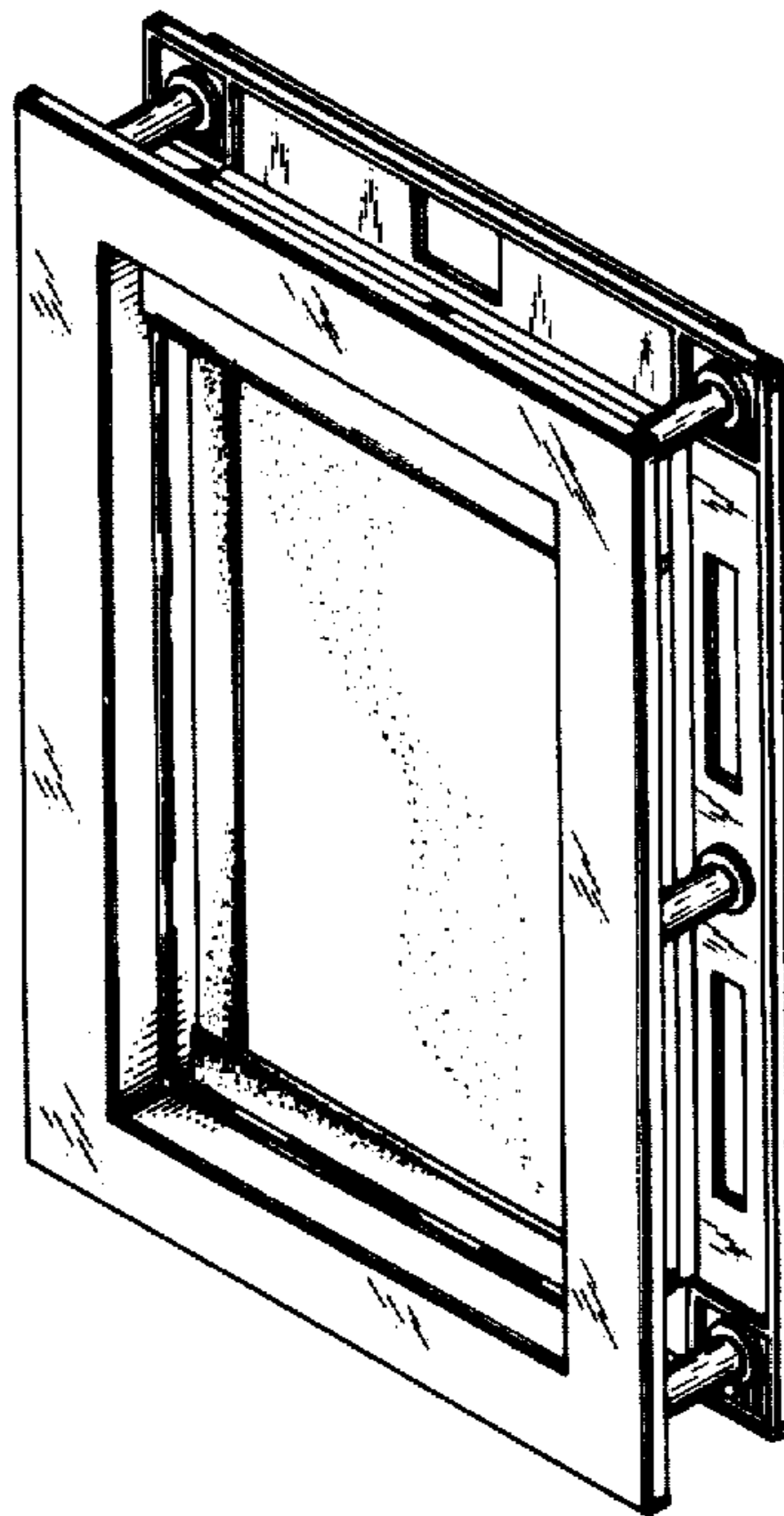

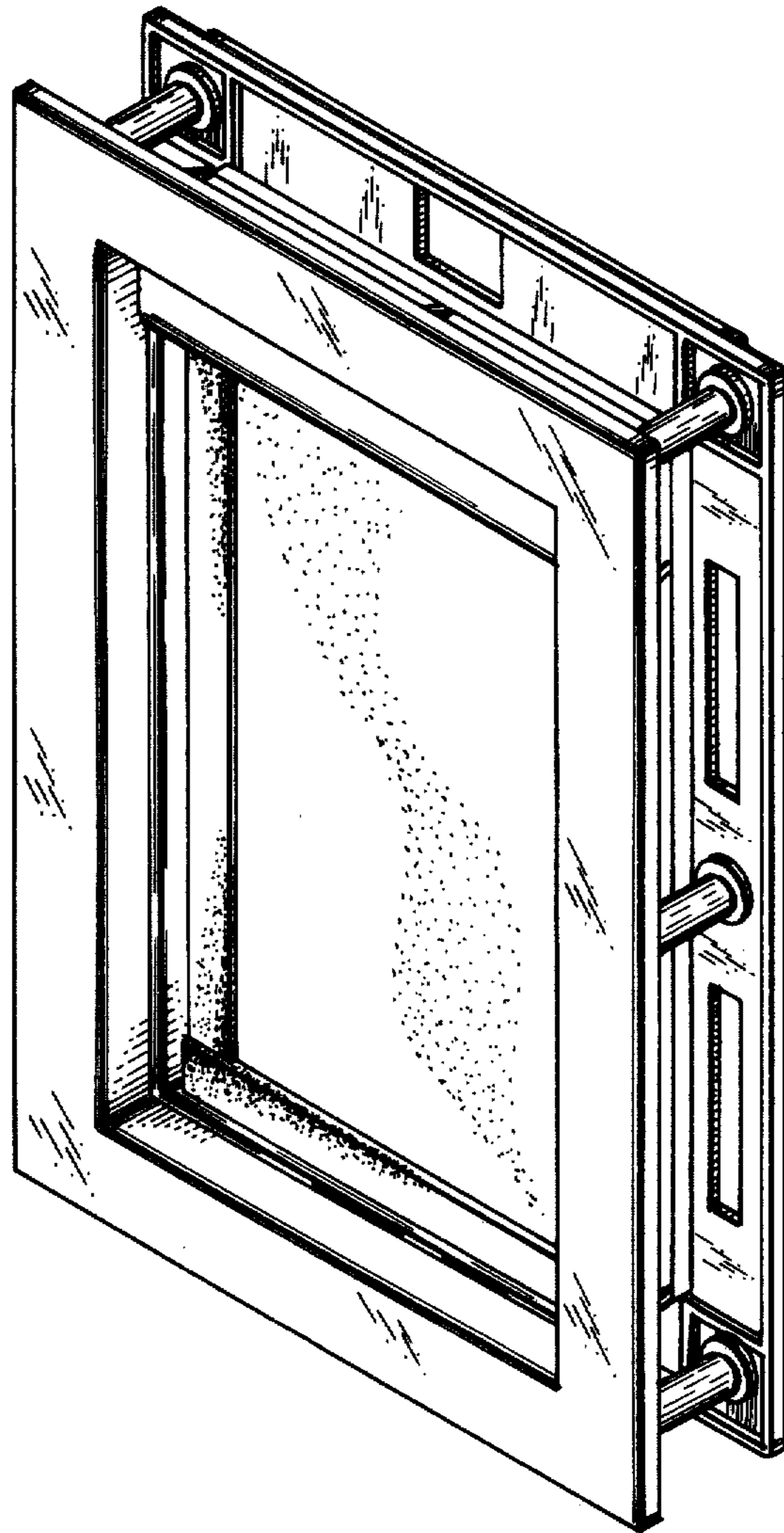
The ornamental design for a pet access door, as shown and described.

