DESCRIPTION

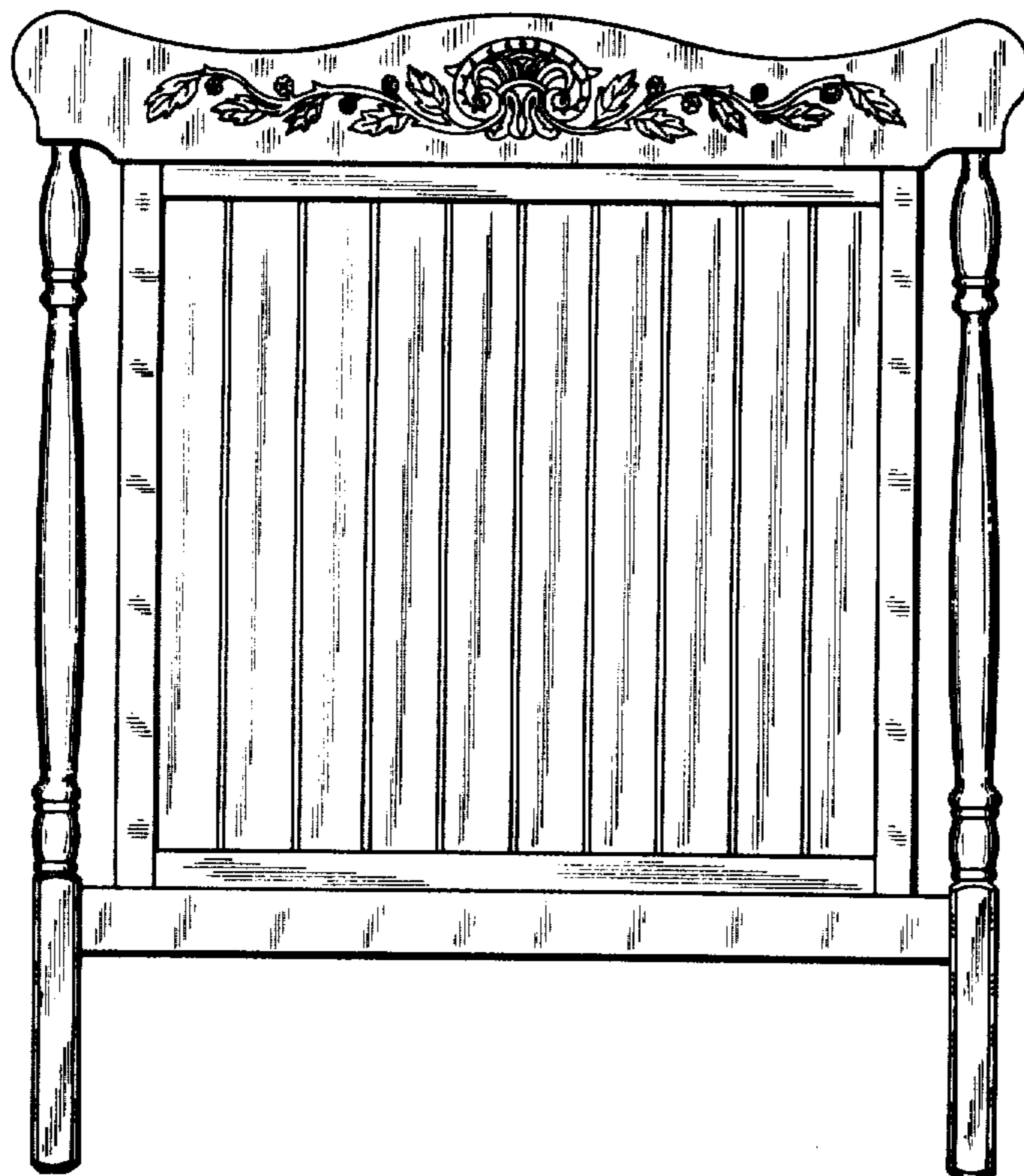
FIG. 1 is a front elevational