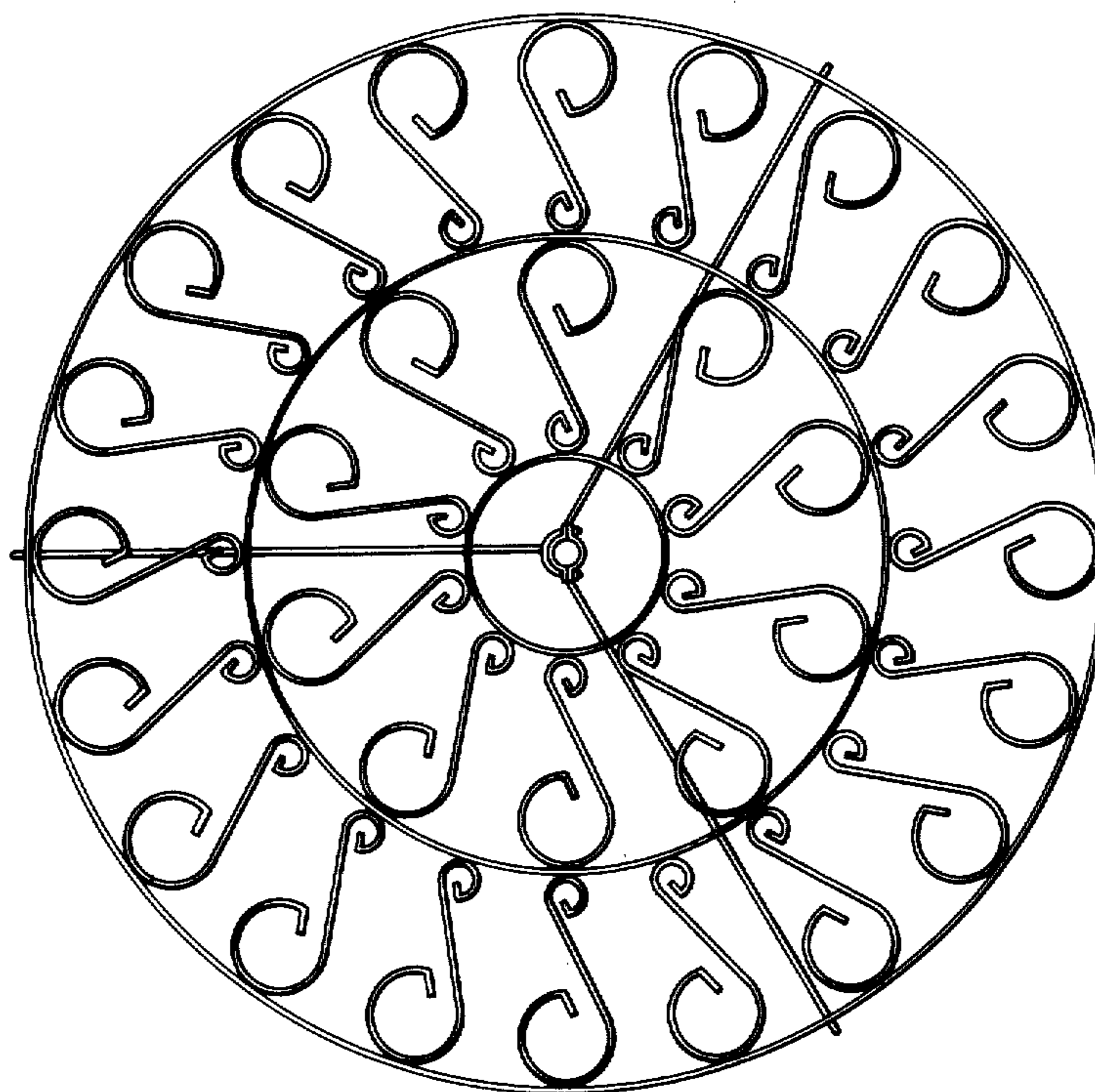

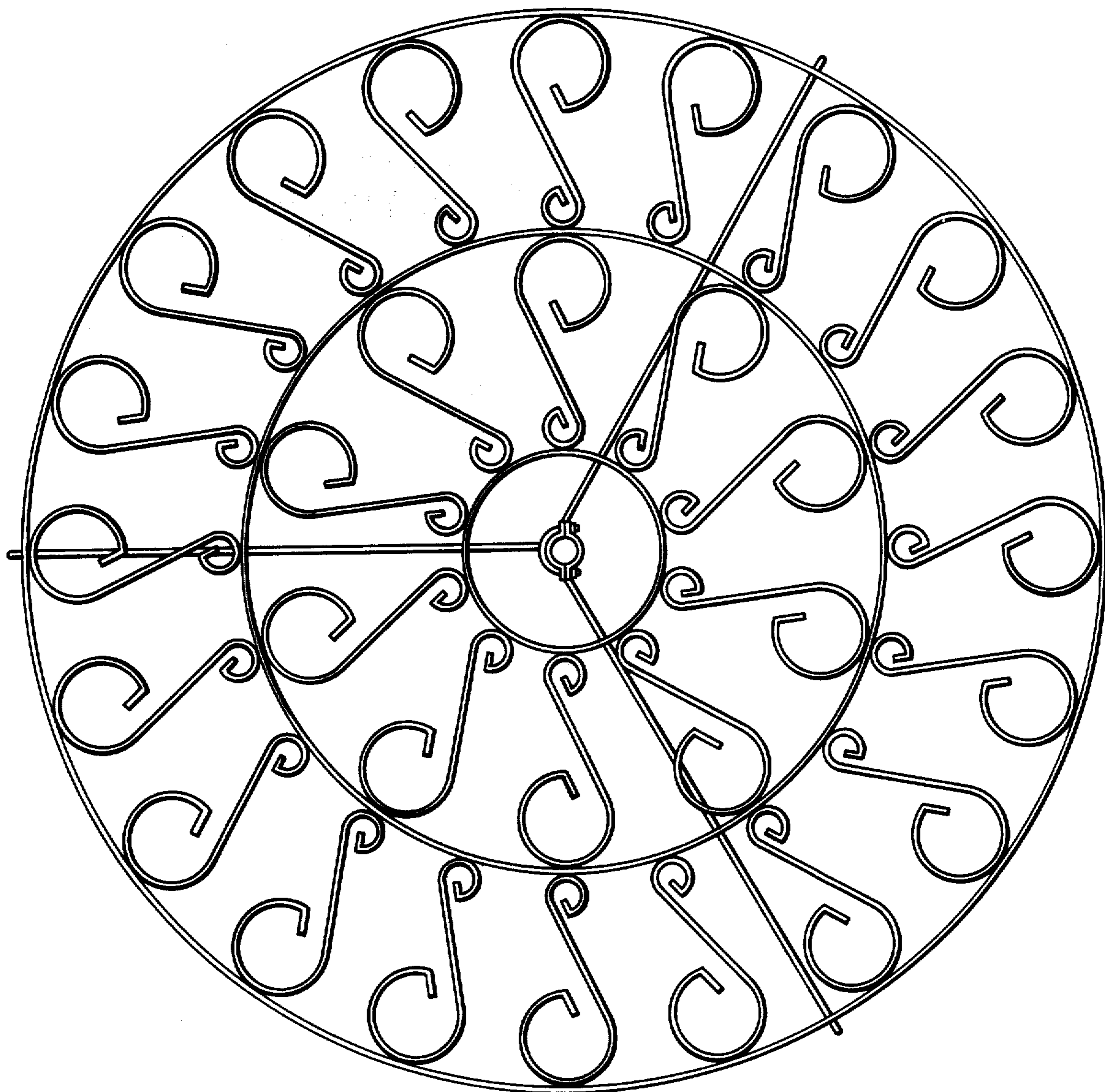
[57] **CLAIM**

The ornamental design for a shield for ceiling fans and the like, as shown and described.

