FIG. 2 is a bottom plan view thereof;

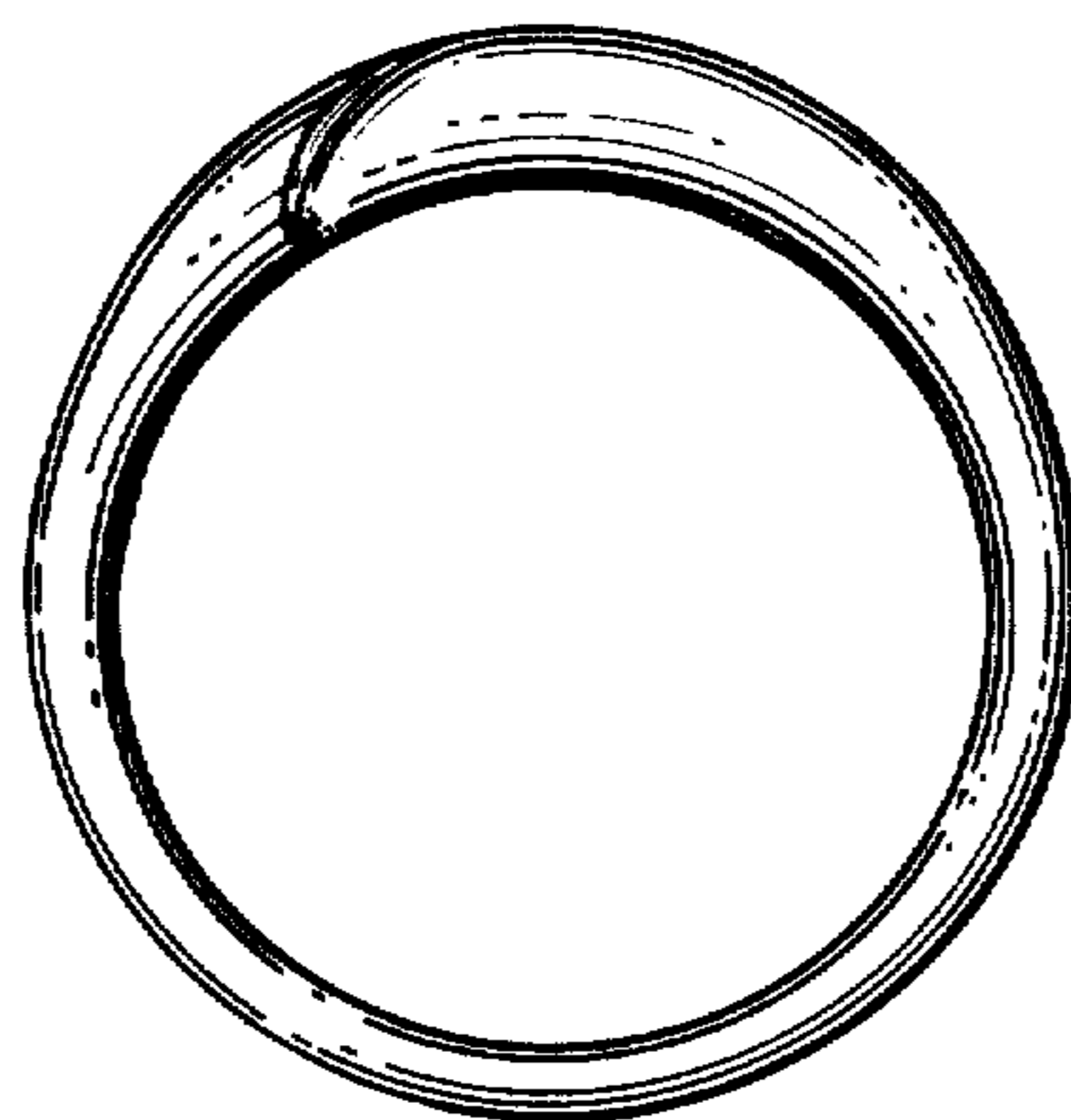