view of a twin headboard showing our new design;

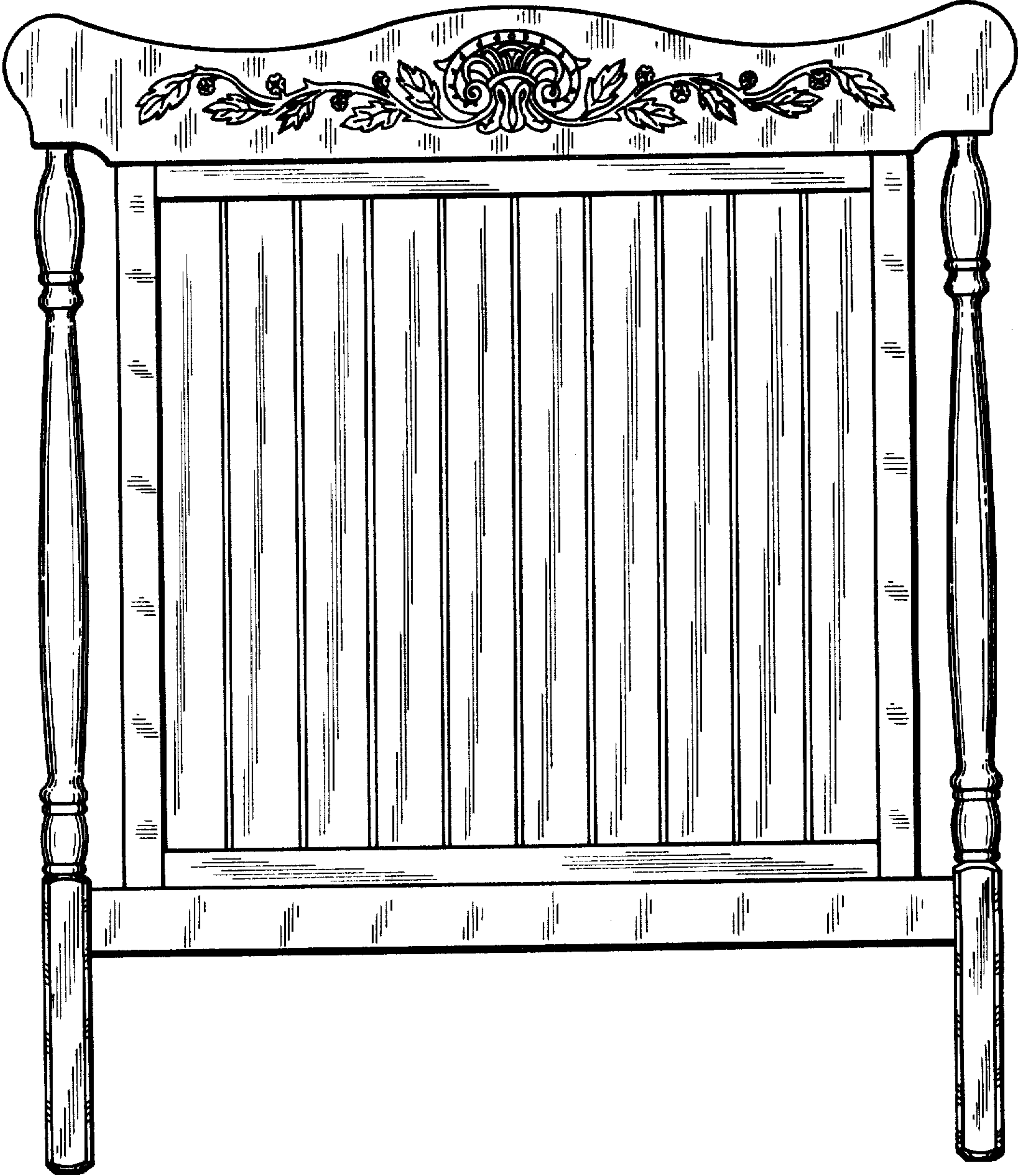