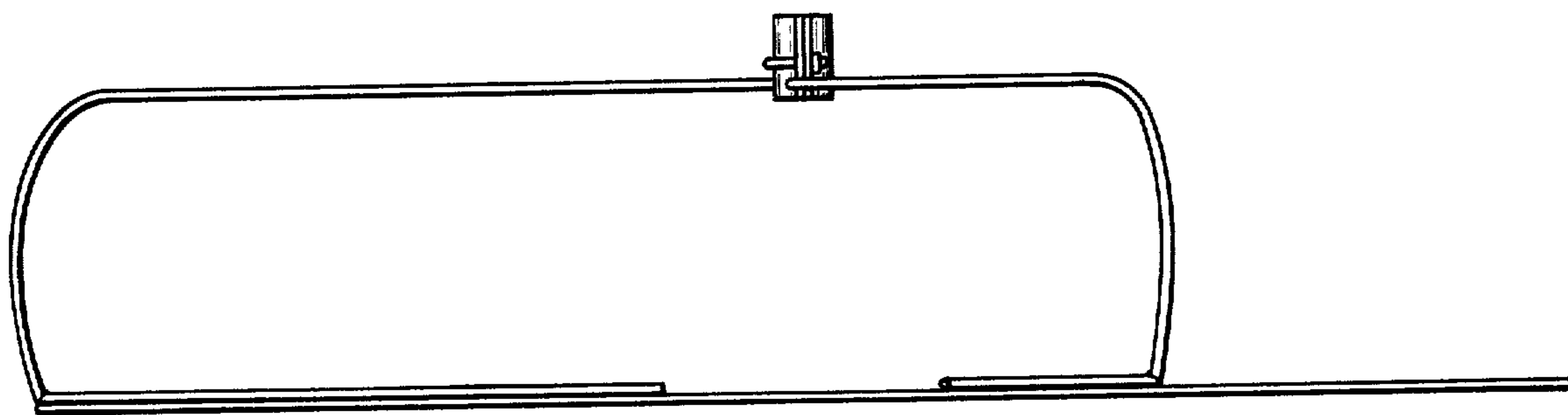
**DESCRIPTION**

