DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a front perspective view of a ring showing my new design;

FIG. 2 is a front perspective view of a ring showing a modified form of my new design;

FIG. 3 is a side elevational view of the ring of FIG. 1 with the opposite side thereof being of a mirror image; FIG. 4 is a side elevational view of the ring of FIG. 2 with the opposite side thereof being of a mirror image; FIG. 5 is a rear elevational view of the ring of FIG. 1; and

FIG. 6 is a rear elevational view of the ring of FIG. 2.
