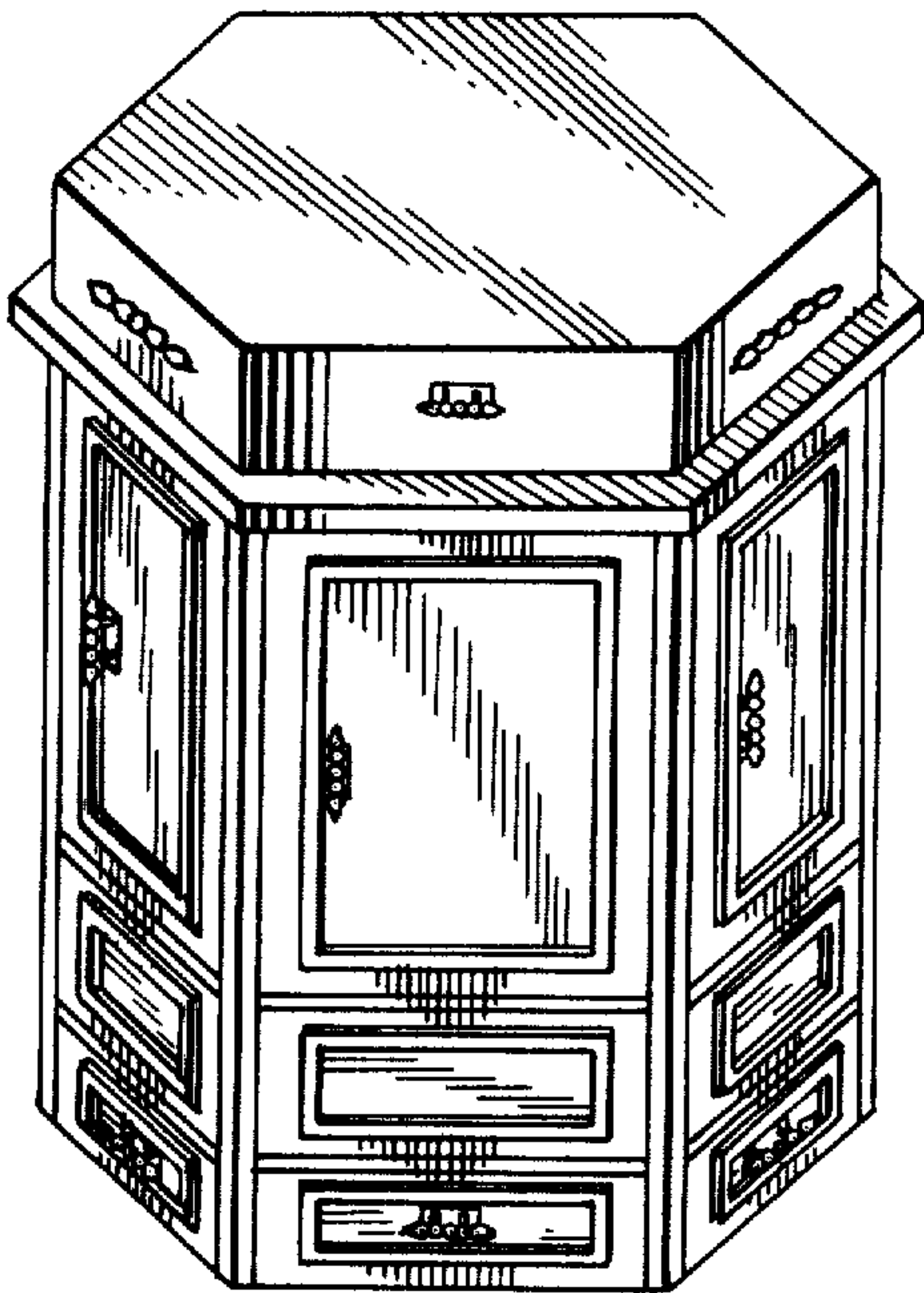

FIG. 4 is a rear perspective view thereof. The bottom is plain and unornamented.



