[57] CLAIM

The ornamental design for a combined packaging and shipping container, as shown and described.

DESCRIPTION

FIG. 1 is a perspective view of a combined packaging and shipping container showing our design;
 FIG. 2 is a top plan view;
 FIG. 3 is a front elevational view, the opposite side elevational views and the rear elevational view appearing substantially identical;
 FIG. 4 is a bottom plan view;
 FIG. 5 is an enlarged fragmentary cross-sectional view, as viewed along line 5-5 of FIG. 2; and,
 FIG. 6 is an enlarged fragmentary cross-sectional view, as viewed along line 6-6 of FIG. 5.

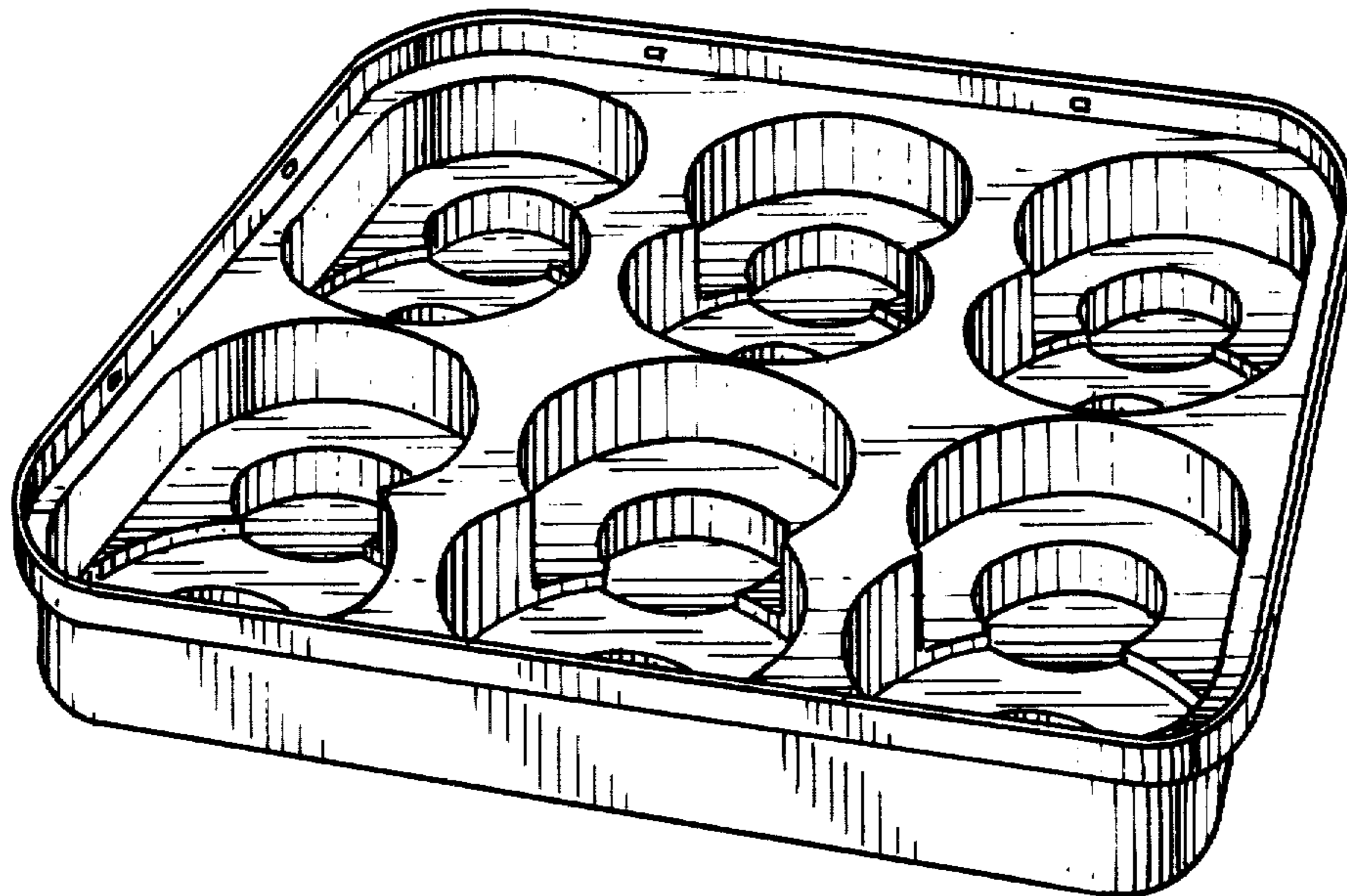

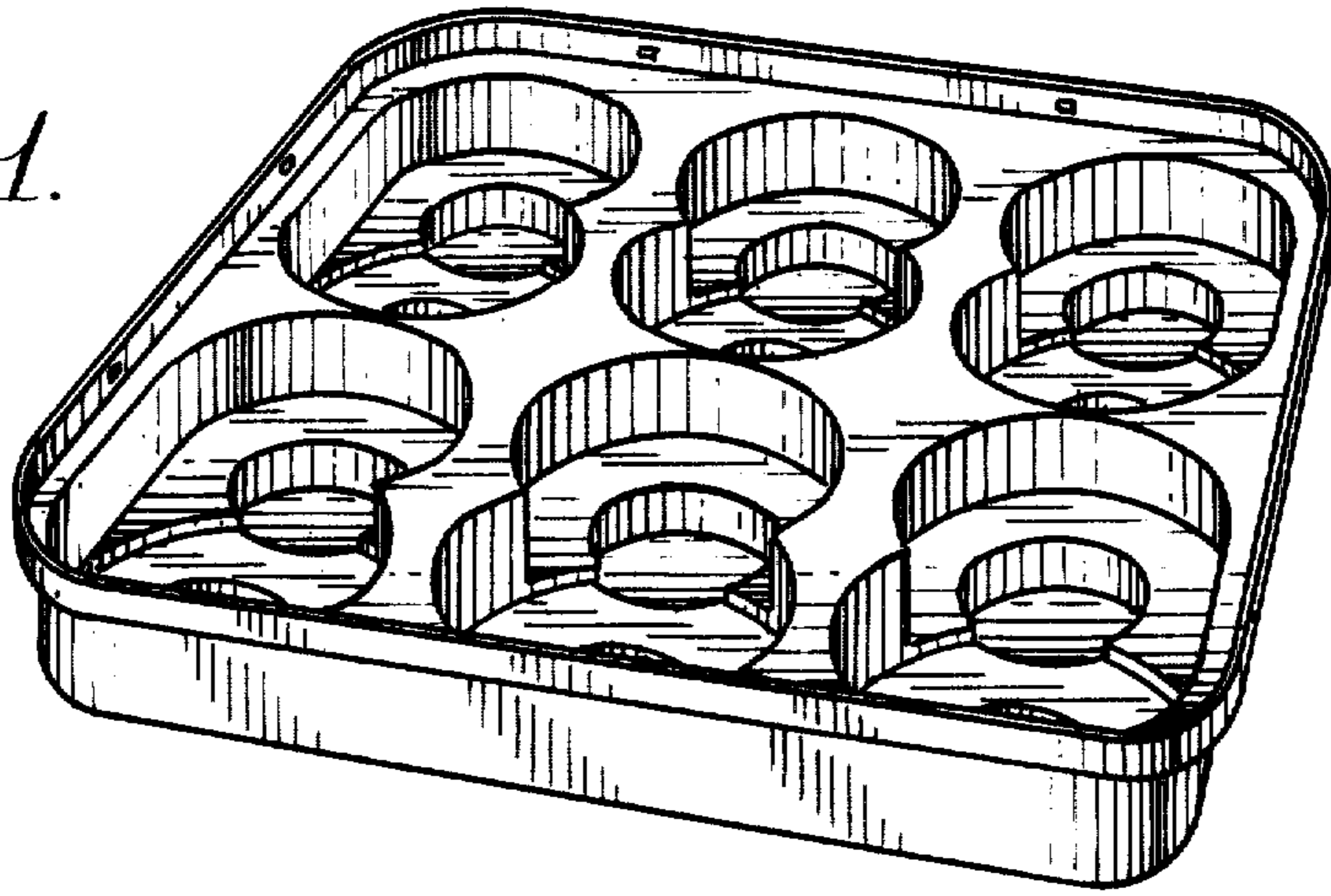