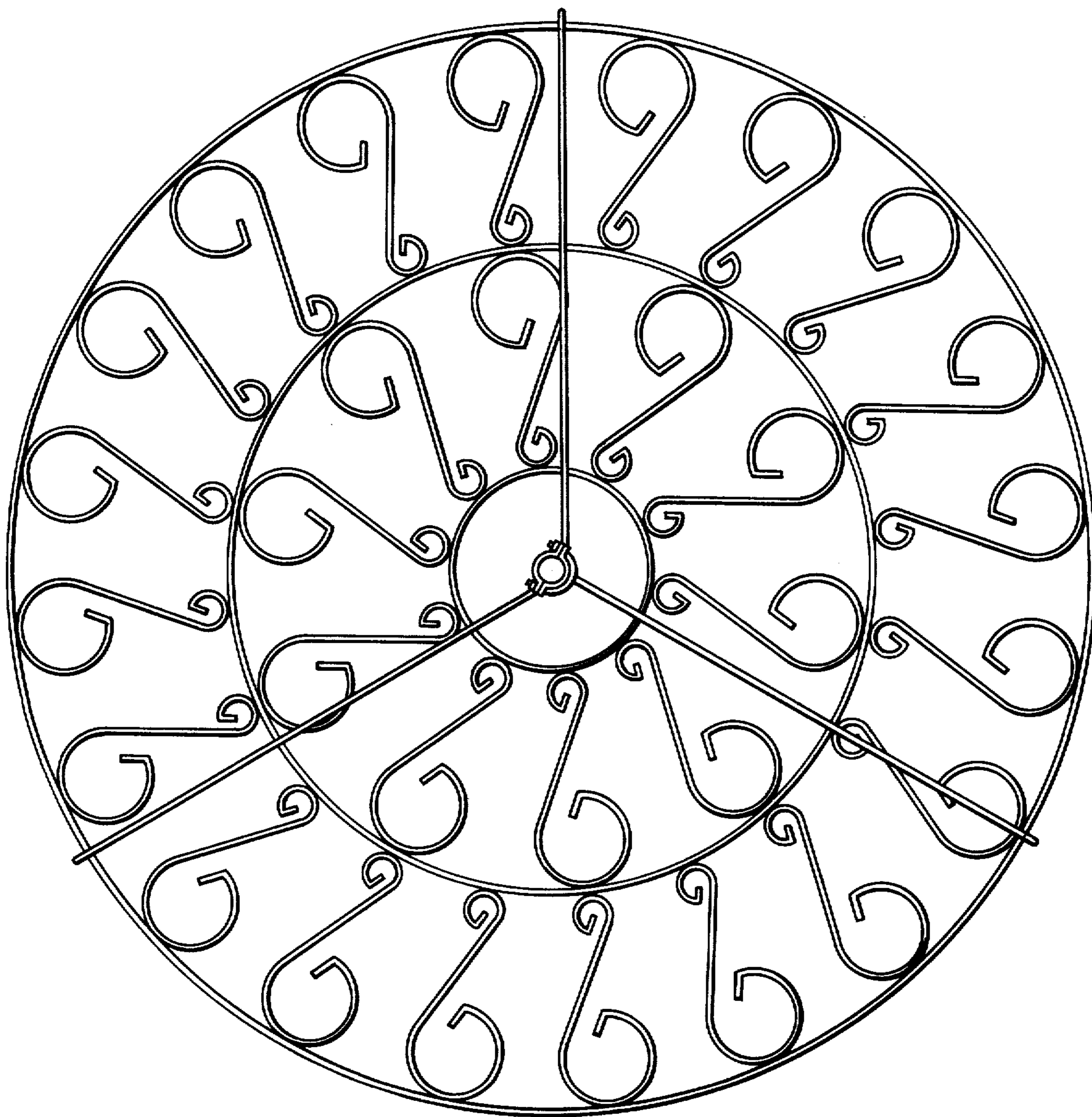

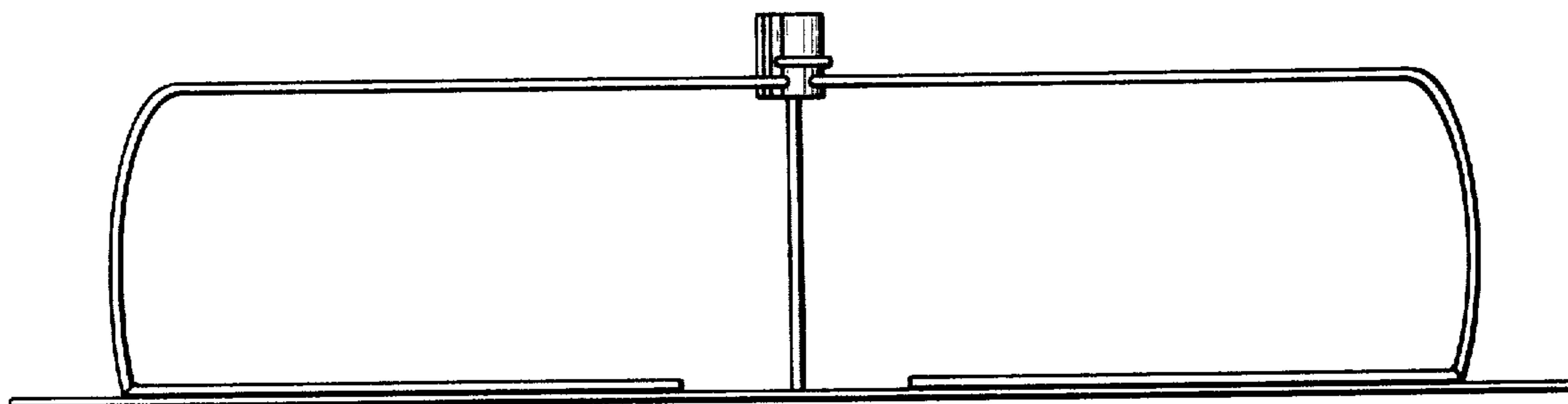
