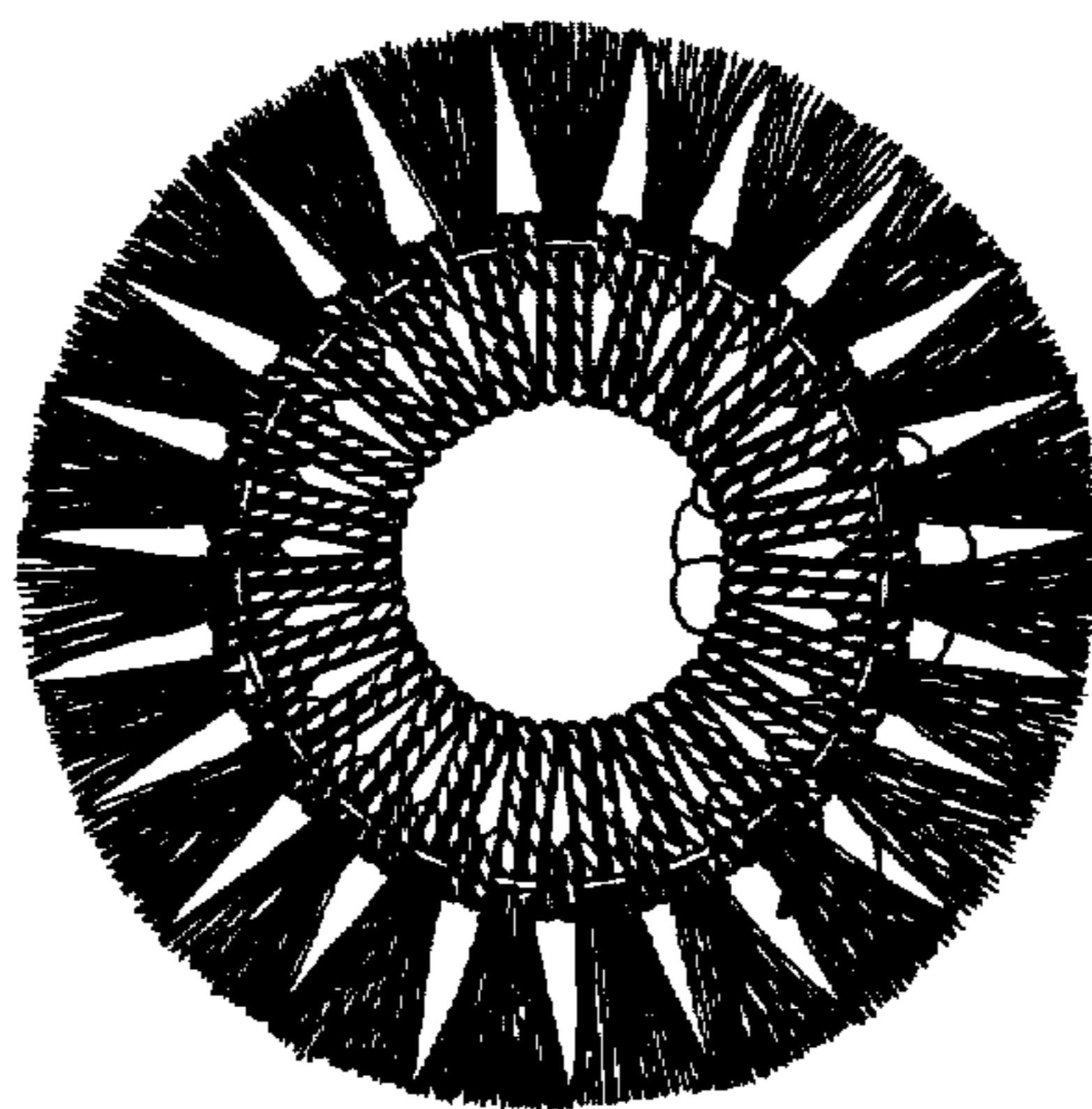
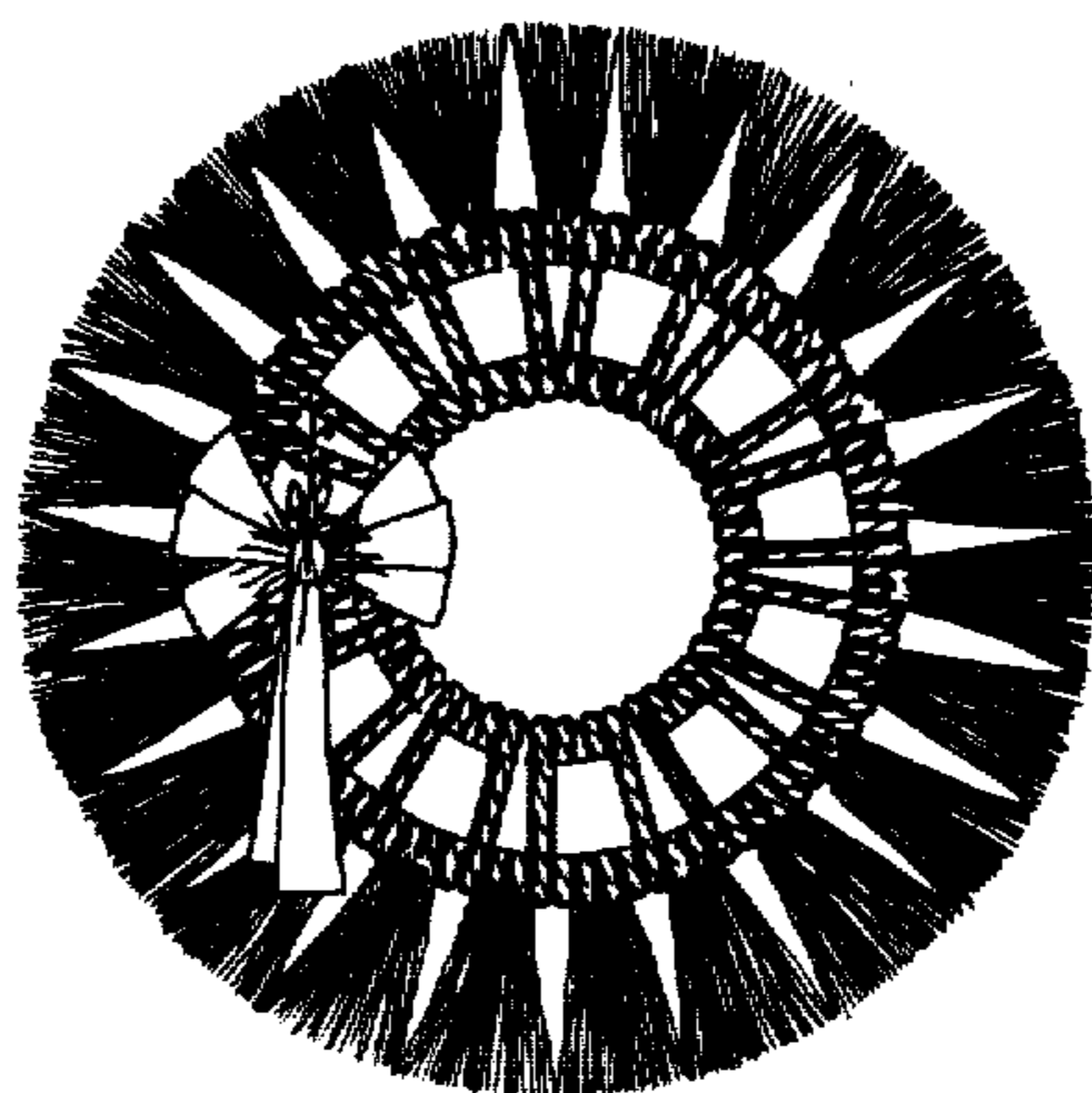

FIG. 3 is a right side elevational view of the wreath.



