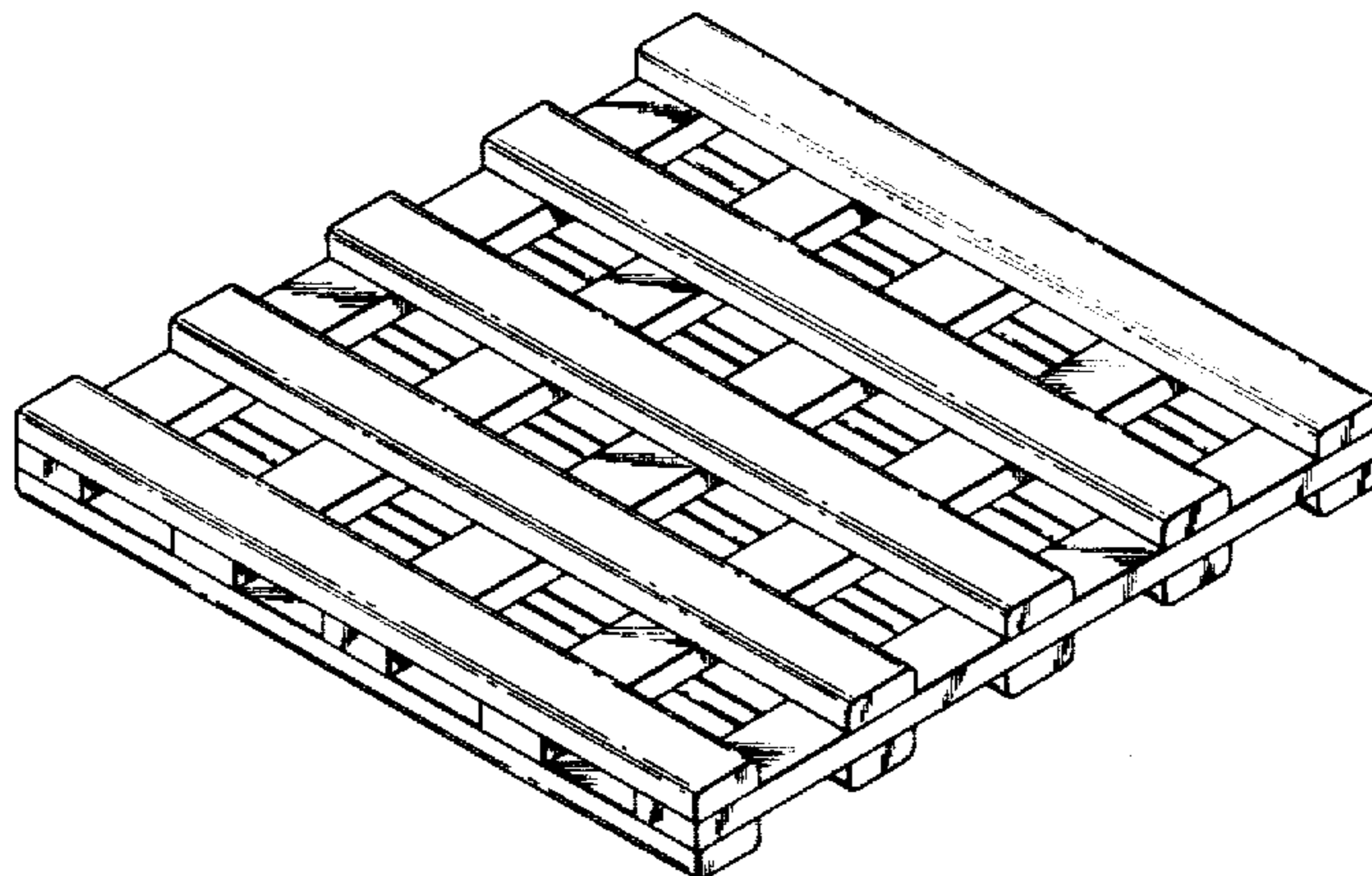
FIG. 3 is an end view thereof.