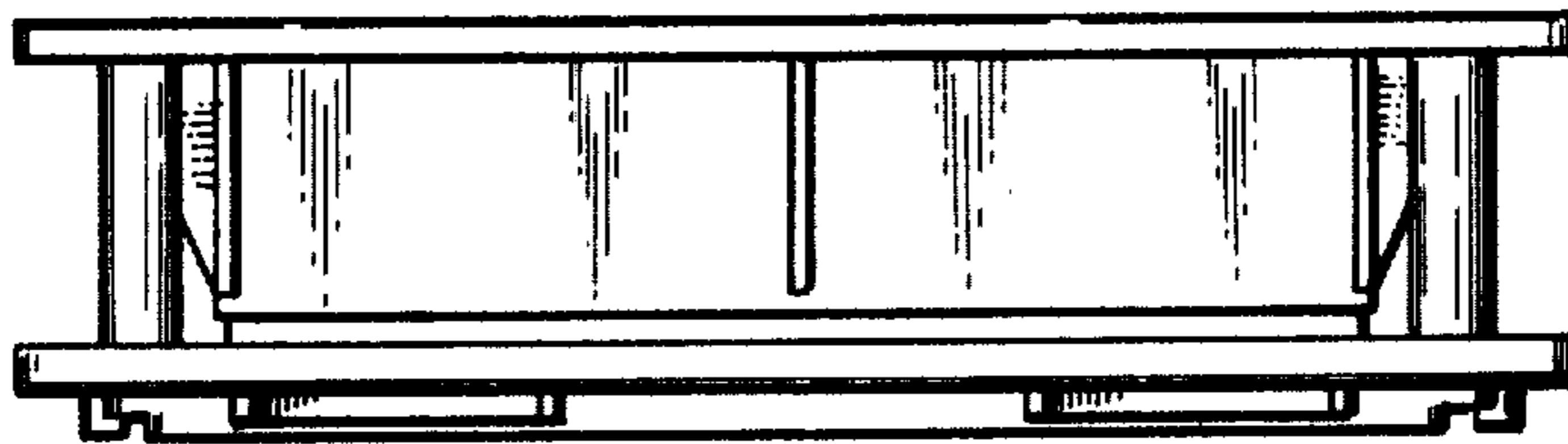

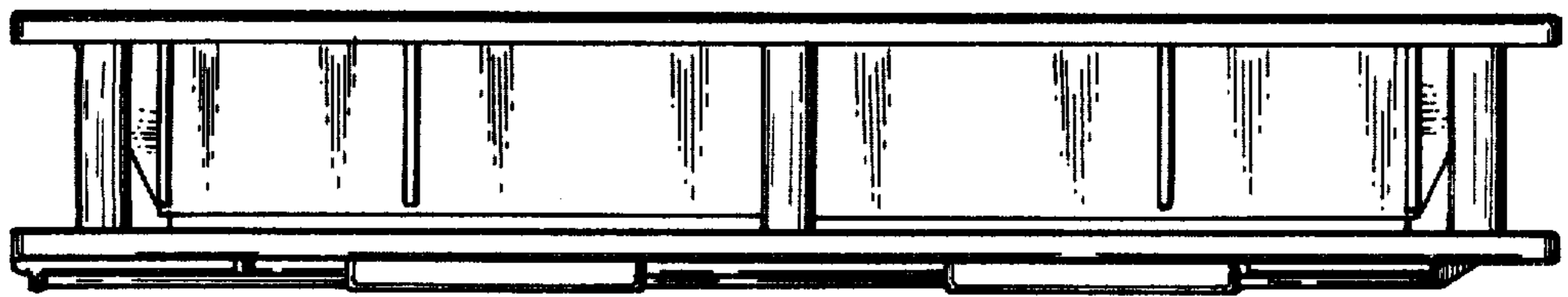