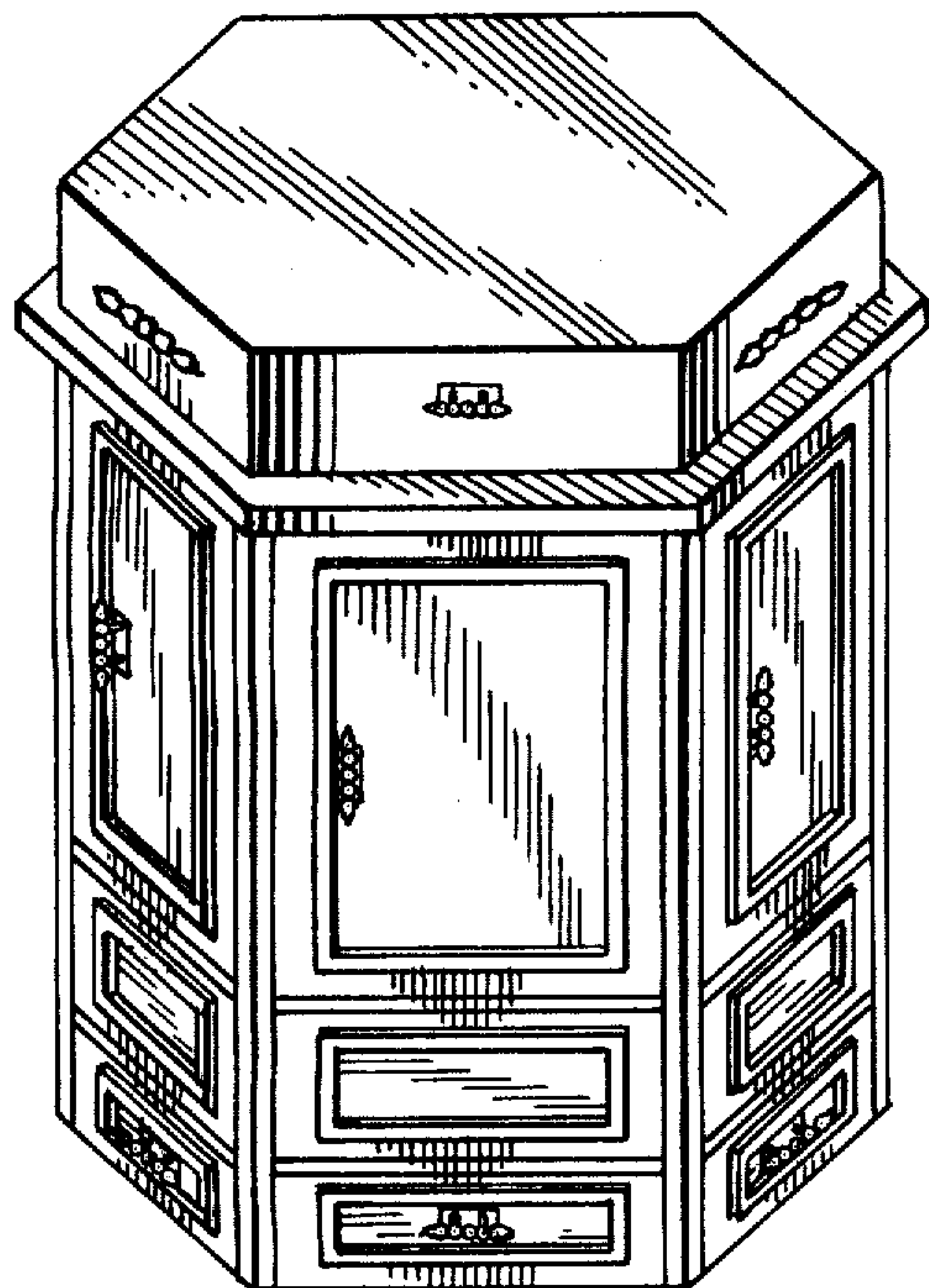