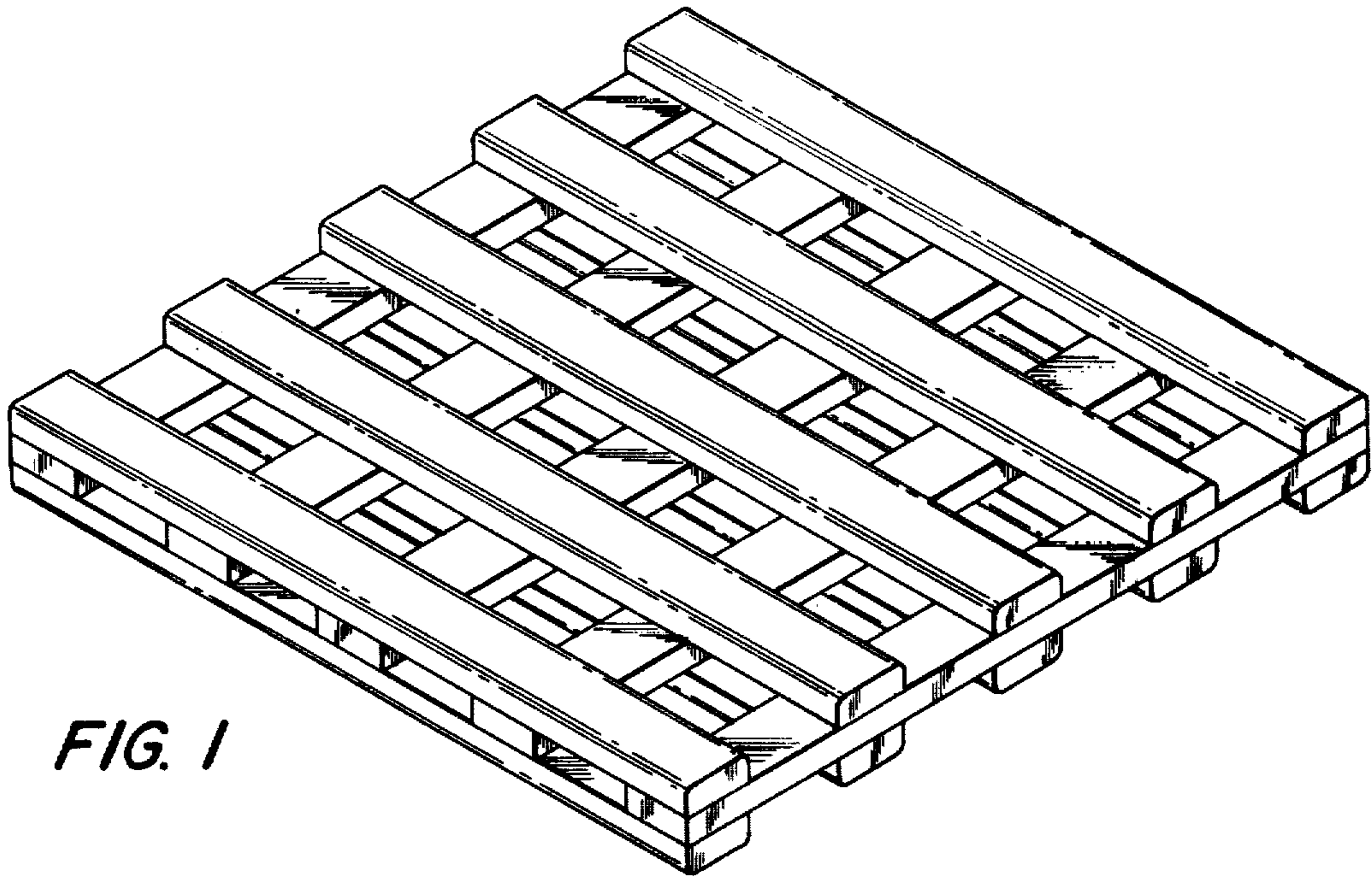

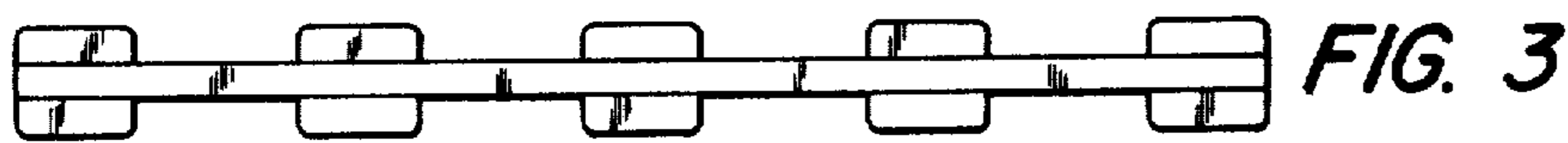