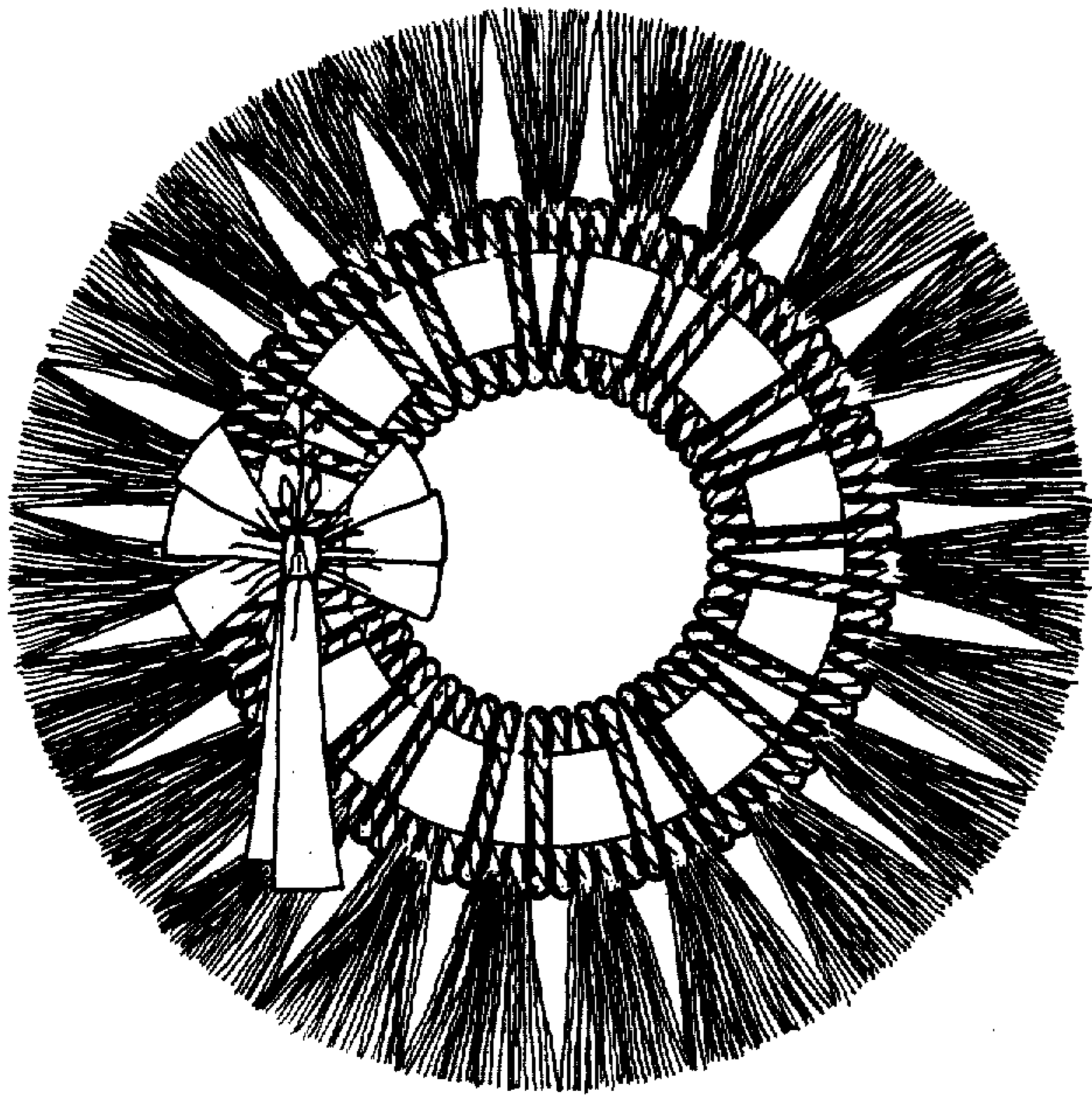

