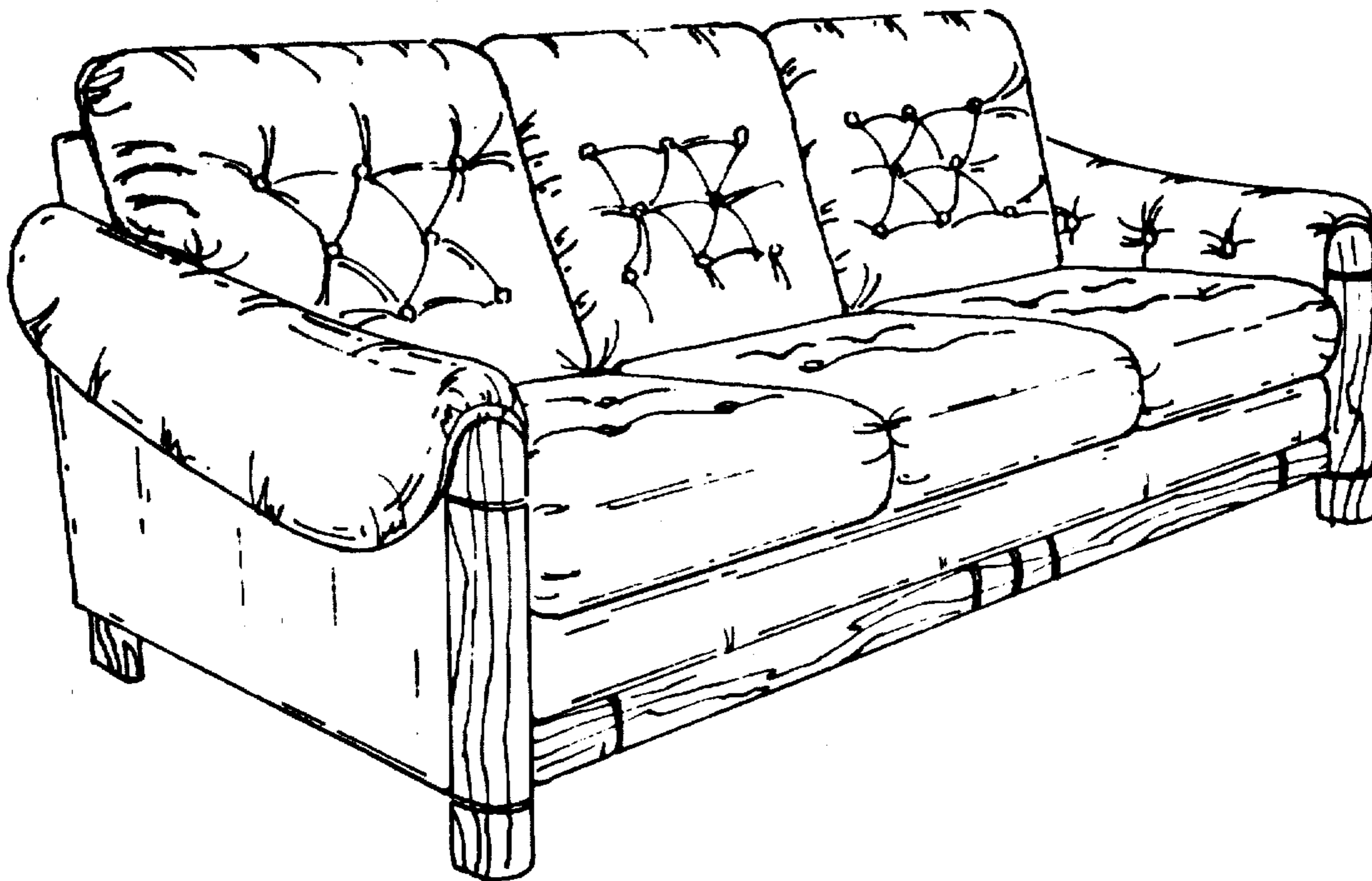
CLAIM