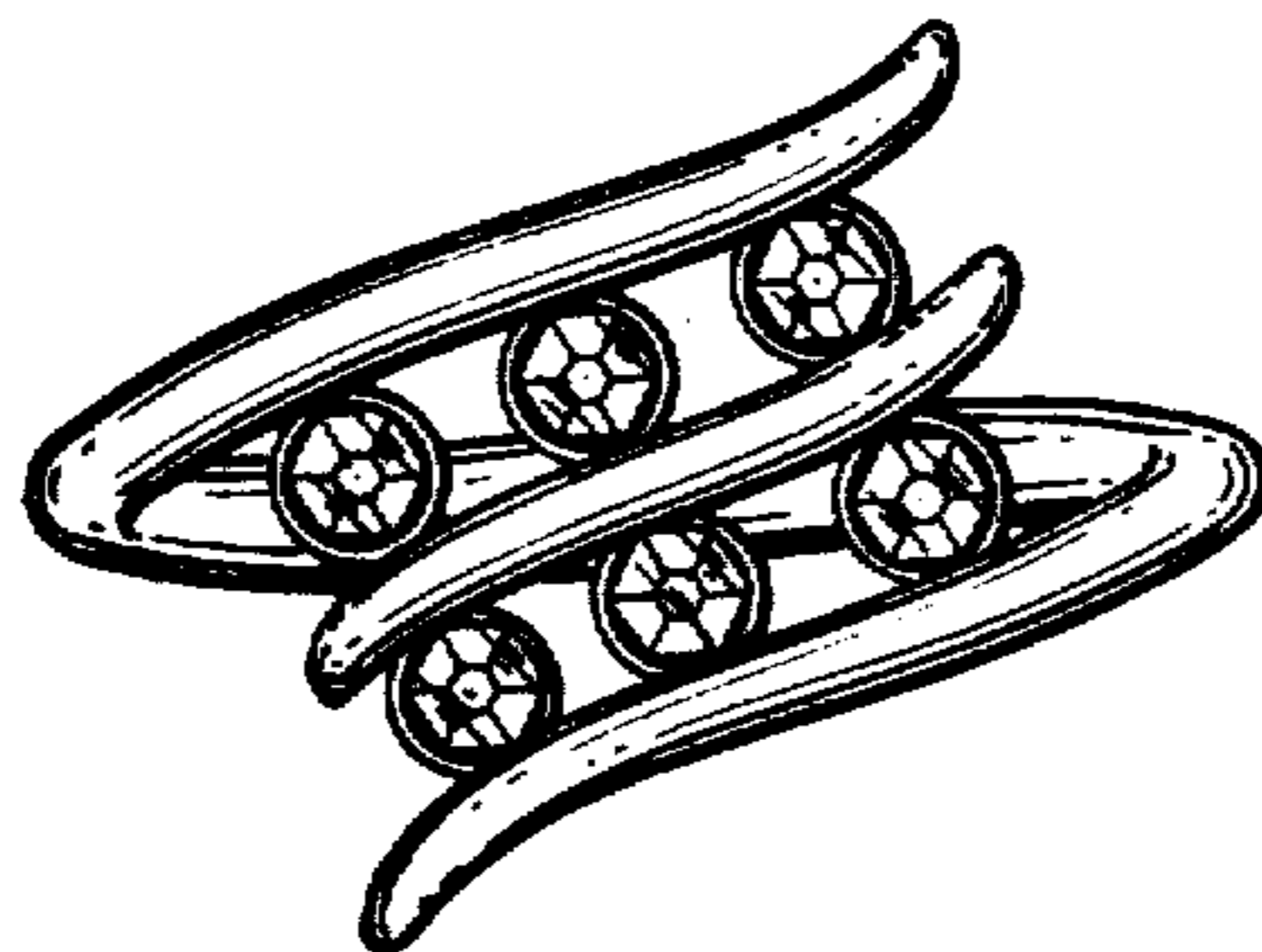
