DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a body thermal bandage embodying our new design; FIG. 2 is a right side view of FIG. 1; FIG. 3 is a right side view of FIG. 2; FIG. 4 is a top view of FIG. 1; and FIG. 5 is a front elevational view of a modified embodiment.

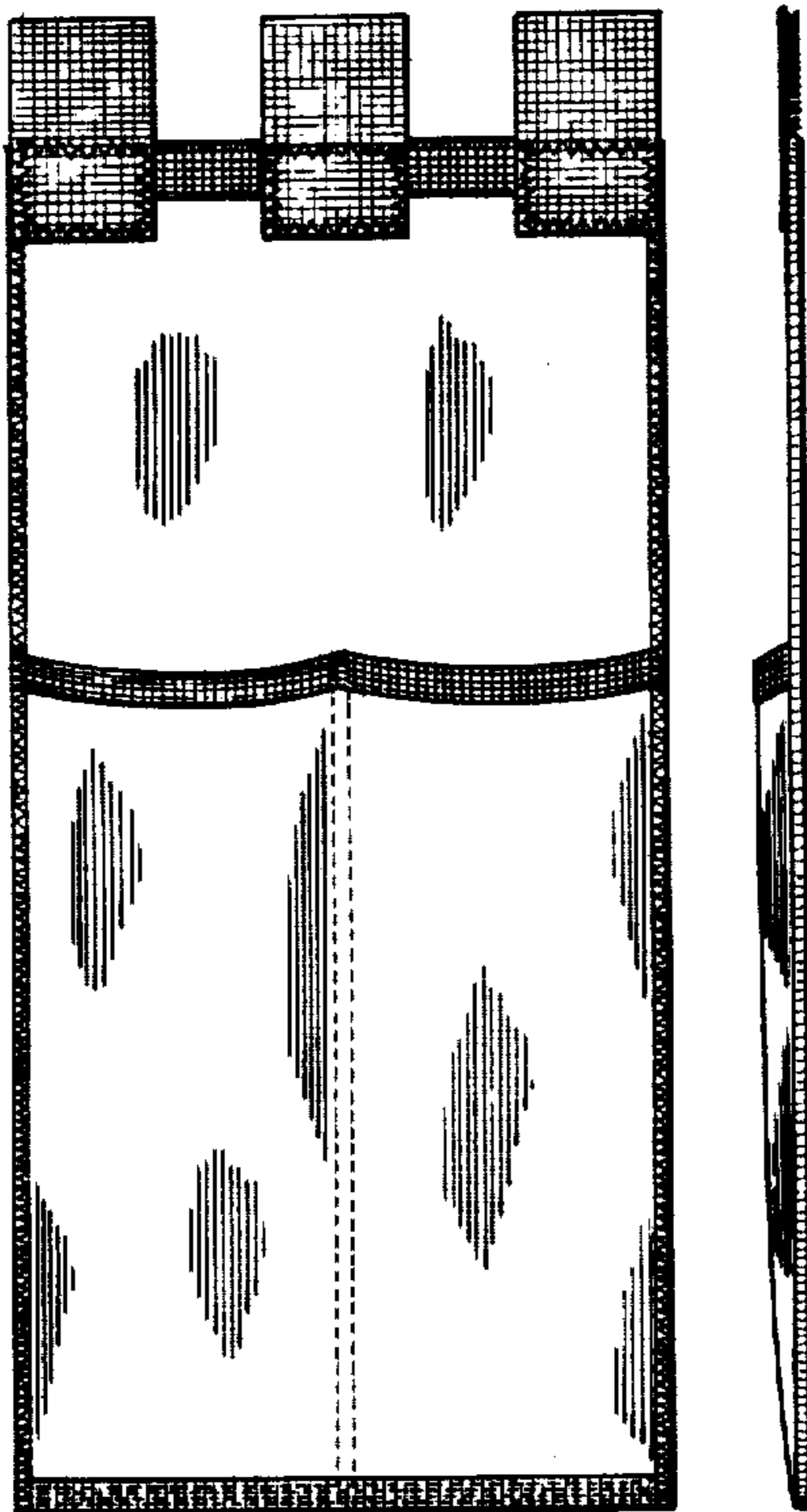

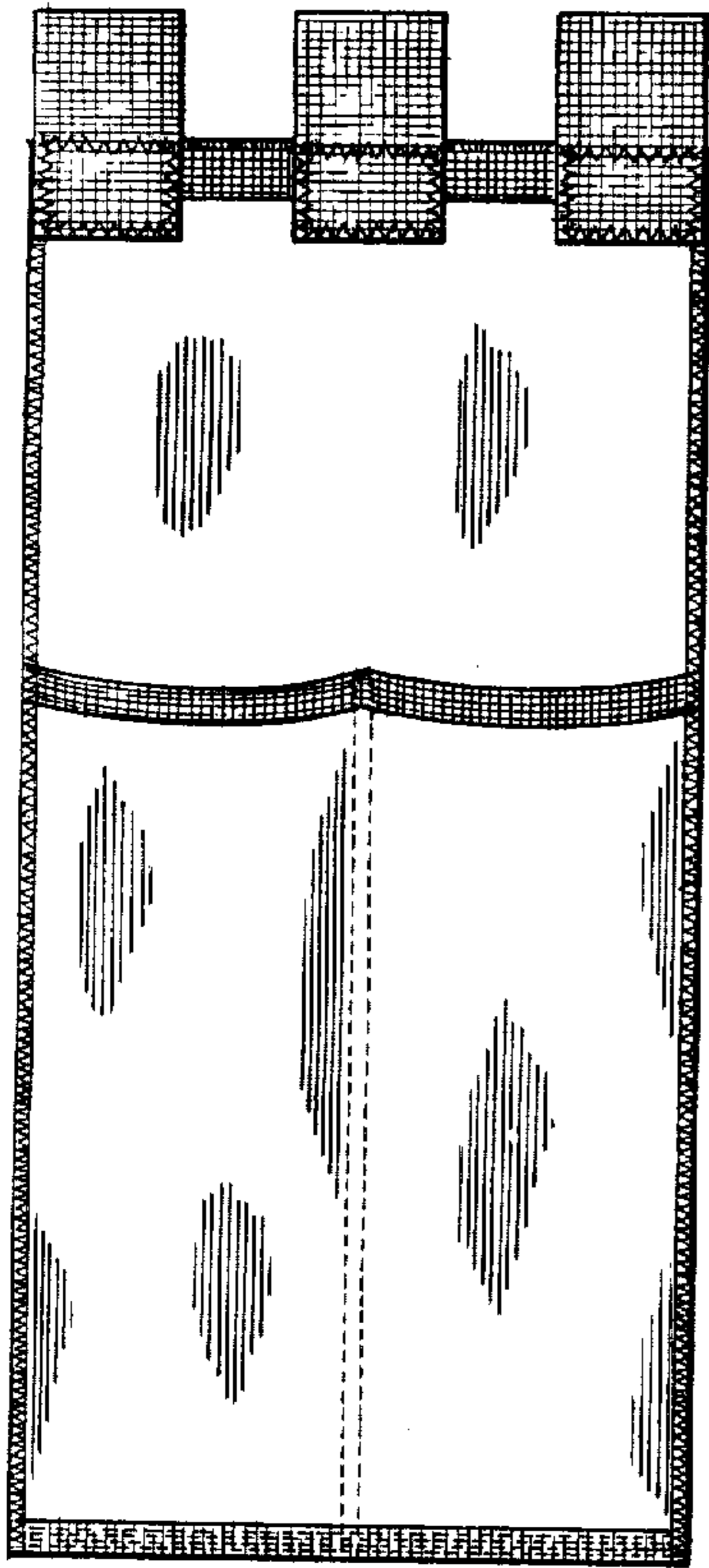

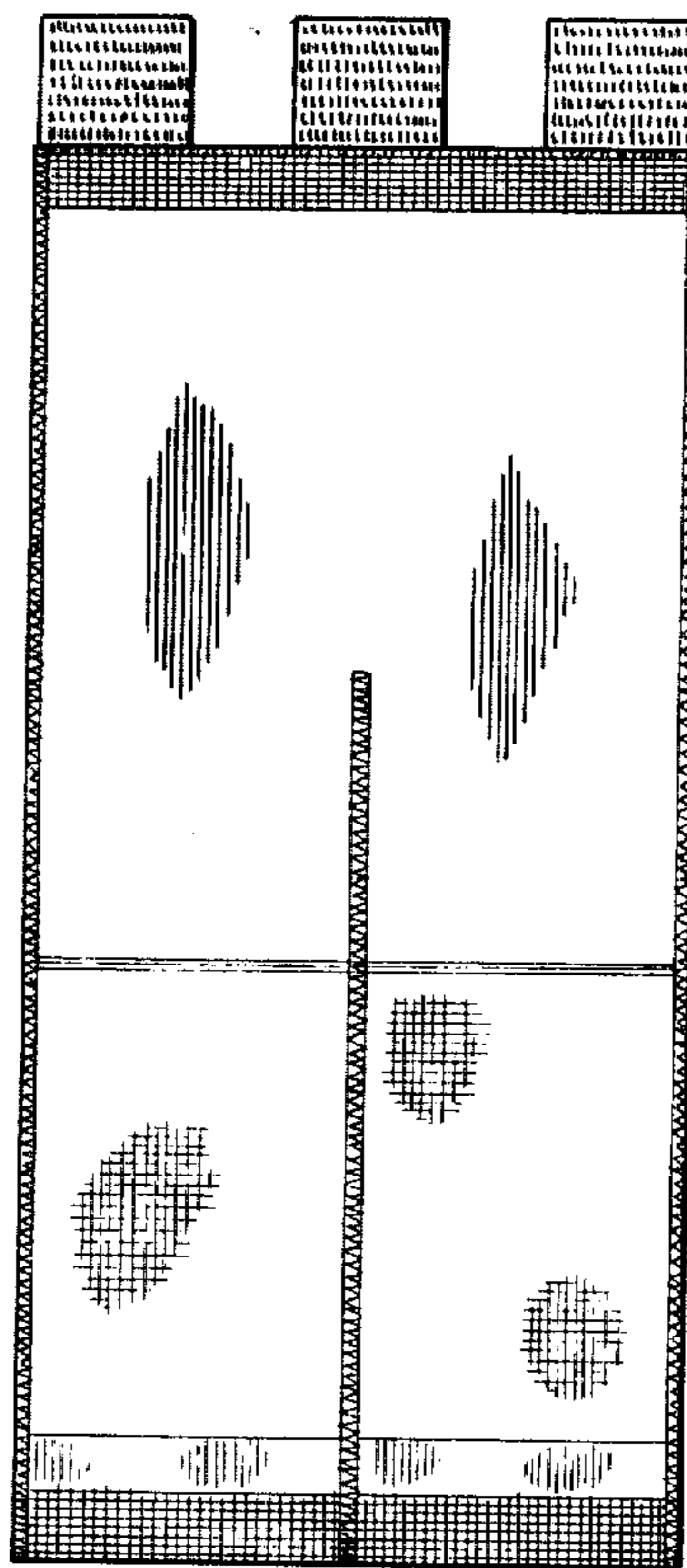

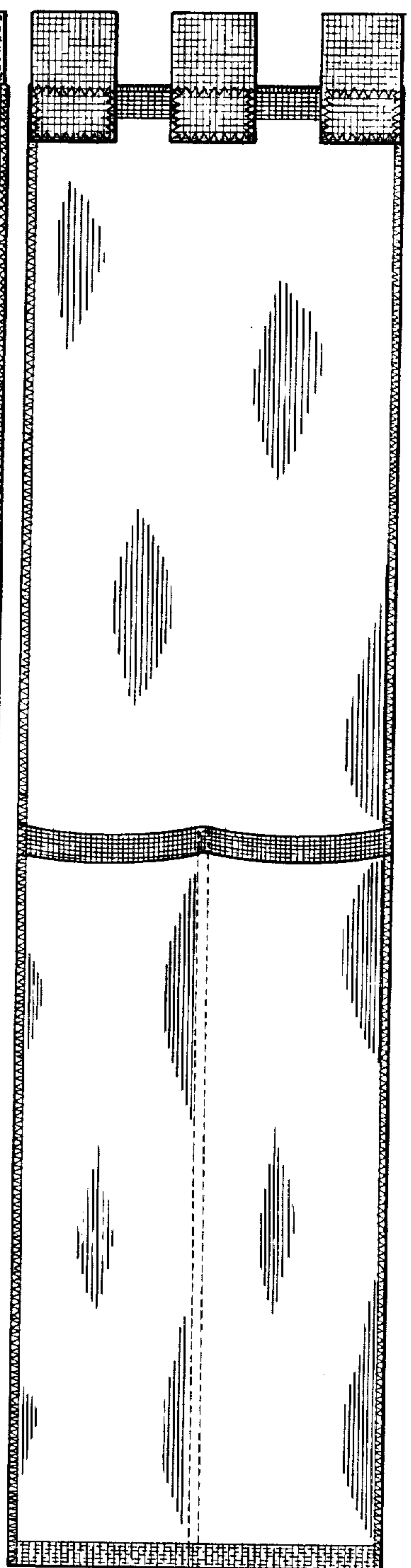