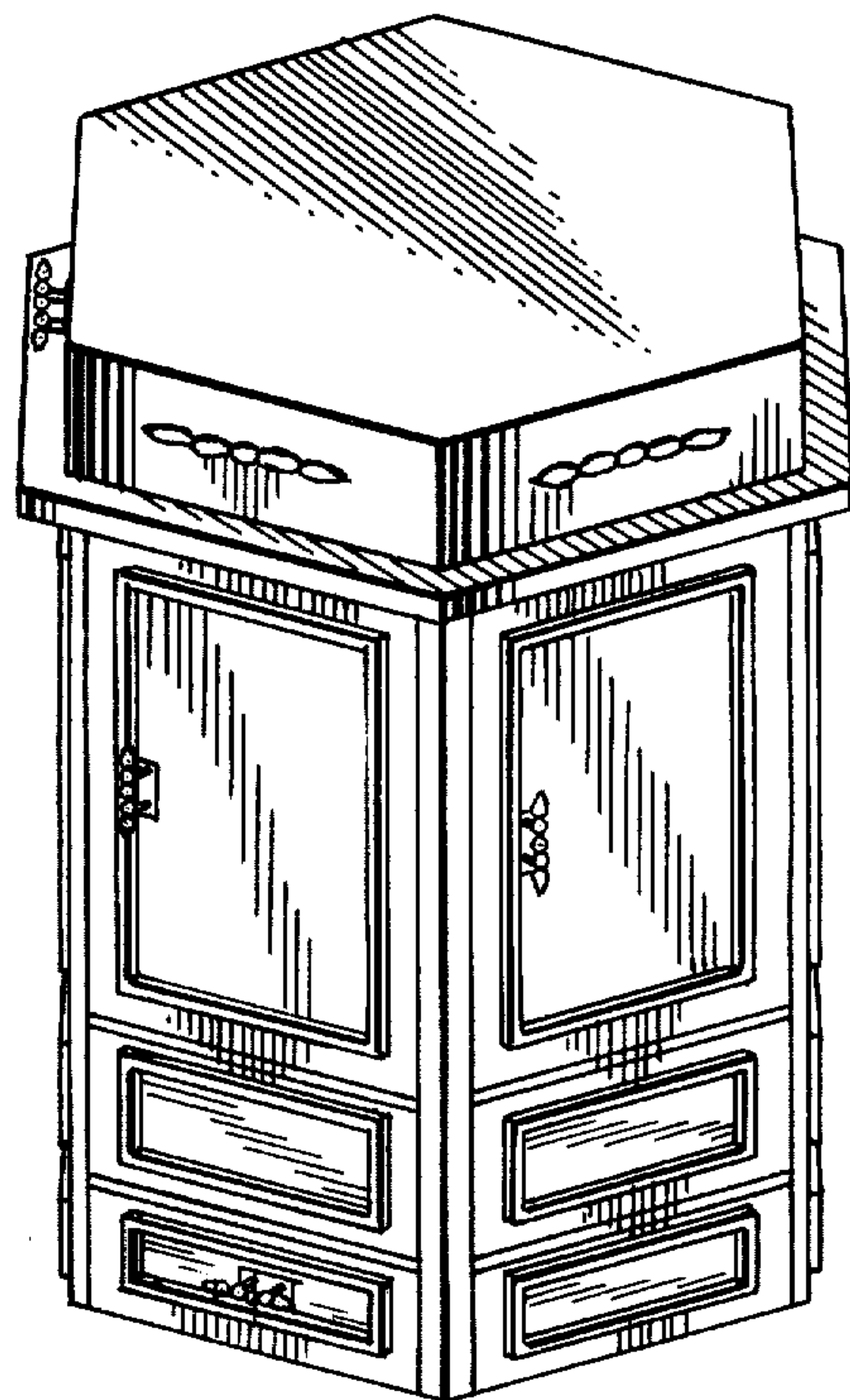