FIG. 3 is an end elevational view thereof, the opposite end being the same; and

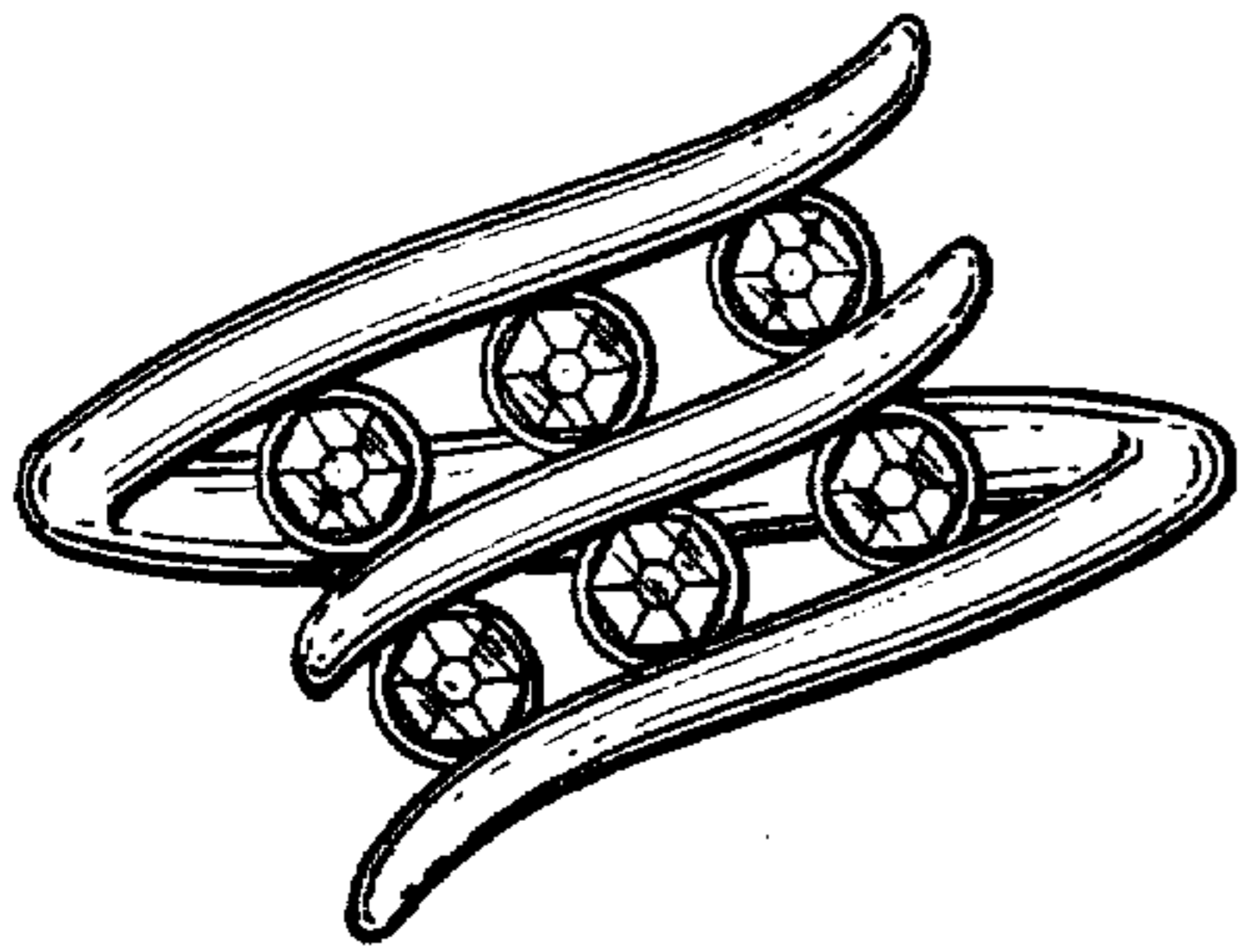

