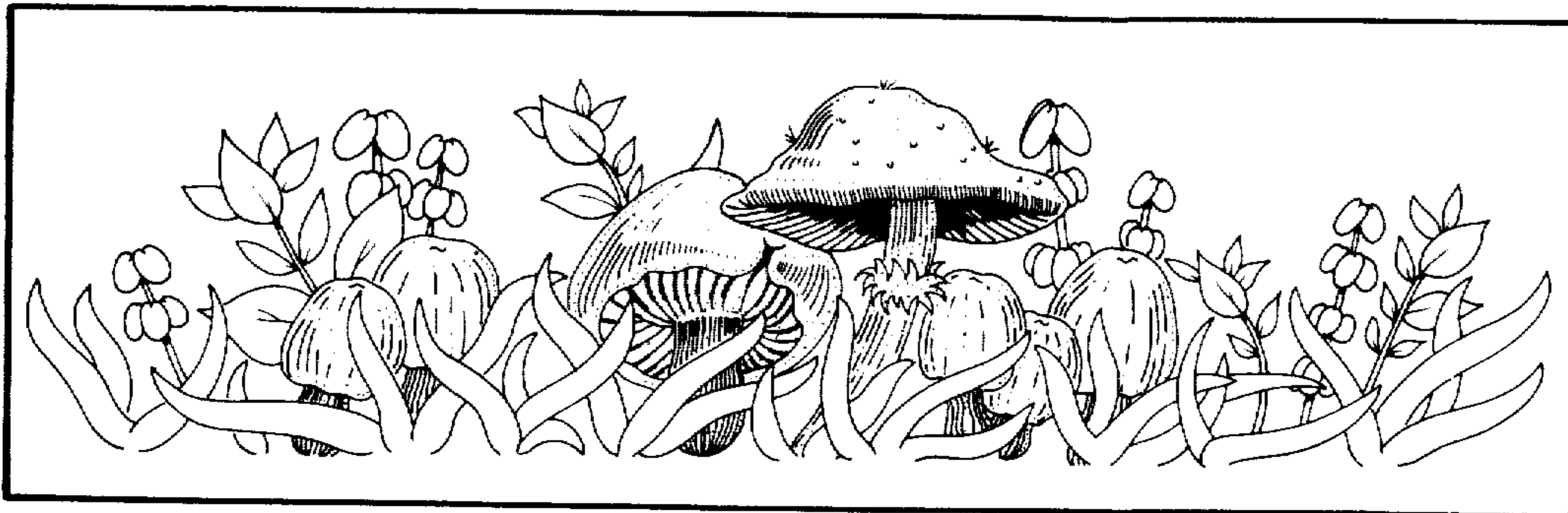
[57] CLAIM