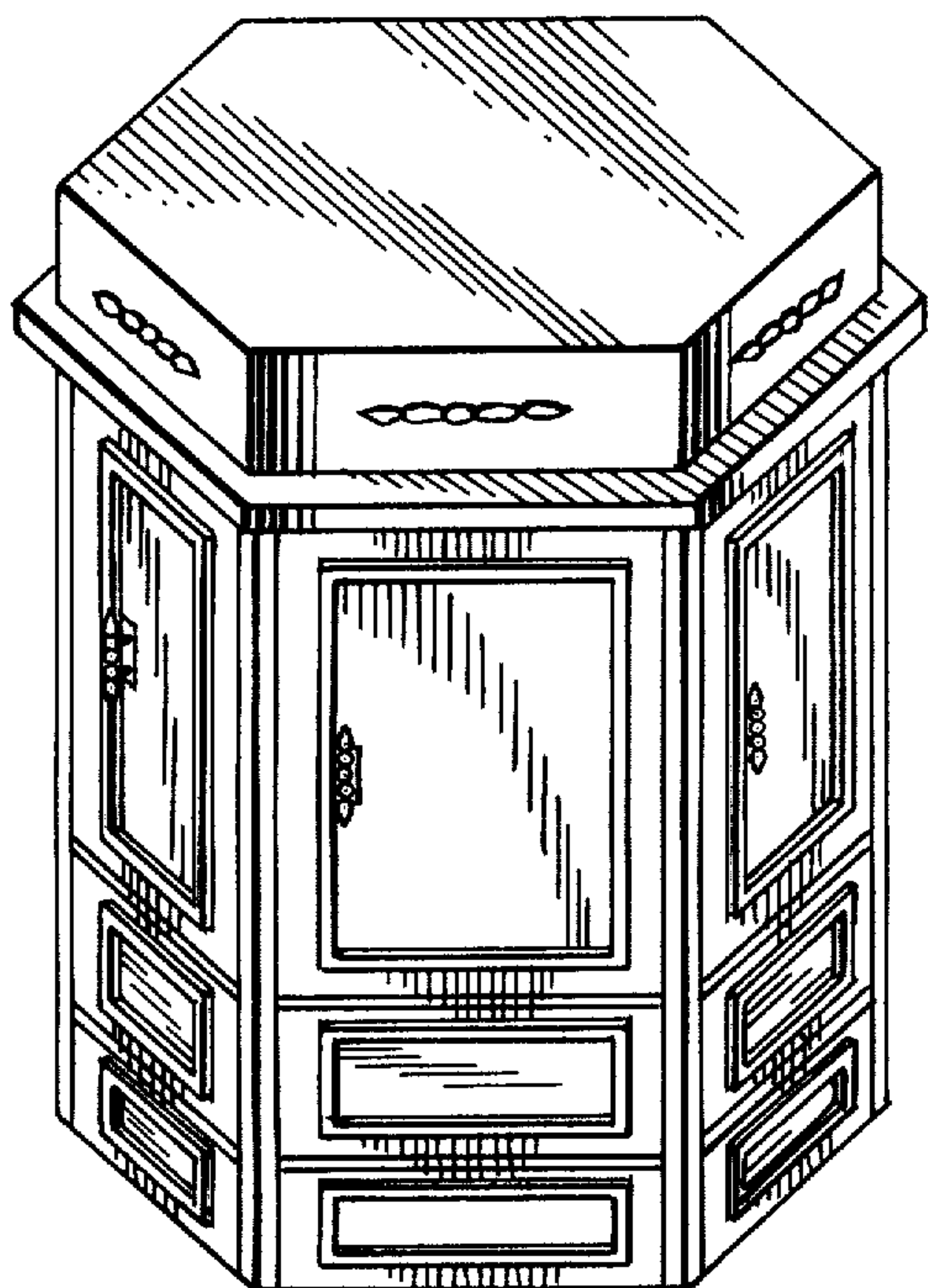