FIG. 2 is a top plan view;

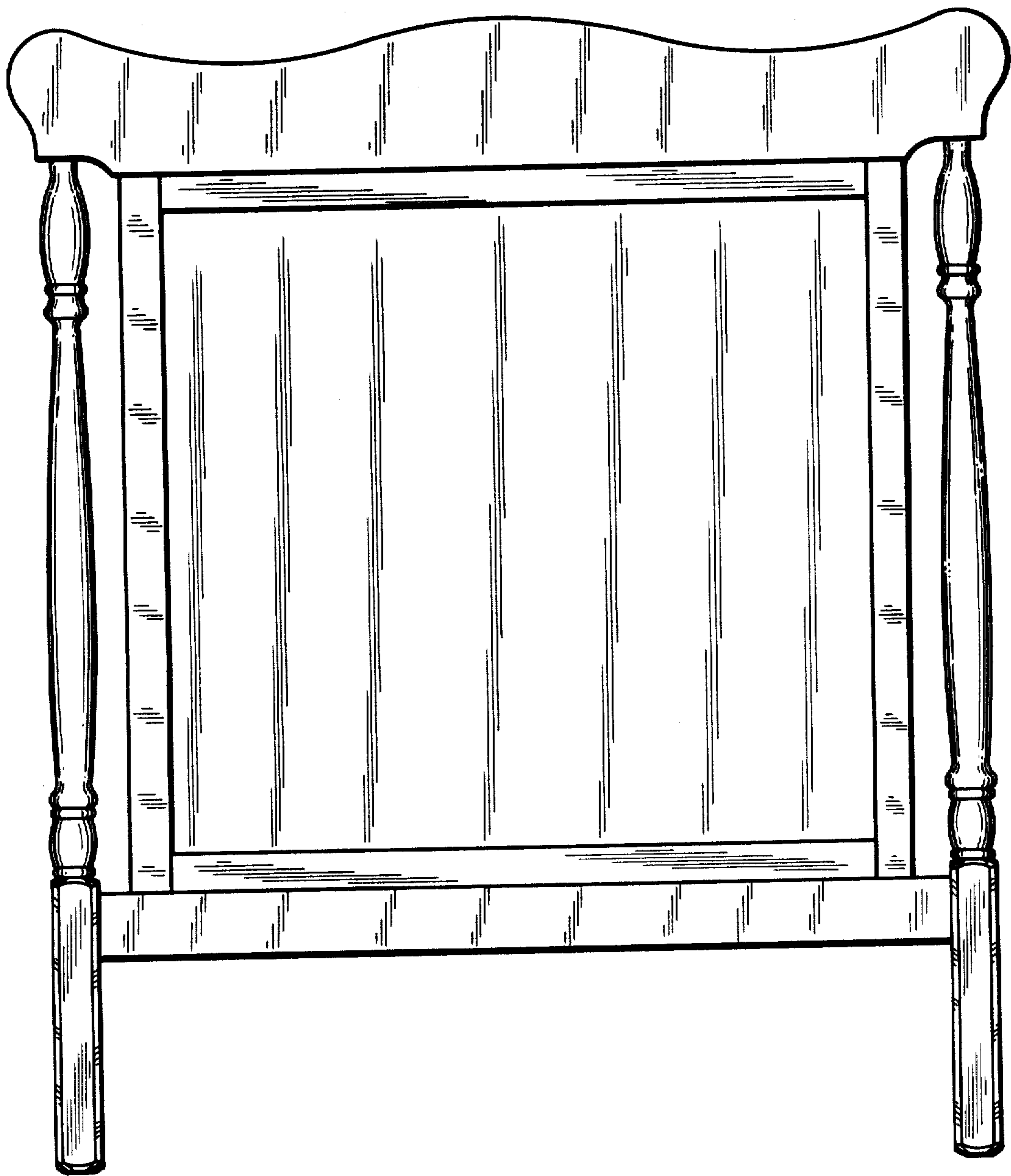