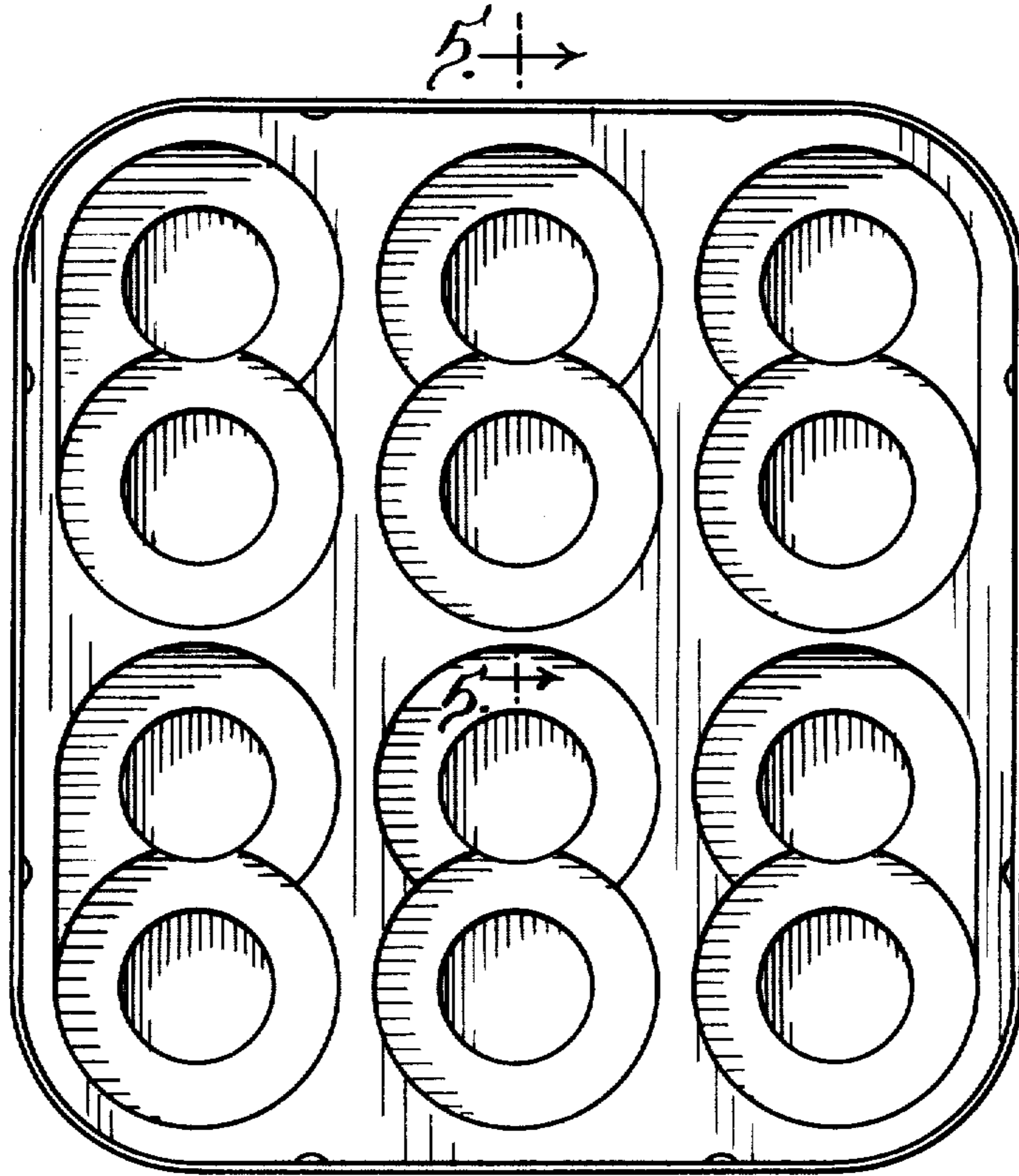

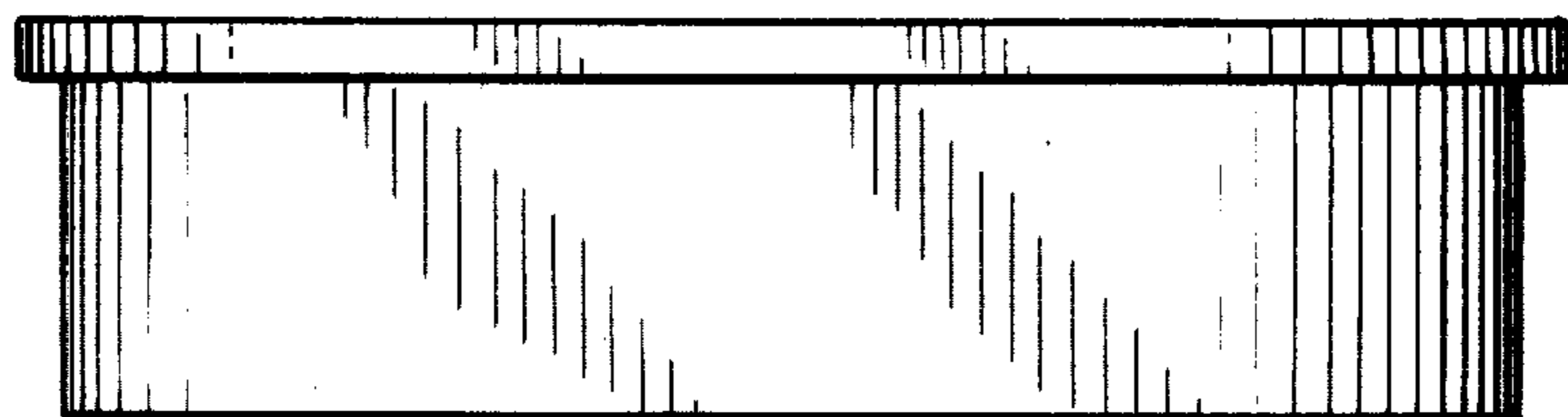

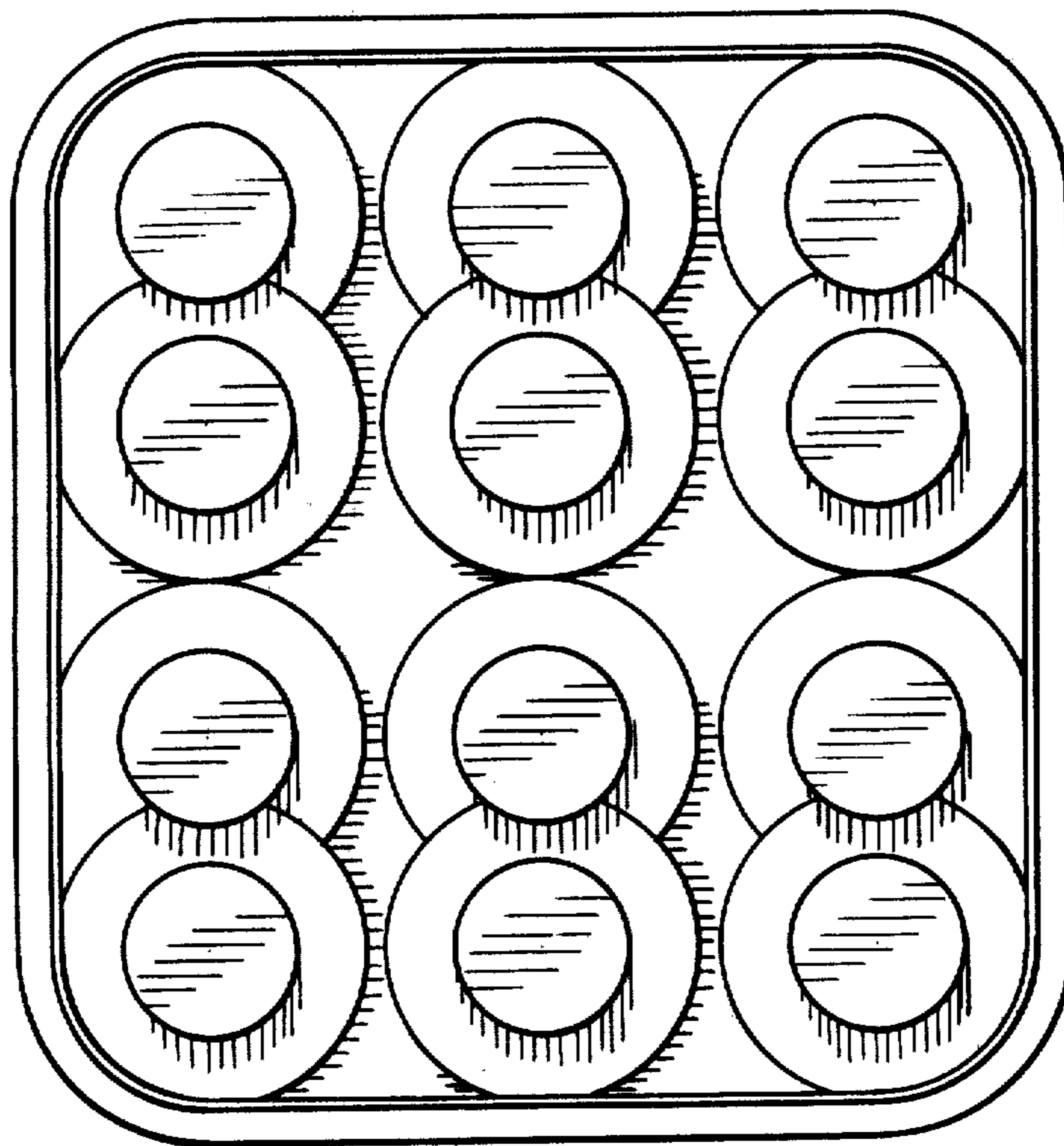

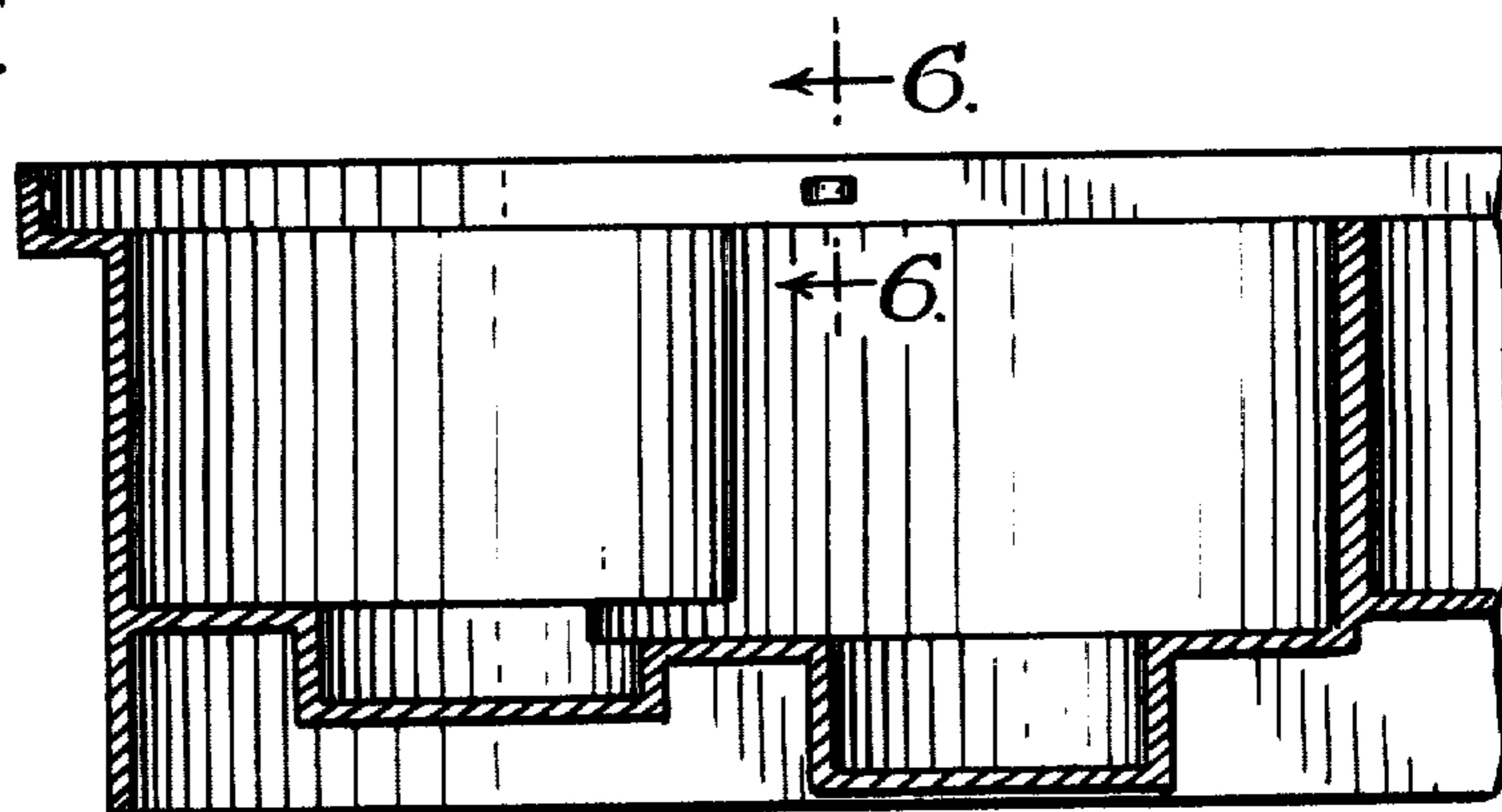