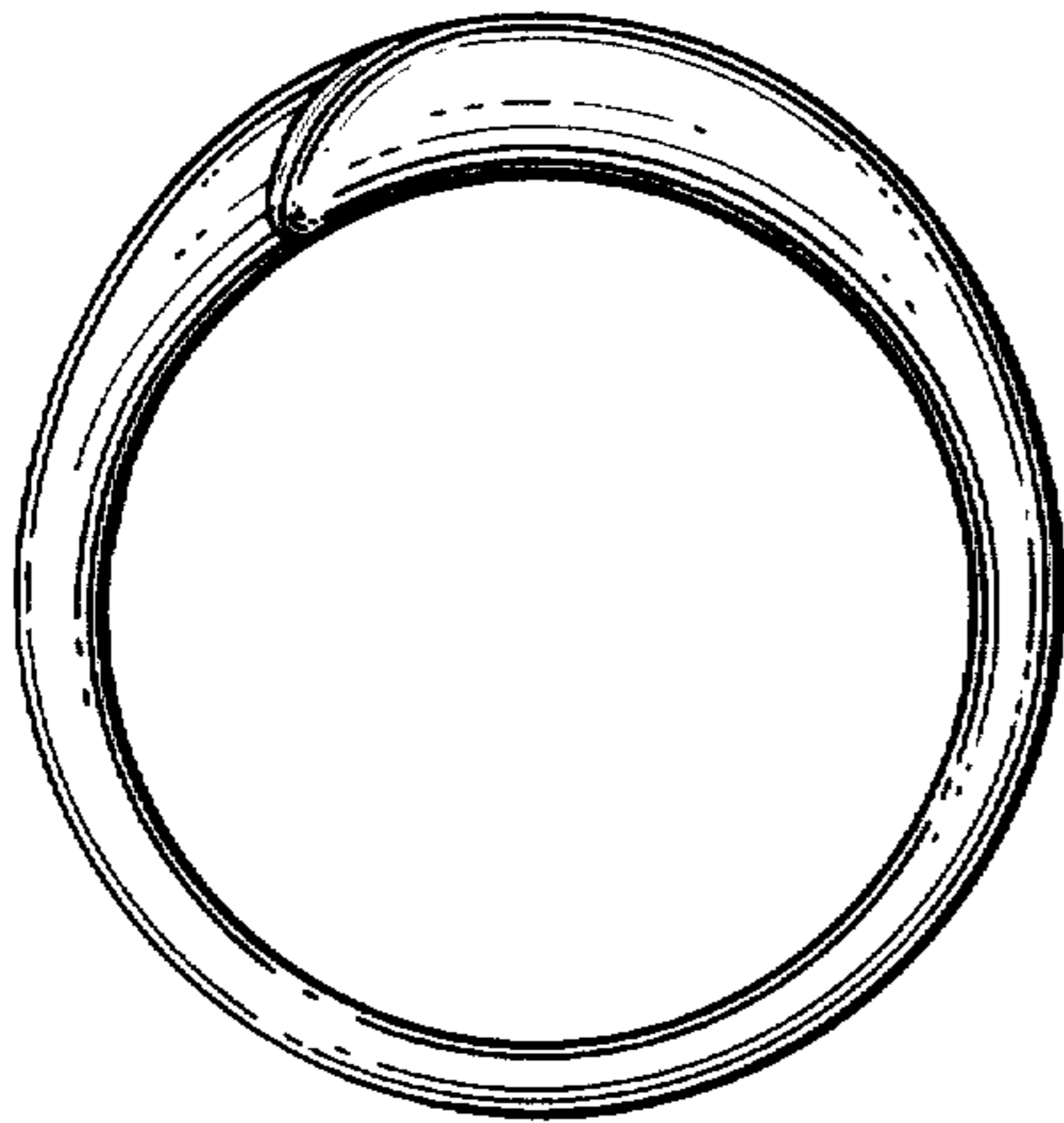

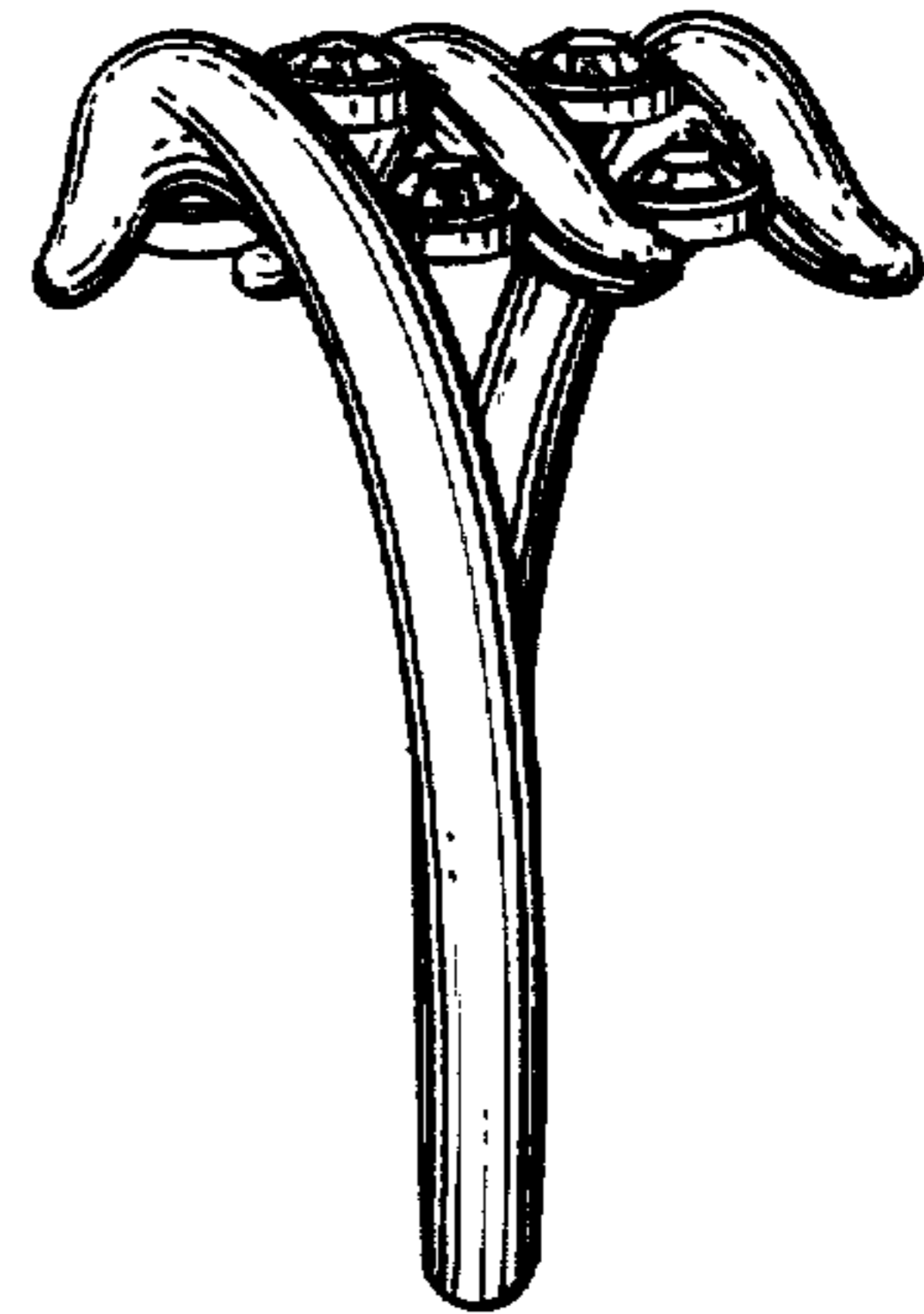