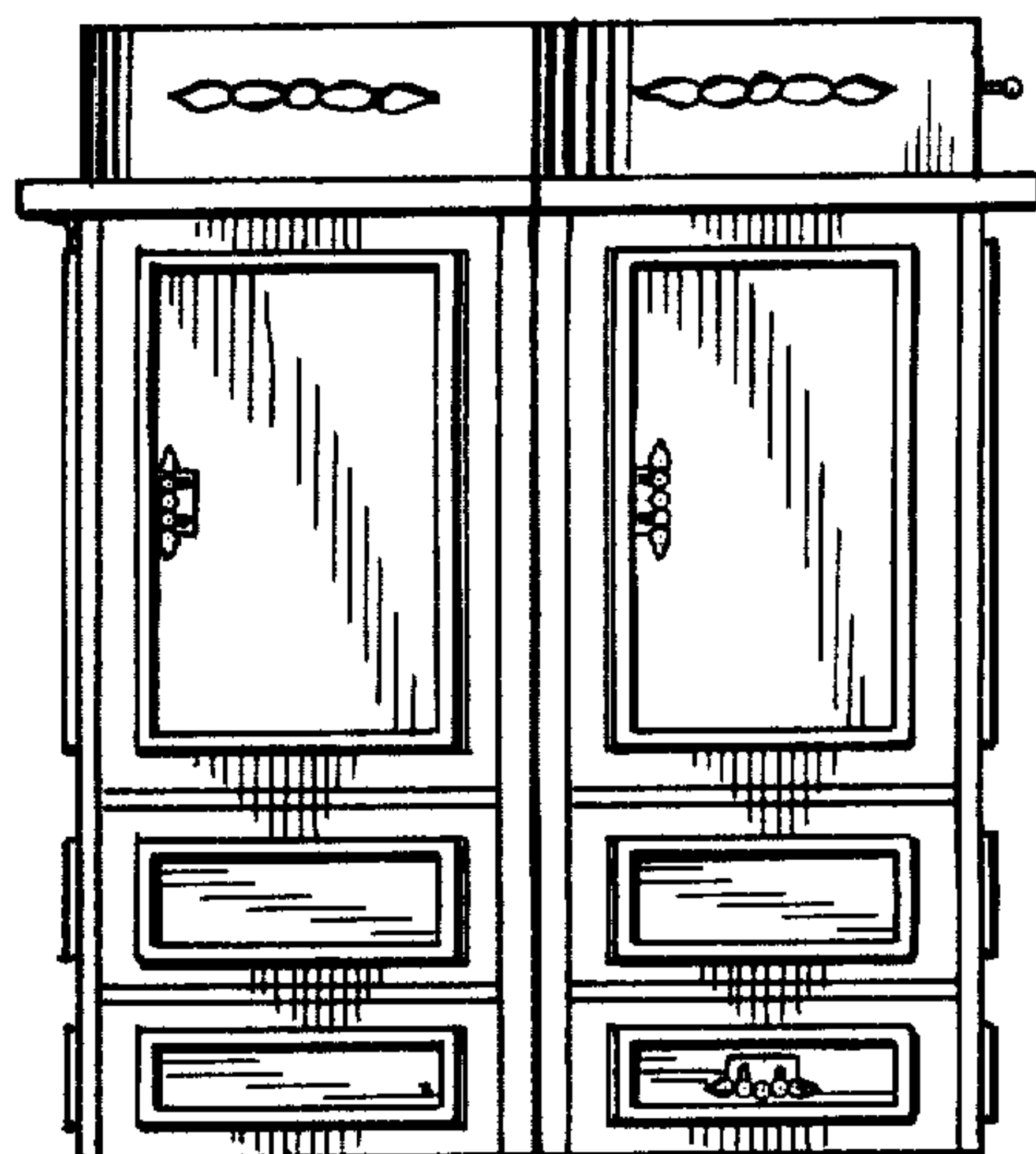