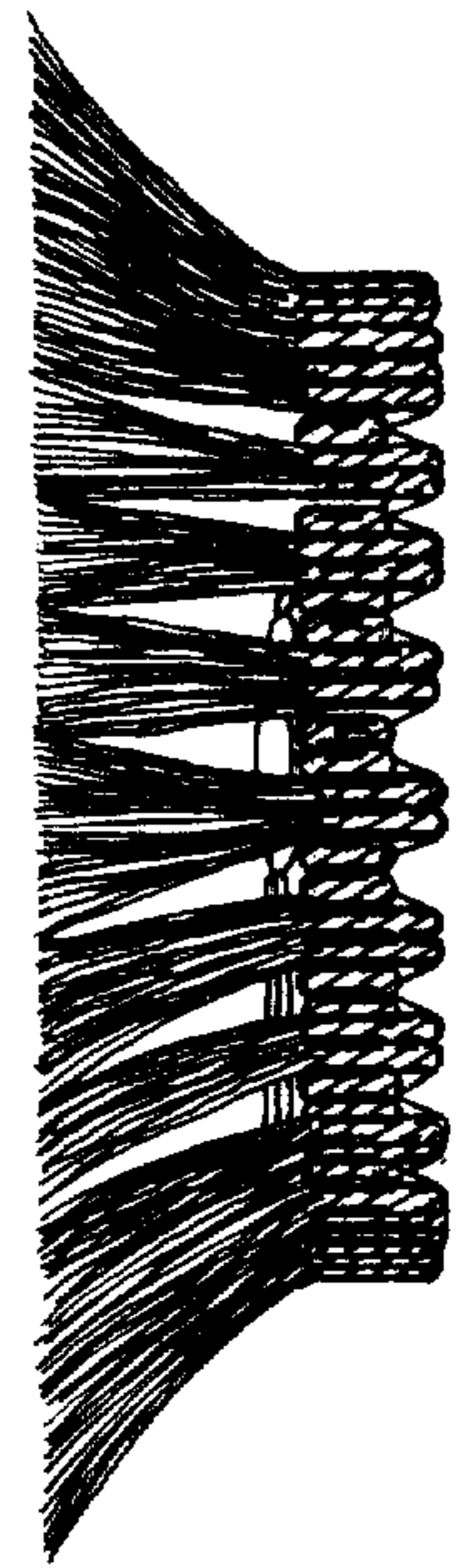

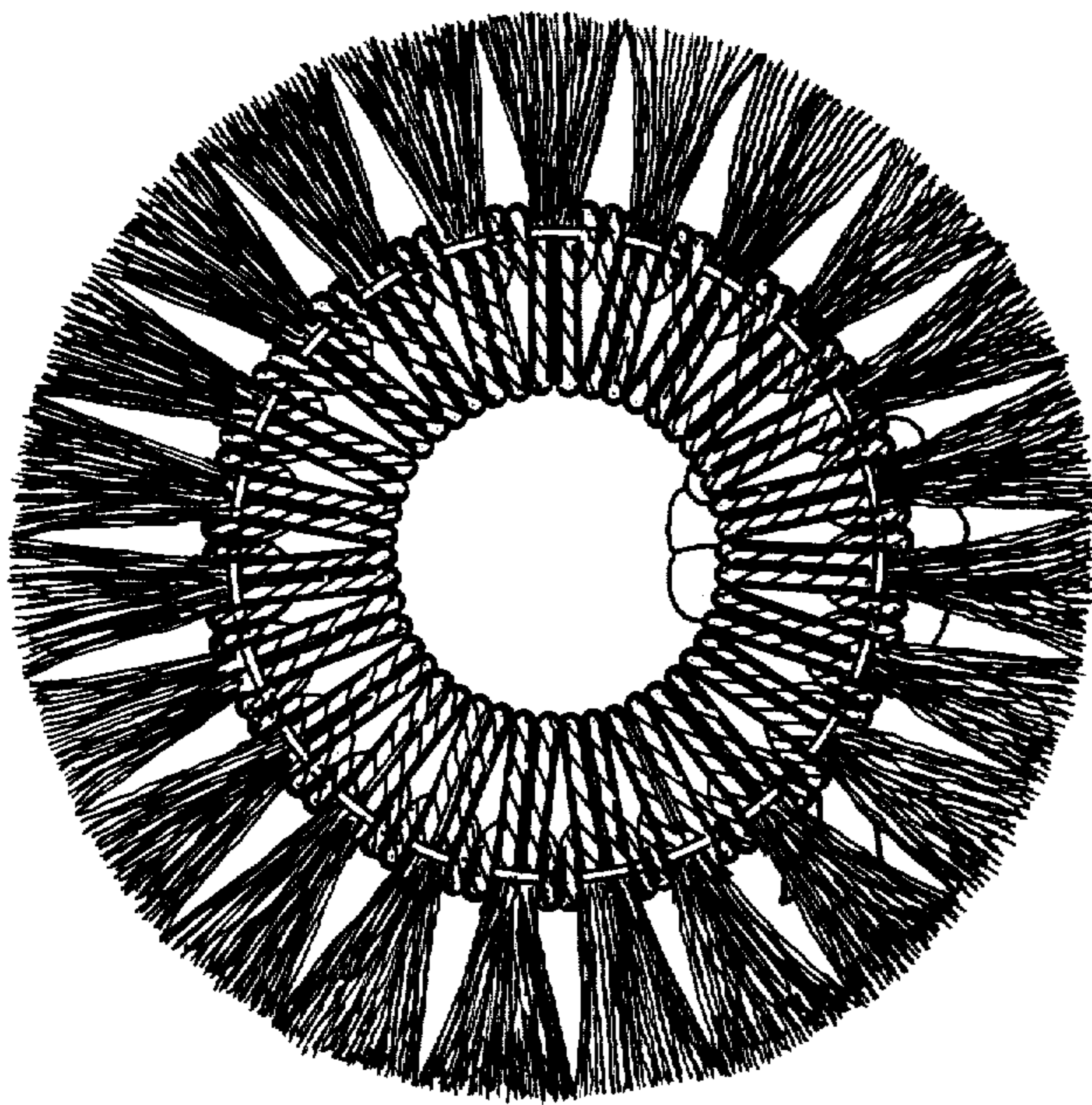