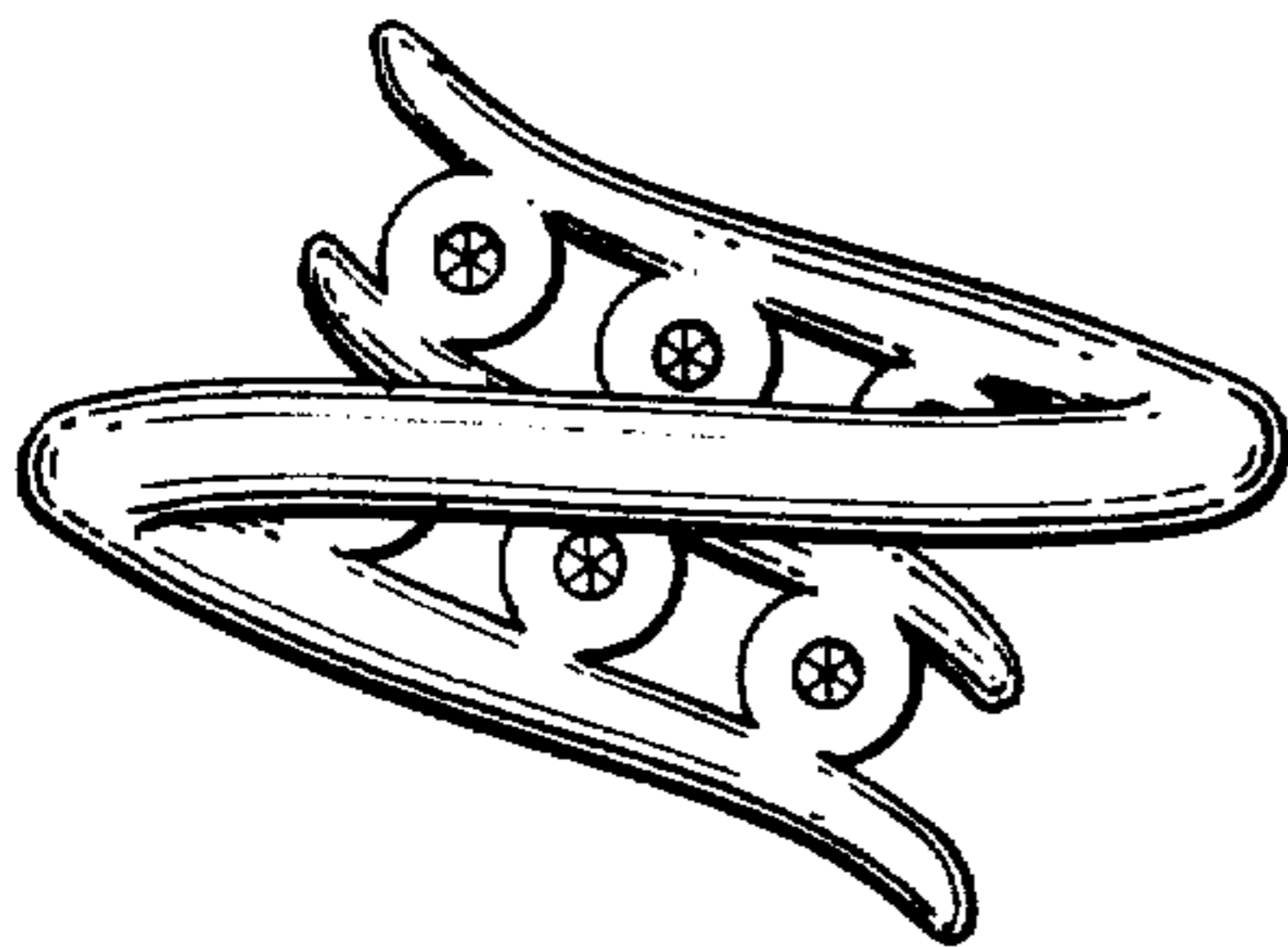
